[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined lens cabinet and writing desk, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an illustration, in perspective, of the combined lens cabinet and writing desk embodying my new design;

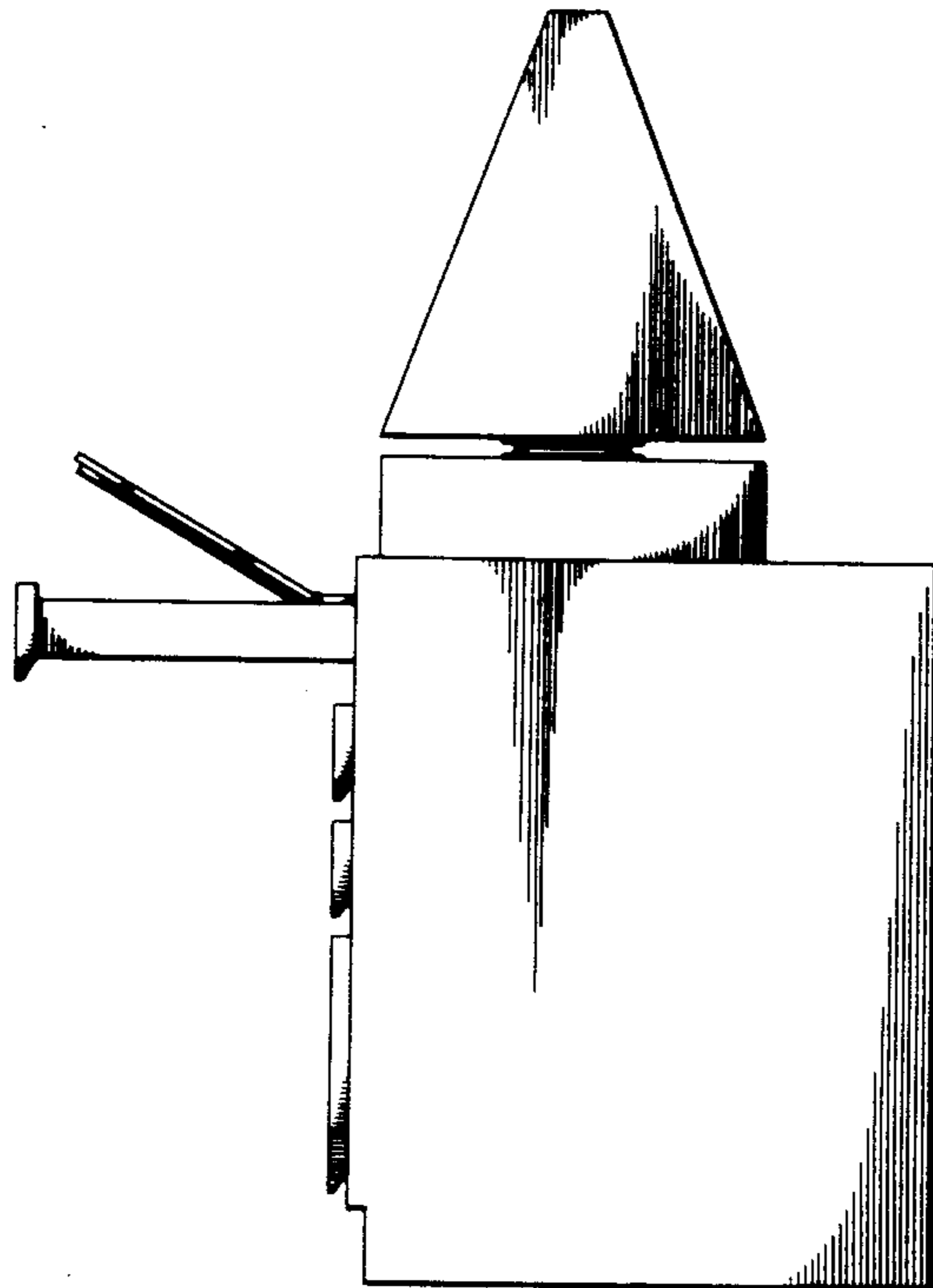
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is another top plan view thereof with the uppermost drawer opened to expose a writing desk;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a view of one side thereof as it appears with all drawers closed, its opposite side having substantially the same appearance; and

FIG. 6 is a view of one side of the cabinet with the uppermost drawer open to expose the writing desk partially lifted to provide access to the drawer beneath.



