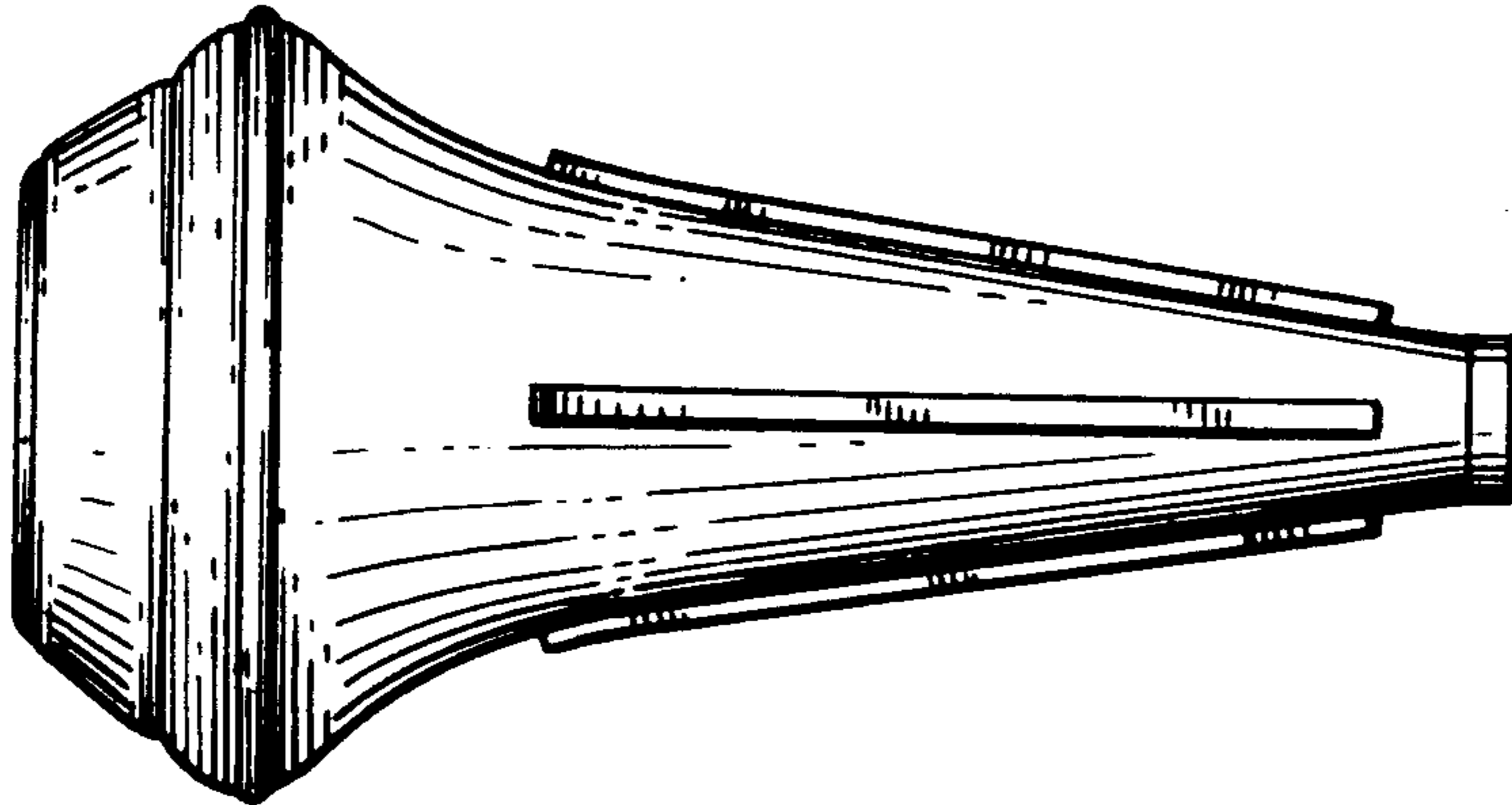

The ornamental design for a mute for brass instruments, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a mute for brass instruments showing my new design; FIG. 2 is another side elevational view; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view; and FIG. 5 is an elevational view of the side opposite FIG. 1.



