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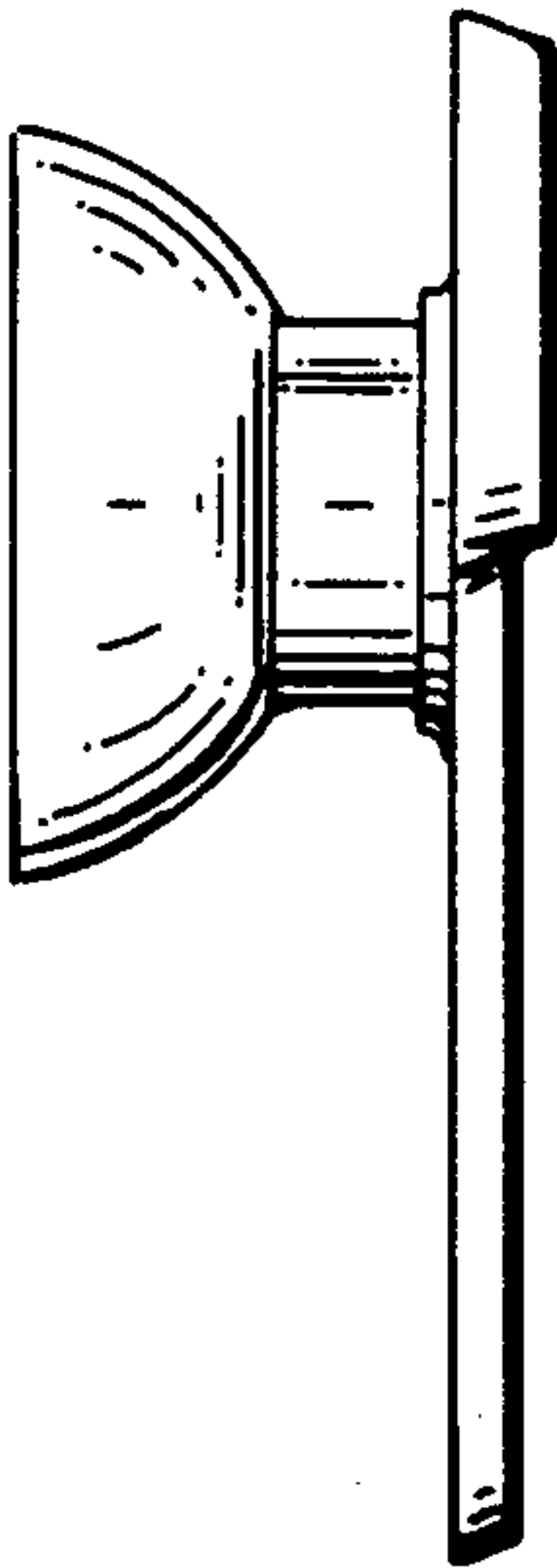
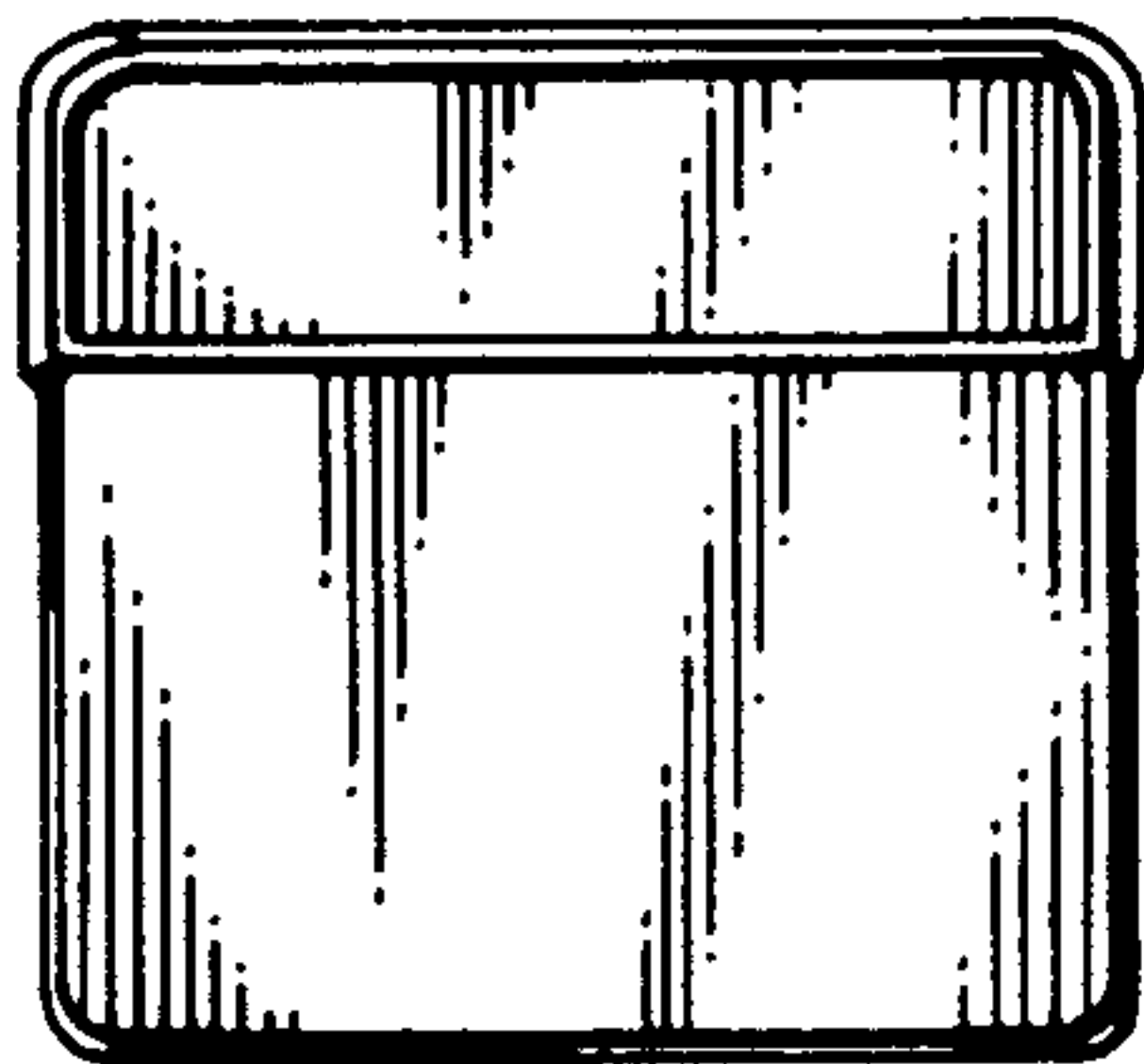
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[57] **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a memo card for written messages showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is an enlarged scale perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is an enlarged scale rear perspective view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 2.



