[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a projection television console, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and left side perspective view of a projection television console showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view; FIG. 5 is a top plan view; and FIG. 6 is a sectional view of the front covering taken along line 6-6 in FIG. 2. The undisclosed side of the system is a mirror image of the side shown in FIG. 3.

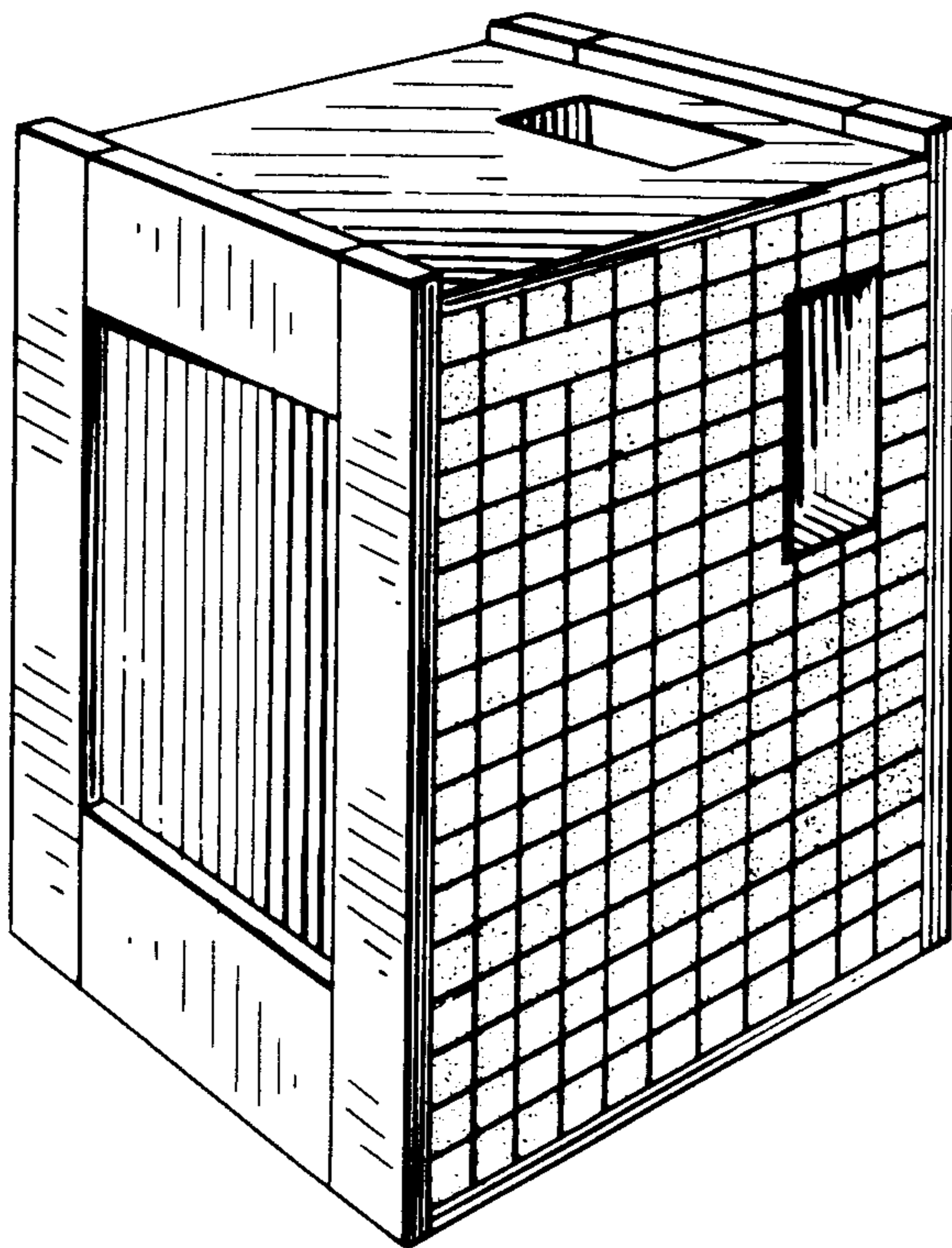

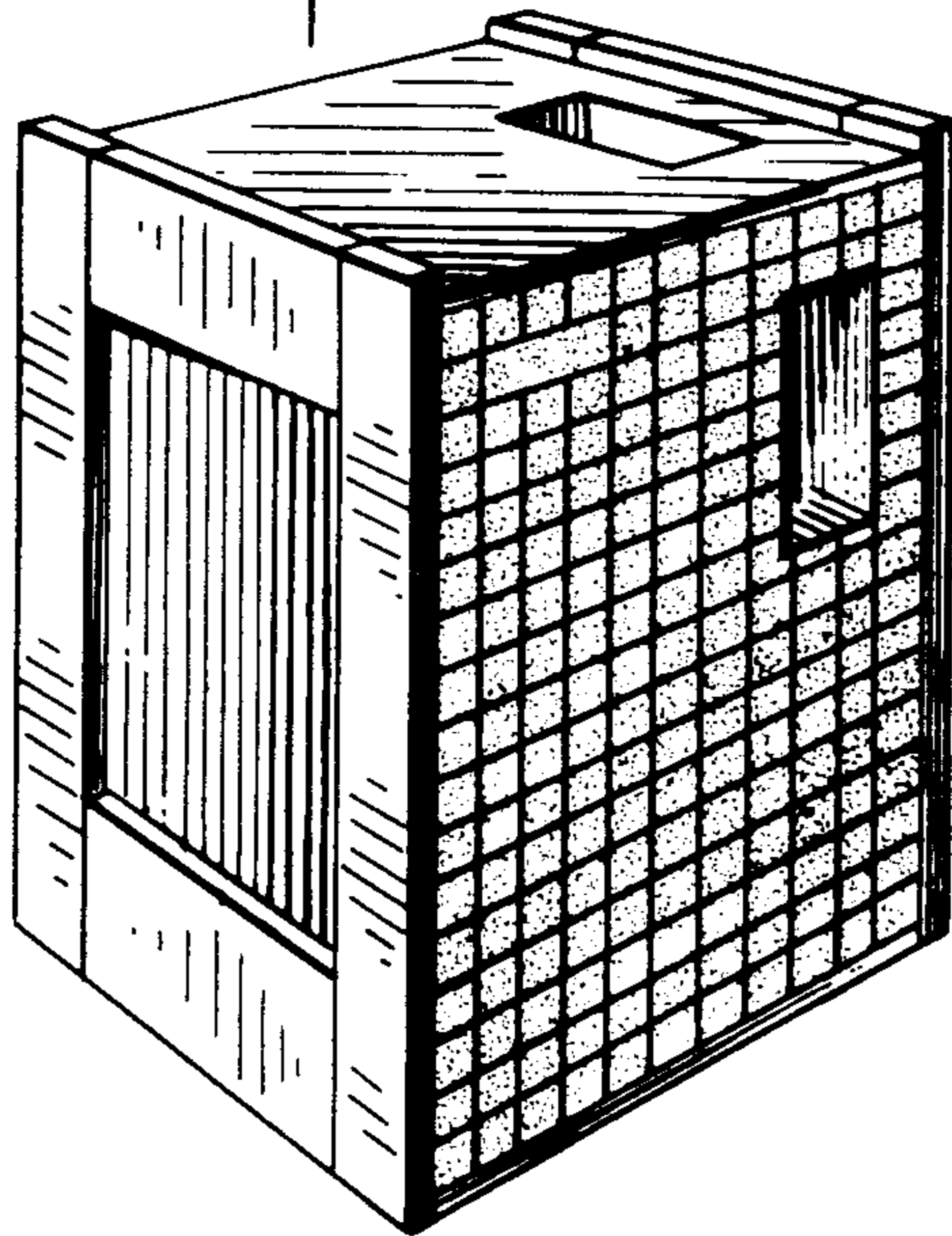

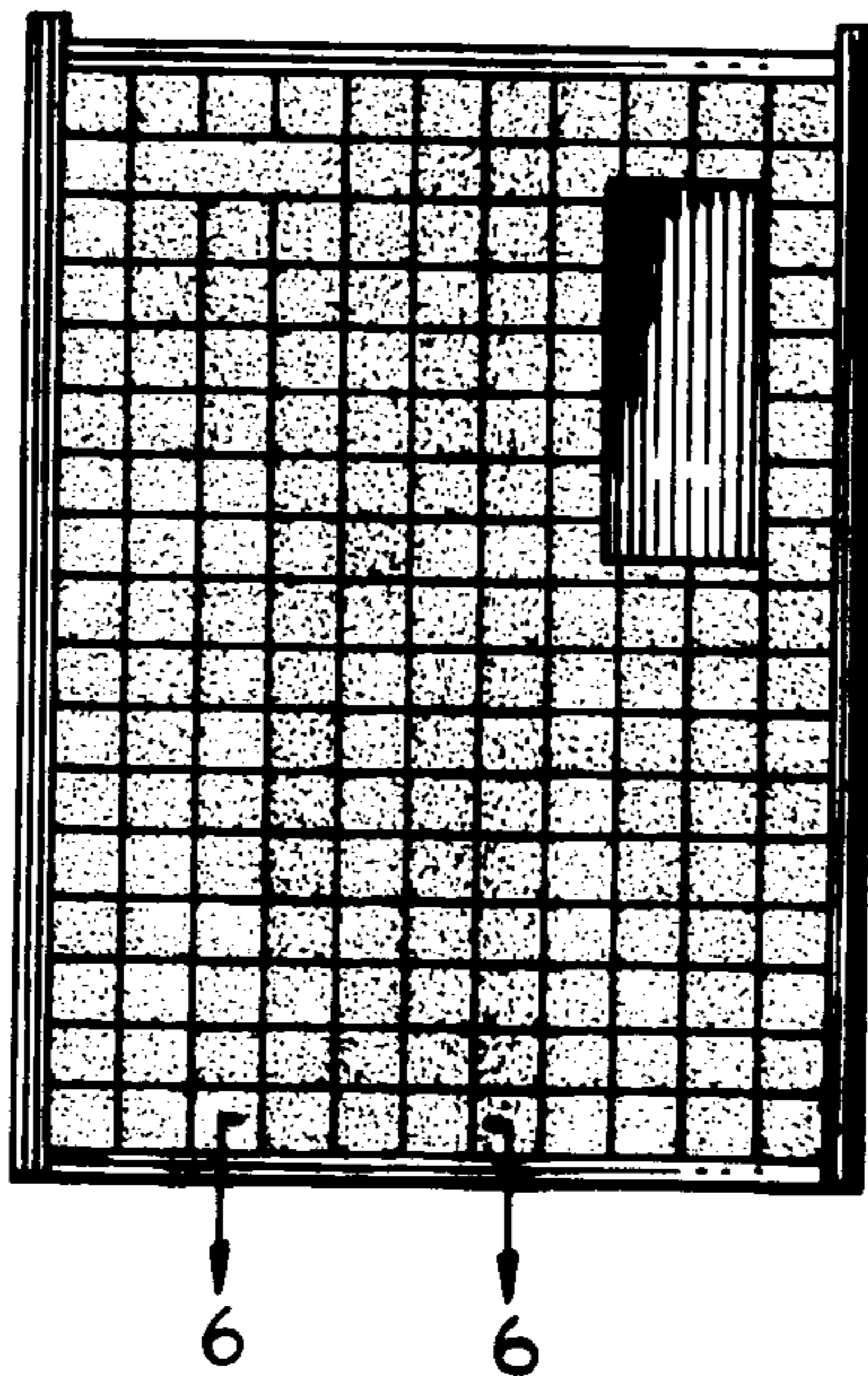

