The ornamental design for a combined jar and closure, as shown and described.

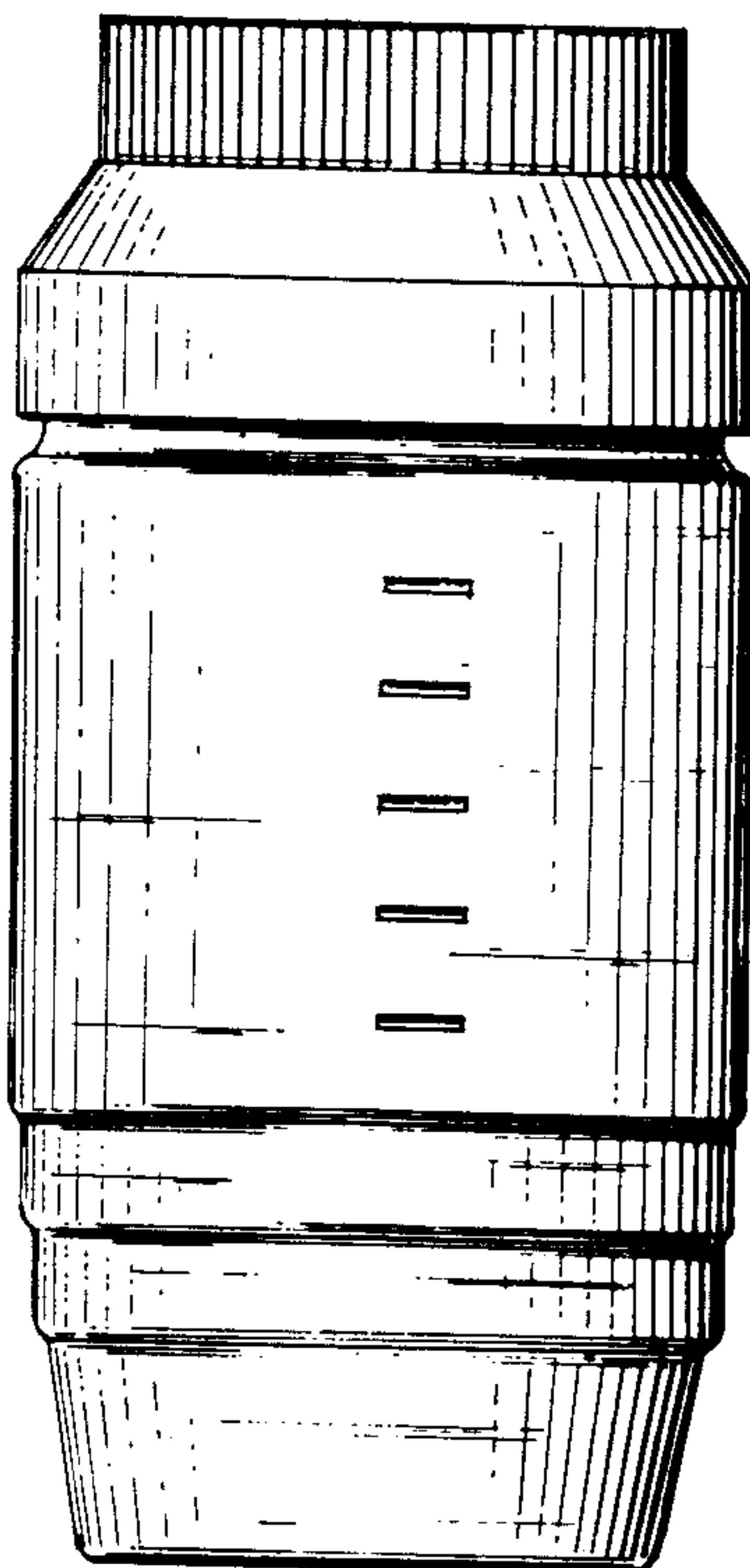
