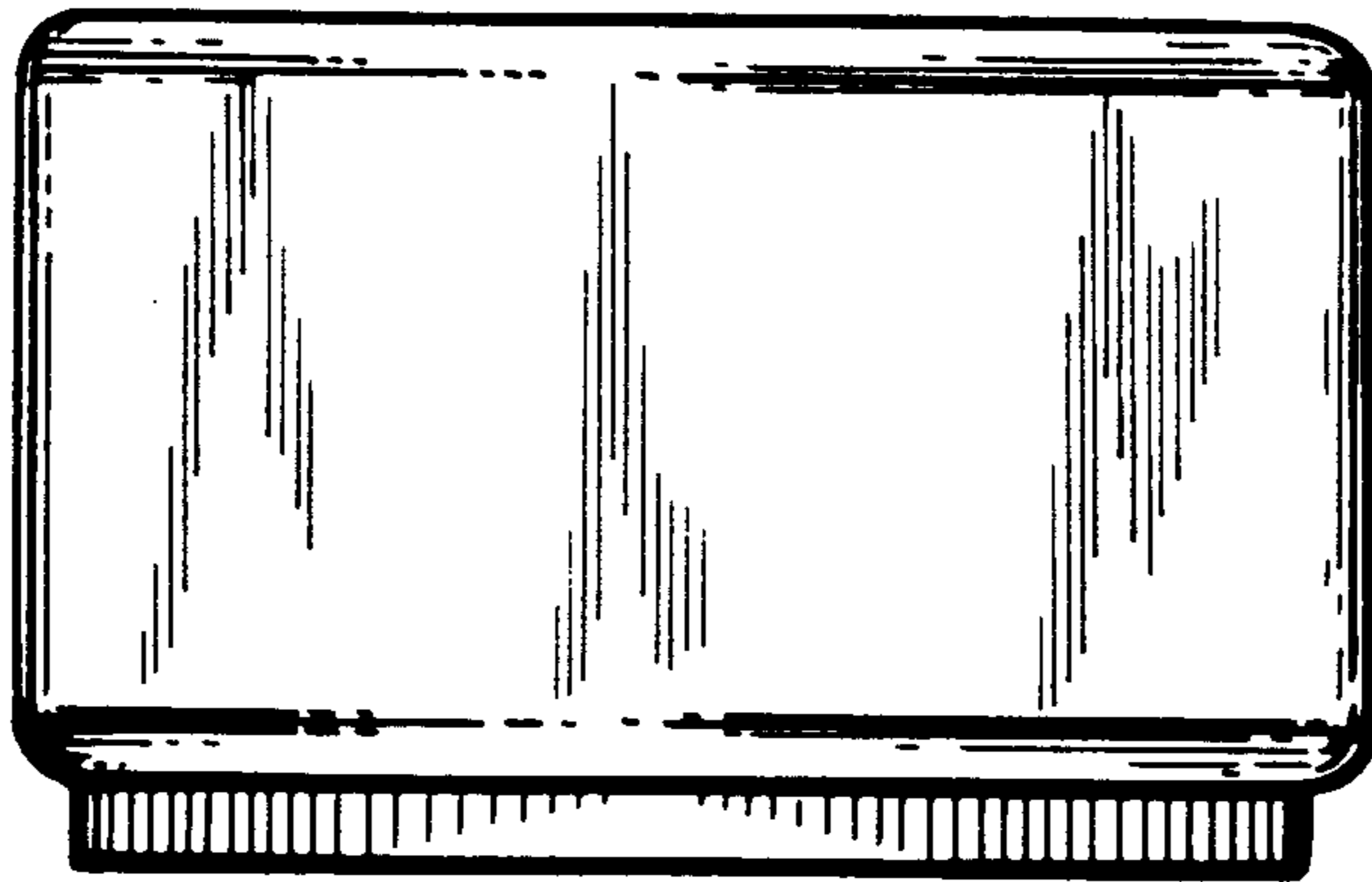

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a modular lamp stand for indirect lighting, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a modular lamp stand for indirect lighting showing our new design, the back and two opposite sides being identical;  
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; and  
FIG. 3 is a fragmentary perspective view of the top portion thereof.