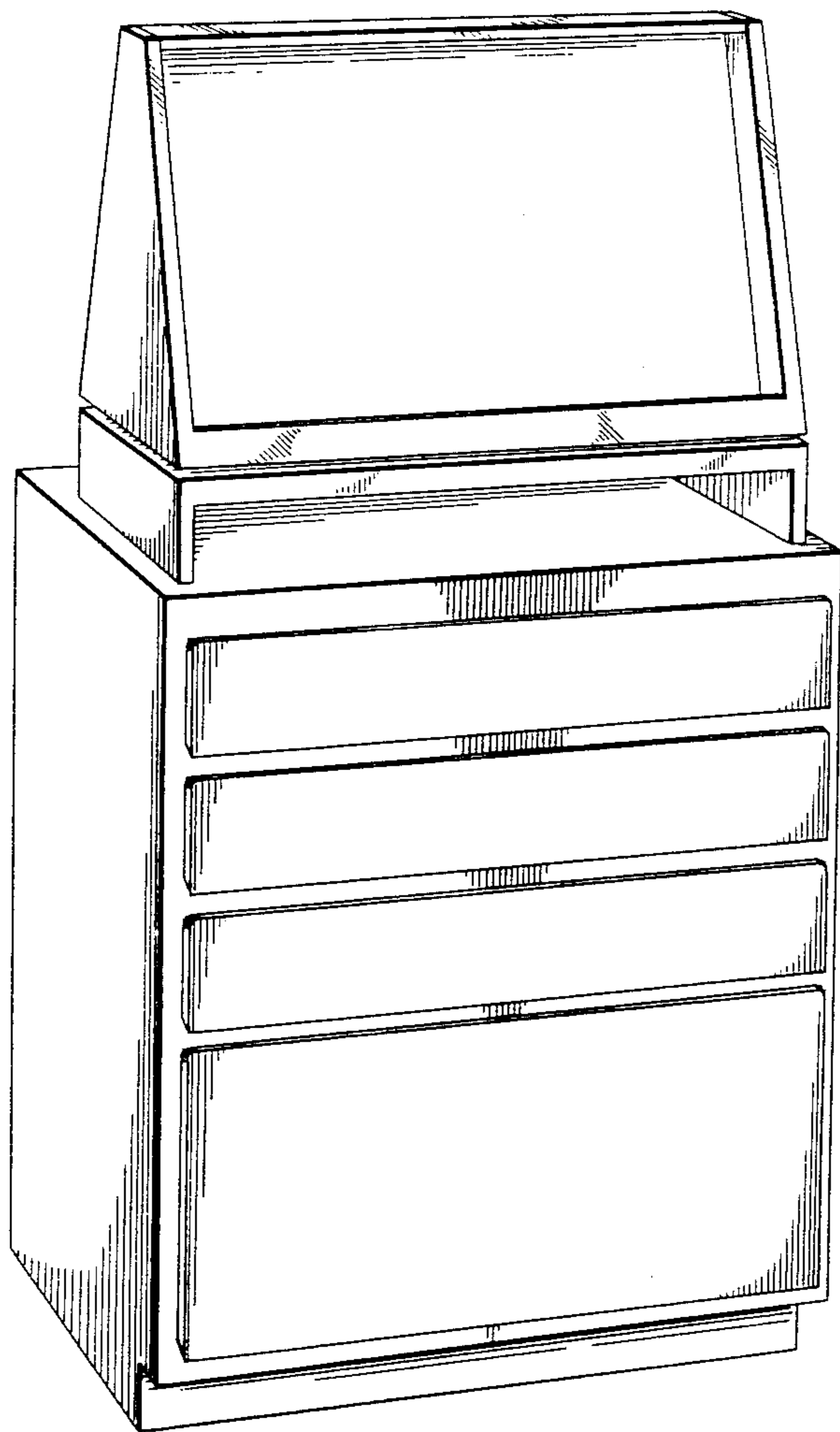