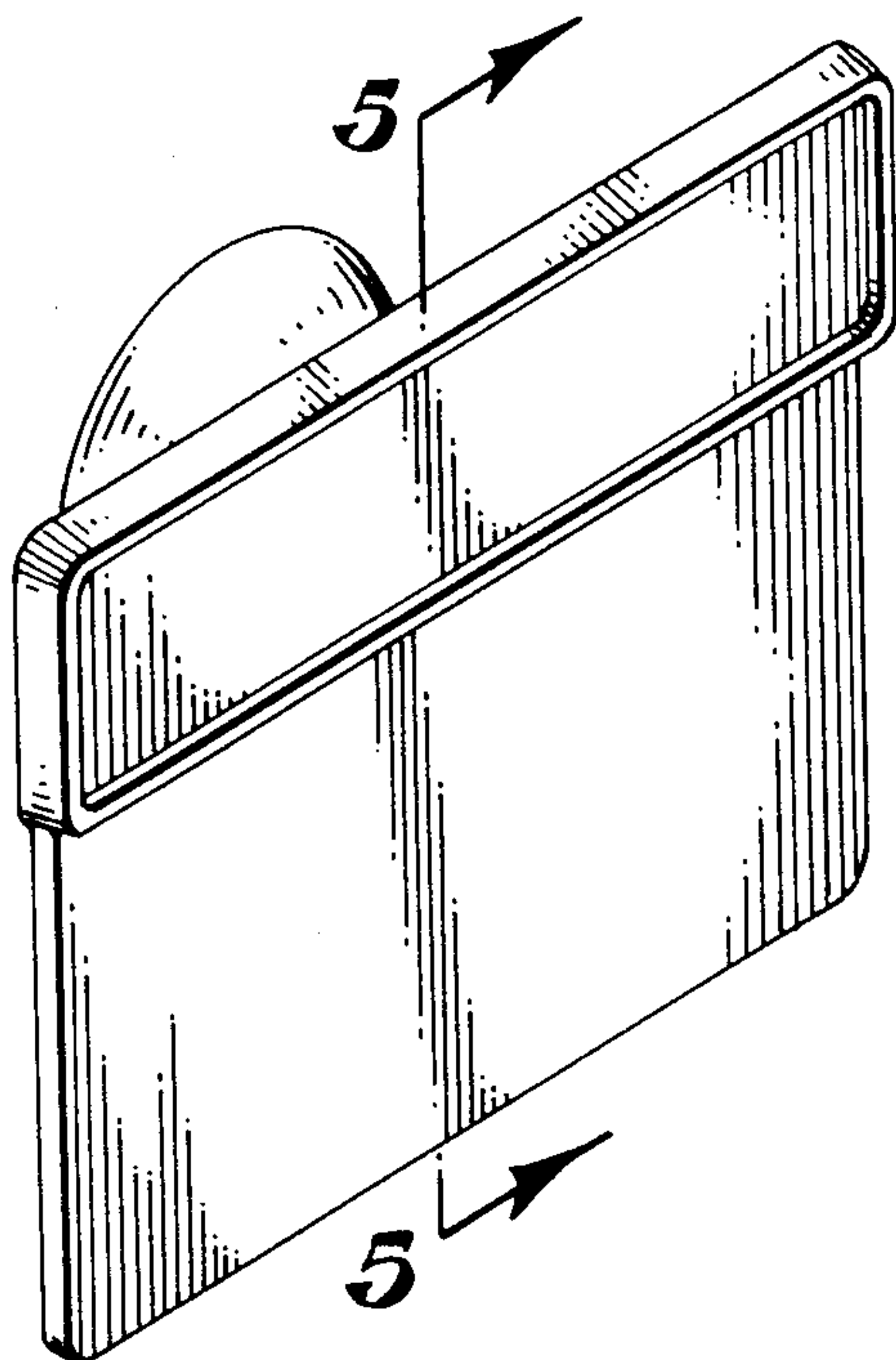

