DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of an aquarium thermometer showing our new design;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view; and

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

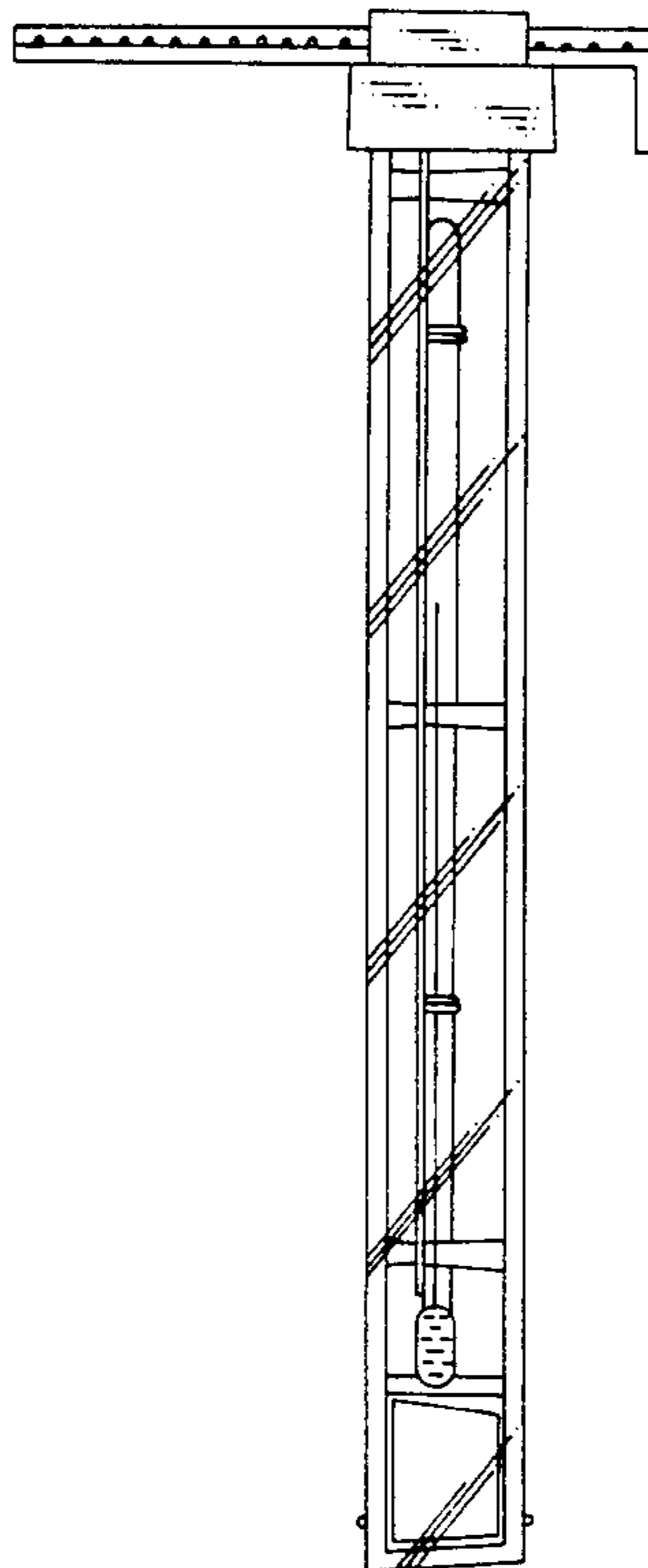

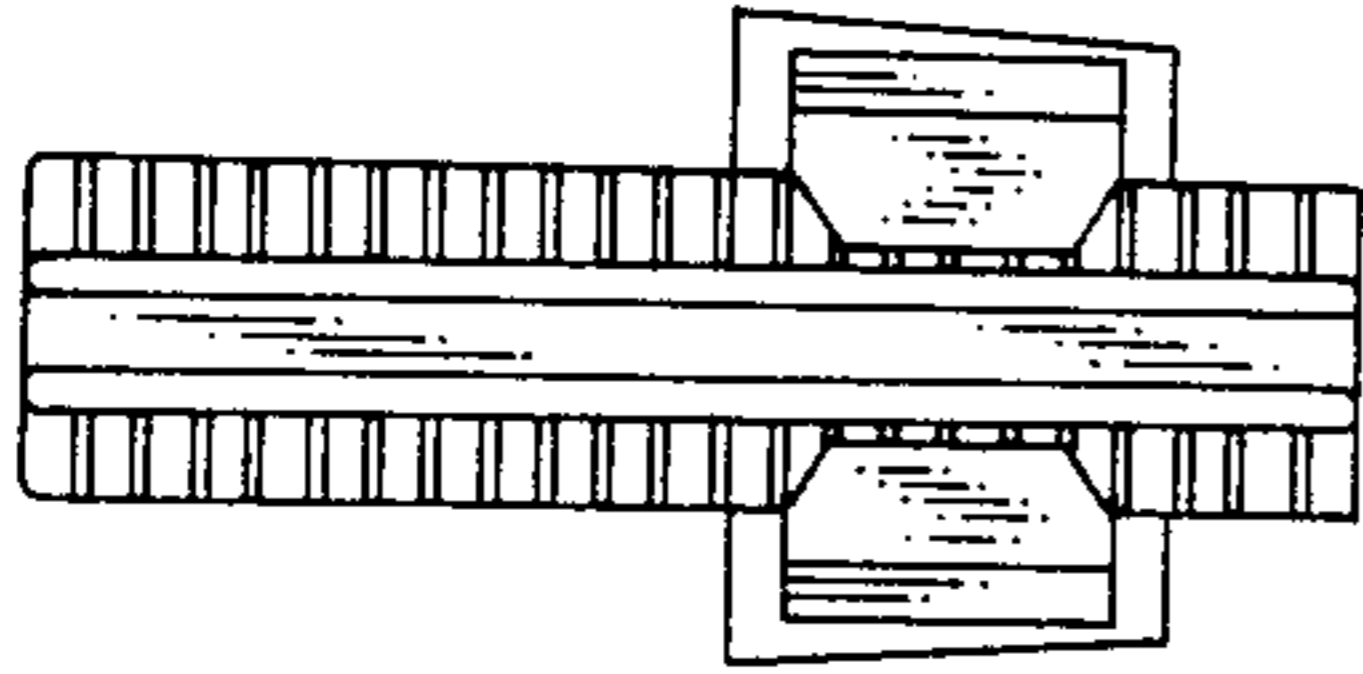