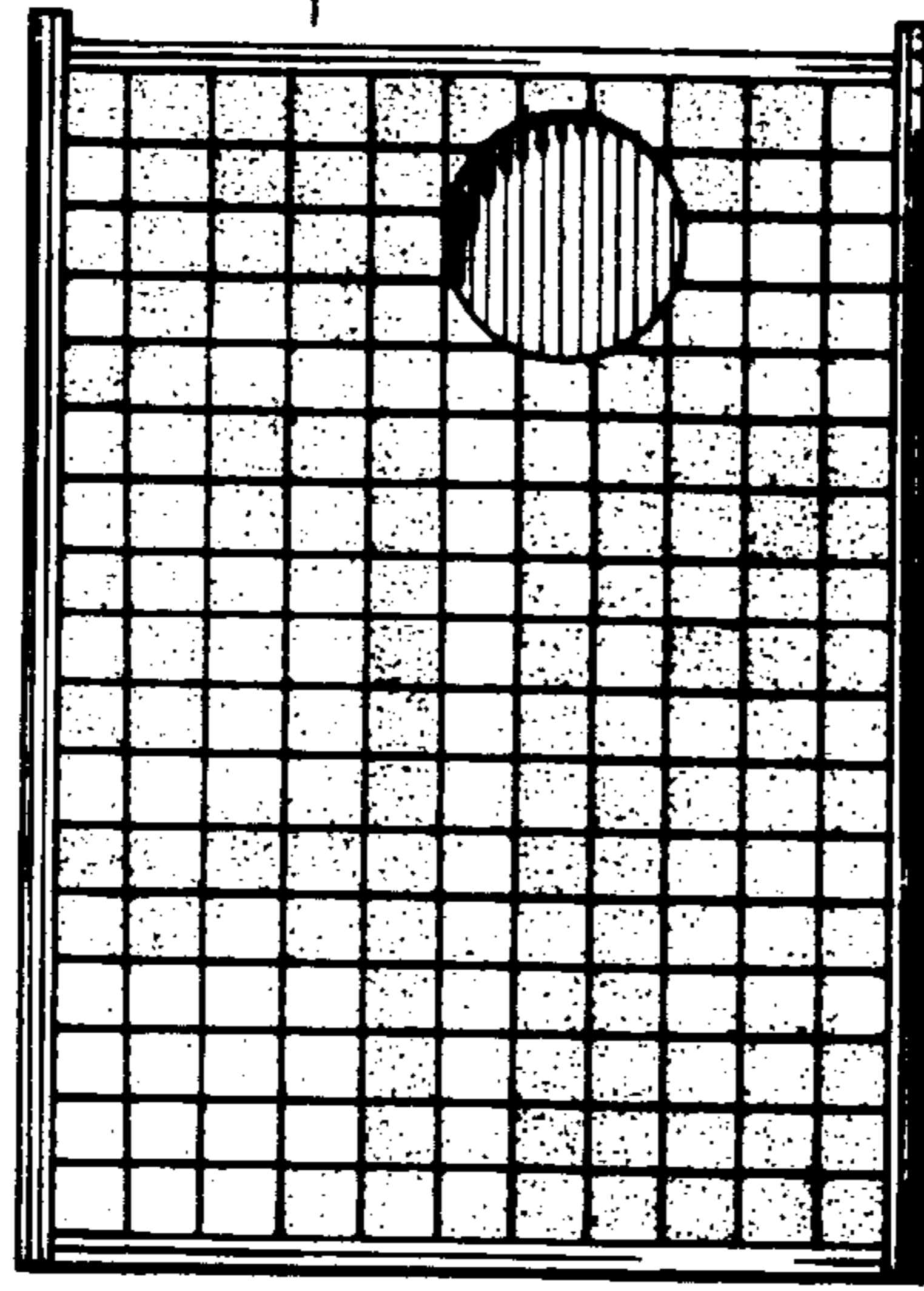

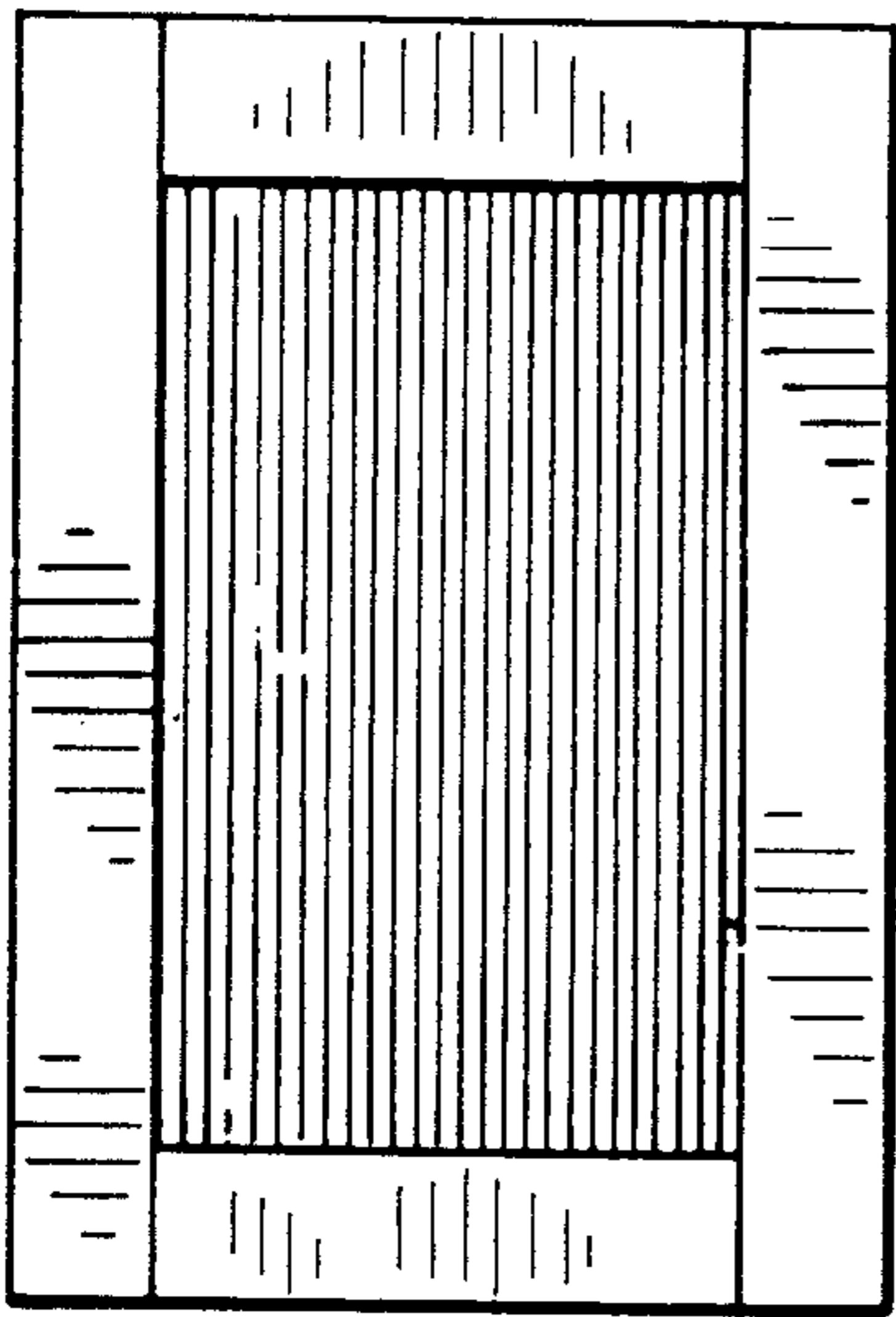

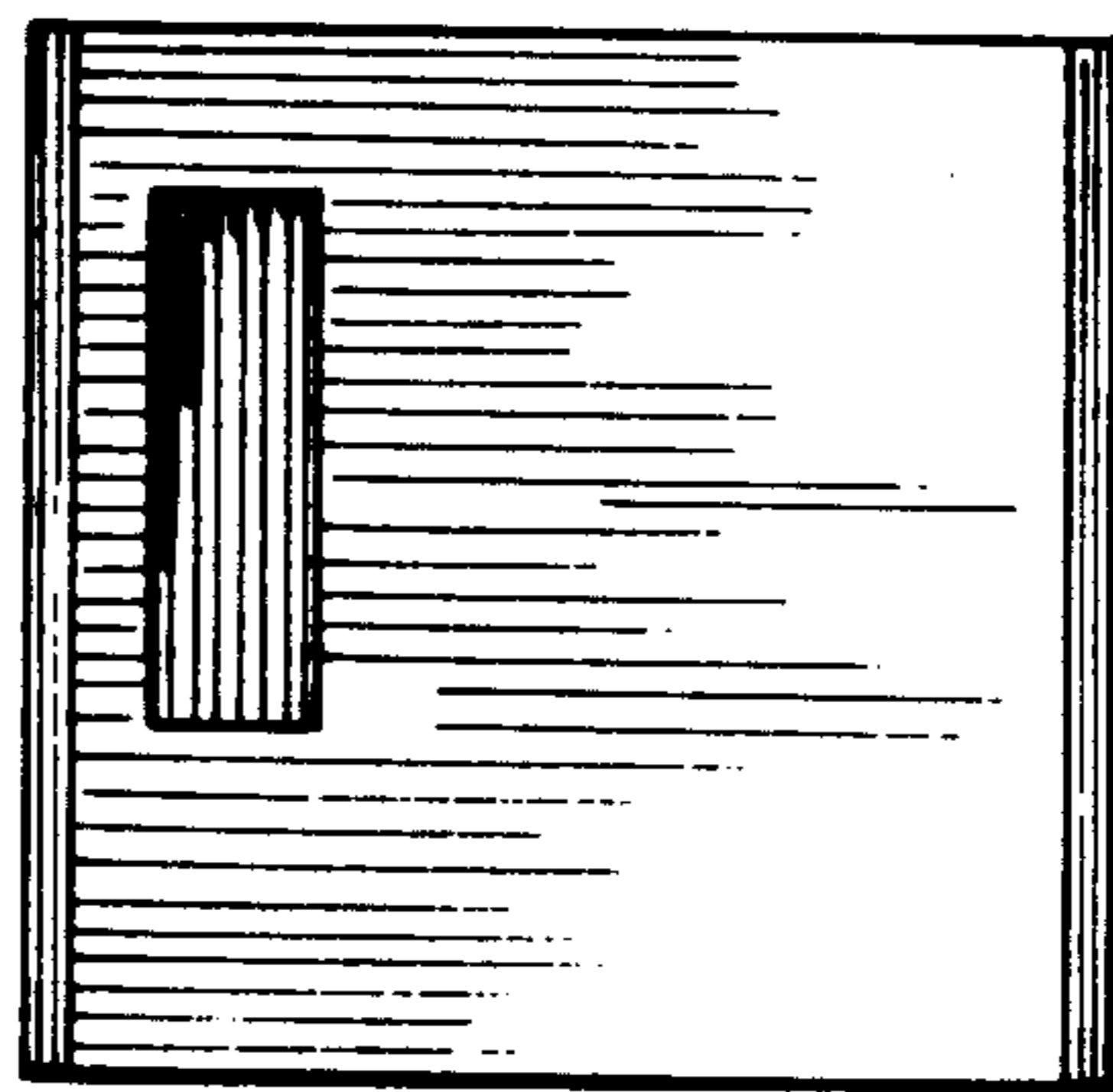
