The ornamental design for a wine decanting machine, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a wine decanting machine showing my new design, the side opposite being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.