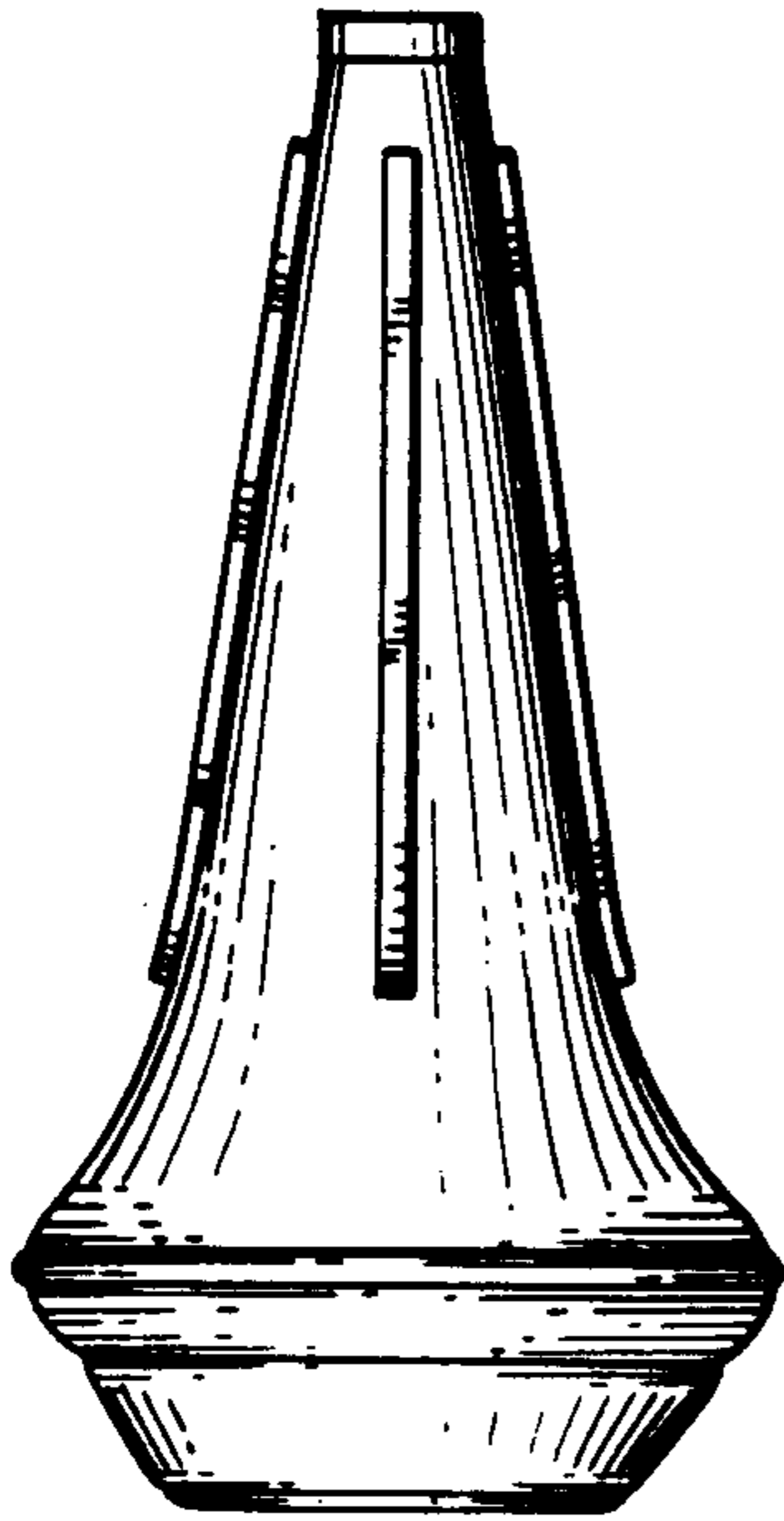

