FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and right side of a canine quick release collar showing our new design, the releasable top buckle being shown in a detached position;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, showing the releasable top buckle in a locked position, the rear being a mirror image of the front shown;  
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view;  
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view;  
FIG. 5 is a top plan view;  
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view; and,  
FIG. 7 is a cross sectional view, taken on line 7—7 of FIG. 2.

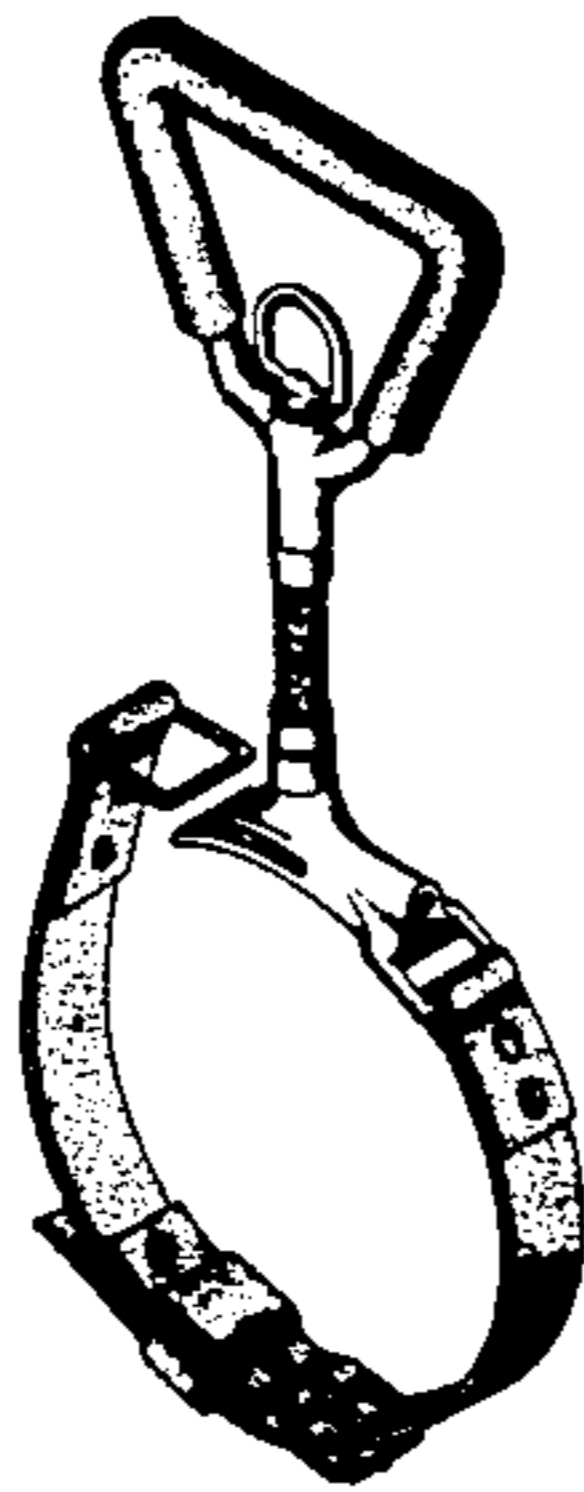

