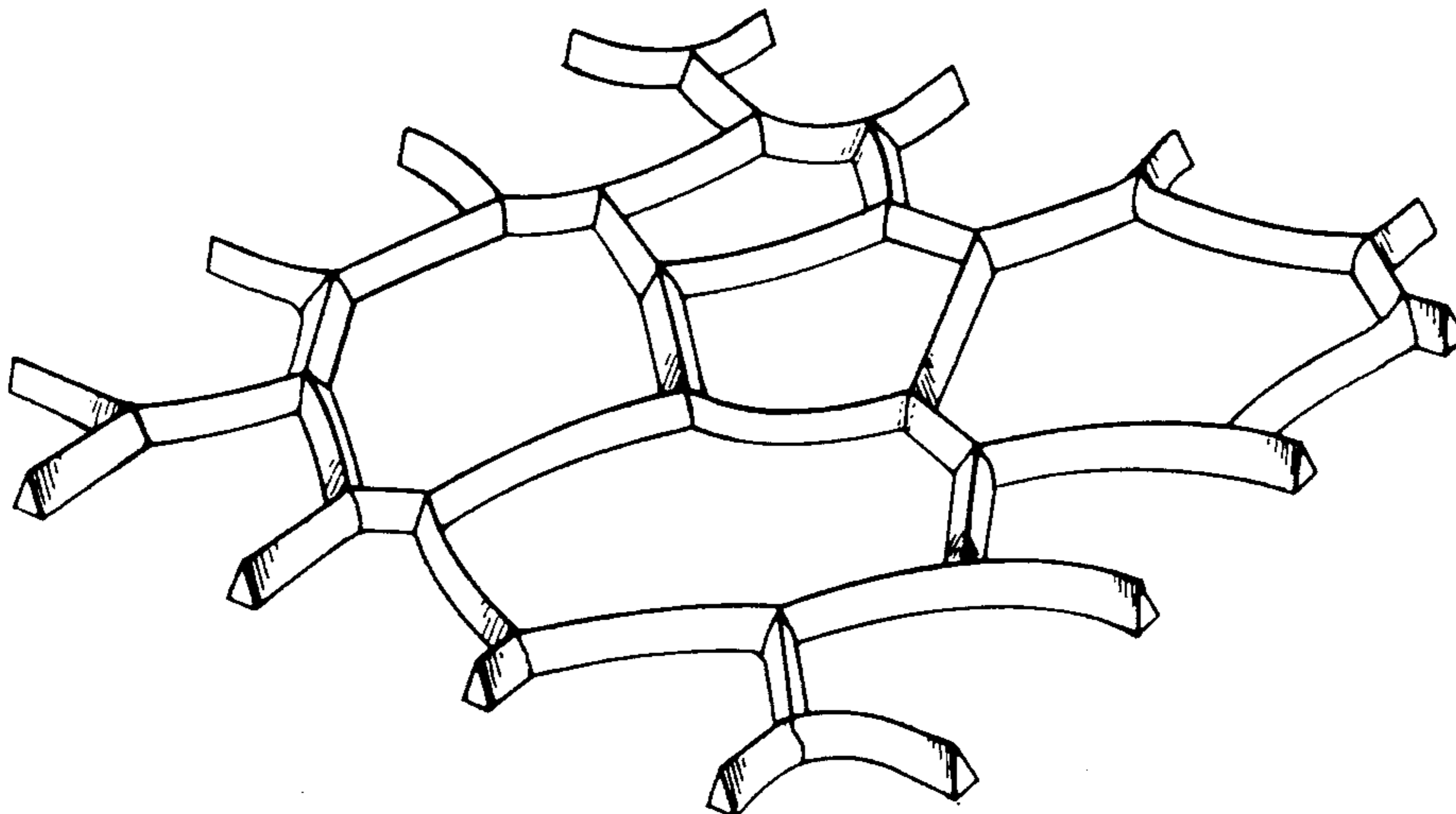

FIG. 3, is a perspective view of the tool of the present invention.



