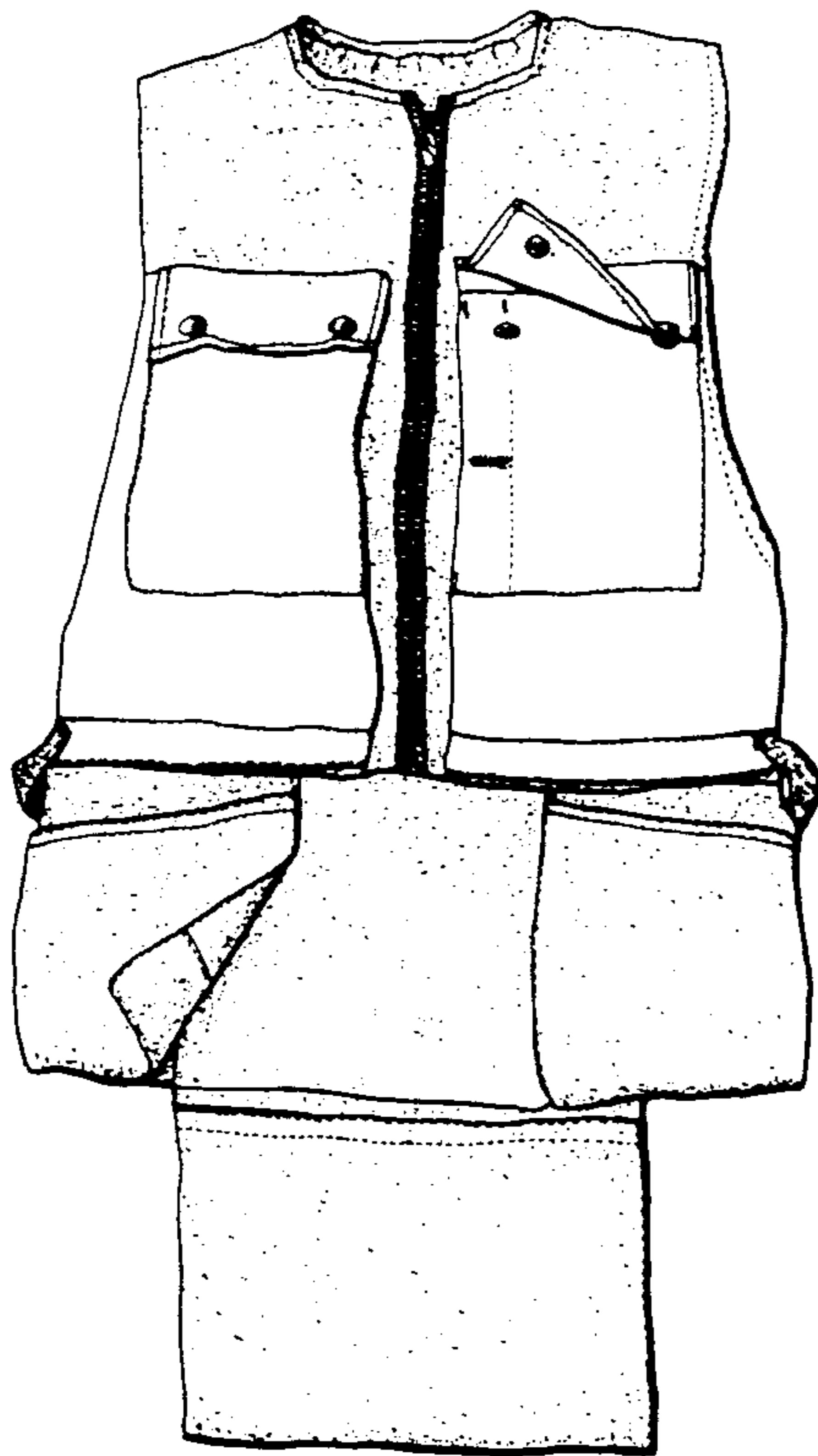

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a workman's vest
showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a view similar to FIG. 1 with the bottom rear
pocket folded down;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the vest in the condi-
tion of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view in the condition of
FIG. 2.