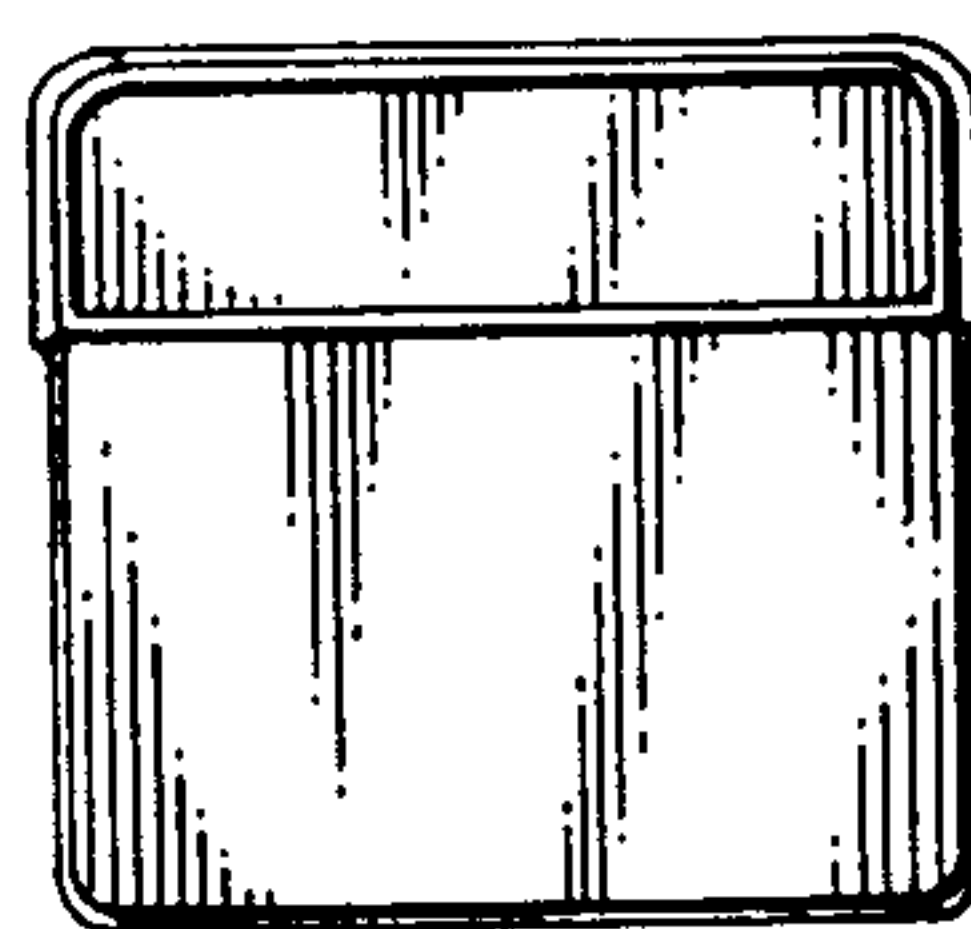

