DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the set of modular display units showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof.

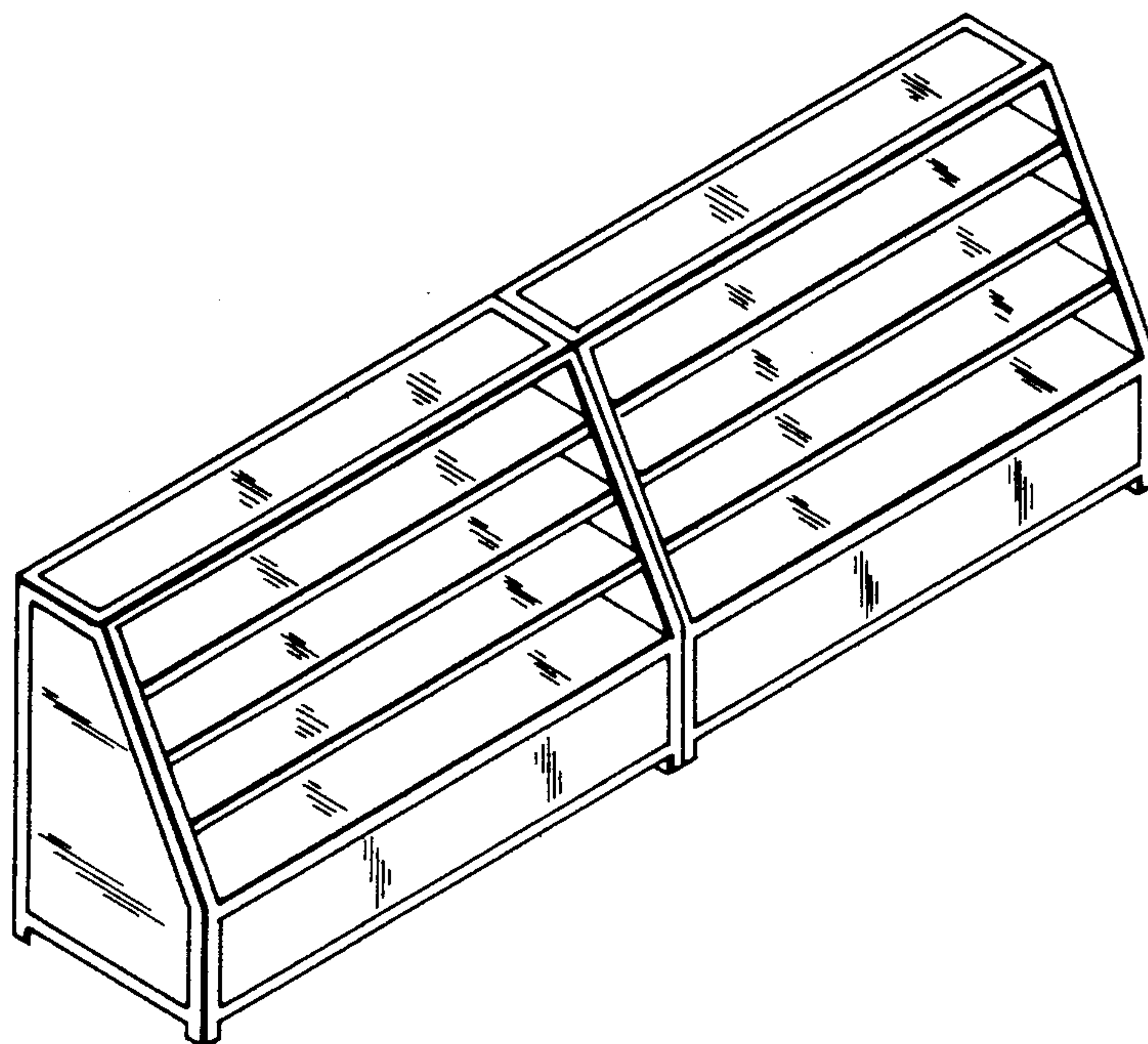

