[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a knife, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a knife showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view from the right of FIG. 1;

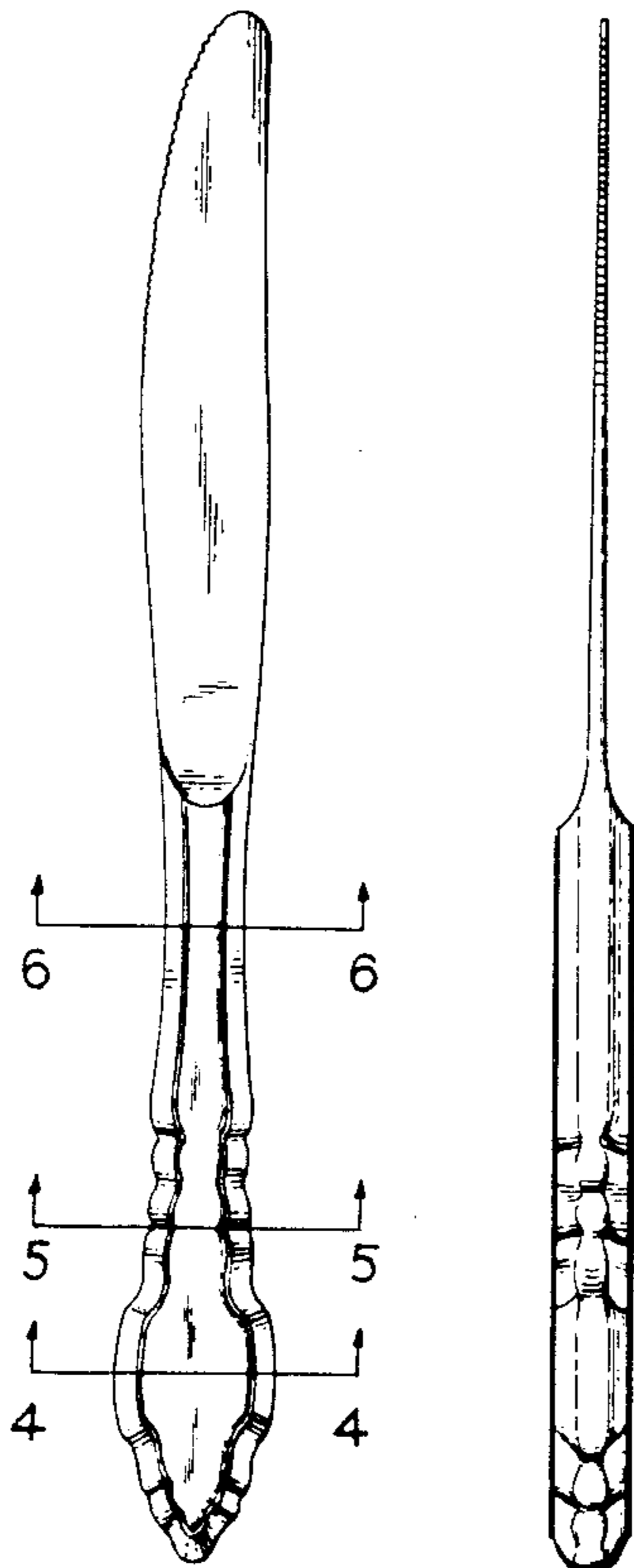
FIG. 3 is an end elevational view from the bottom of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 4-4 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 5-5 of FIG. 1; and

FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 6-6 of FIG. 1.

The sides opposite the handle portion shown in FIGS. 1 and 2 are mirror images of the respective sides shown. The distinguishing feature of my new design for a knife resides in the handle configuration.



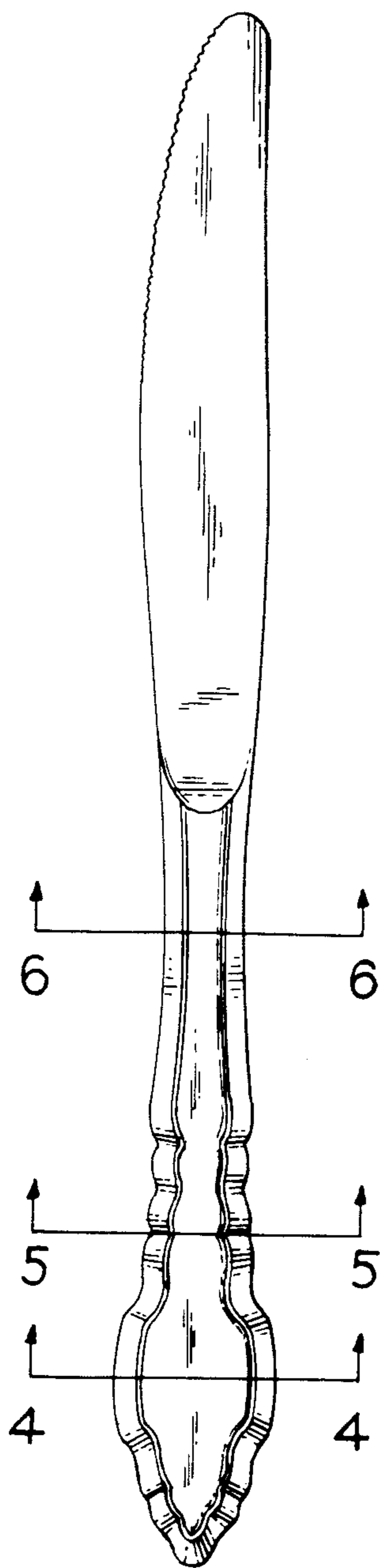
