## **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a knife showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view from the right of FIG. 1:


FIG. 3 is an end elevational view from the bottom of FIG. 1;


FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 4—4 of FIG. 1;


FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 5-5 of FIG. 1; and

FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 6—6 of FIG. 1.