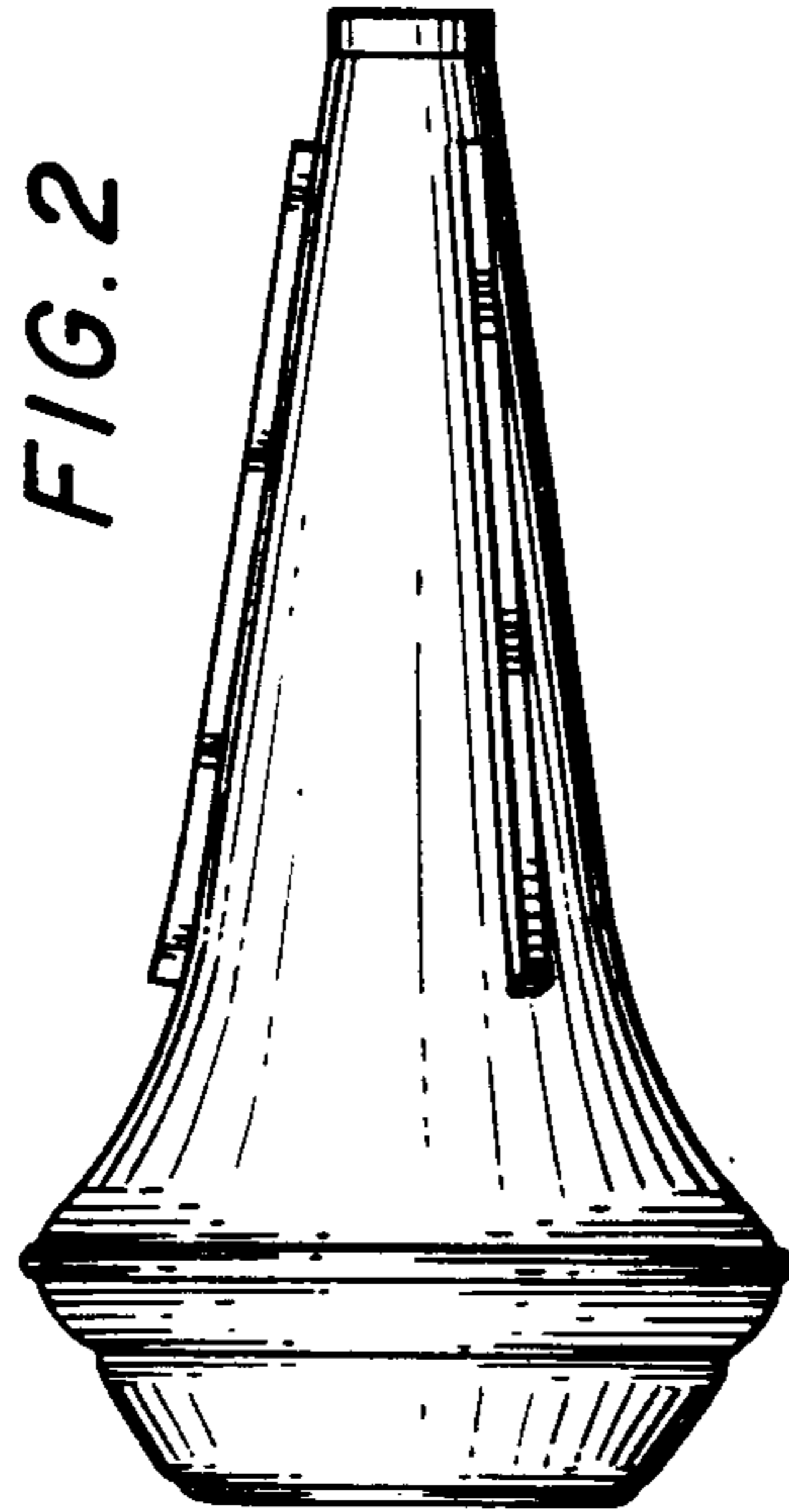

