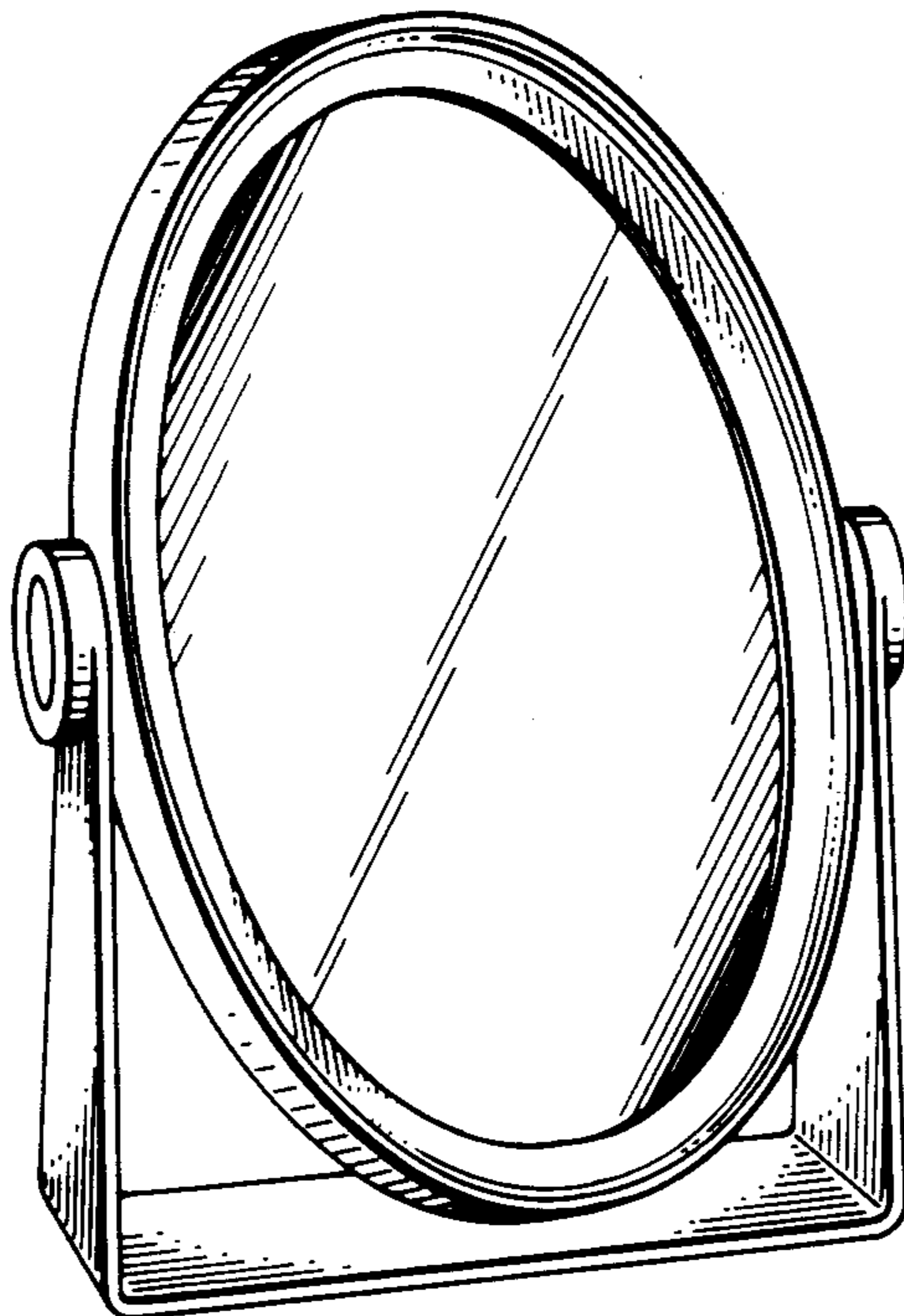

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a mirror arrangement, showing my new design; and, FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the opposite side thereof.



