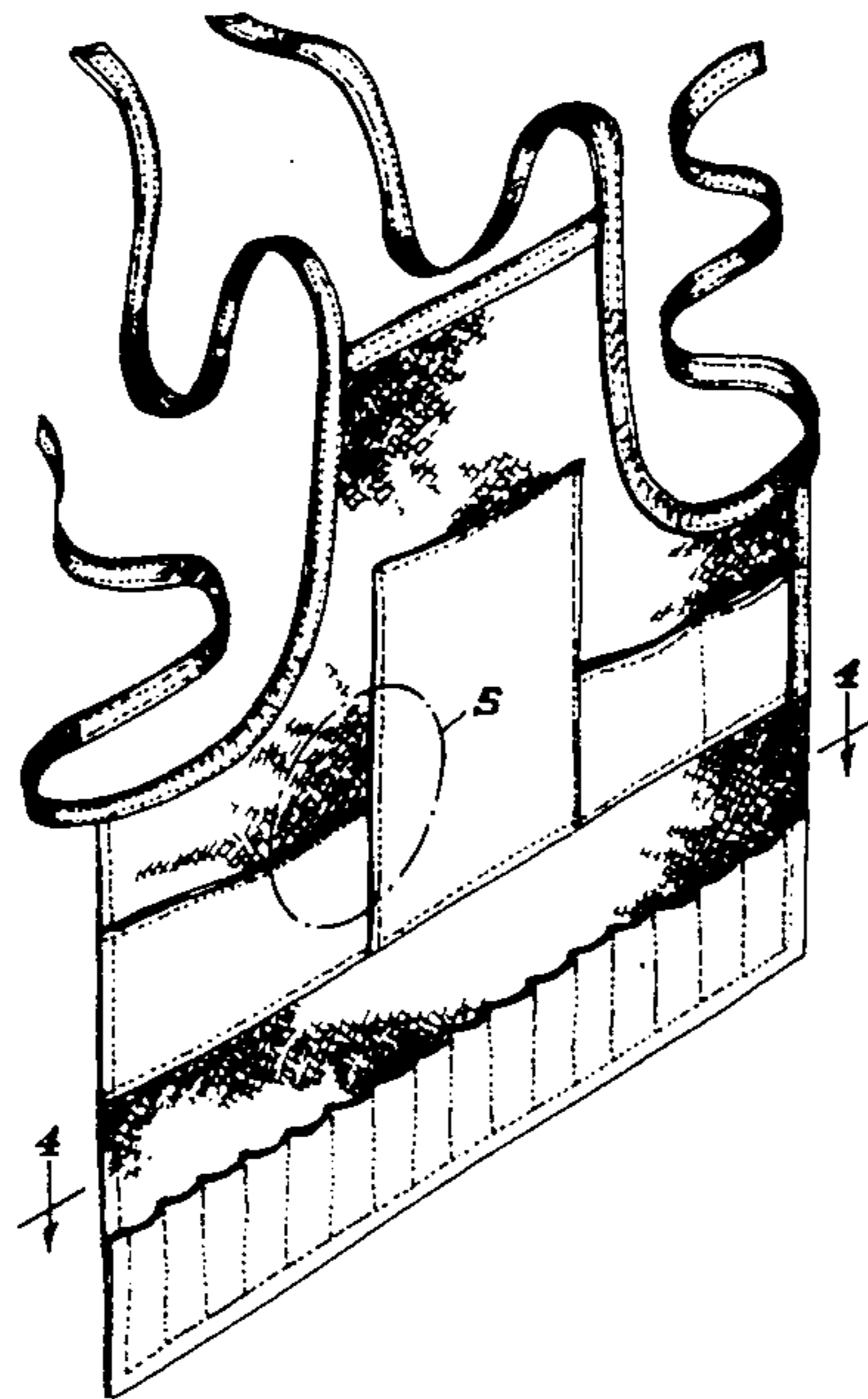

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an apron, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an apron showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view;
 FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view;
 FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken along line 4—4 in FIG. 1; and
 FIG. 5 is an enlarged fragmentary view of part of the apron shown within circle 5 in FIG. 1.
 On the apron, the upper four larger and the bottom sixteen smaller pockets are comprised of striped material like that shown in the bottom half and upper right quarter of FIG. 5. The lining in the upper left quarter of FIG. 5 indicates color contrast of the rest of the apron with the pockets.