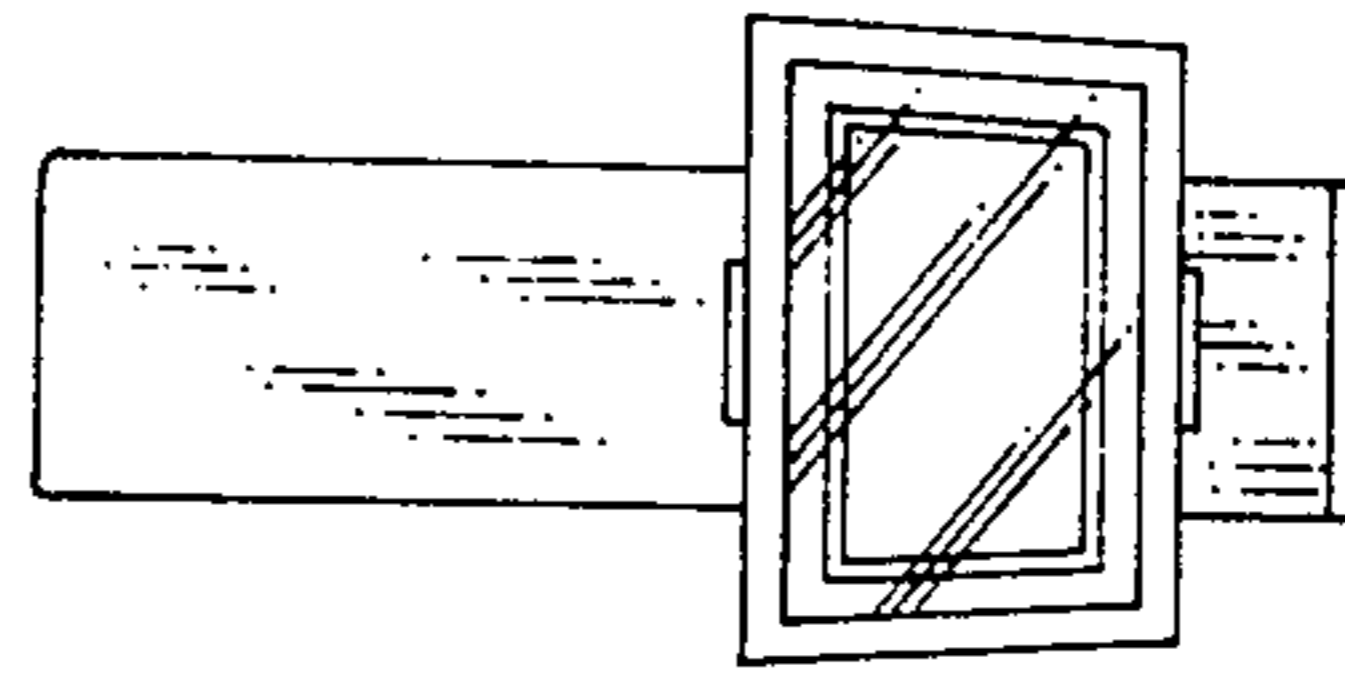

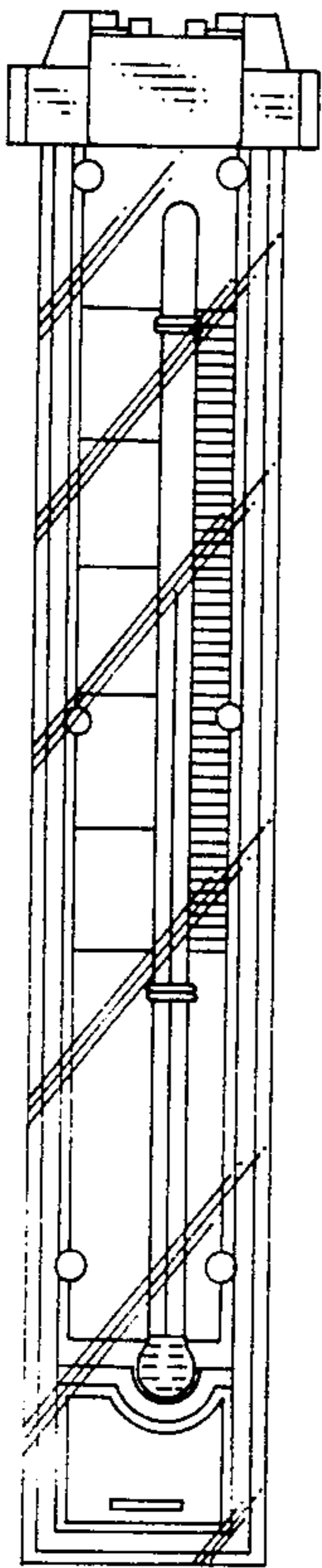

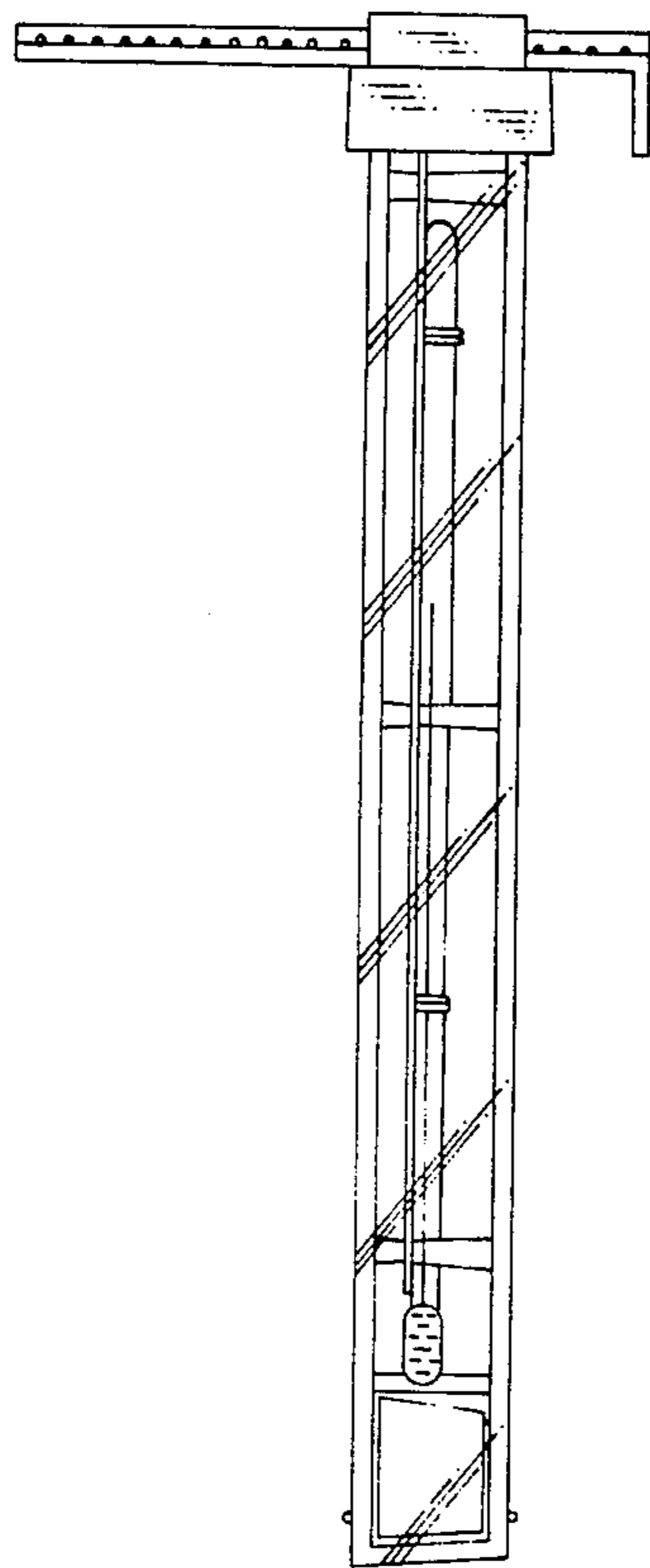
