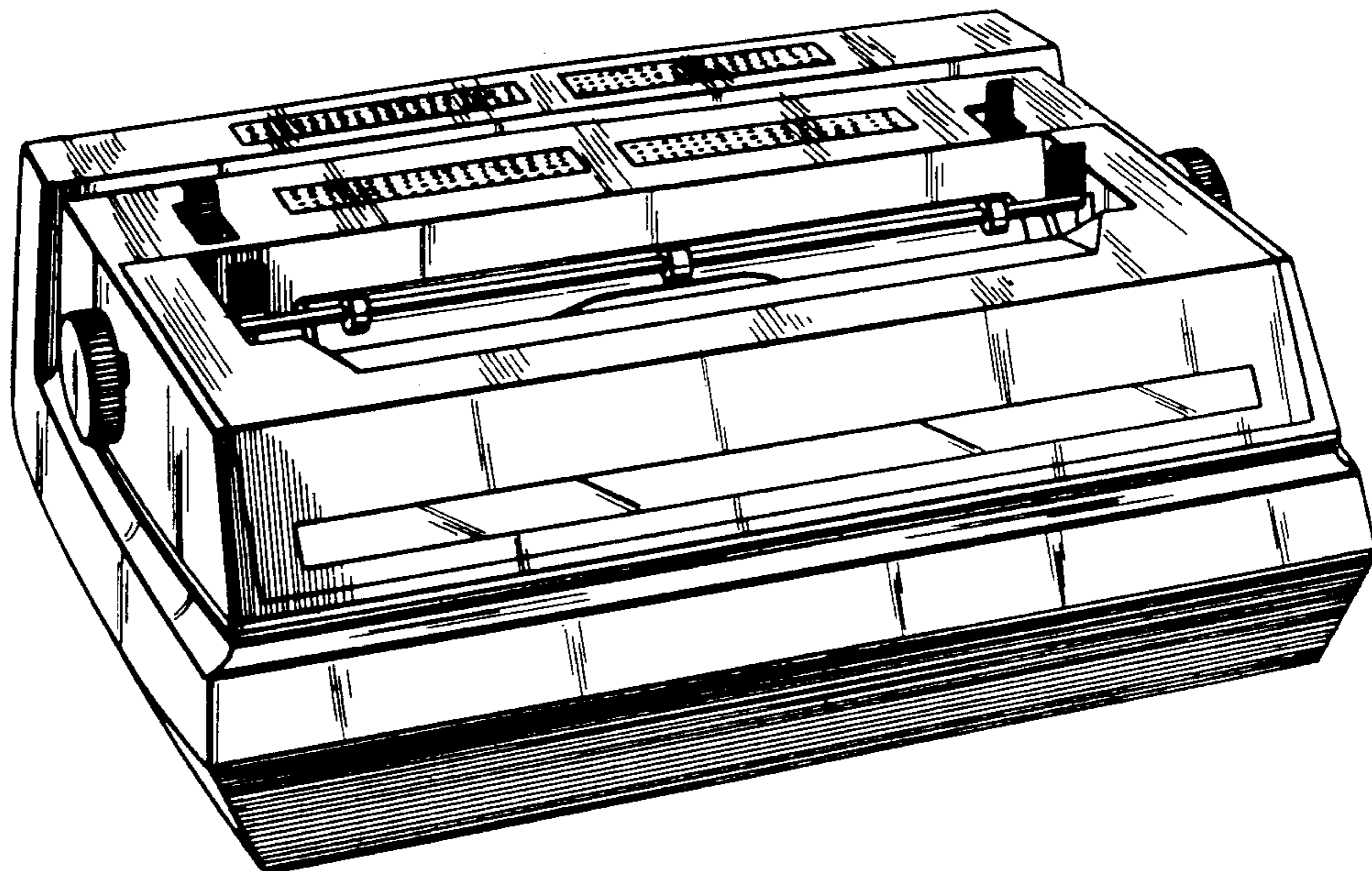

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a receive only high speed impact printer, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a receive only high speed impact printer showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof on a reduced scale; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof on a reduced scale; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof on a reduced scale; FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof on a reduced scale; FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof on a reduced scale; and FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof on a reduced scale.