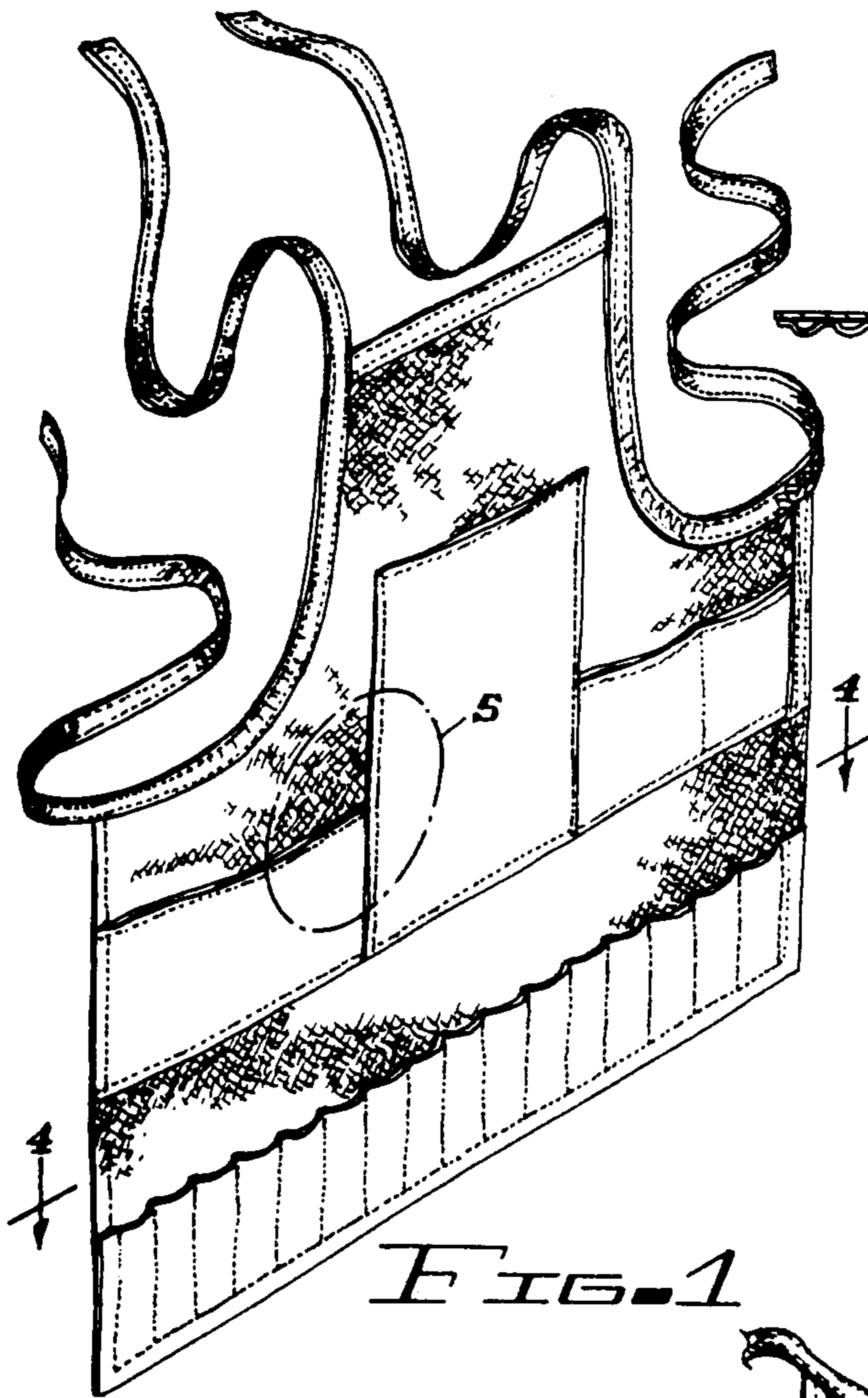