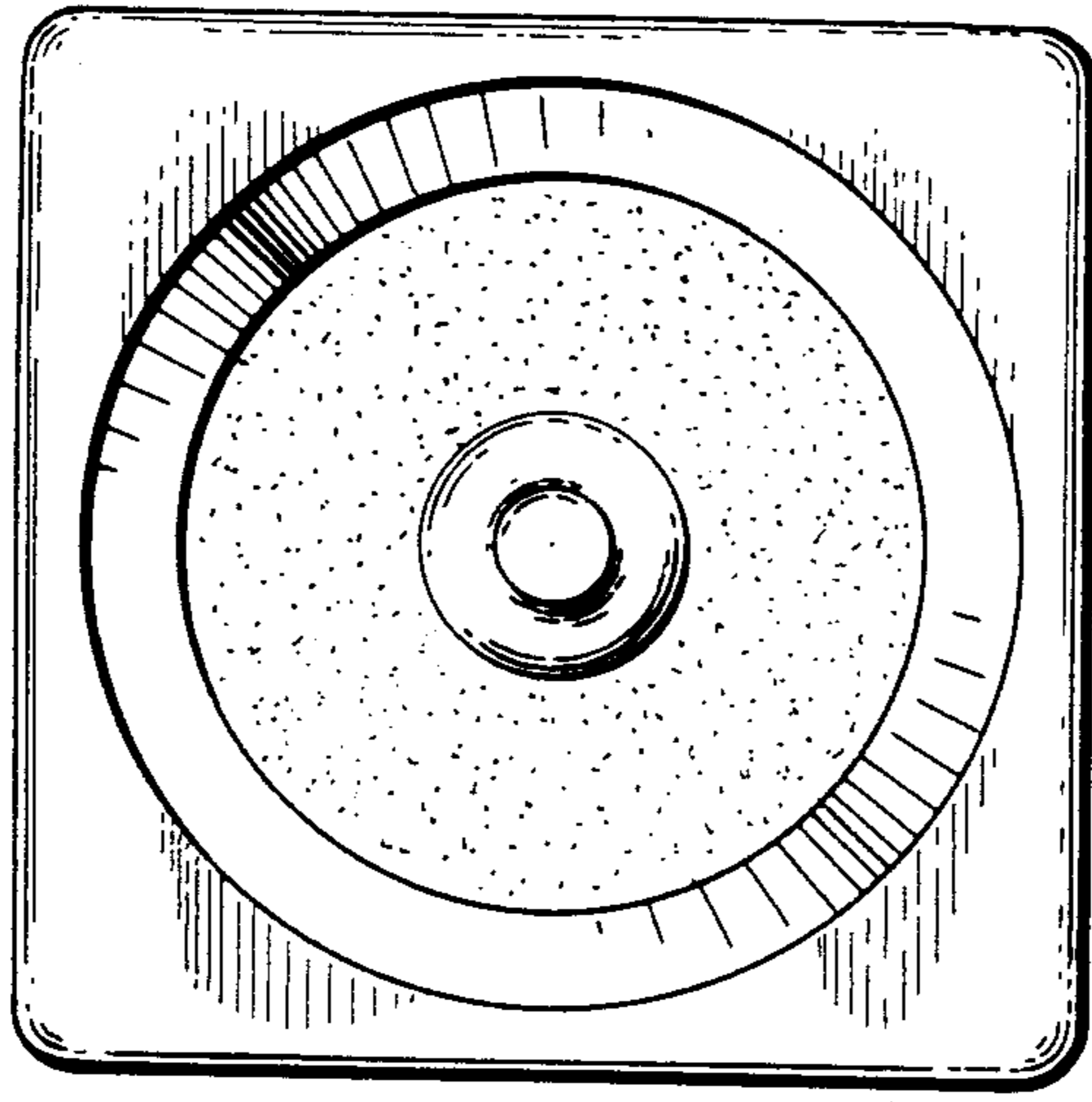