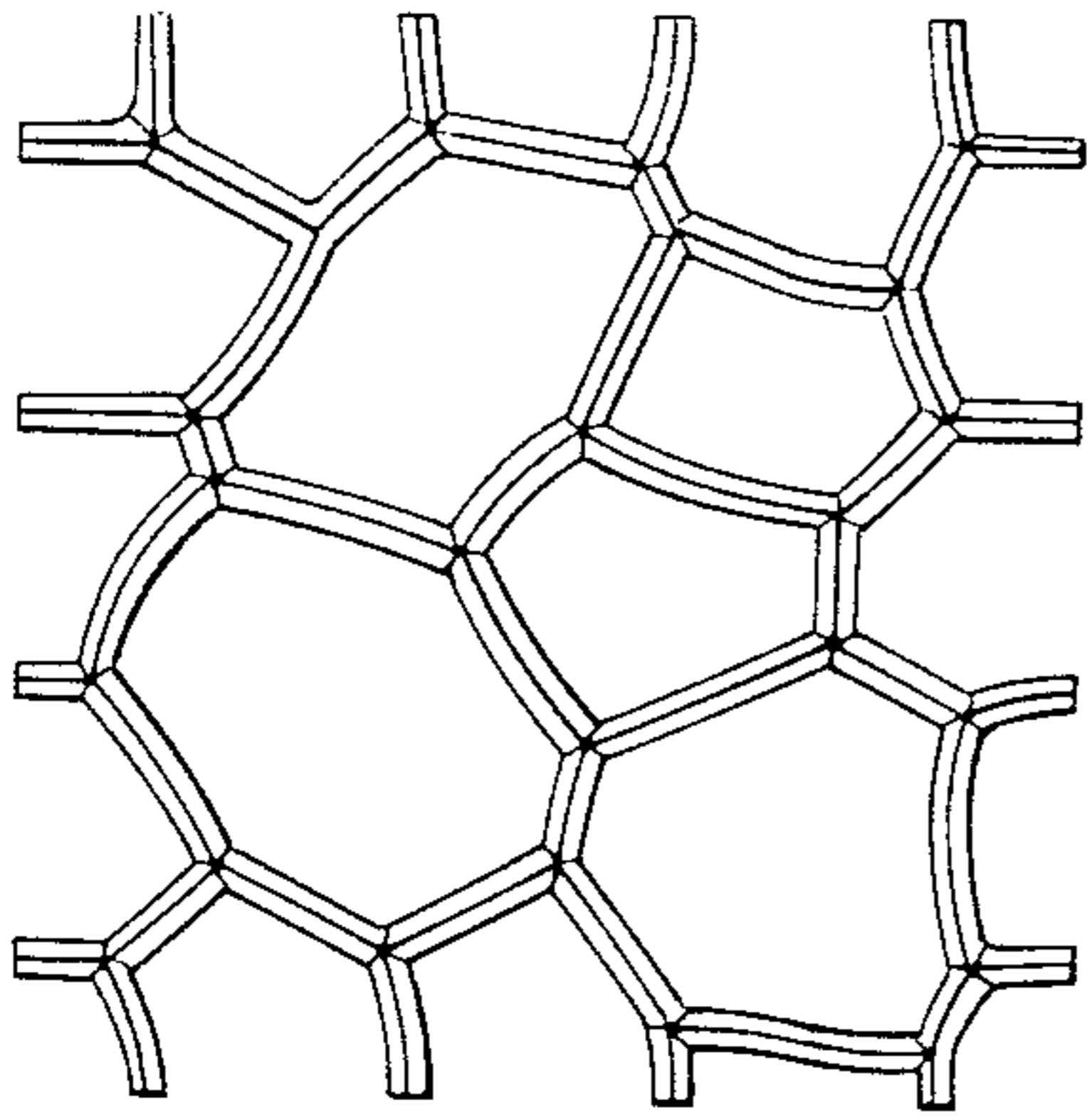