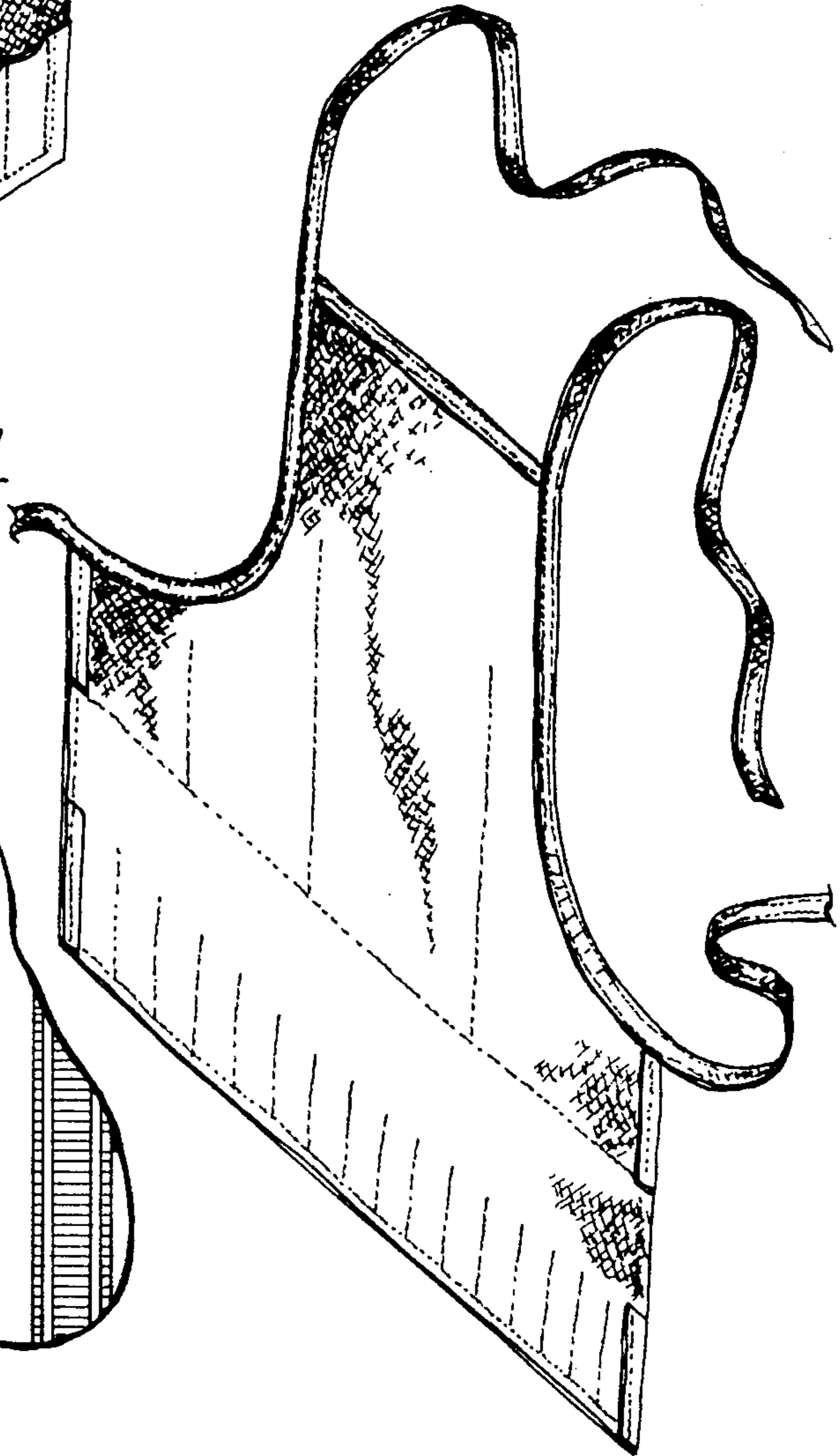

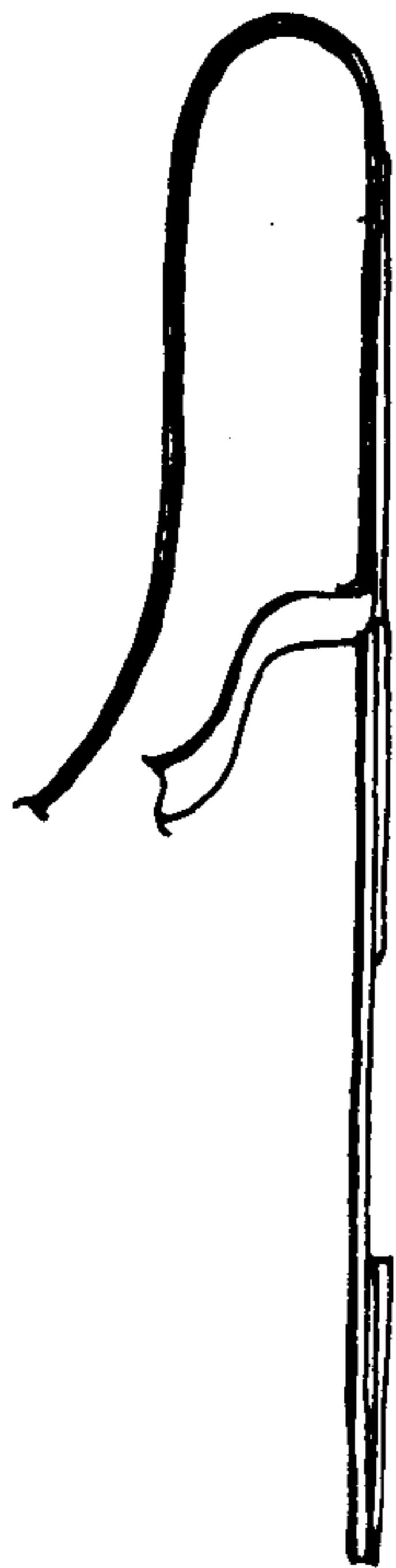