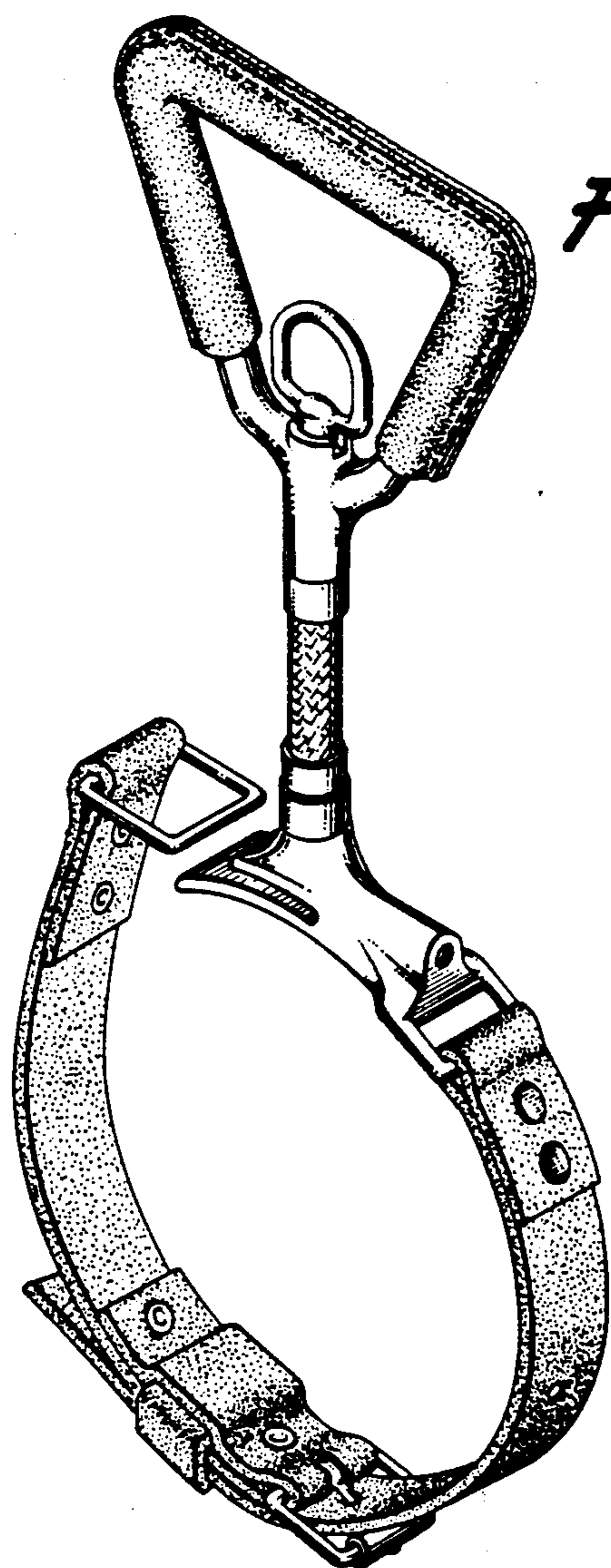

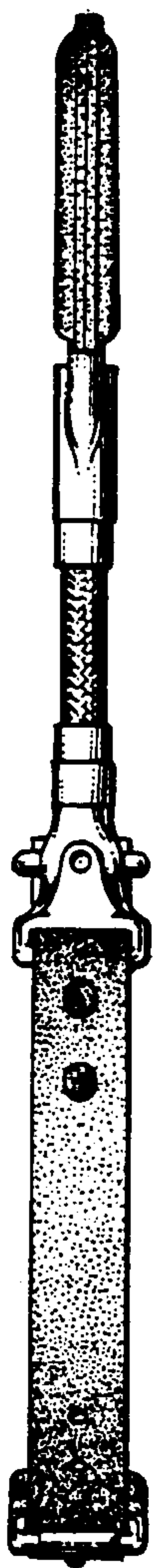

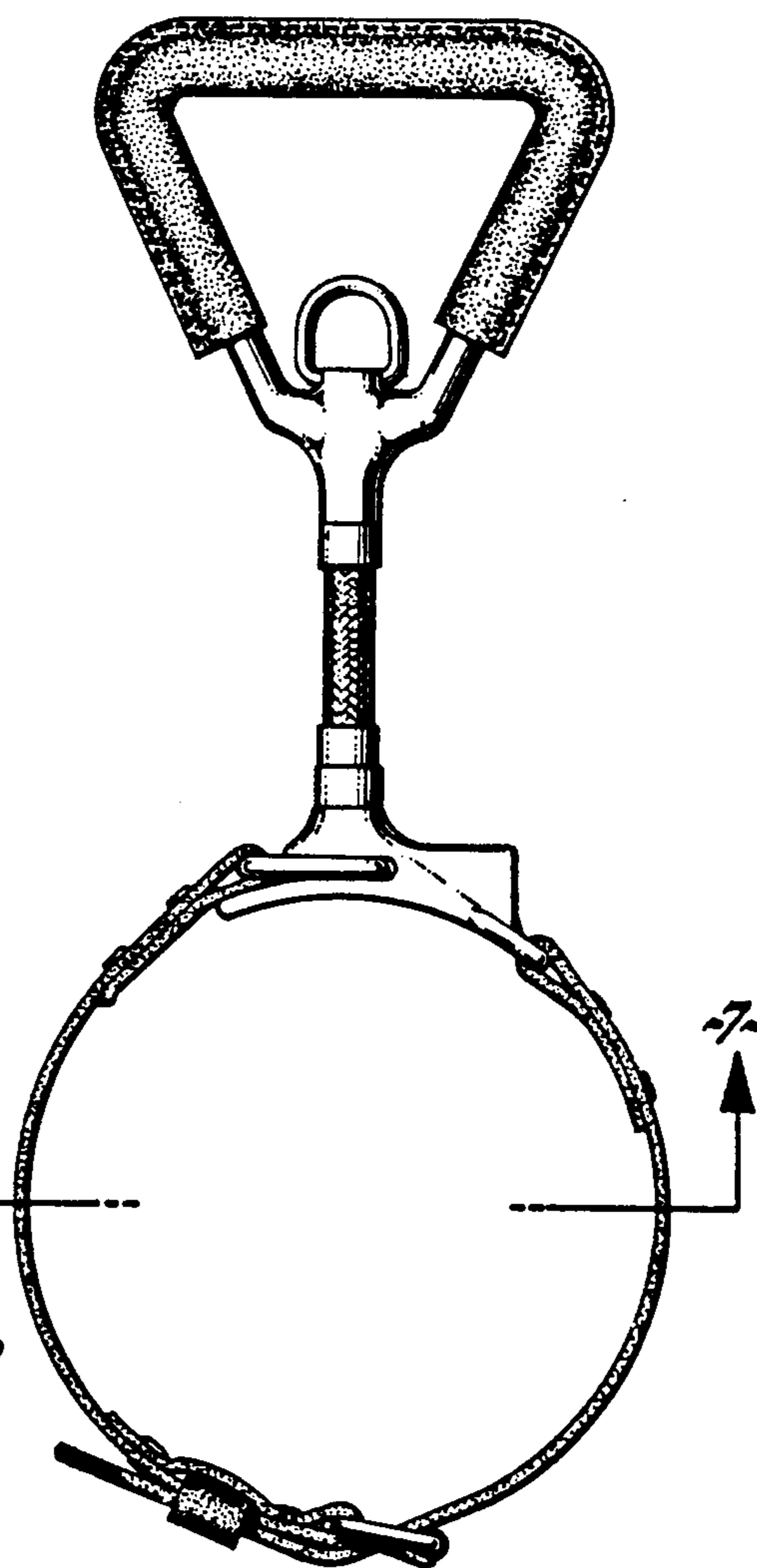
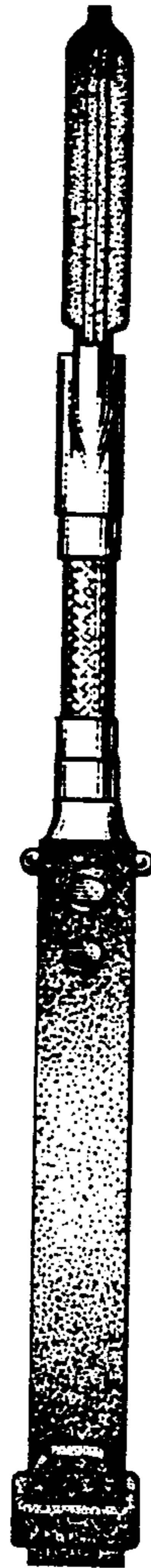
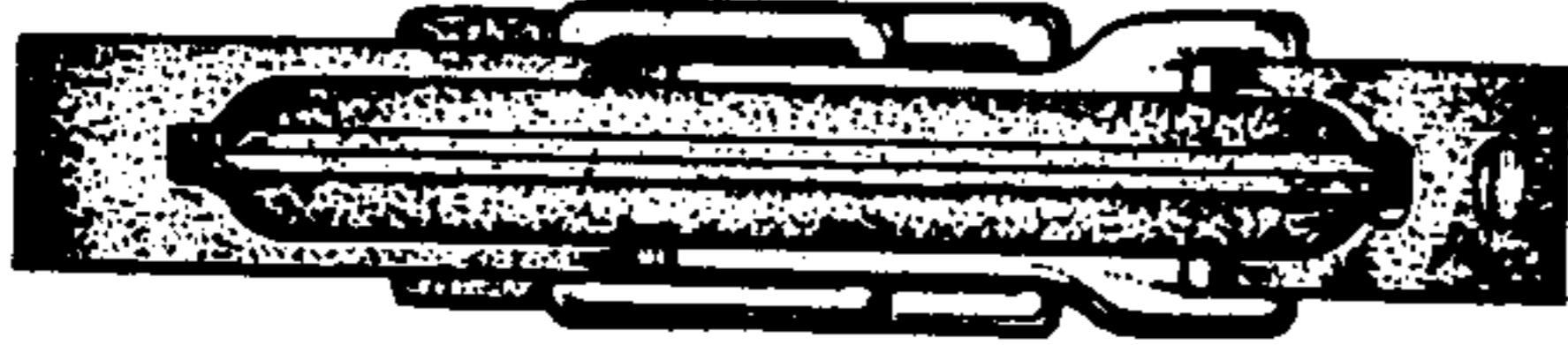

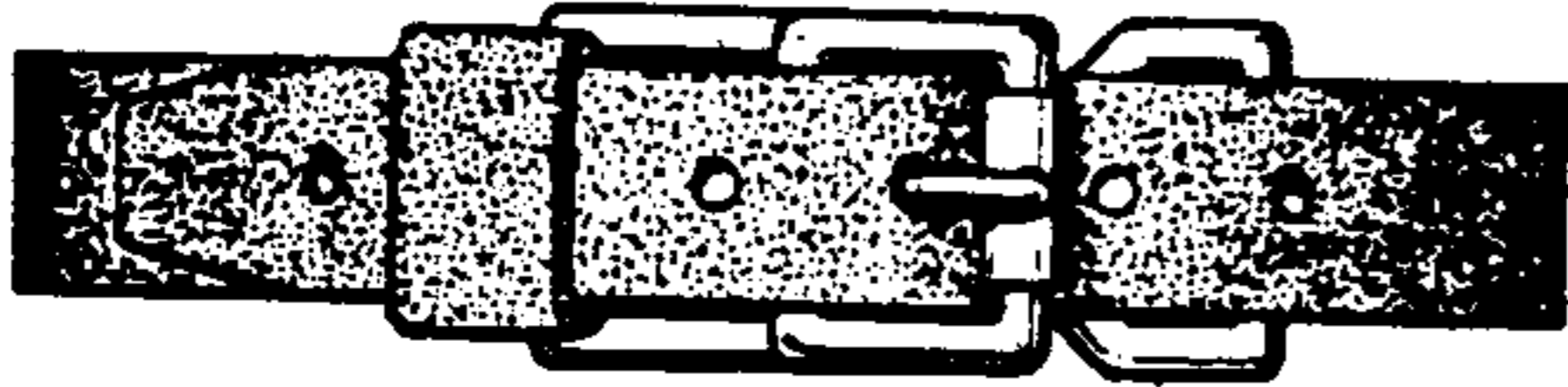