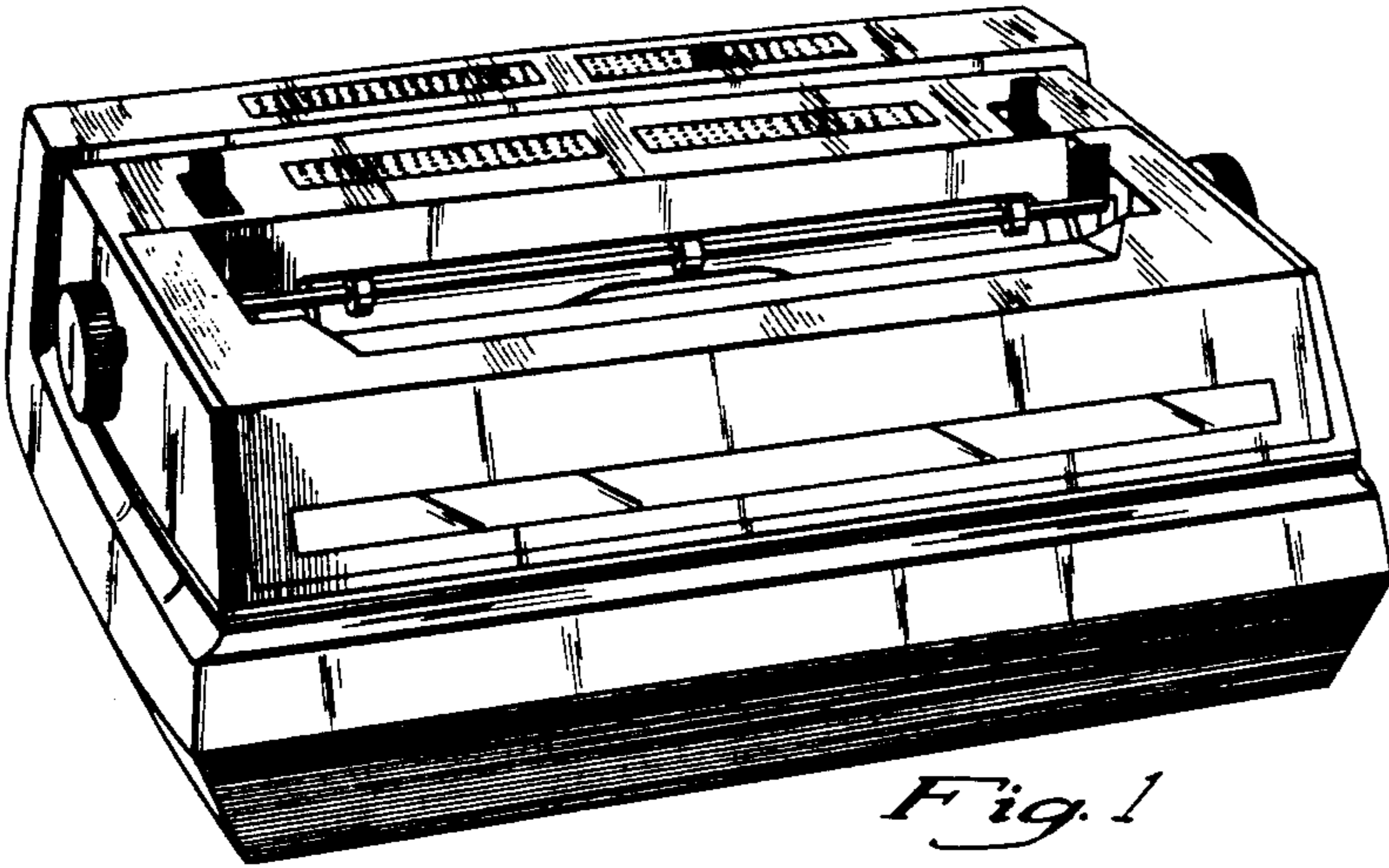