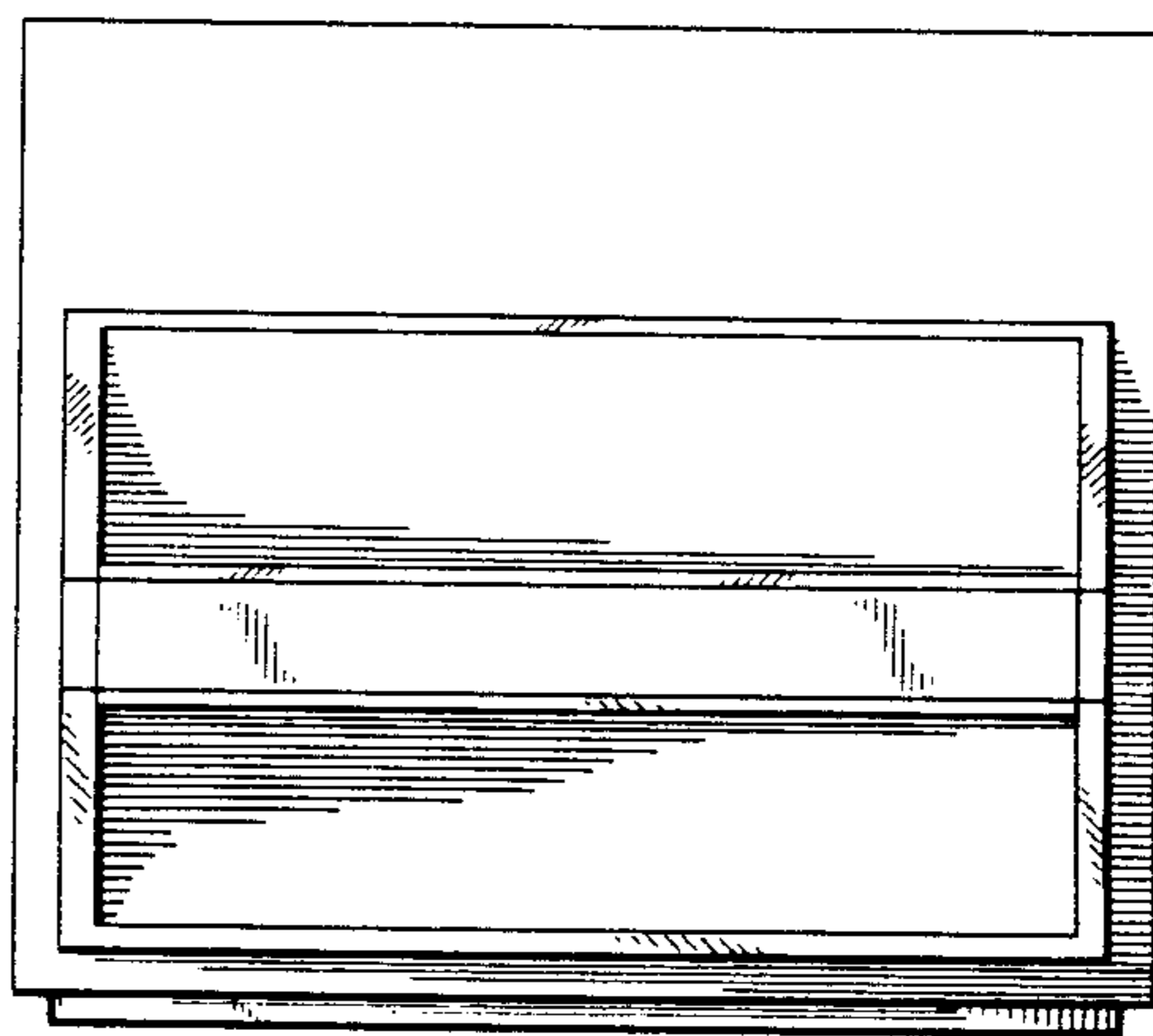