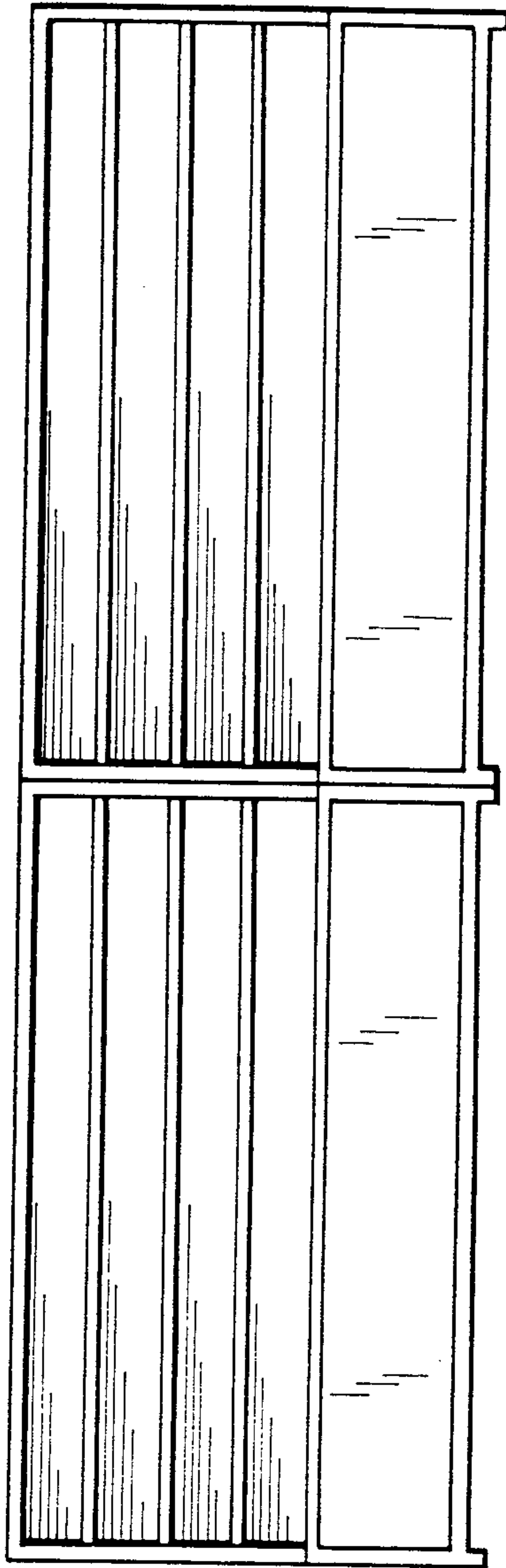

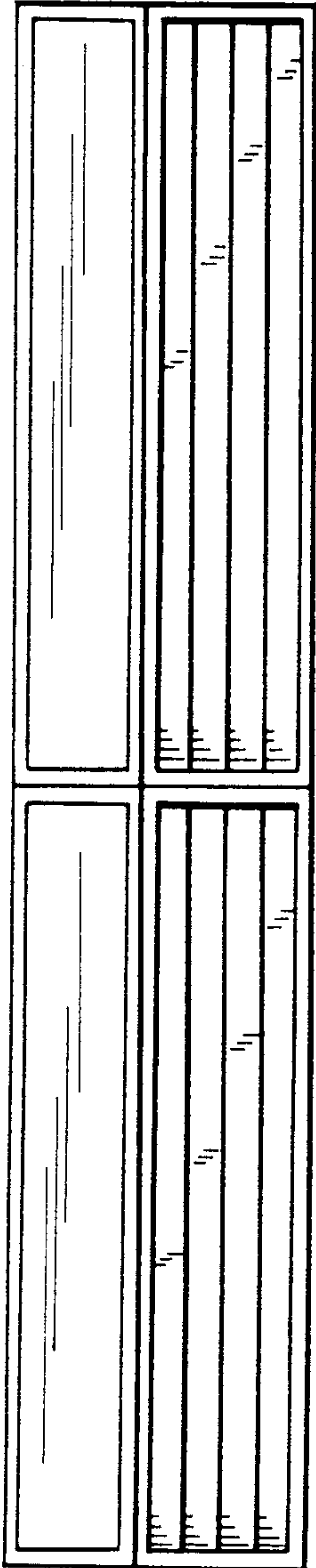

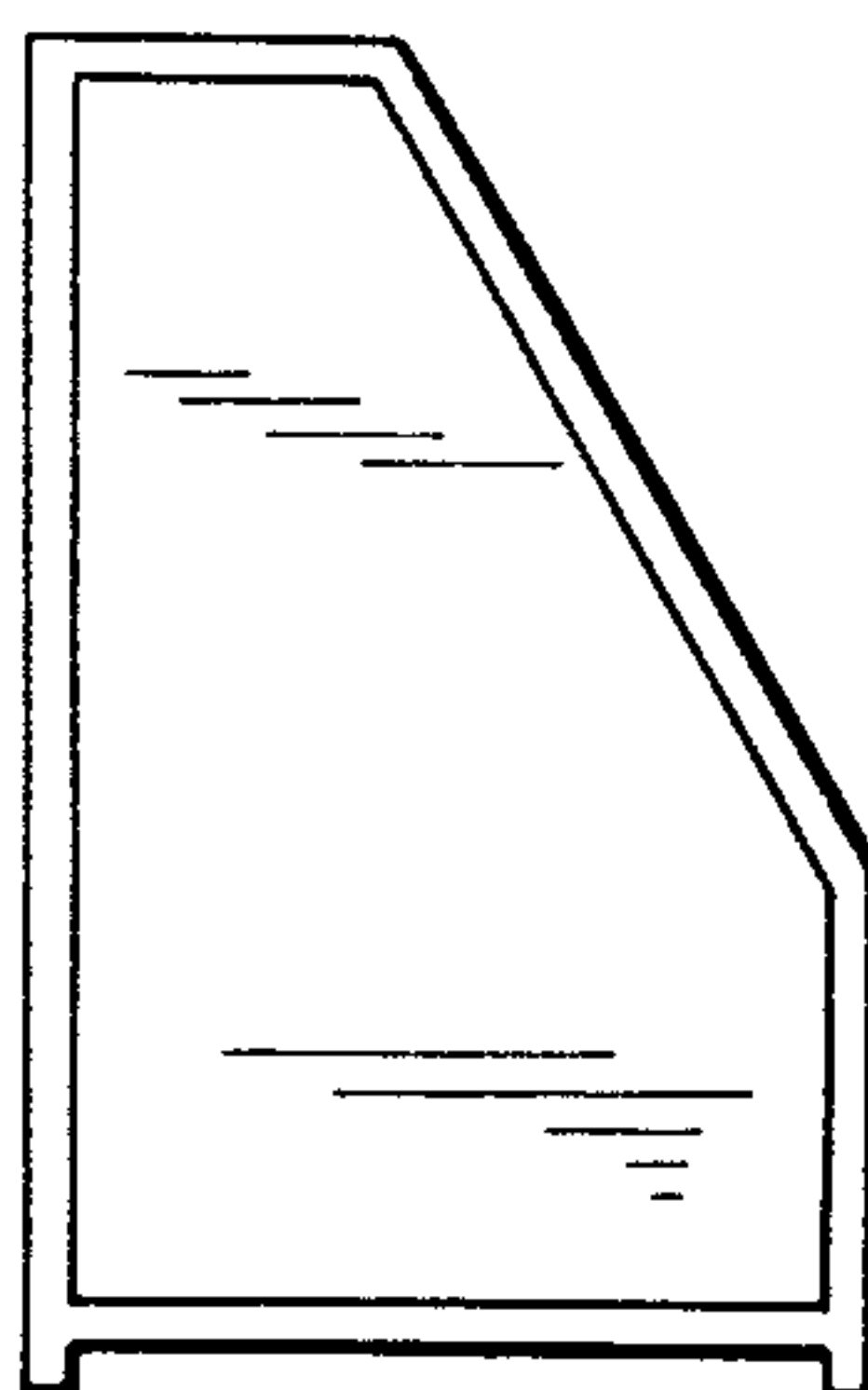

