[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined decanter and stopper, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a combined decanter and stopper showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;


FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof, it being understood that the cut ornamentation continues about the entire periphery in the paths indicated by the dot-dash lines;


FIG. 4 is an enlarged fragmentary sectional view taken on line 4-4 of FIG. 3;