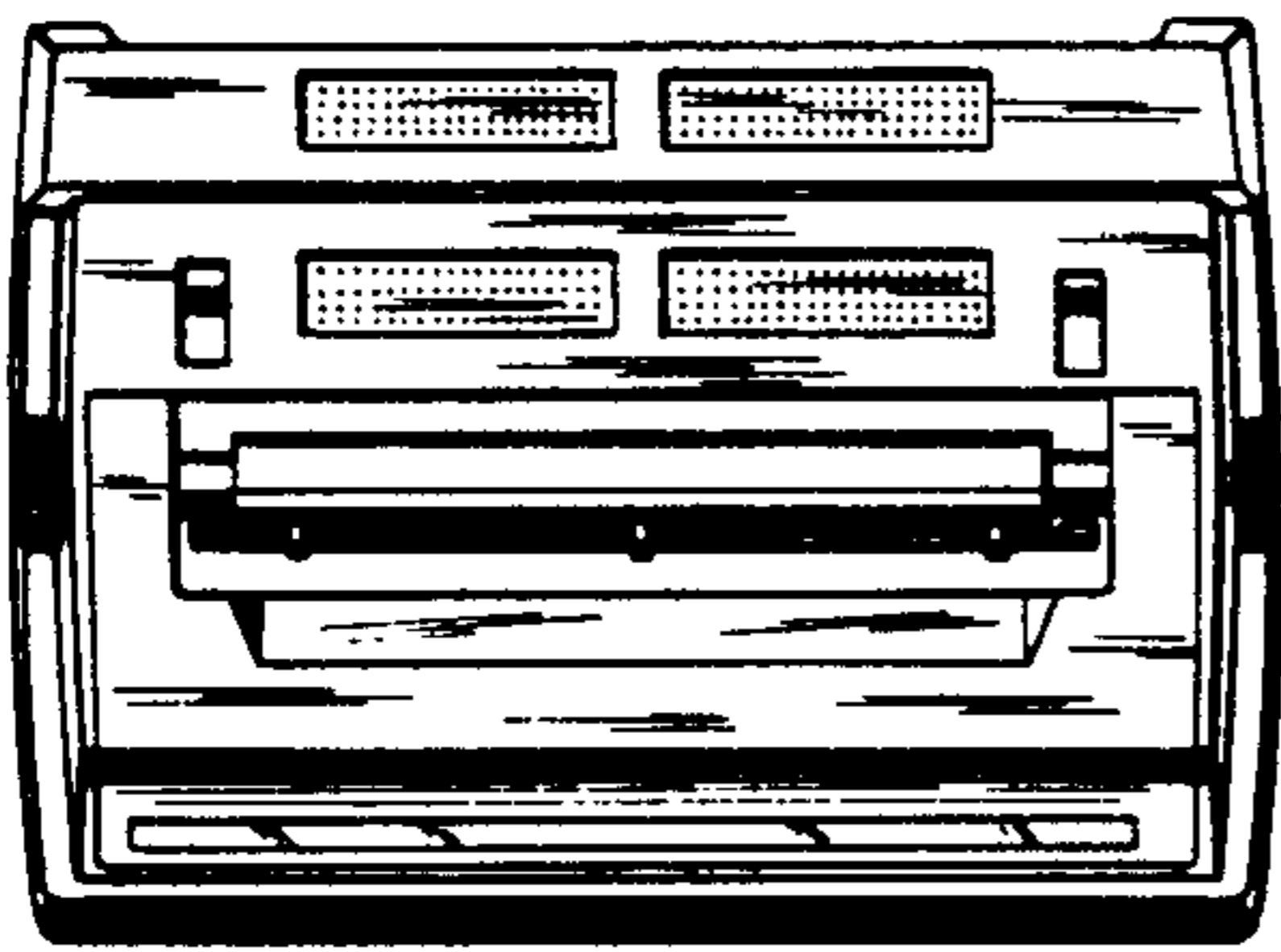

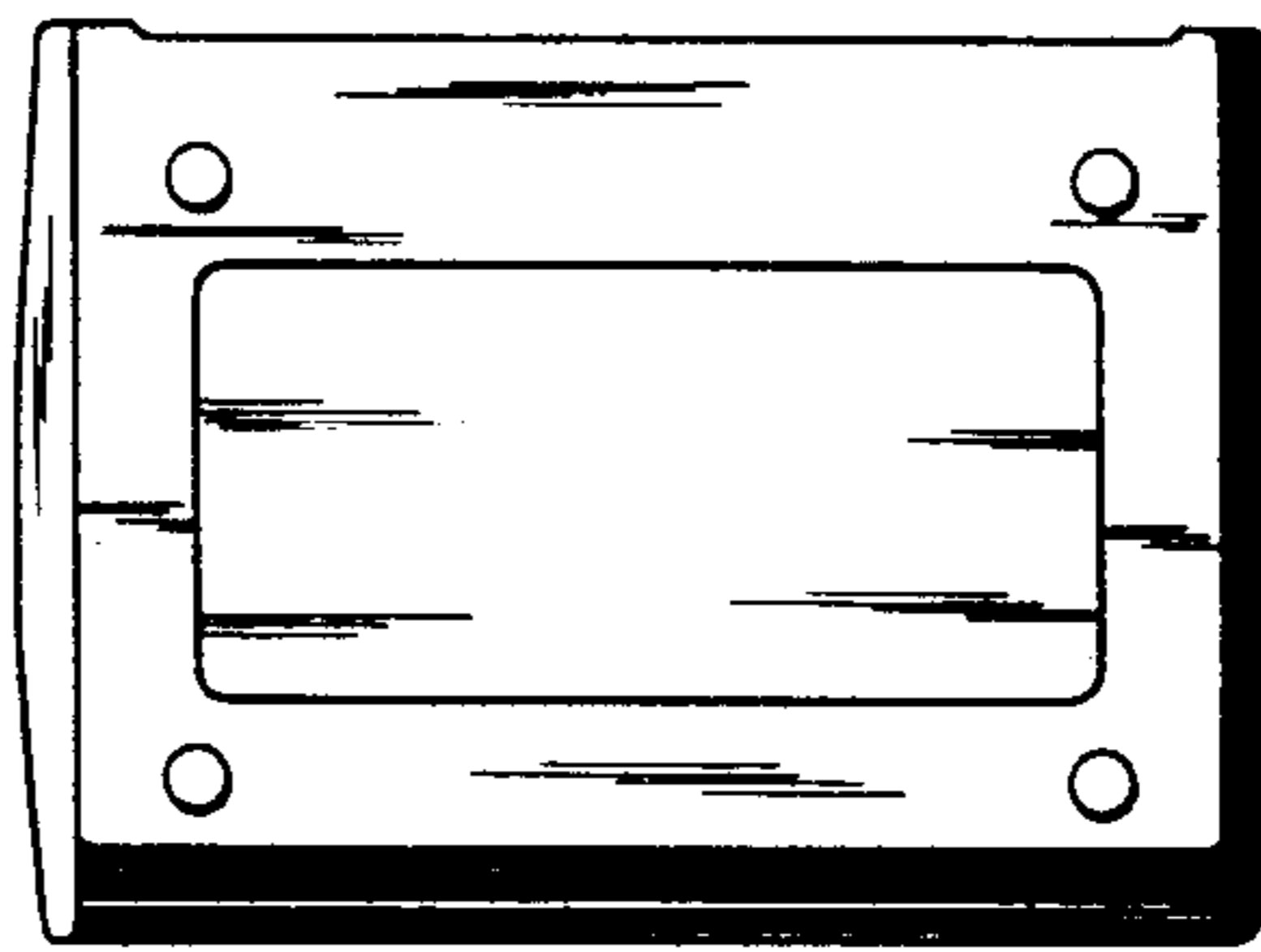