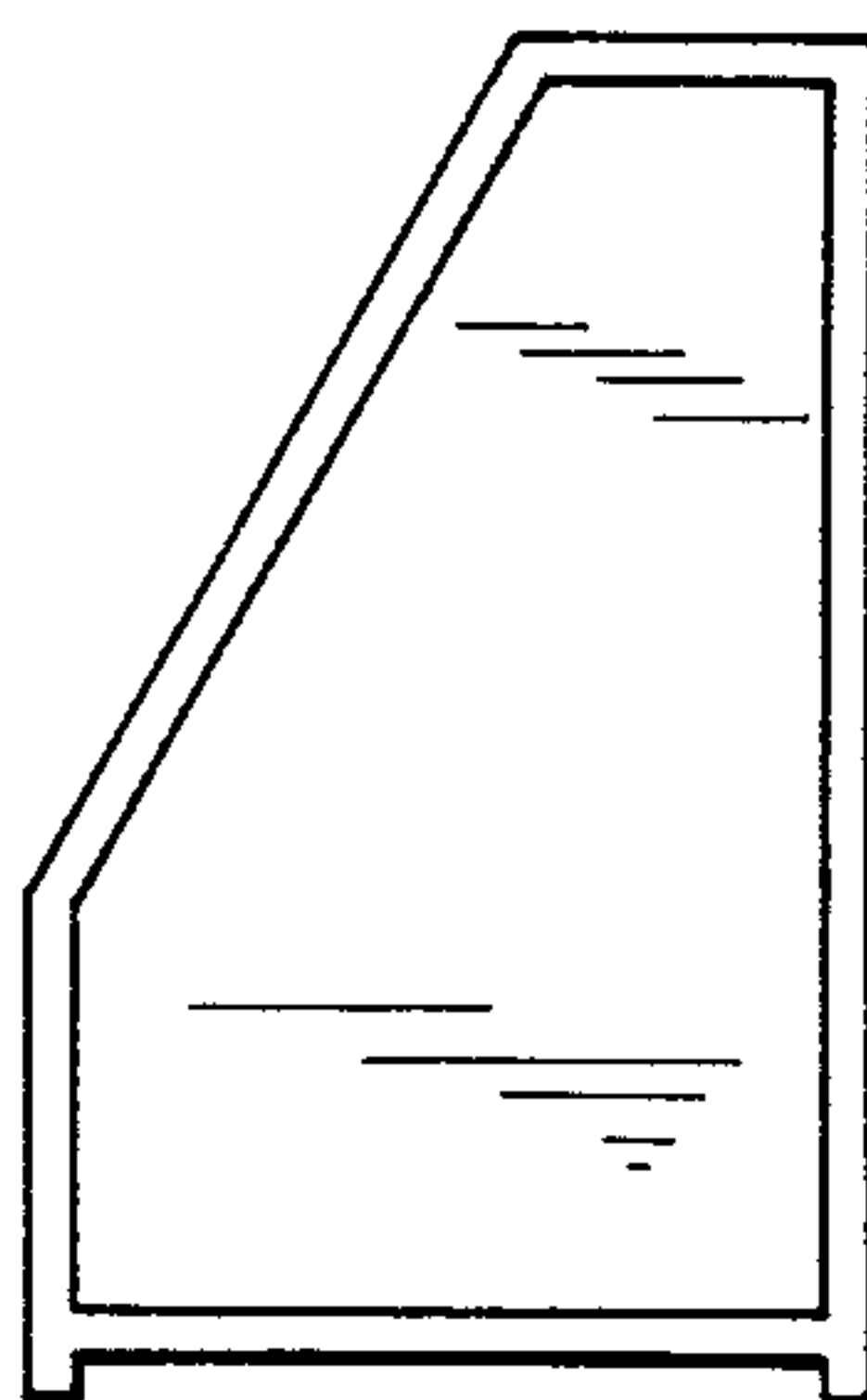

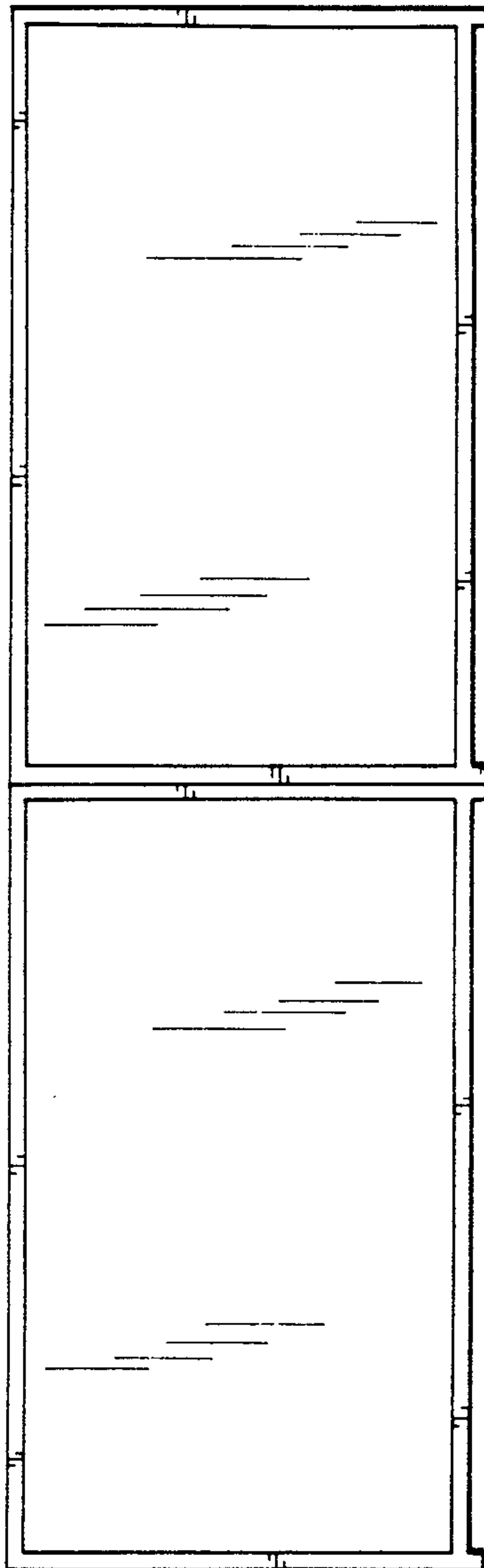