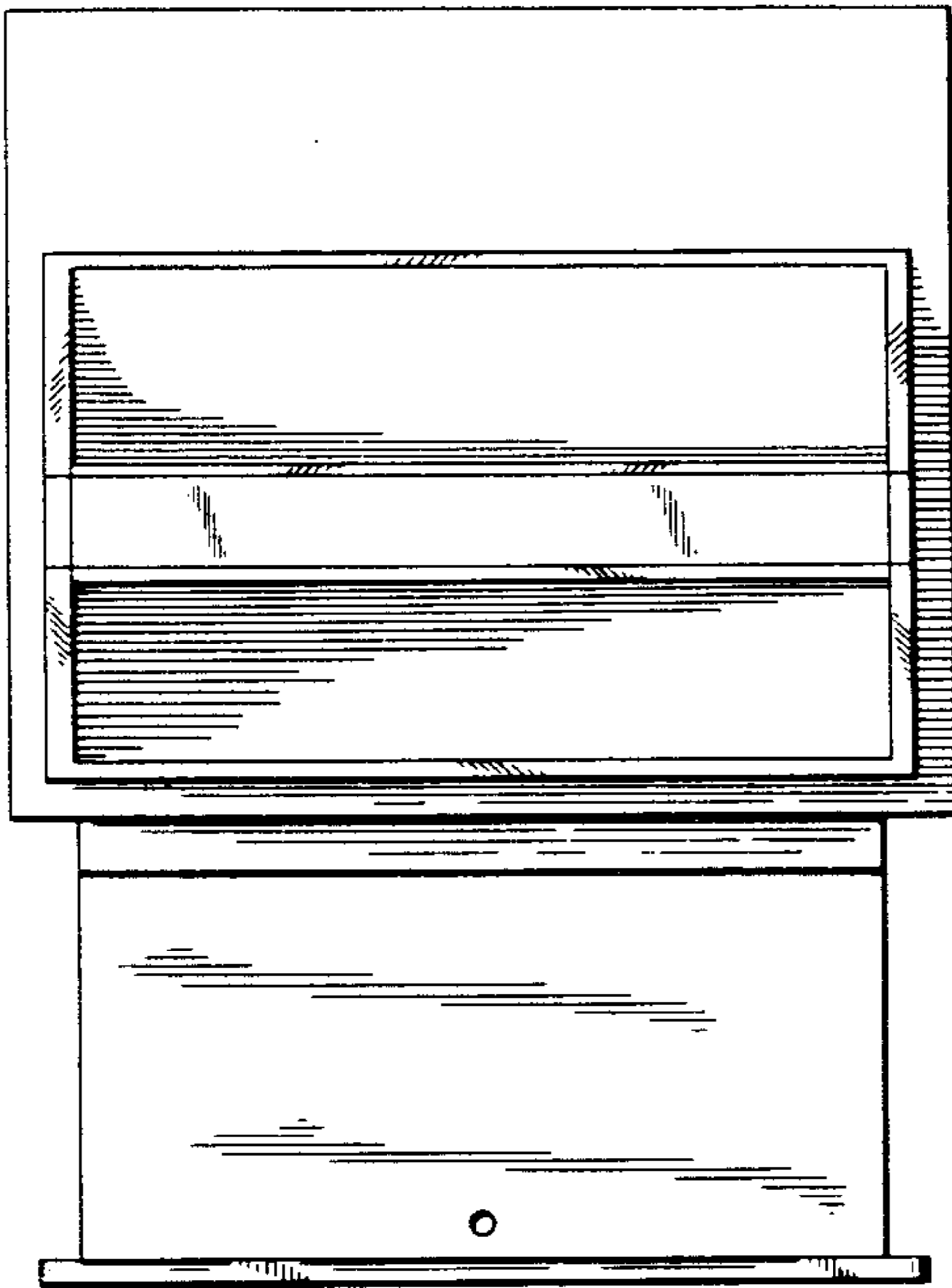