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



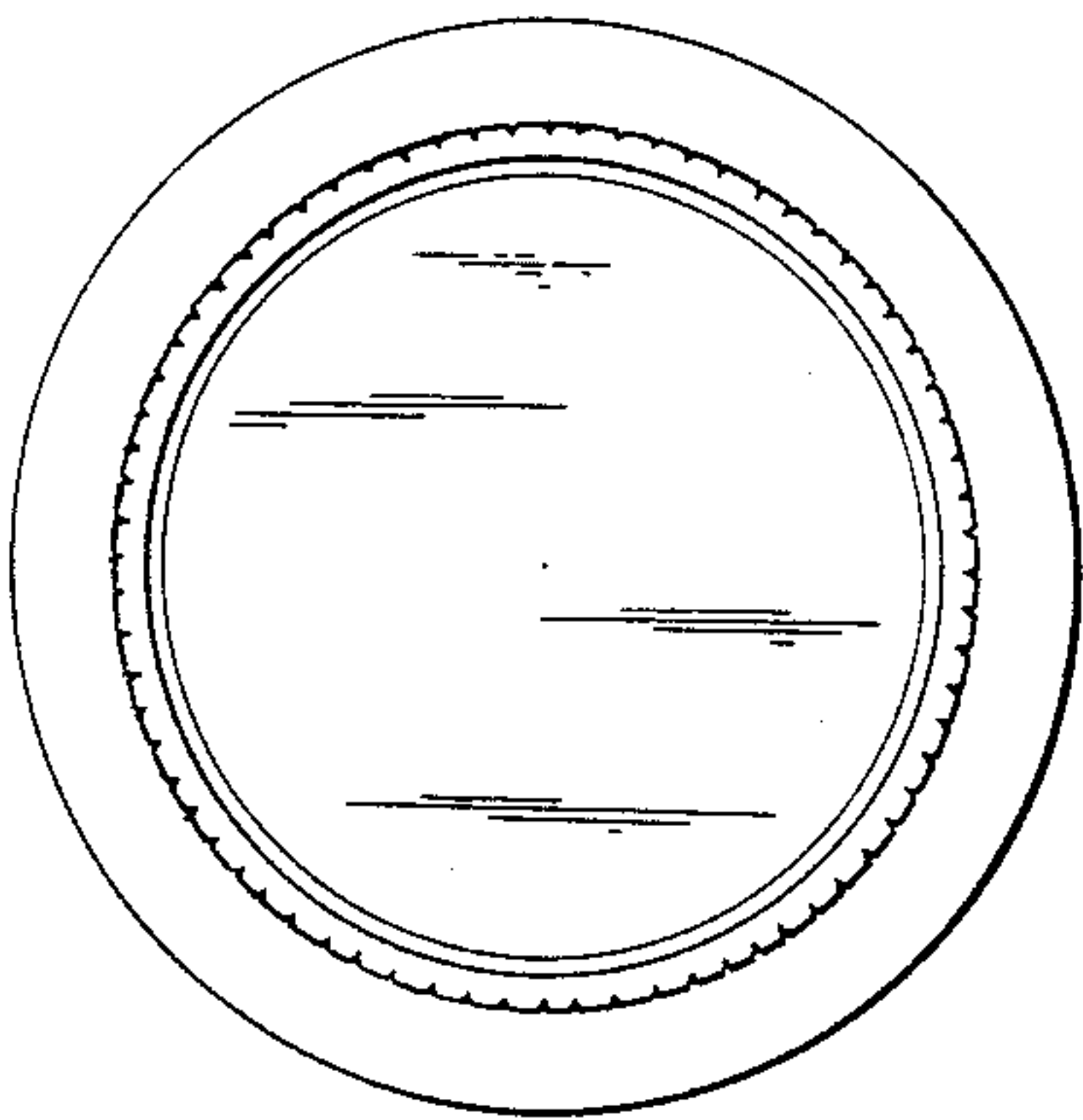