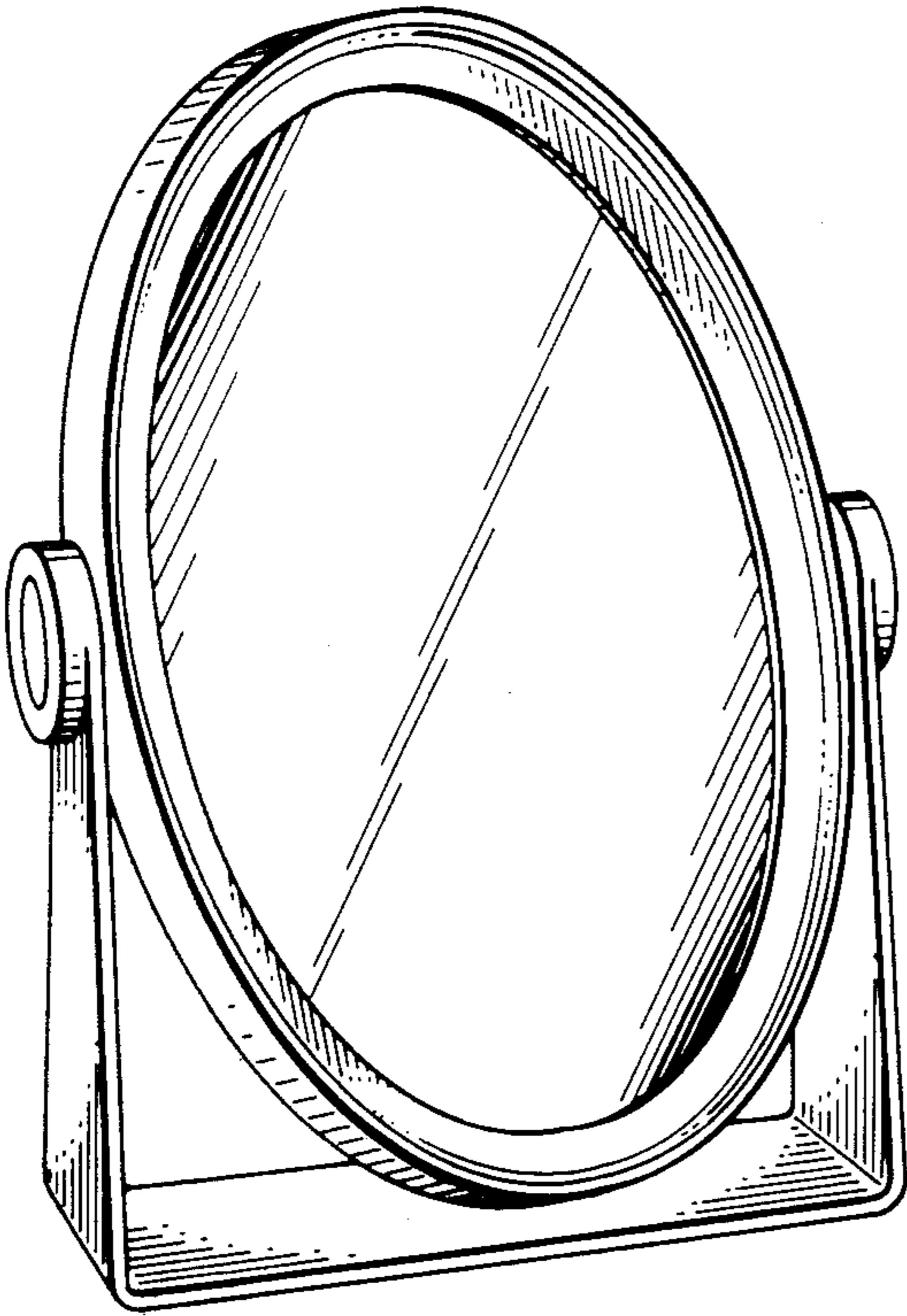

