[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an electric guitar, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an electric guitar showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view;

FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken along line A—A' in FIG. 1 of the body of the guitar, with portions of the head and neck and structure on the body which would be seen omitted for convenience of illustration;

FIG. 5 is a view similar to FIG. 4 taken along line B—B' in FIG. 1; and

FIG. 6 is a sectional view taken along line C—C' in FIG. 2, with structure which would be seen omitted for convenience of illustration.

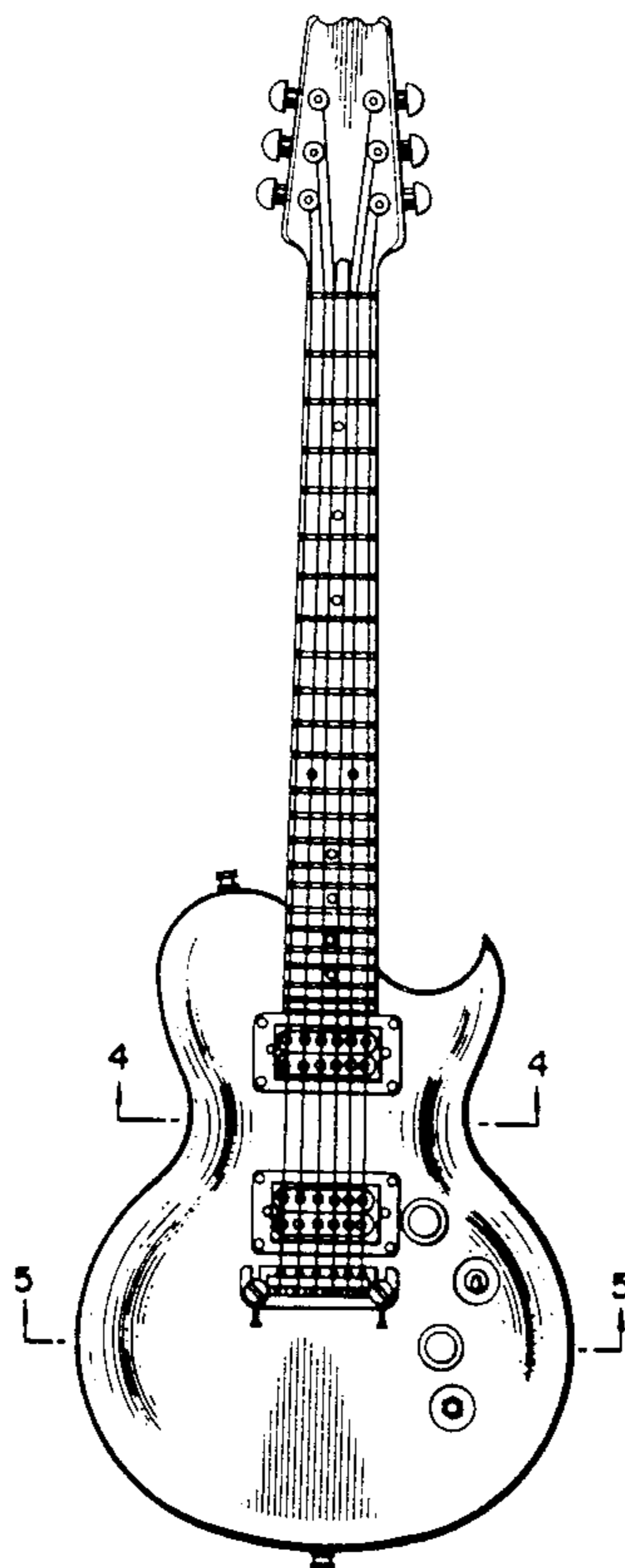

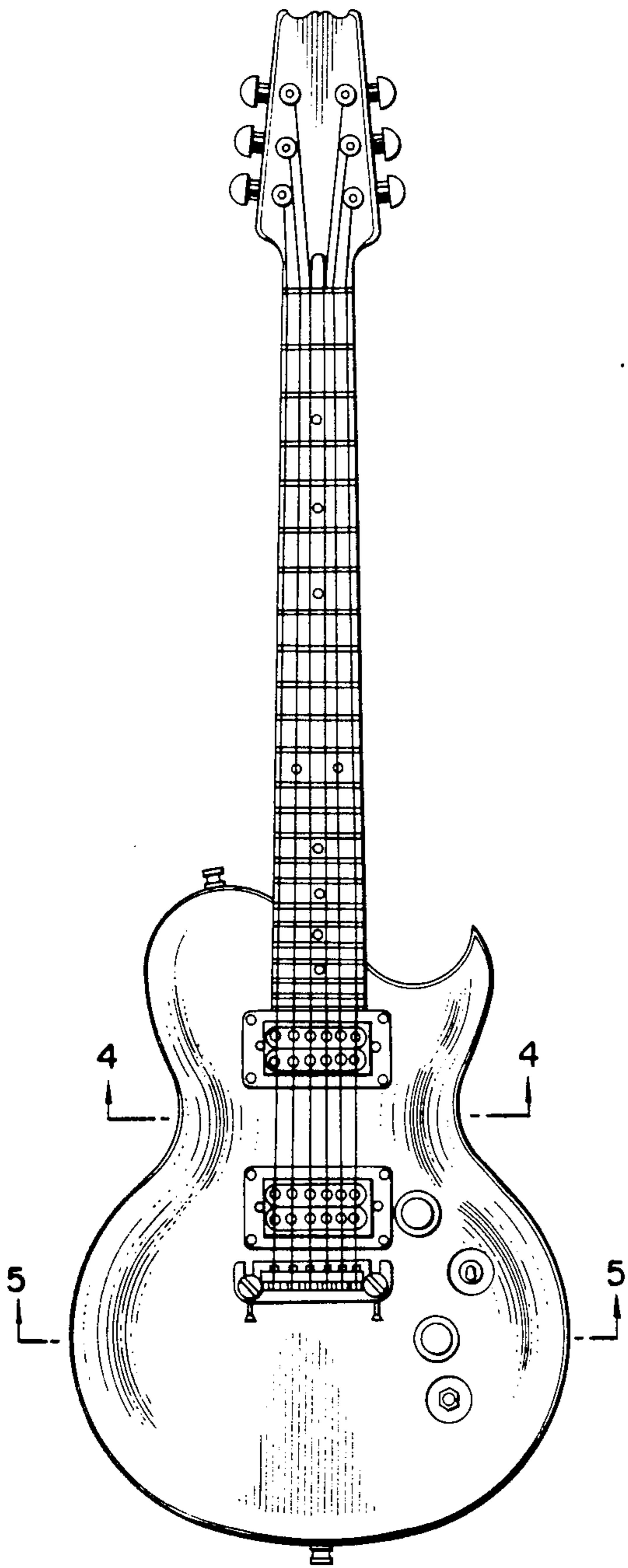

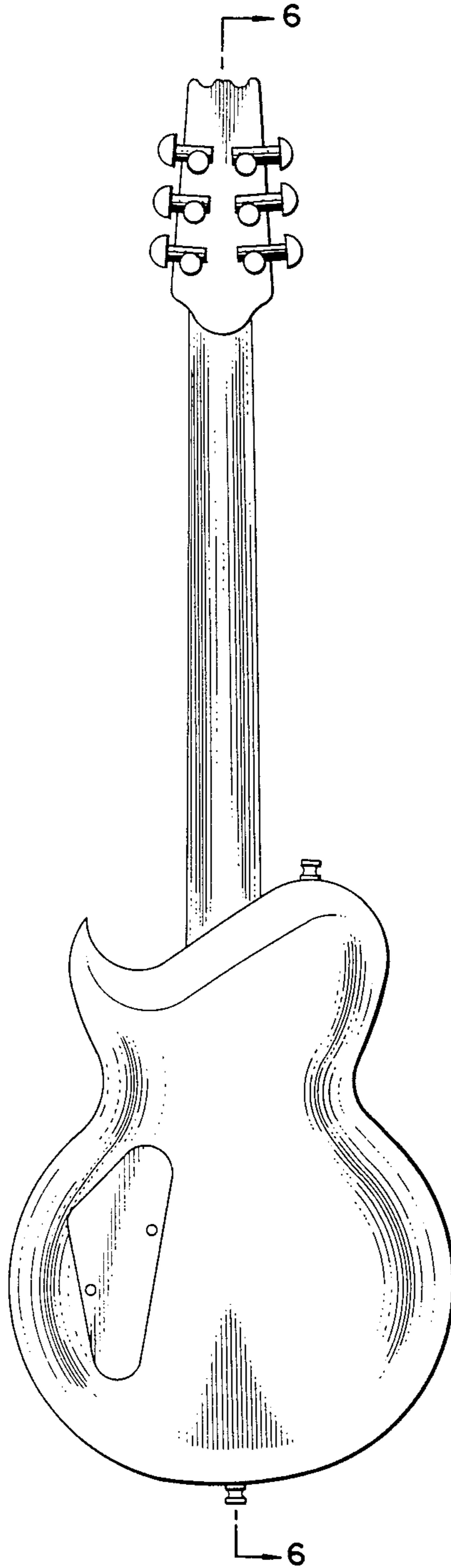

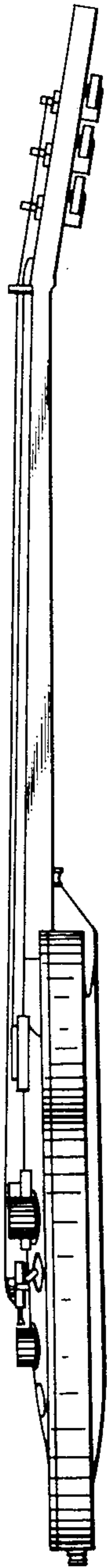

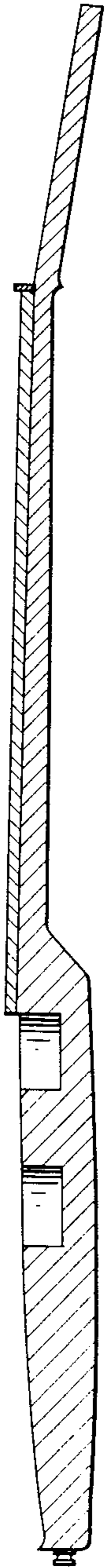