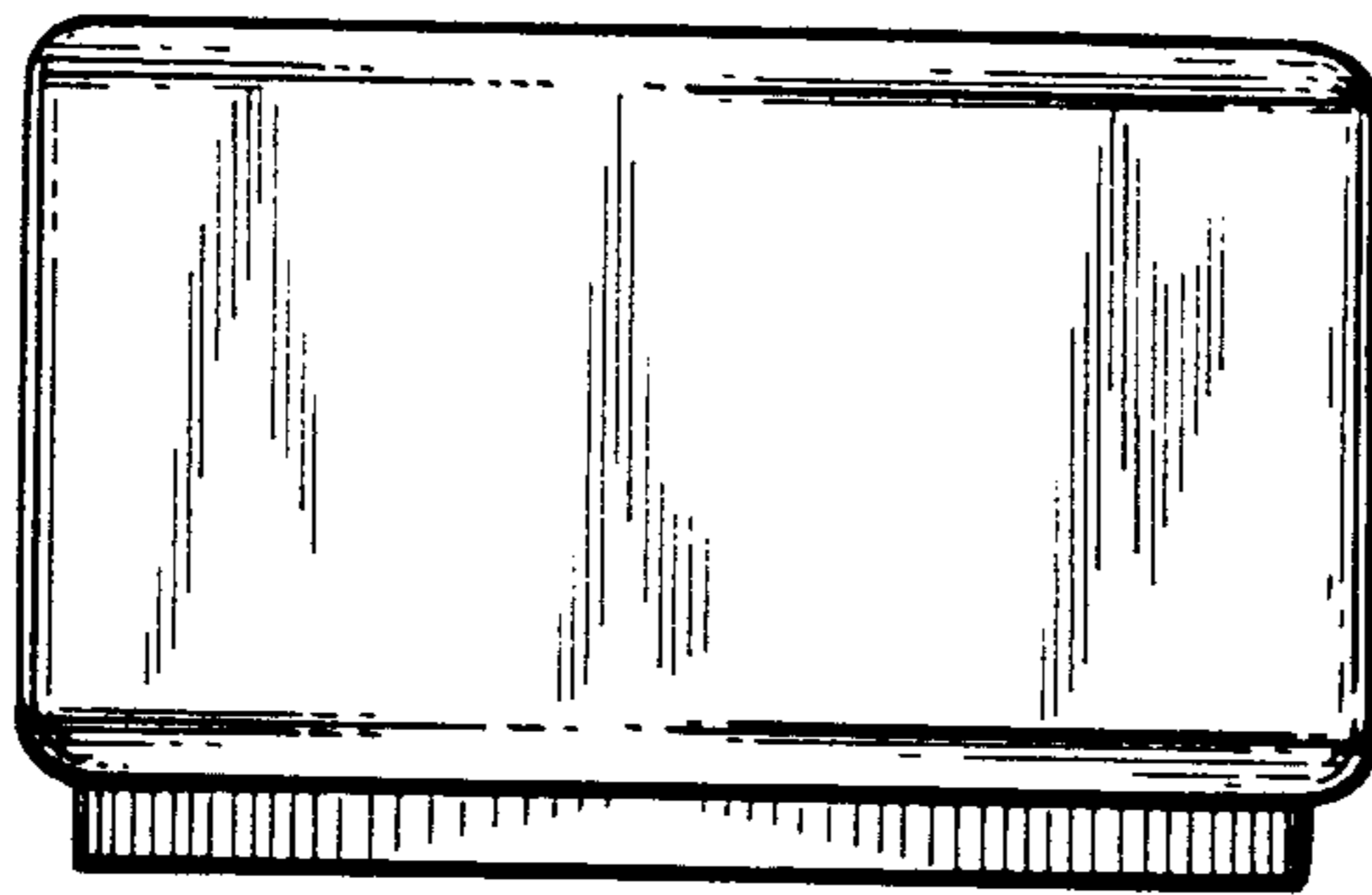