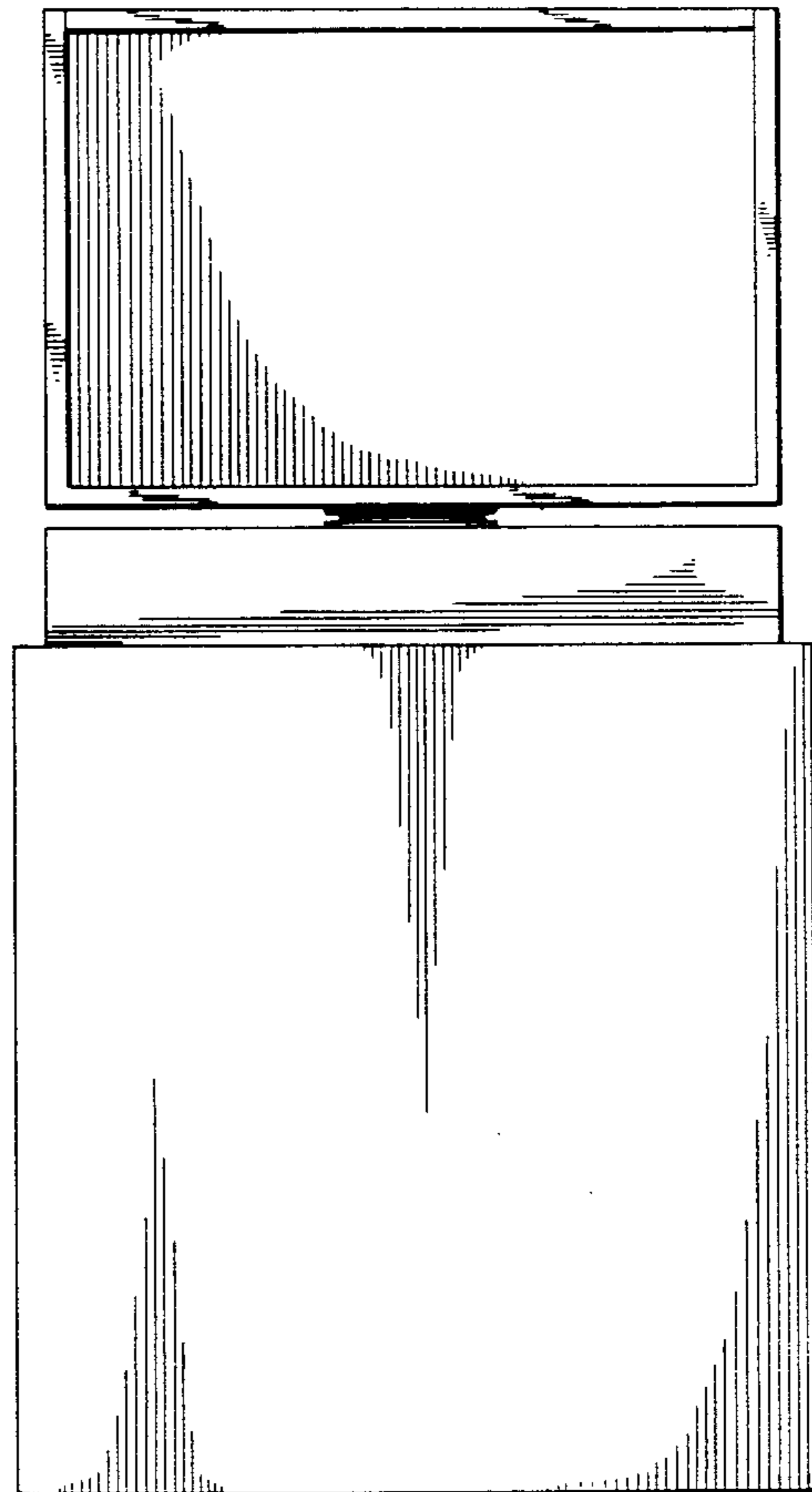

