The ornamental design for an electric pressure cooker, substantially as shown and described.

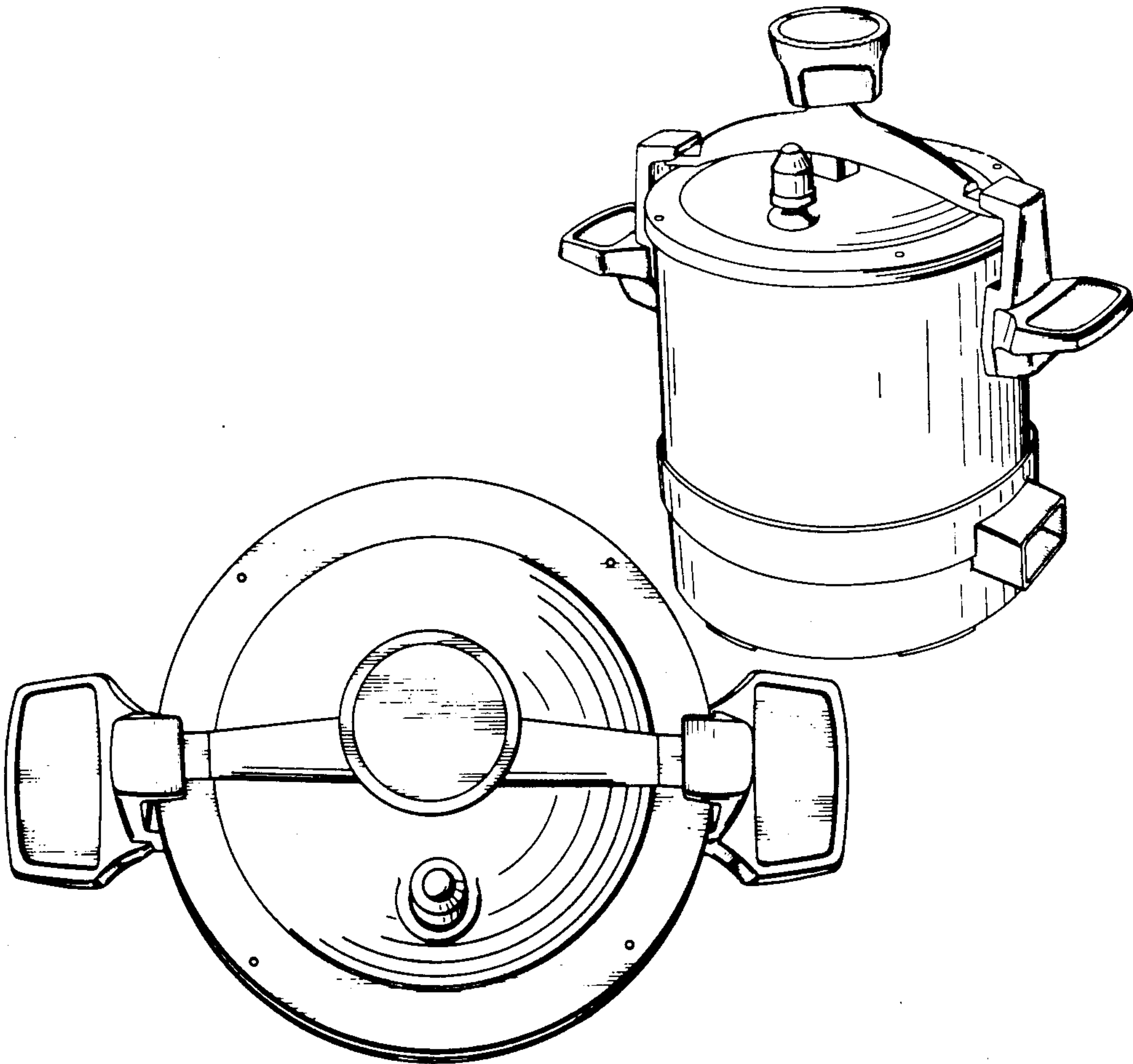
DESCRIPTION

The bottom surface of the pressure cooker base is substantially planar and unornamented.