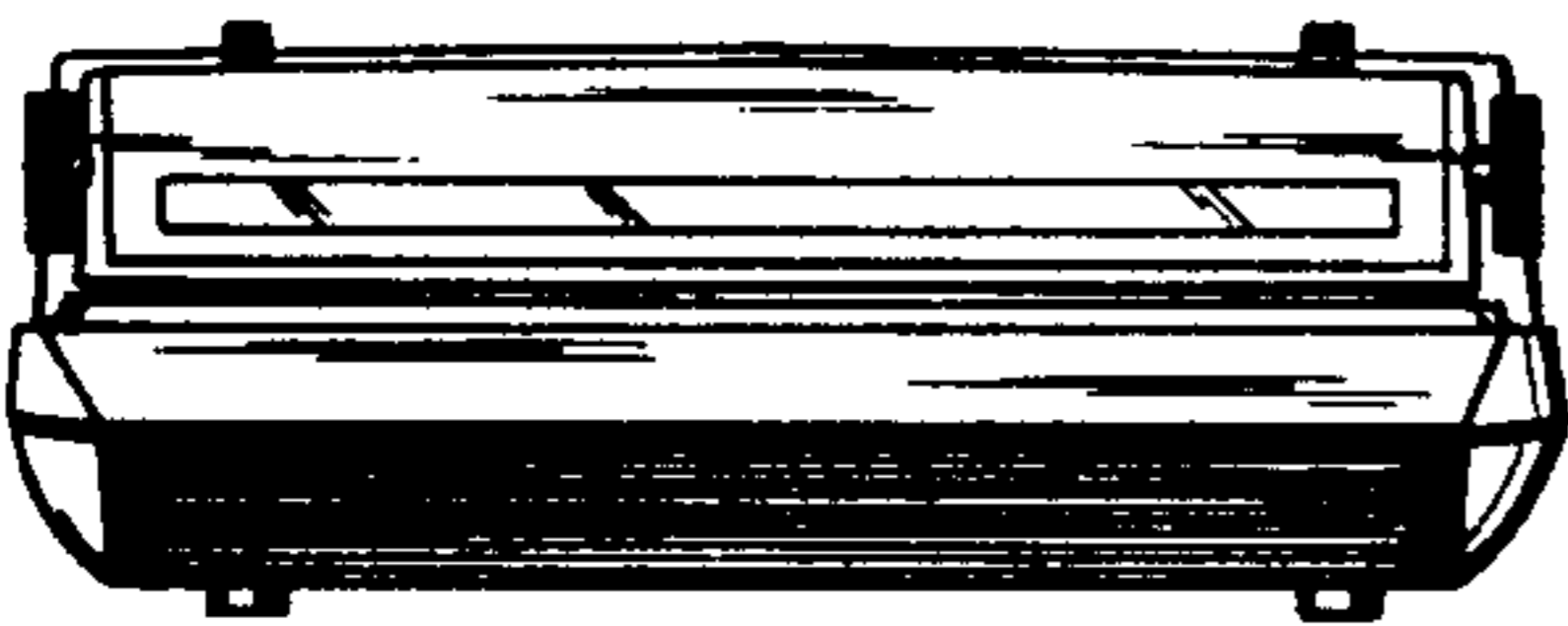