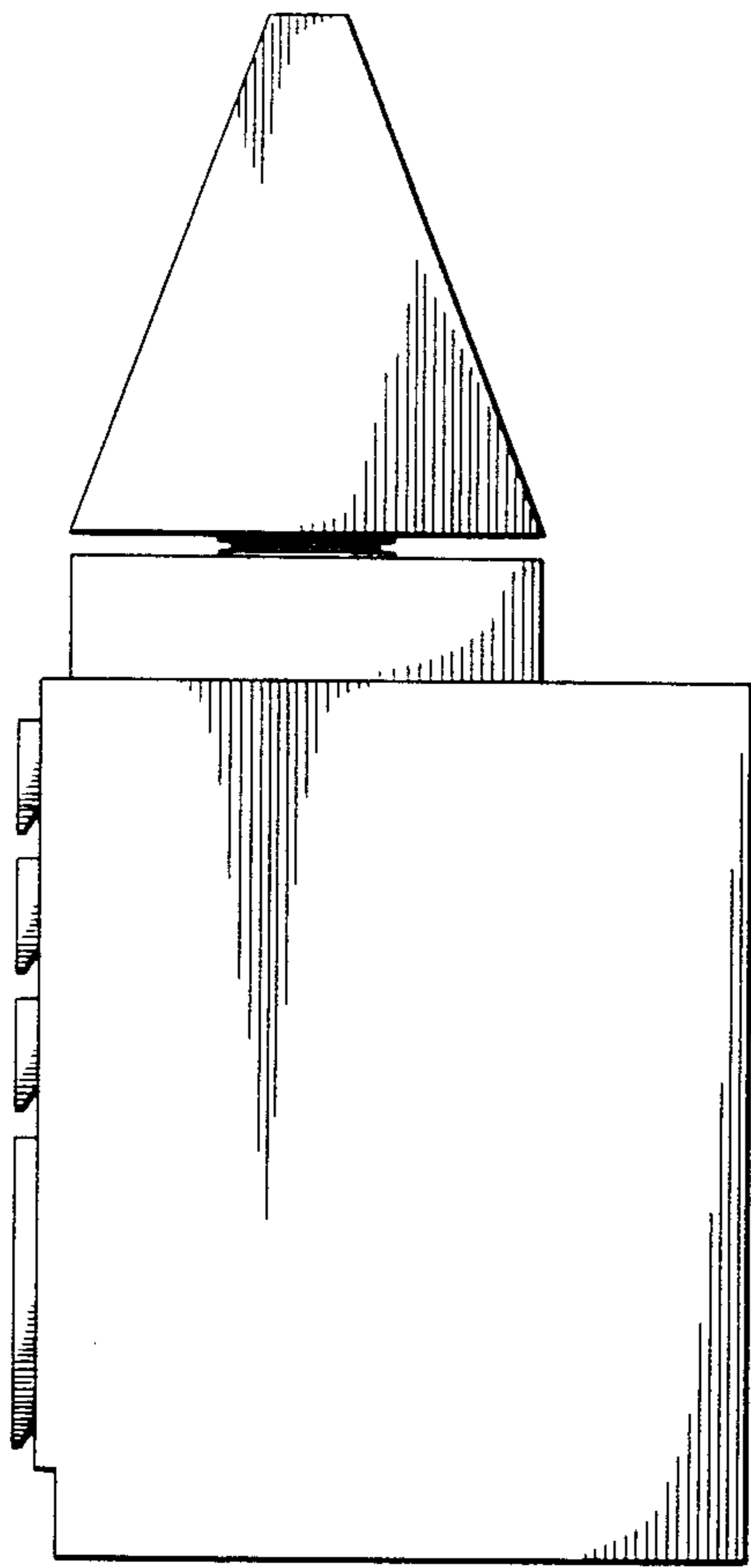

