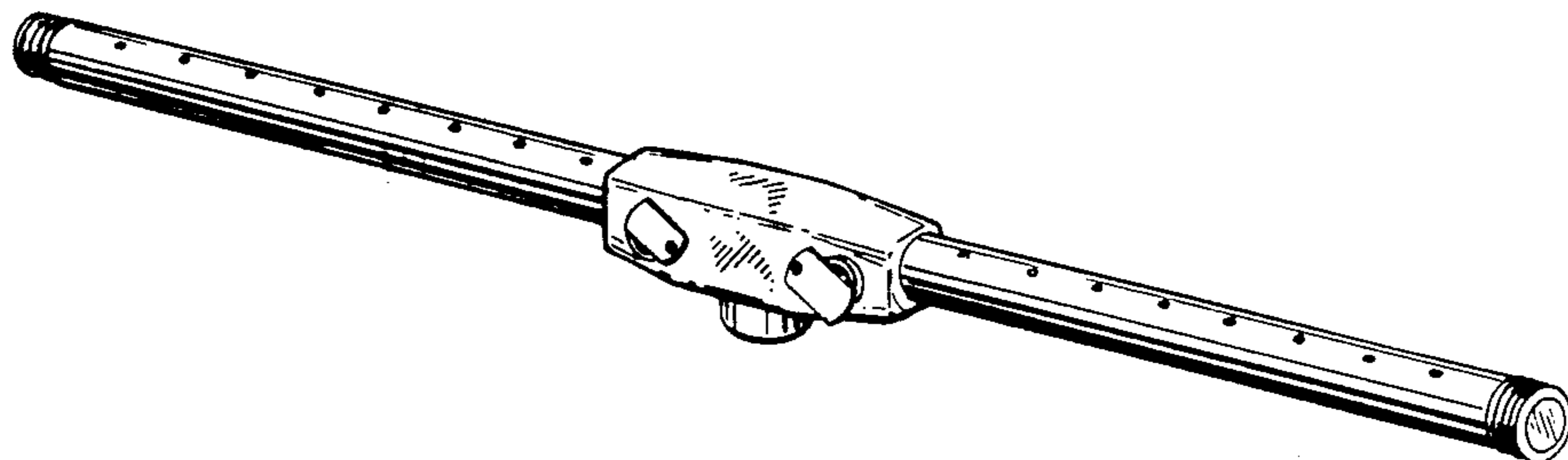
DESCRIPTION

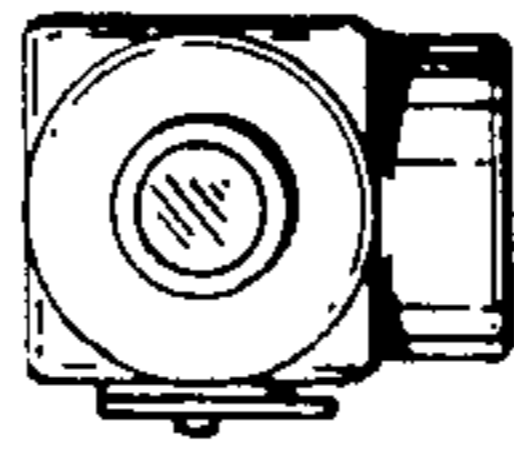
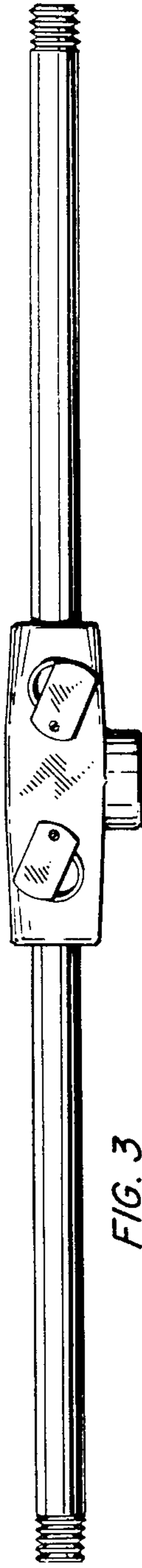
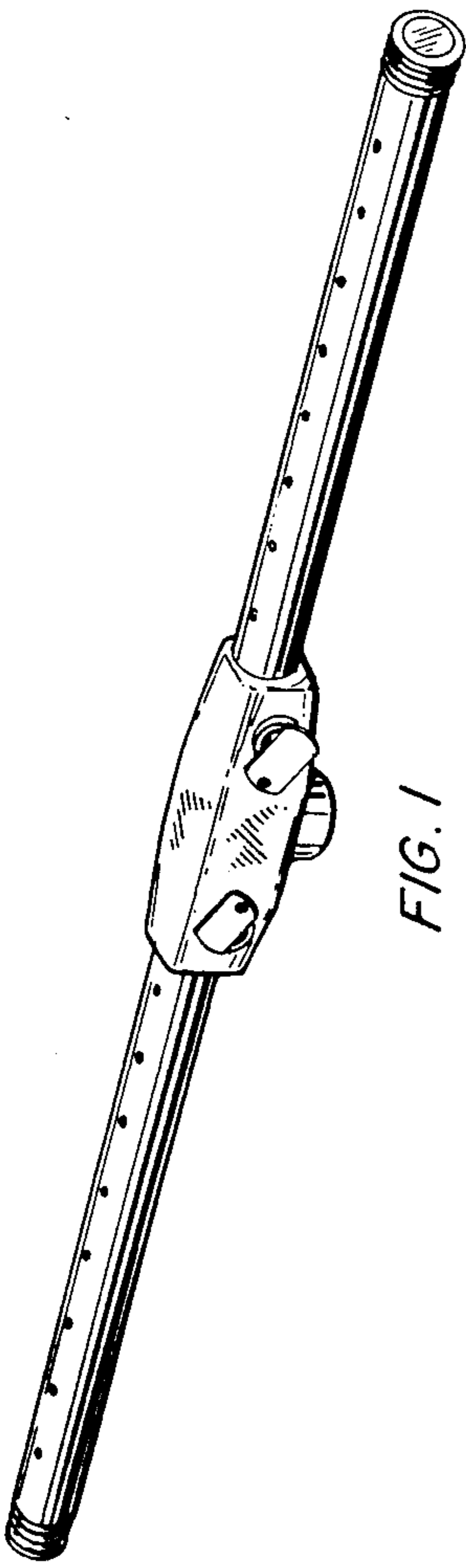

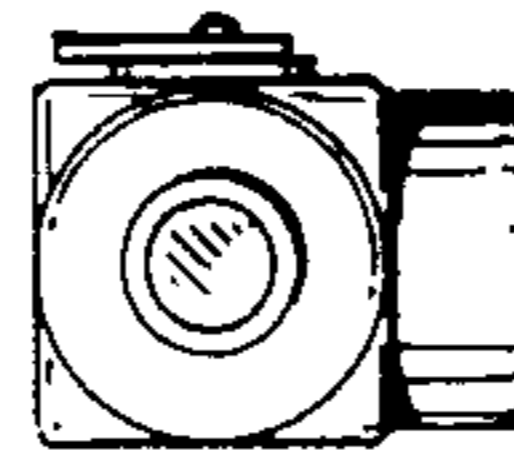