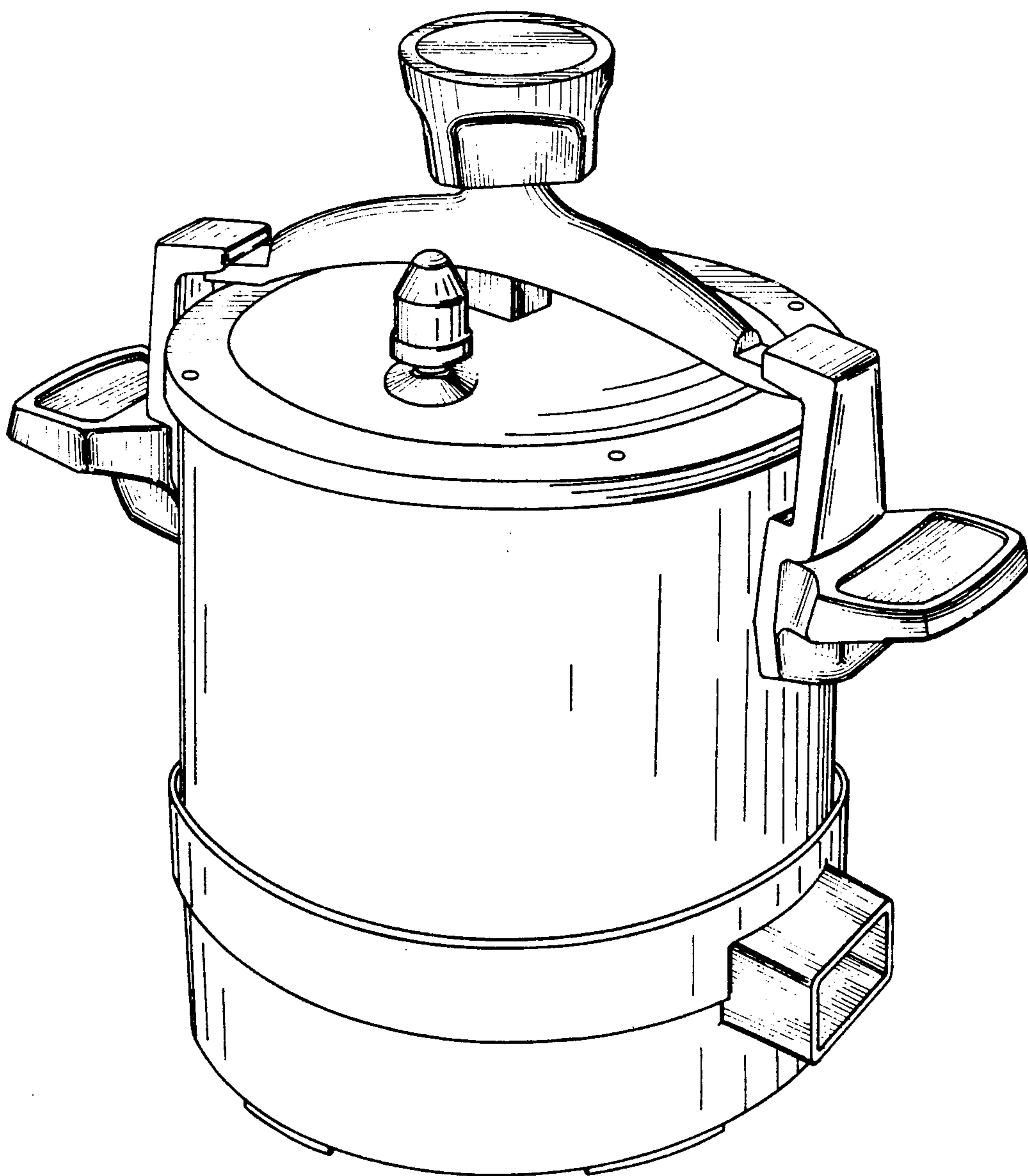