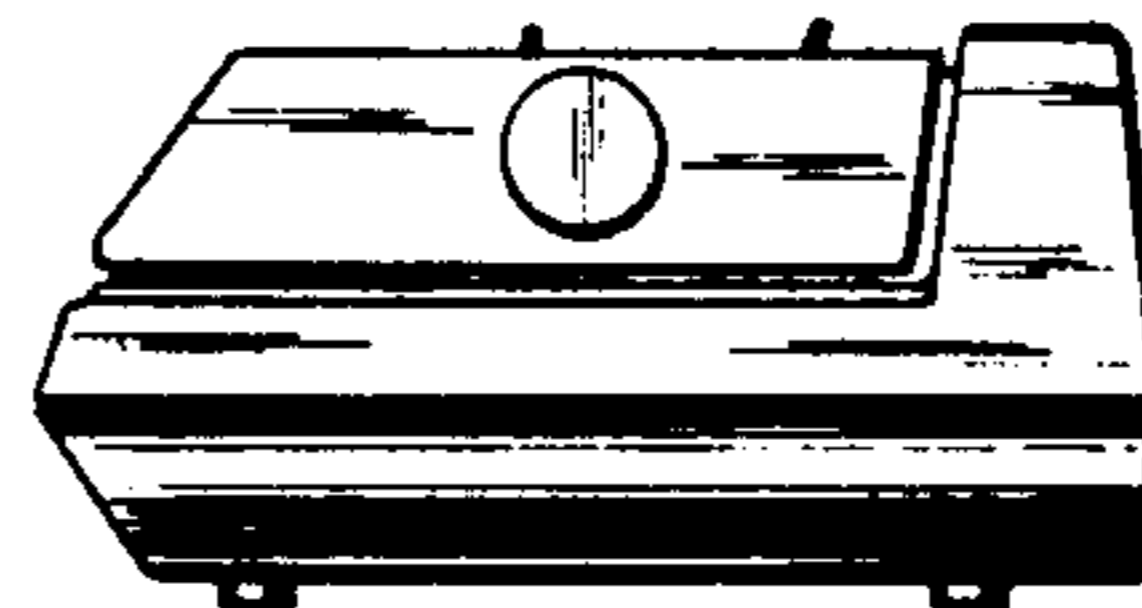

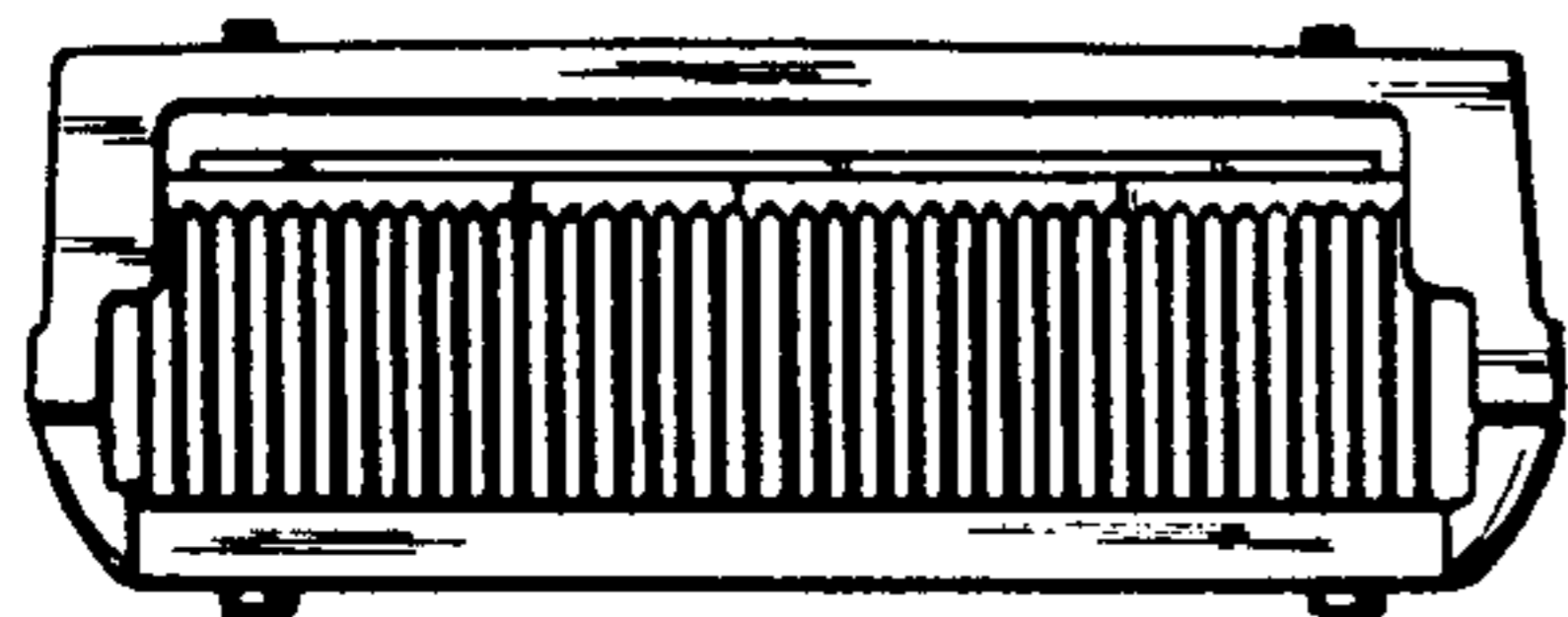