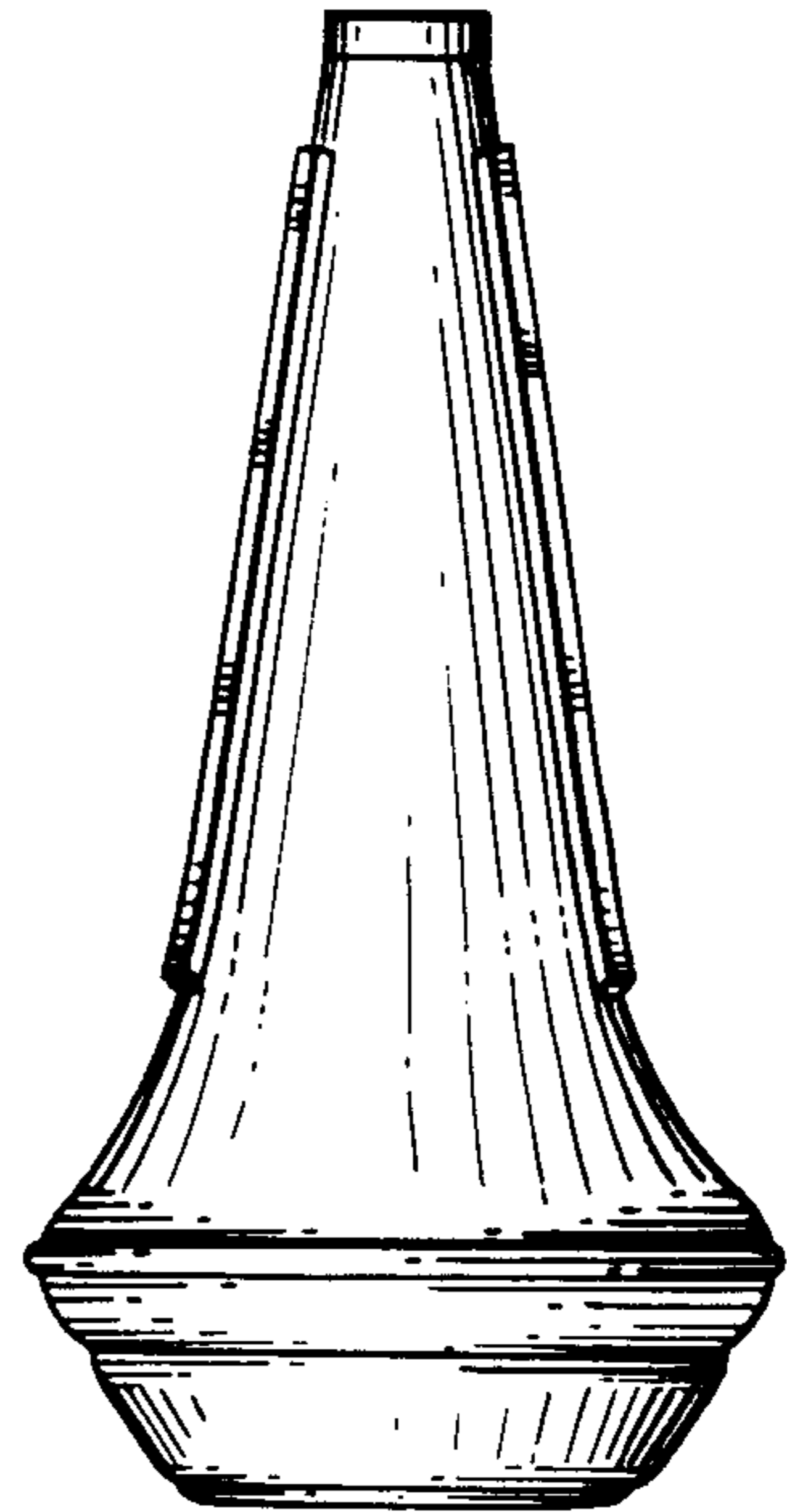