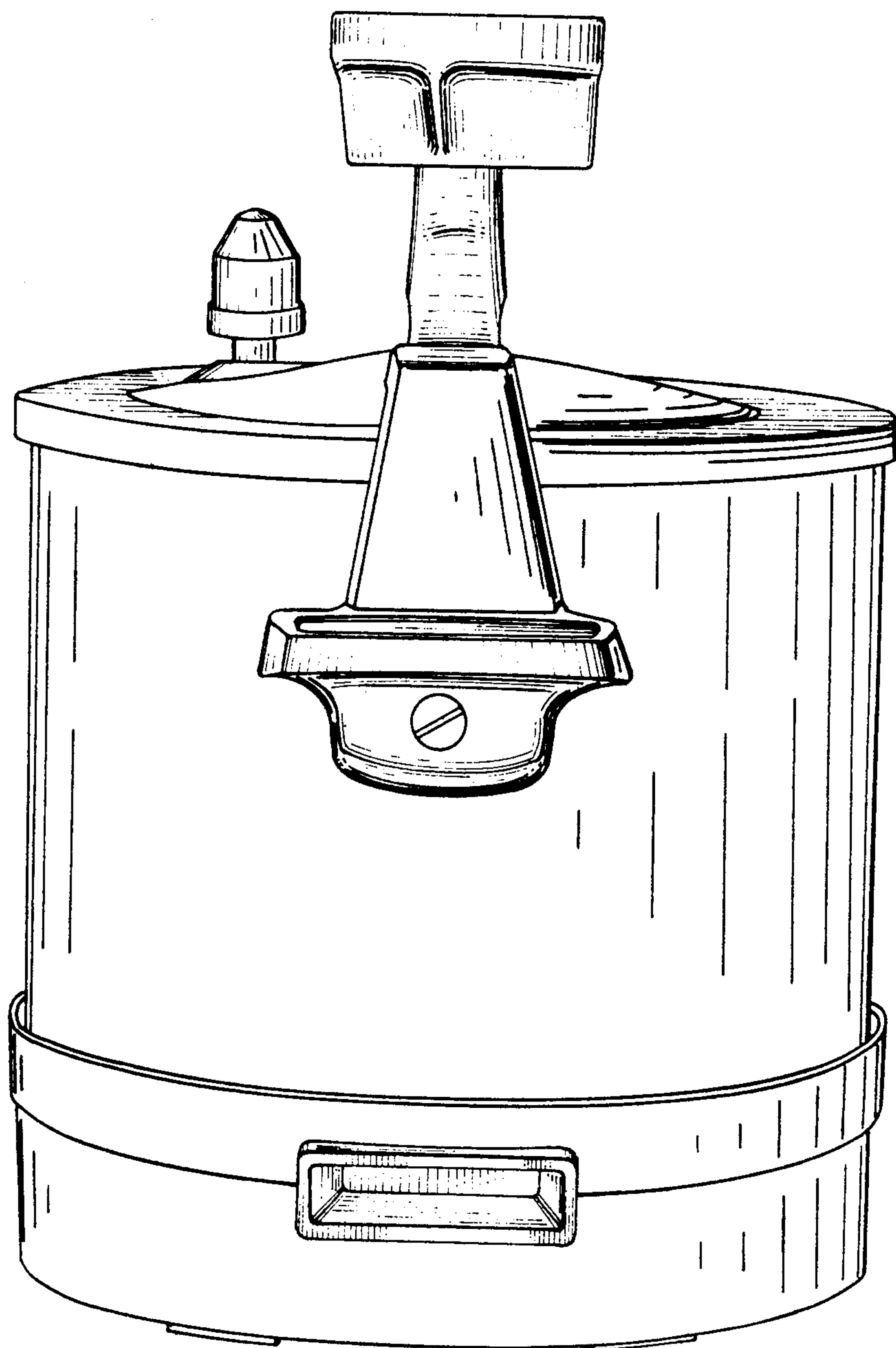