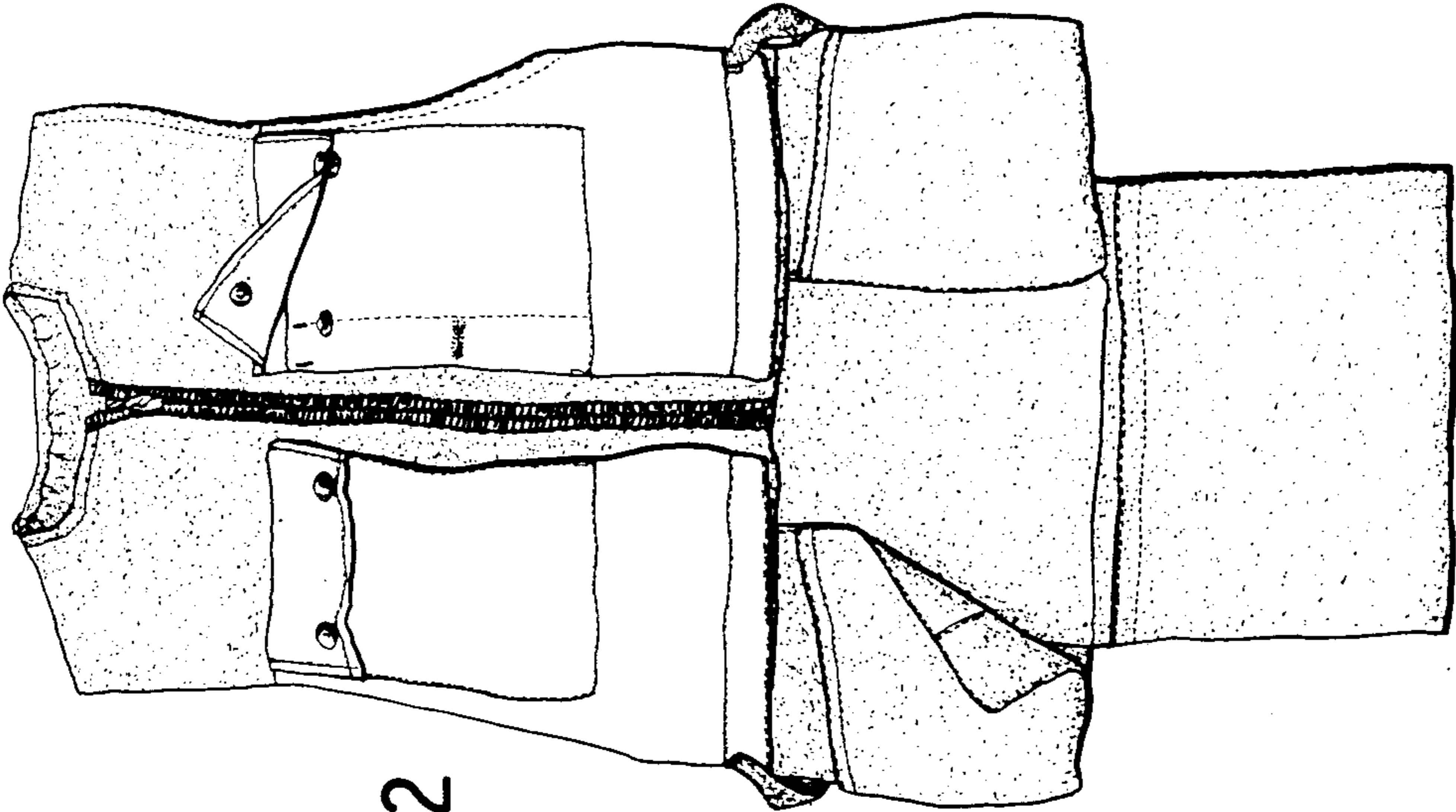

