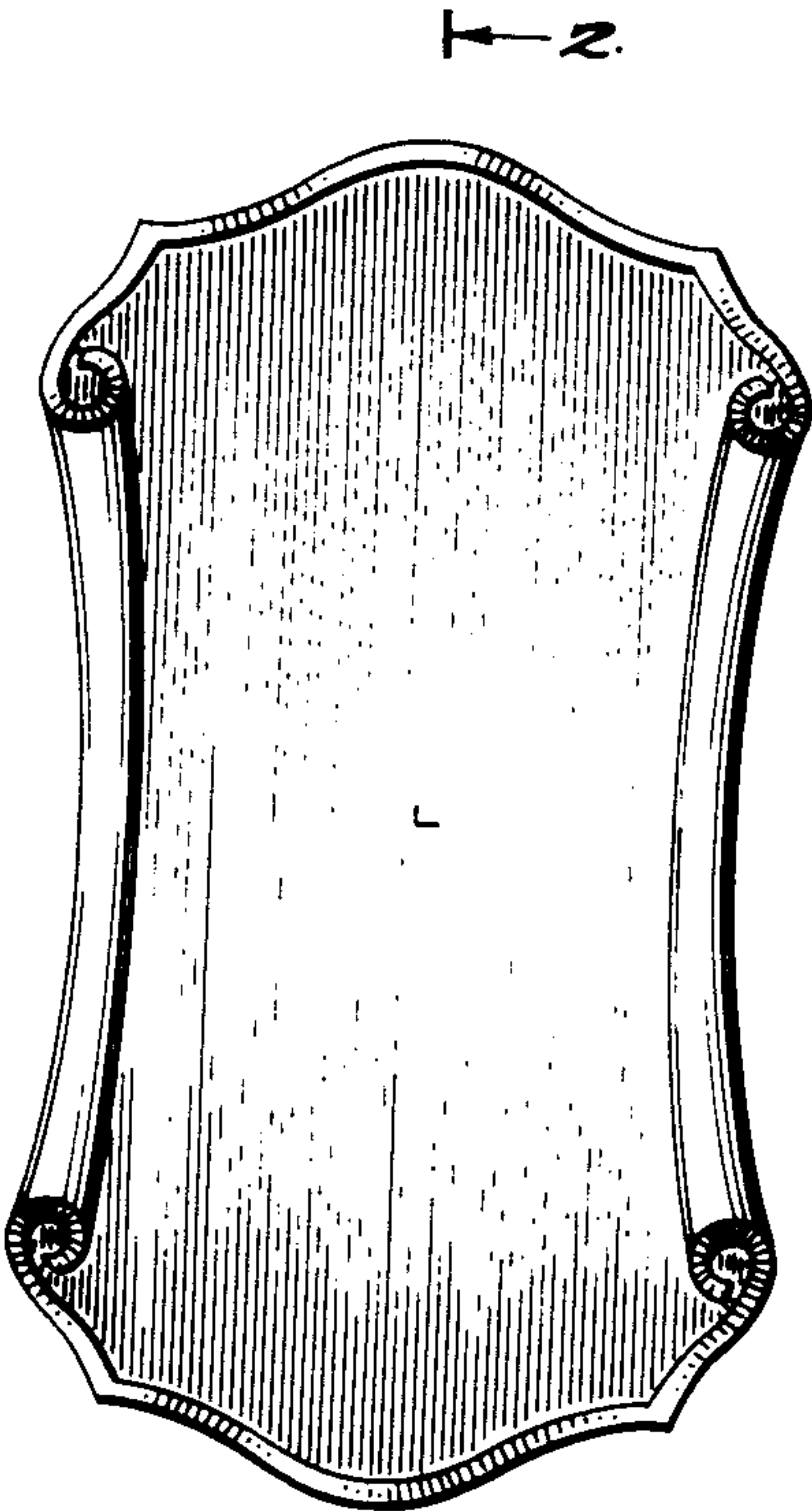

The ornamental design for an escutcheon, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an escutcheon embodying my new design, the rear being flat and unornamental; and
FIG. 2 is a partial sectional view taken in the direction of the arrows on line 2—2 of FIG. 1.