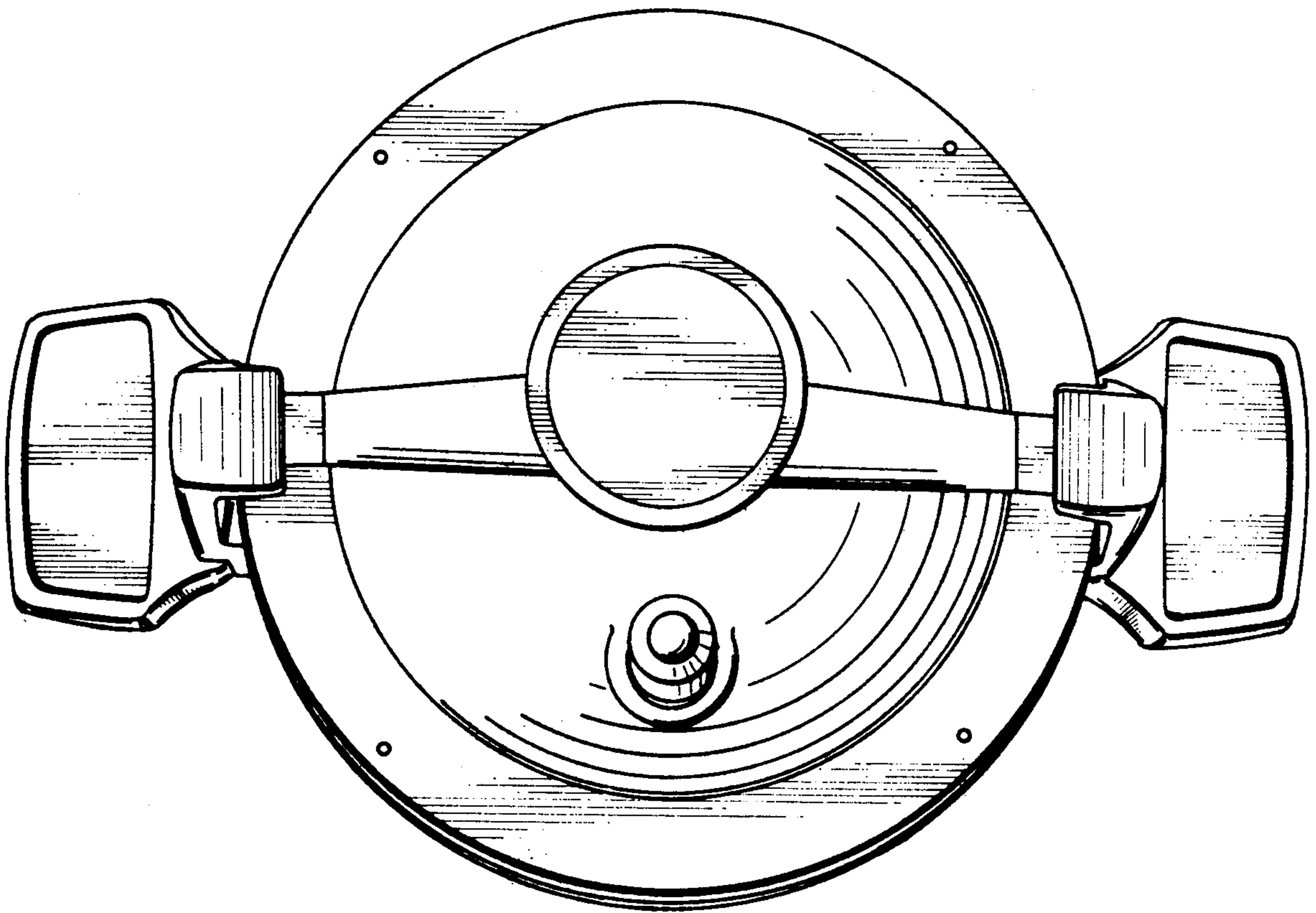