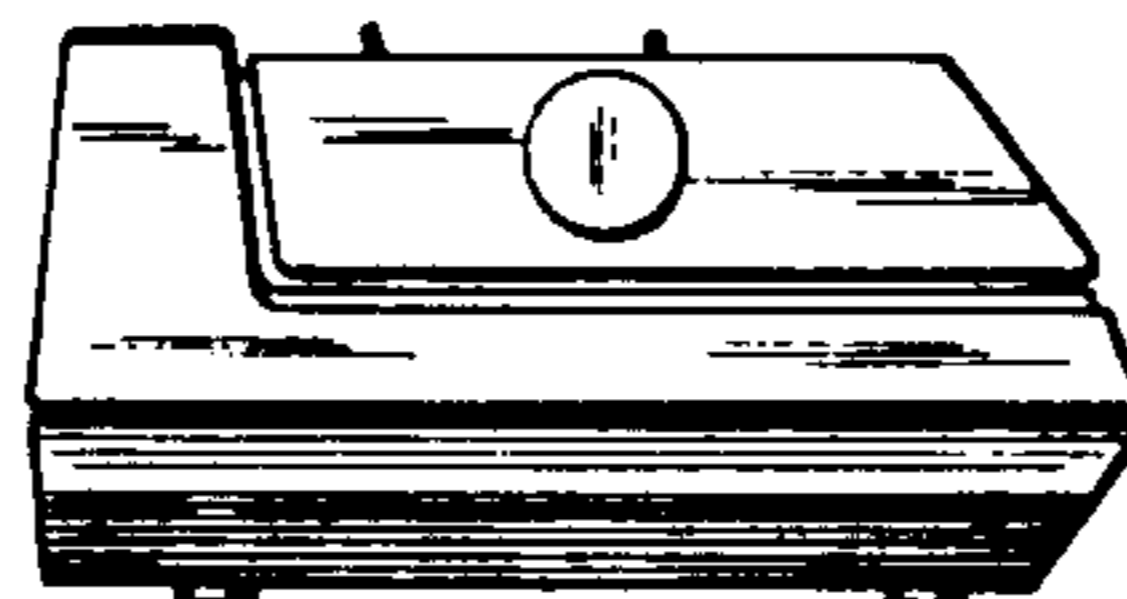