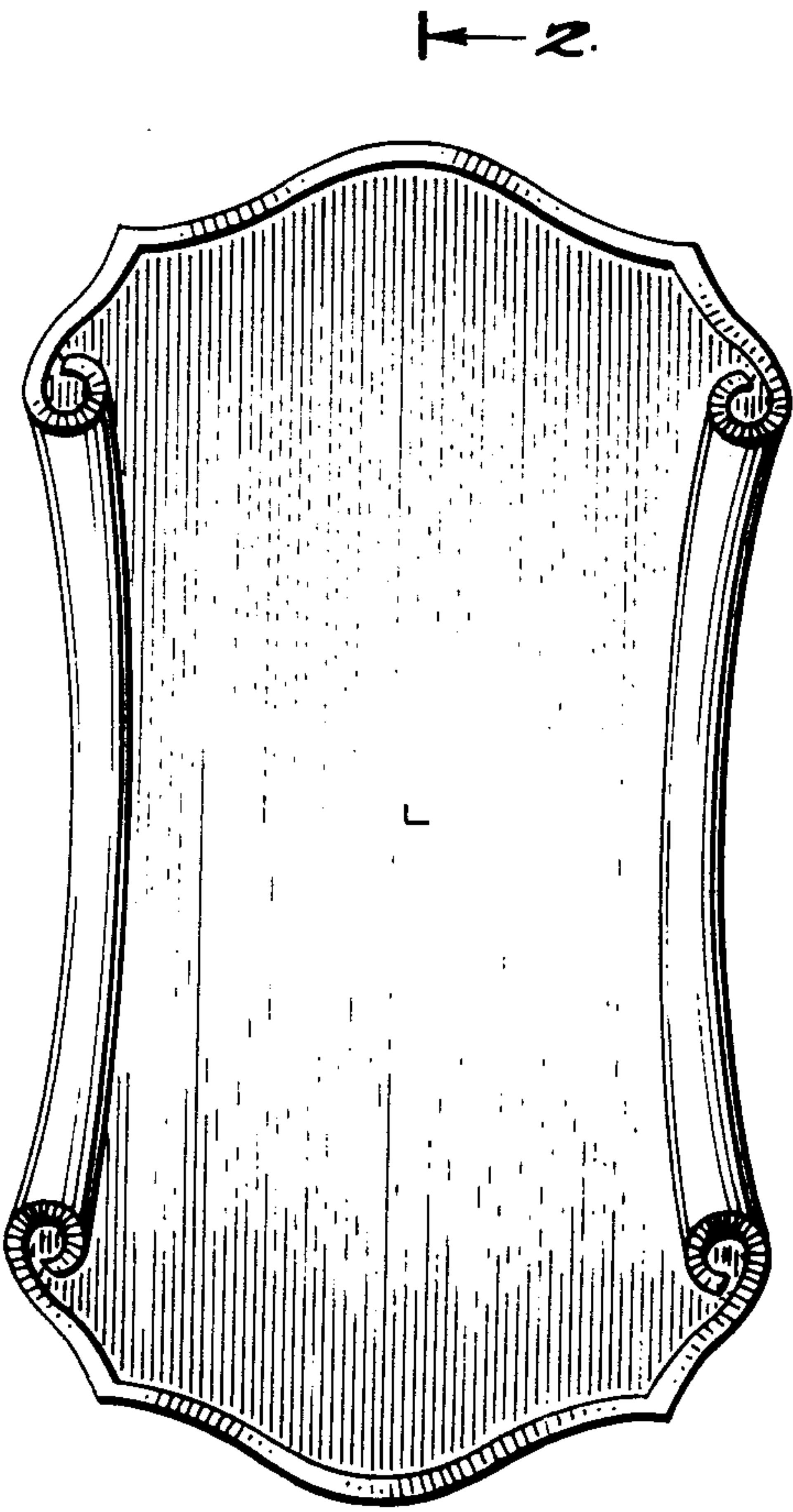

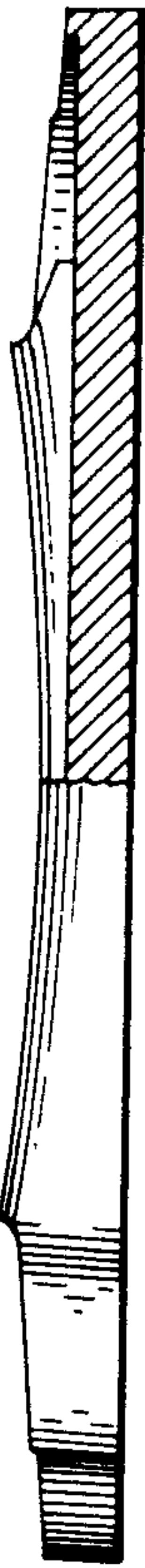