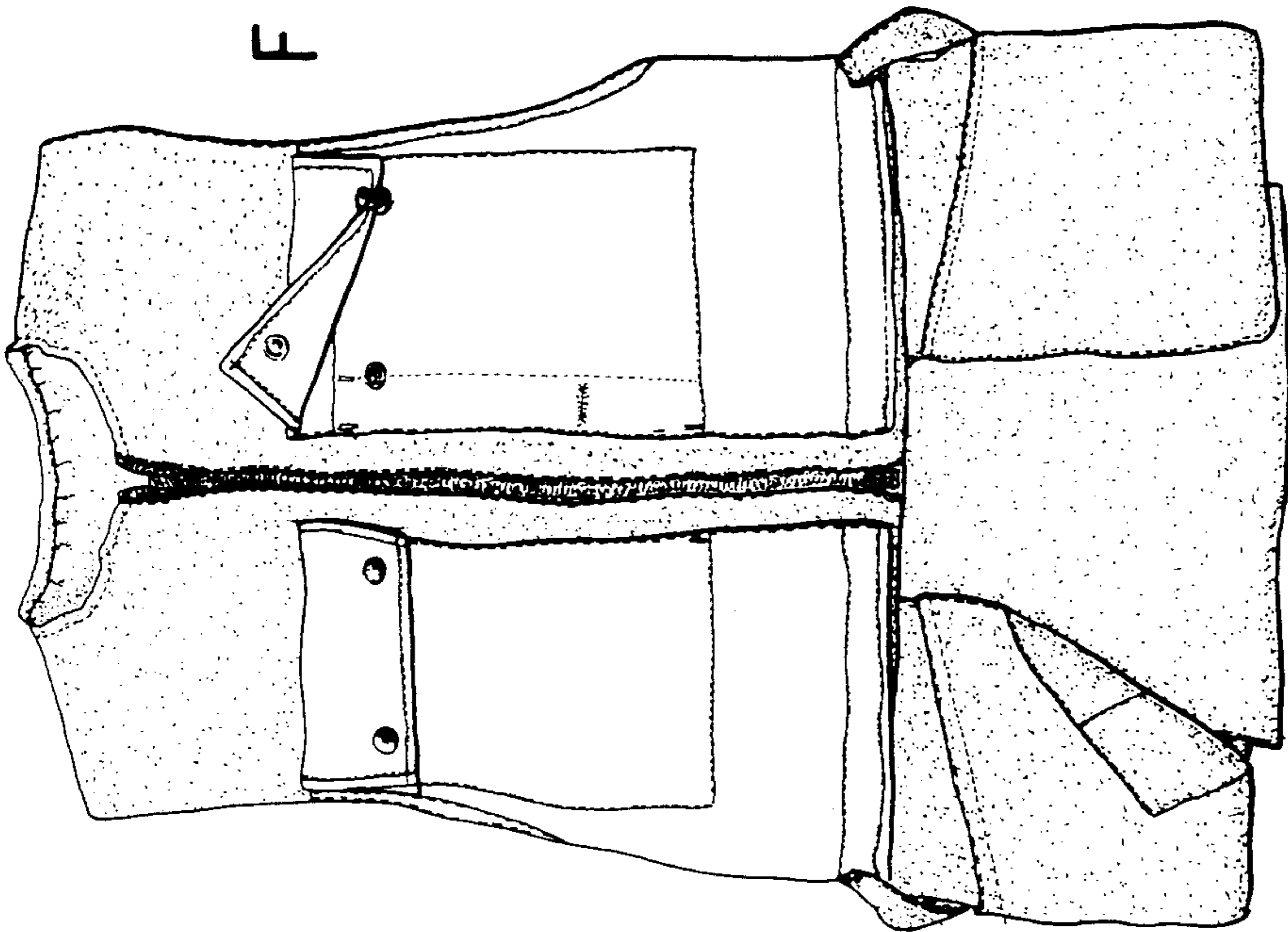