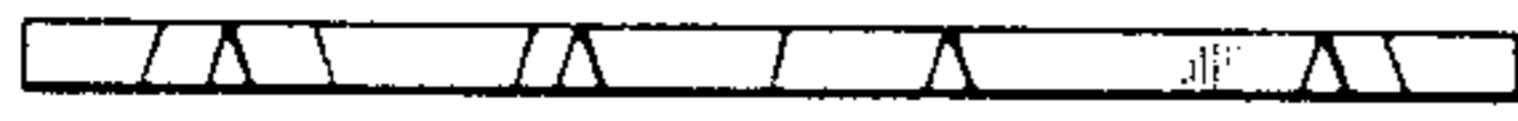

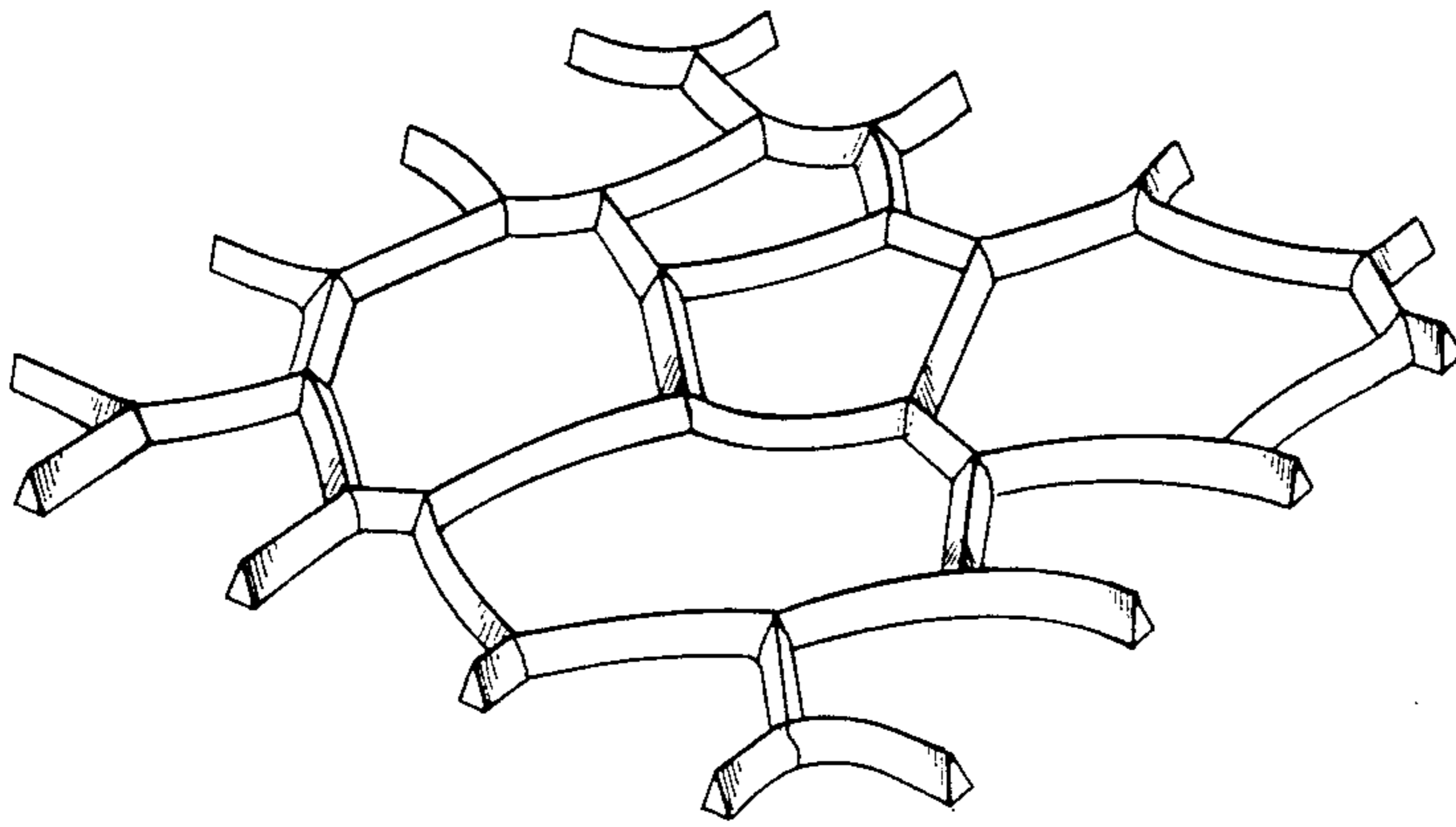