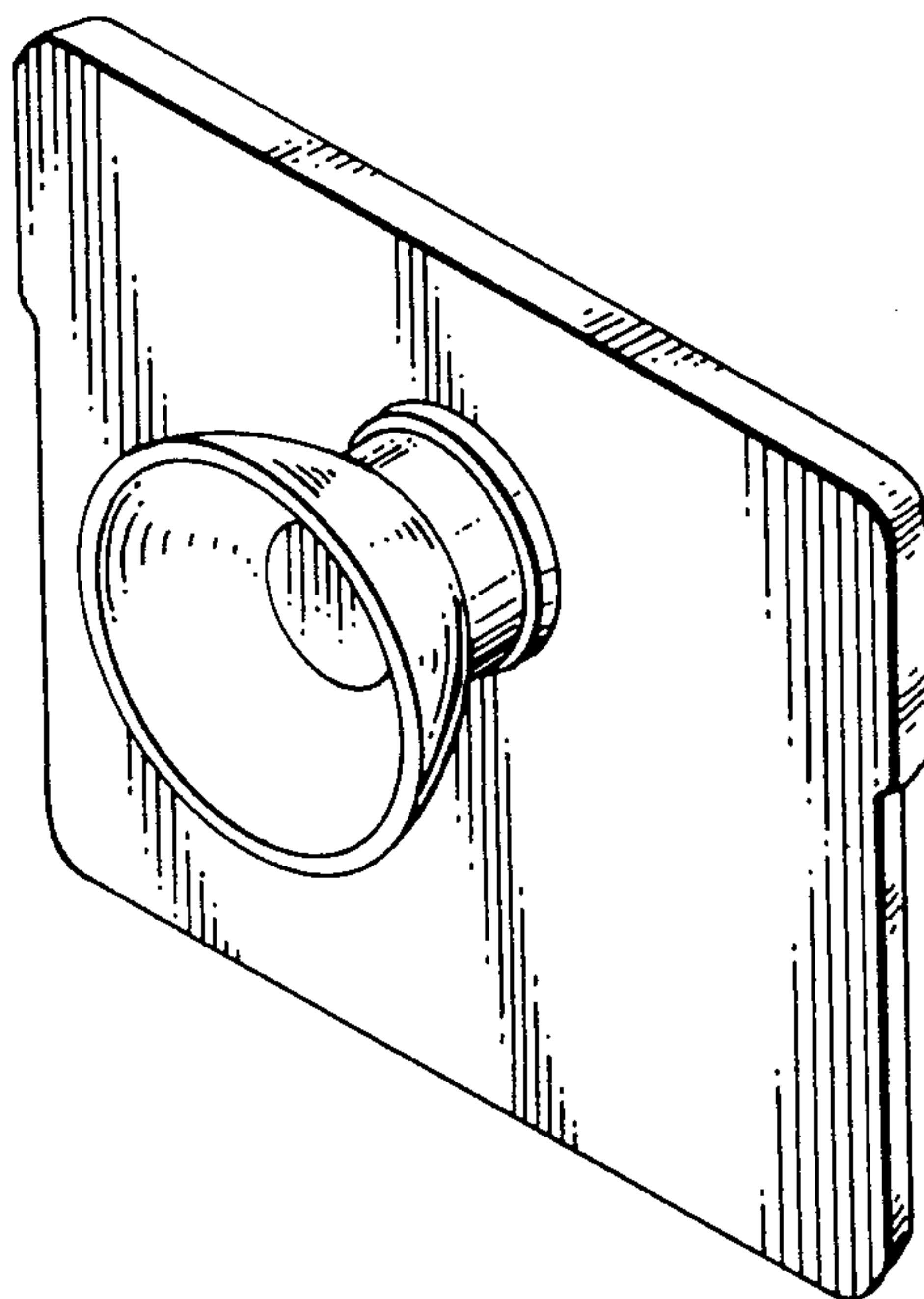

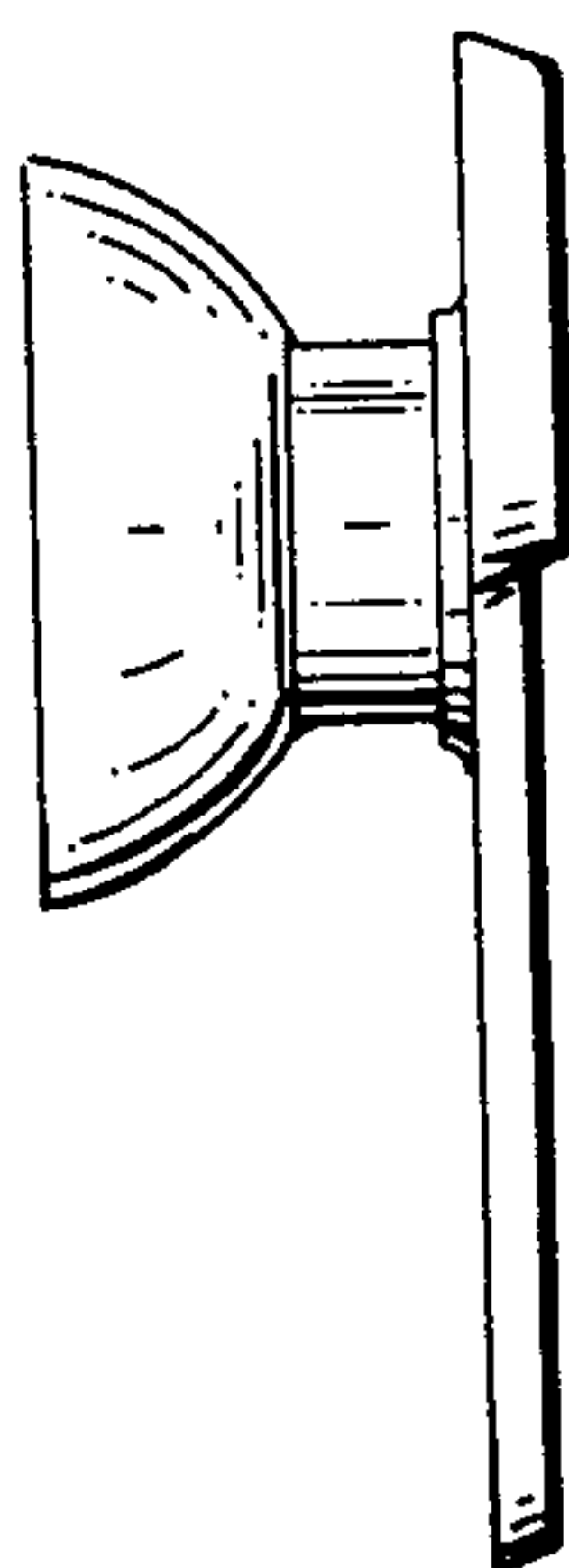