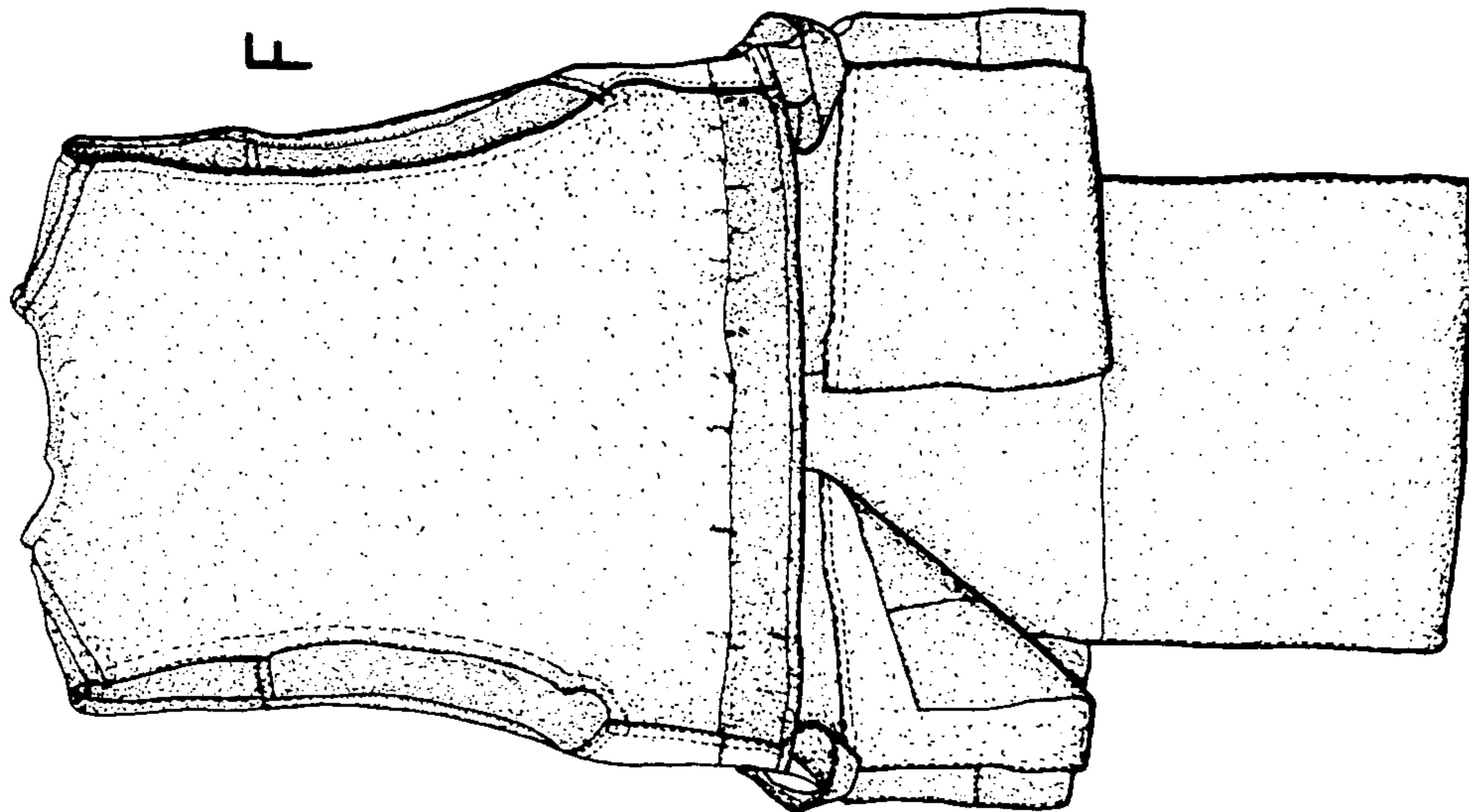
