DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear elevational view of a tape recorder and player showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof.

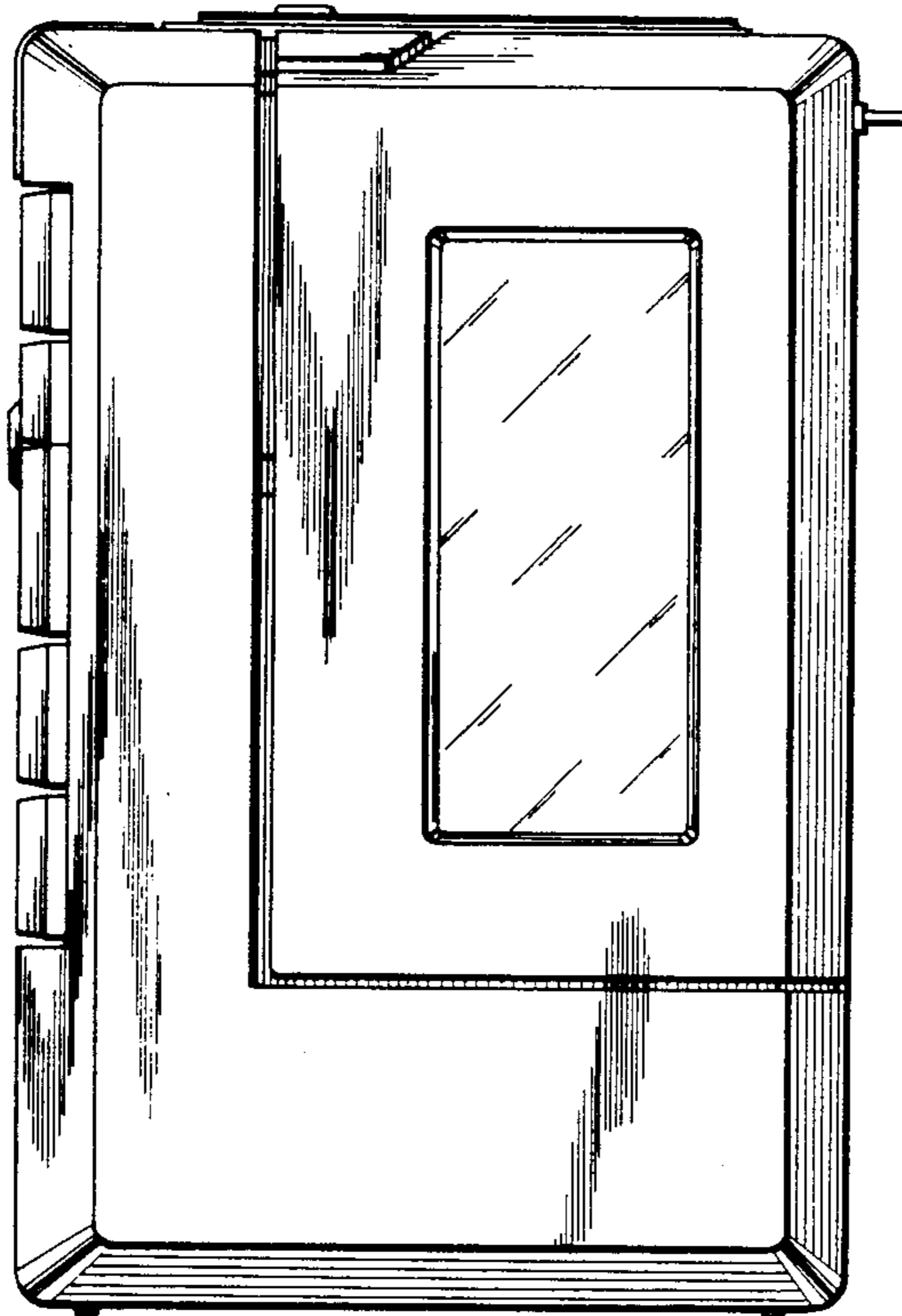

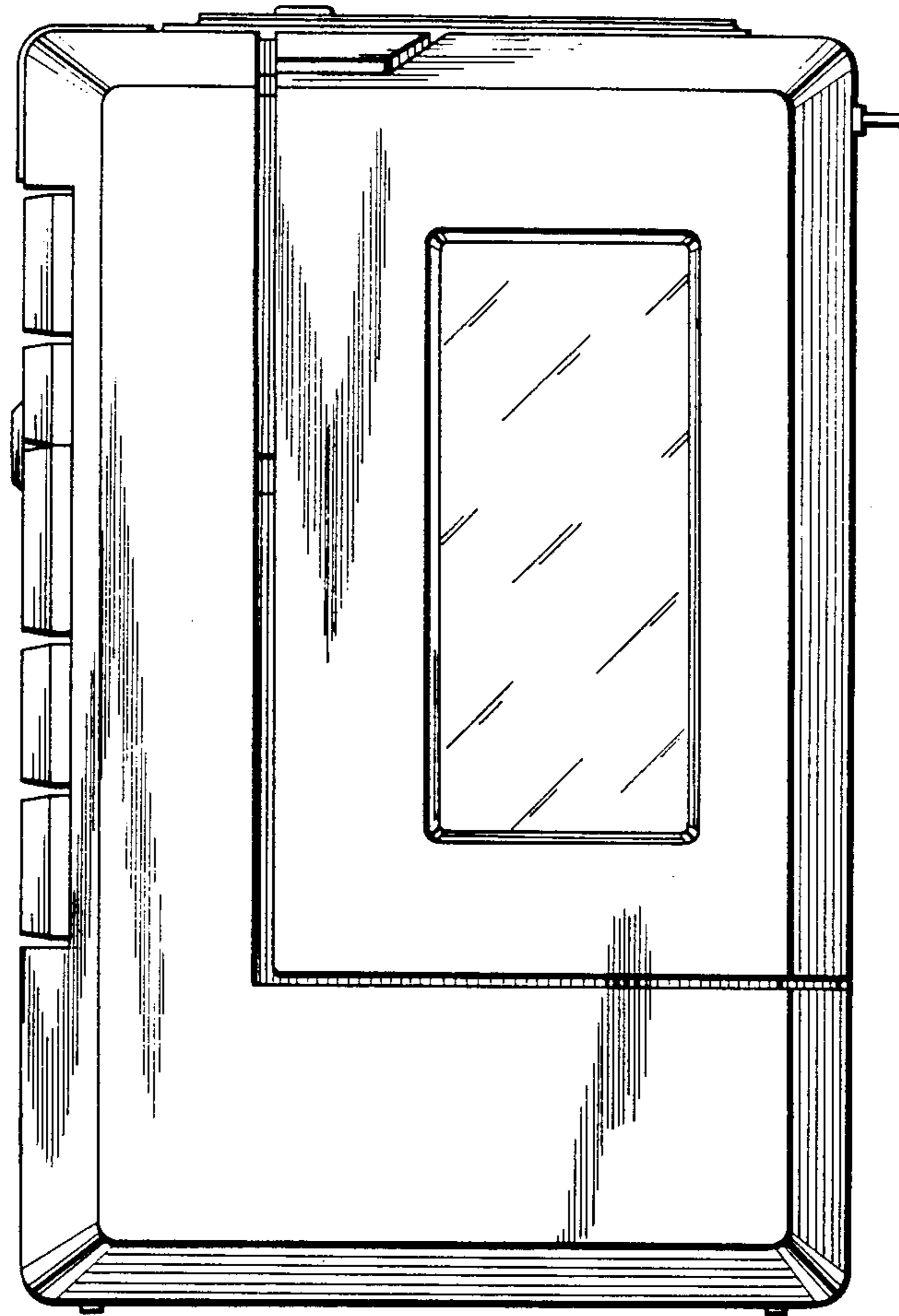