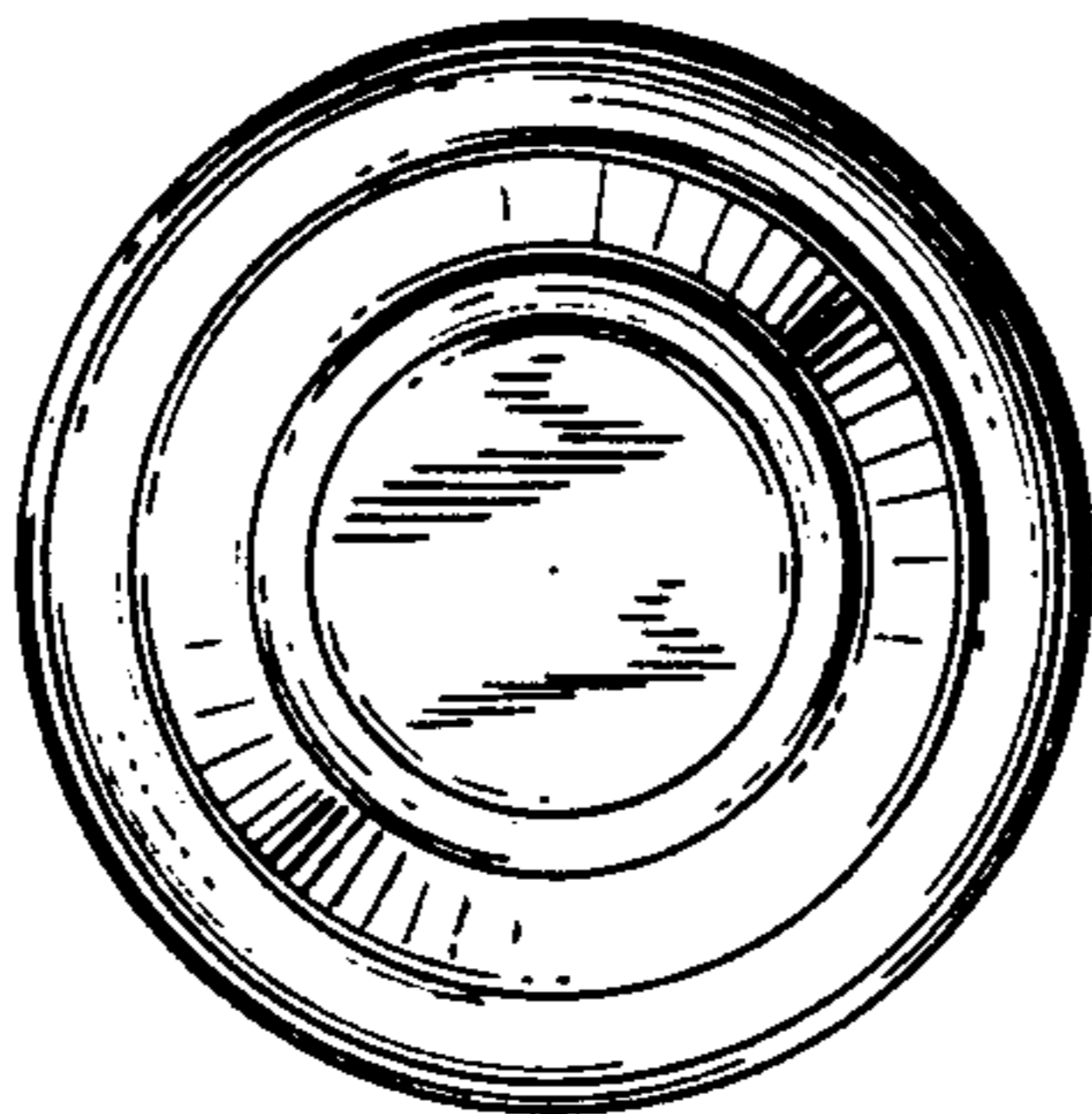