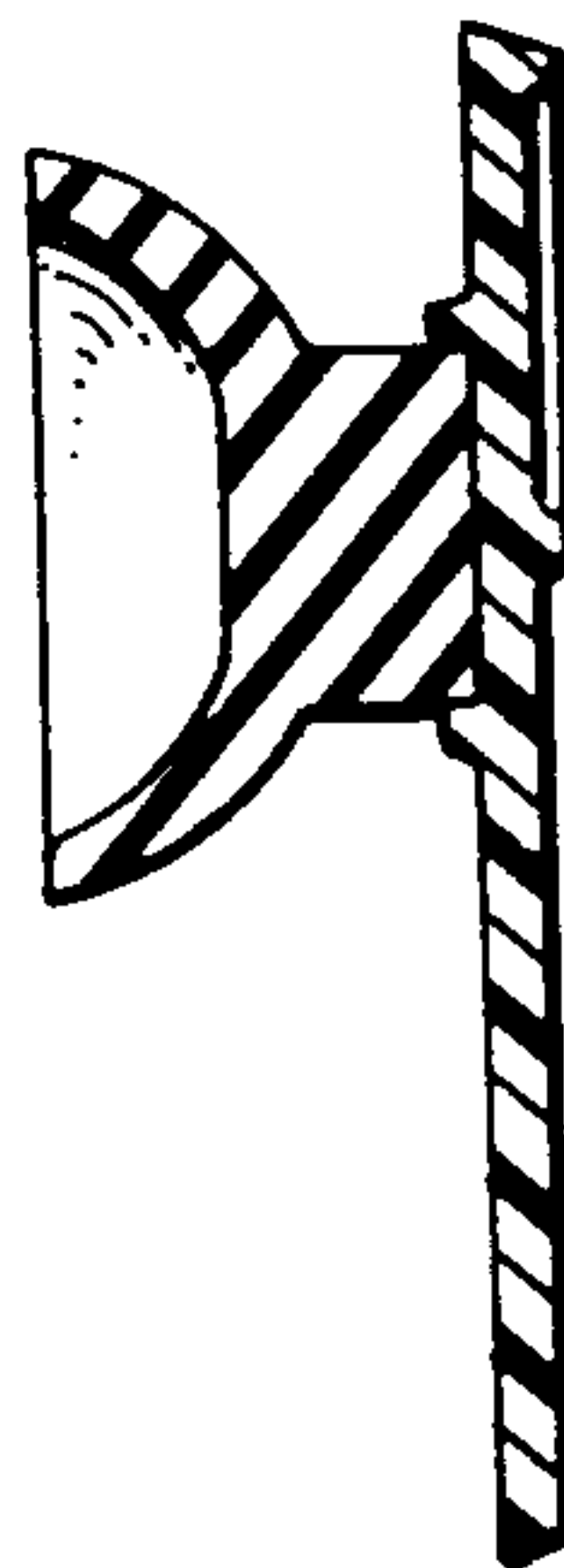