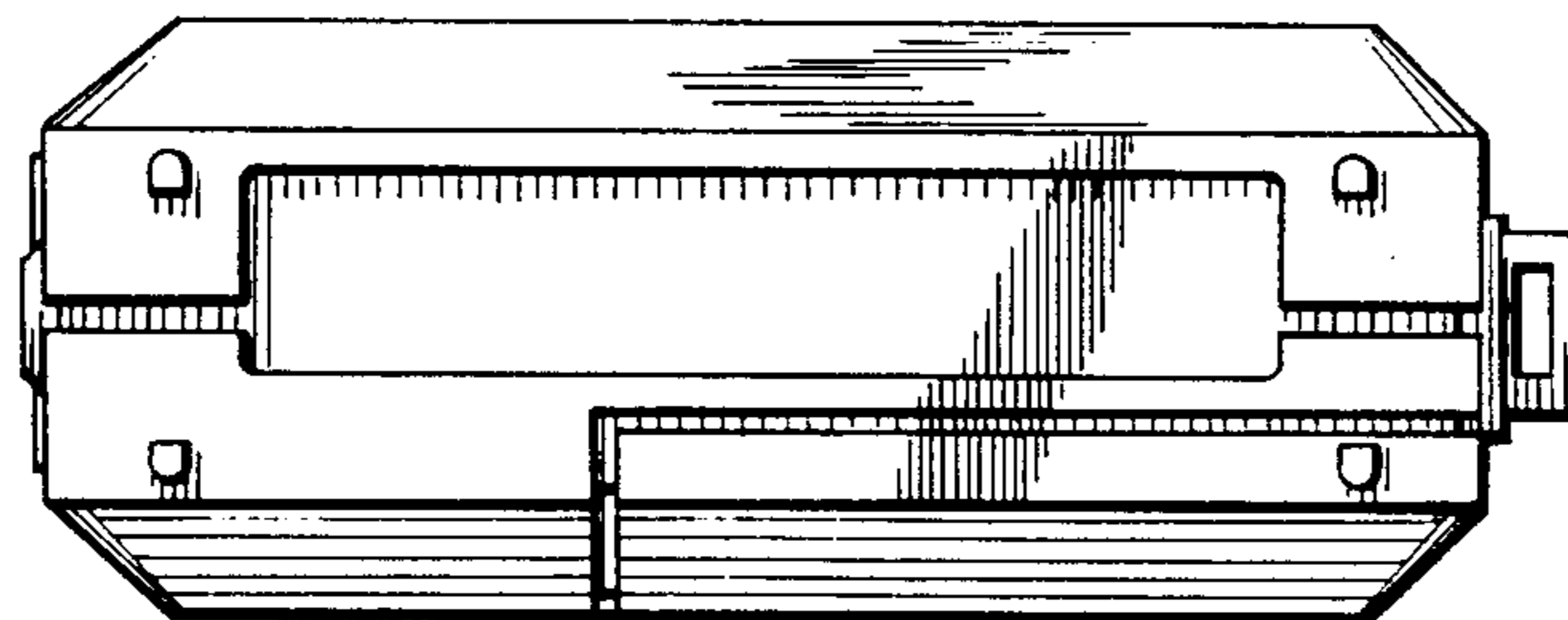

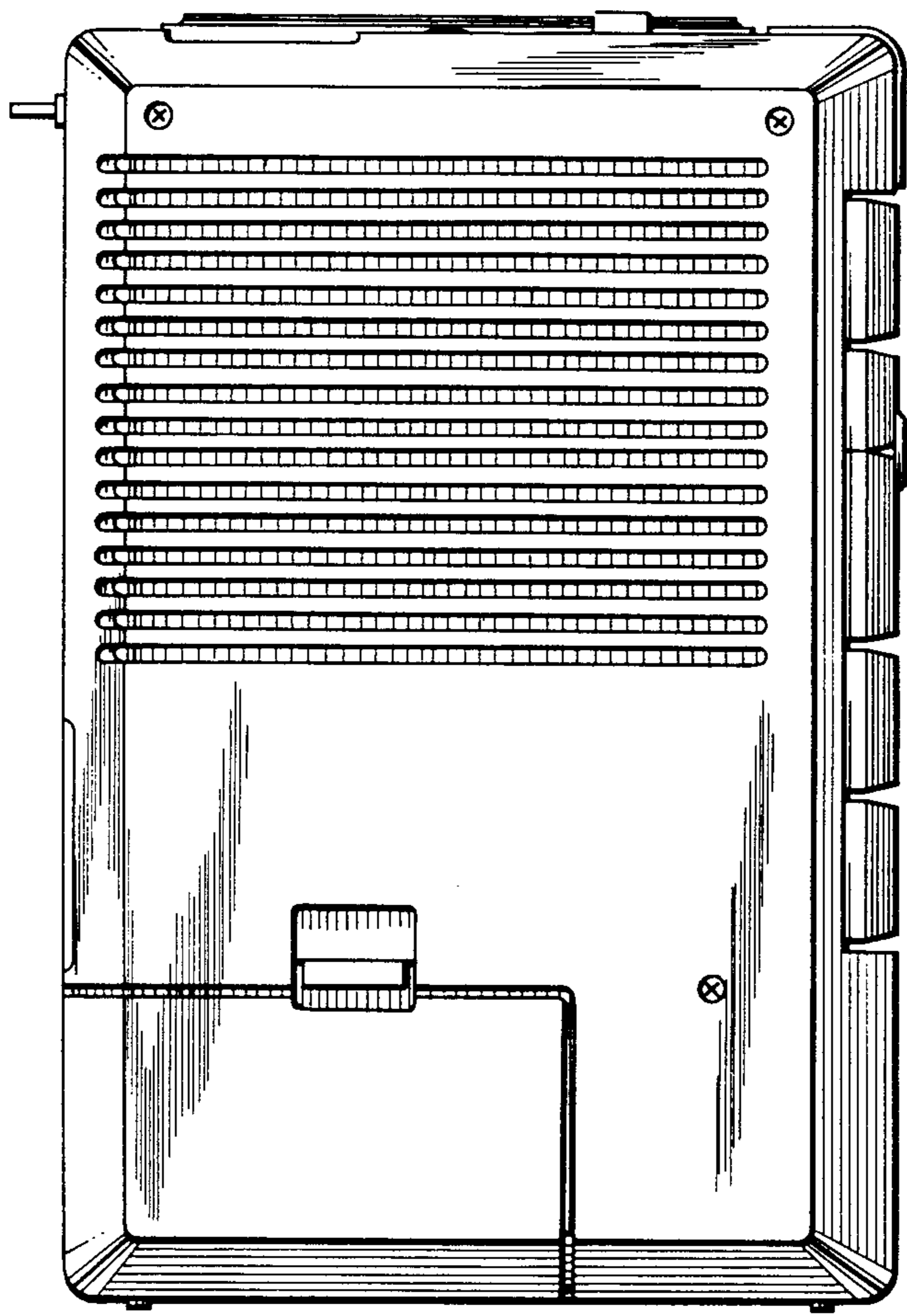