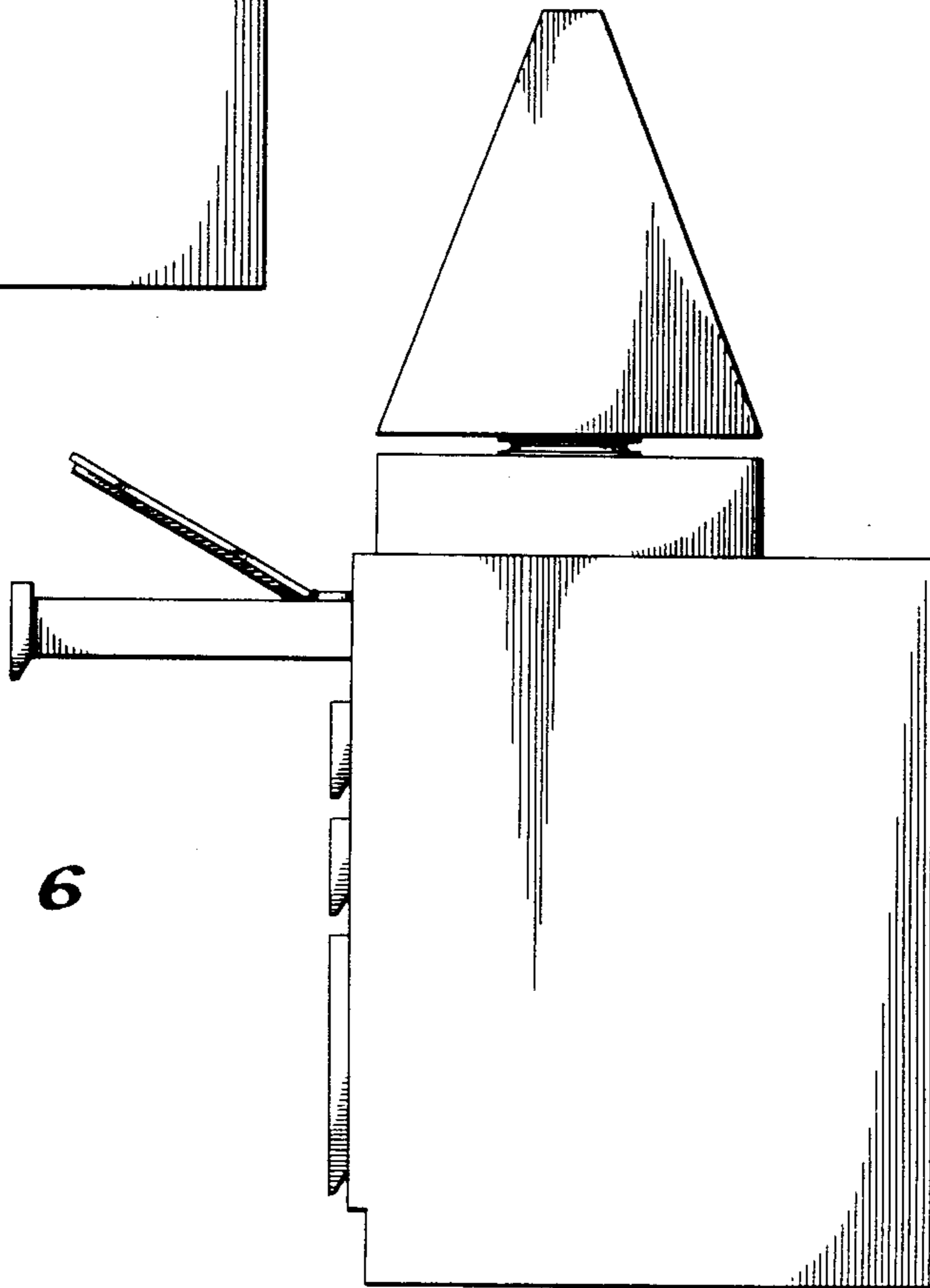