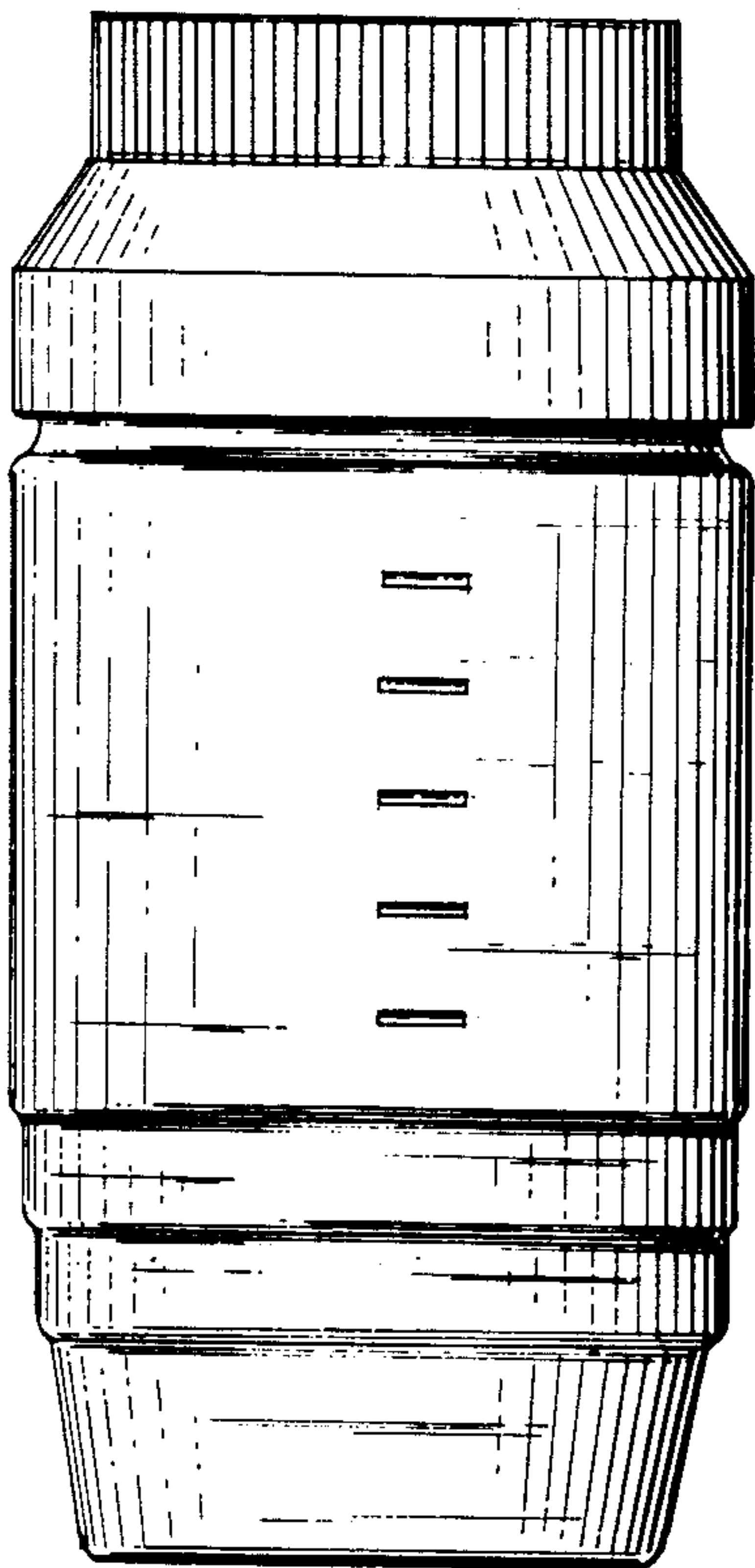

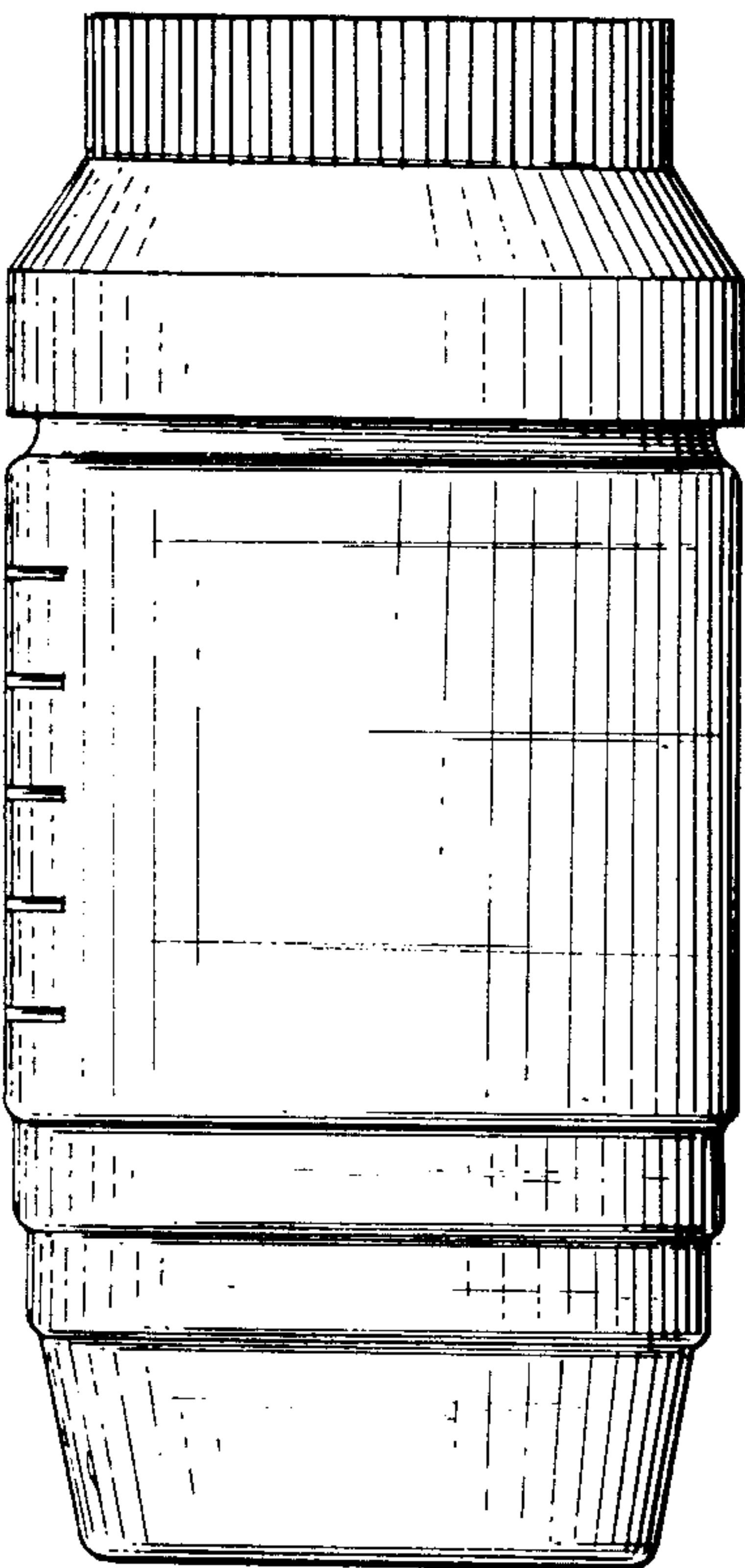