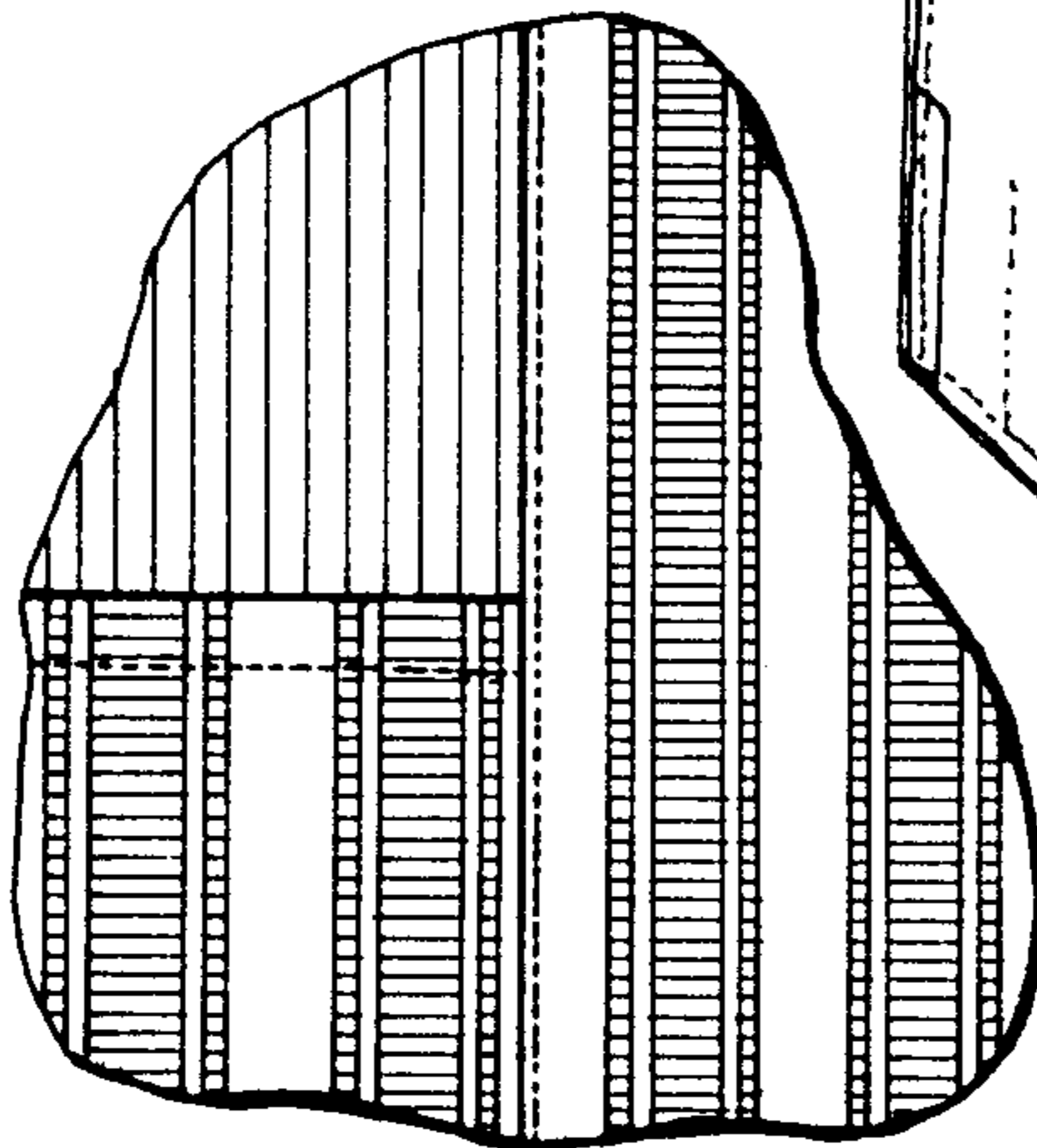