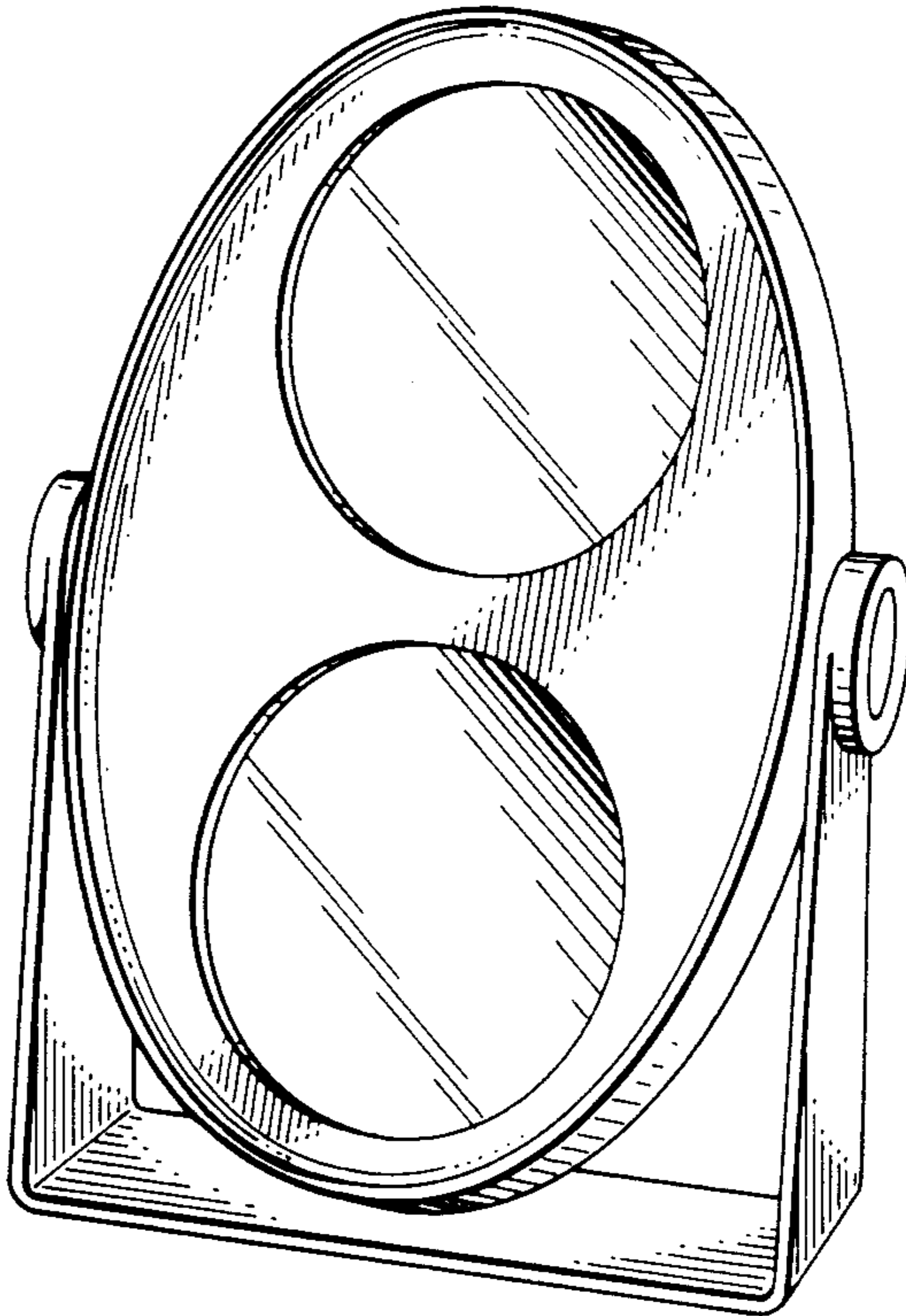