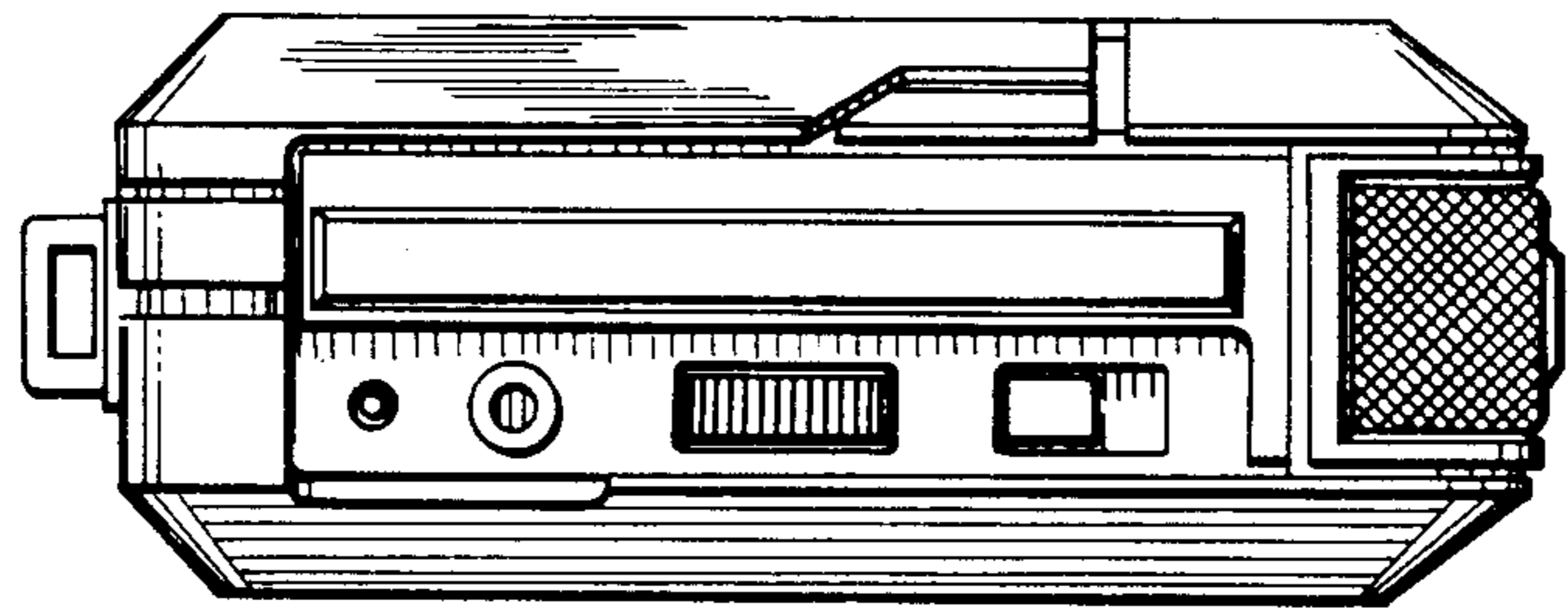

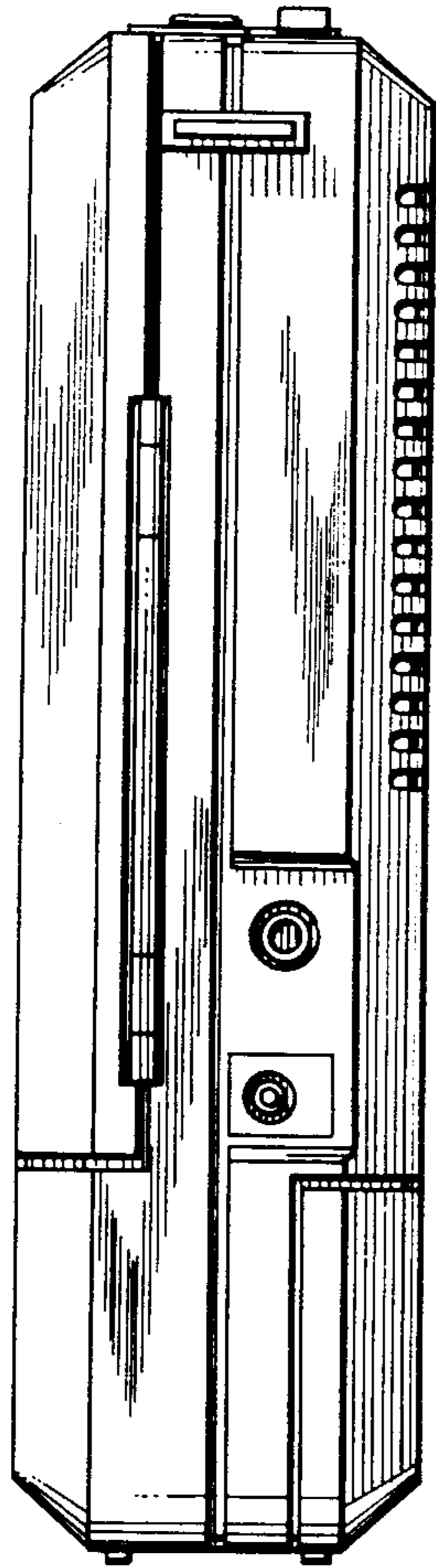
