[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a light fixture, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a light fixture showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken on line 2—2 of FIG. 1 with the bracket portion shown fragmentarily for ease of illustration;

FIG. 3 is an end view thereof with the rotatable shade in an alternate position.