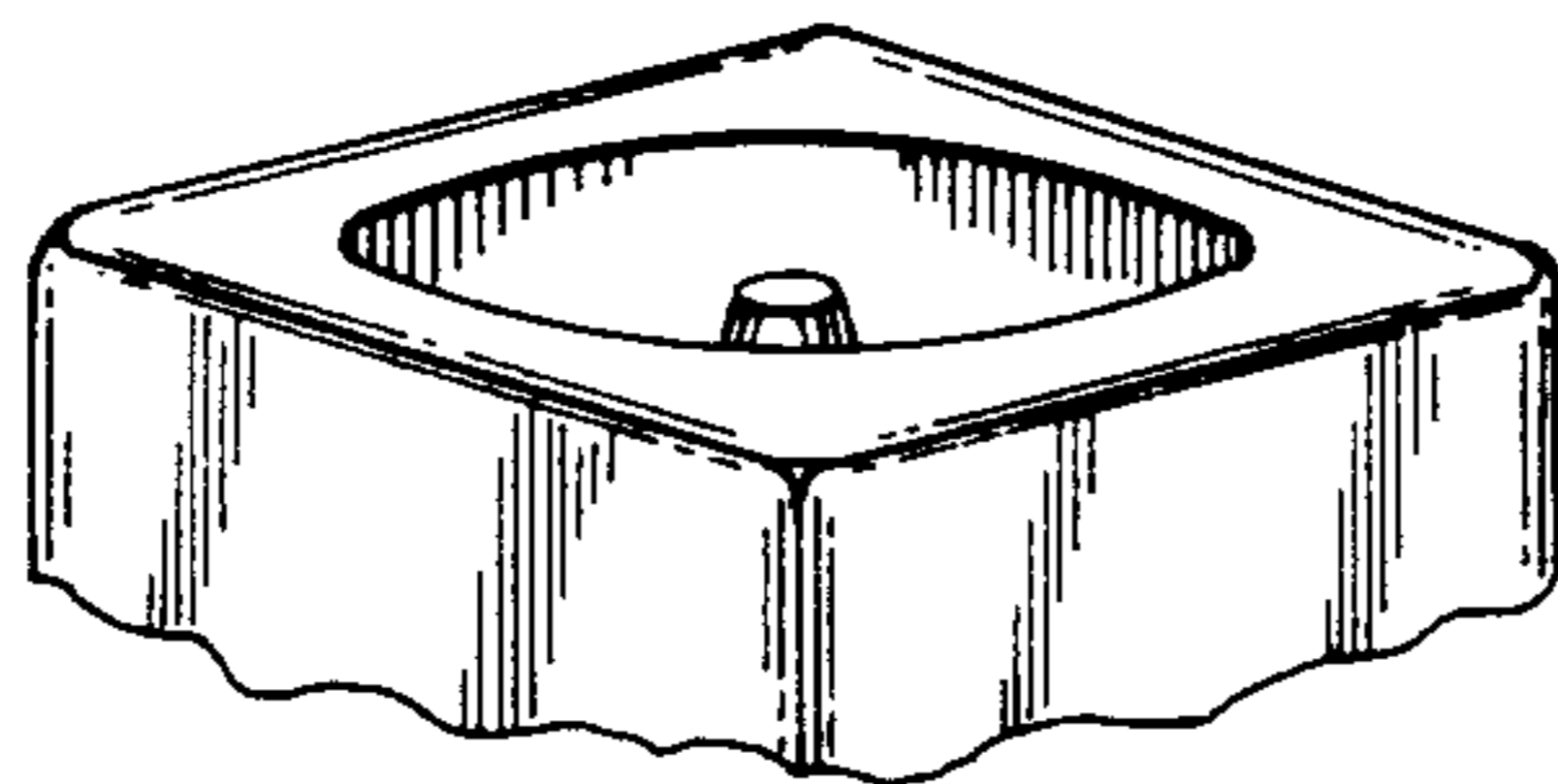