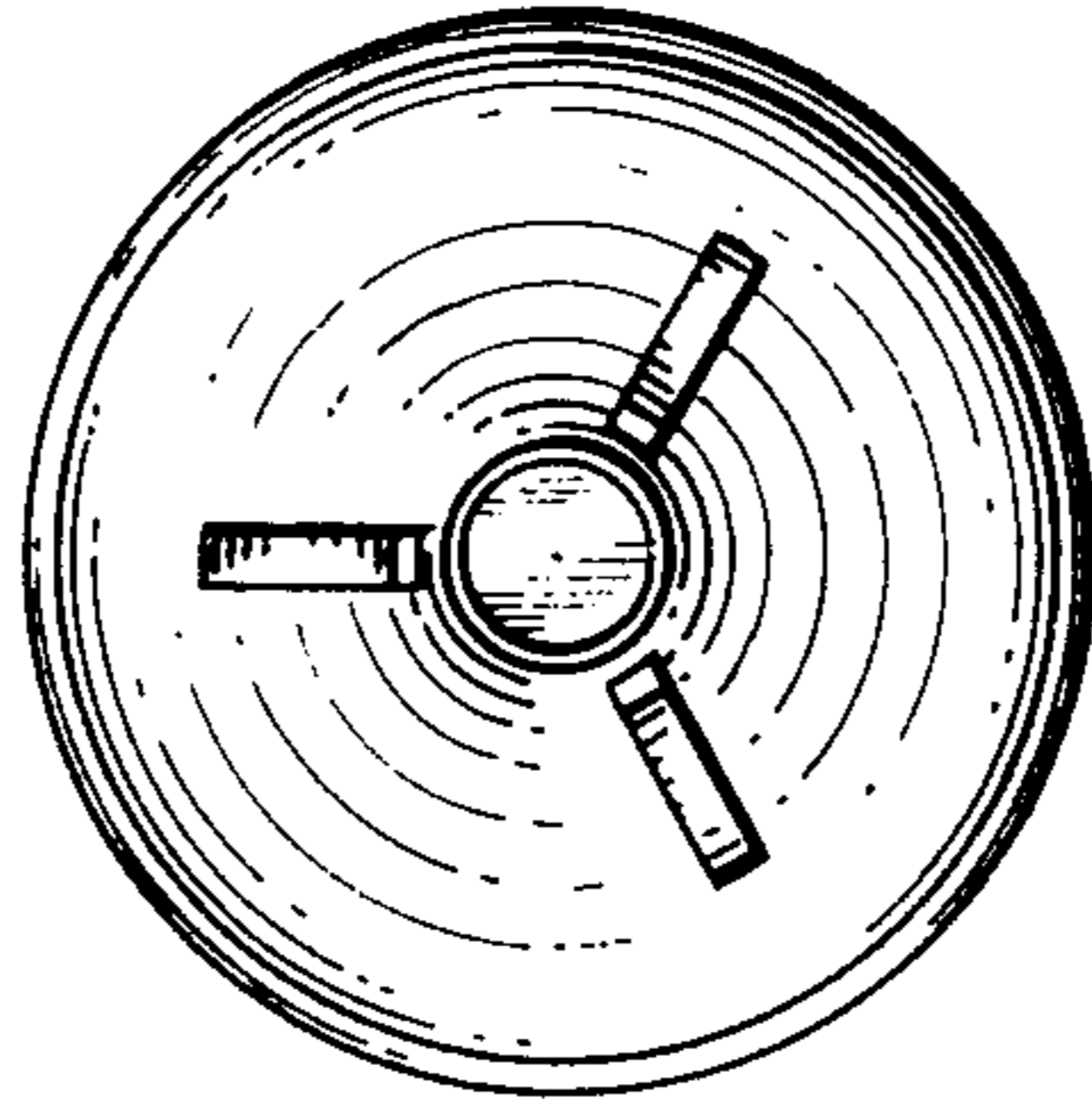
