DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a candle, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; a rear elevational view being identical to the front elevational view; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.
