DESCRIPTION

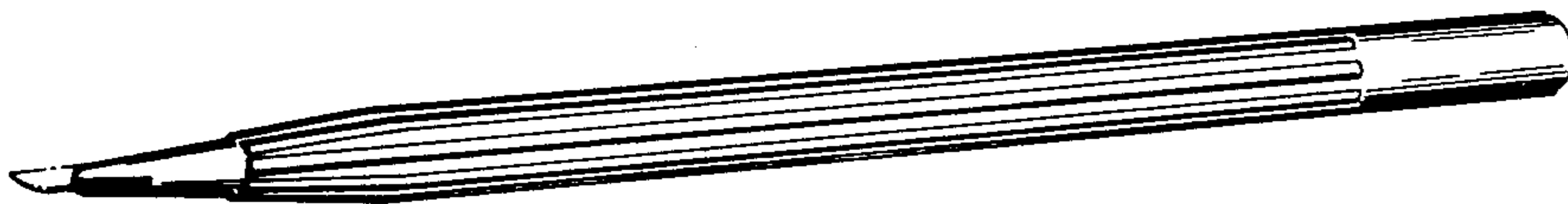
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a scalpel handle with the scalpel blade disclosed in broken lines for purposes of illustration only;

FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof.



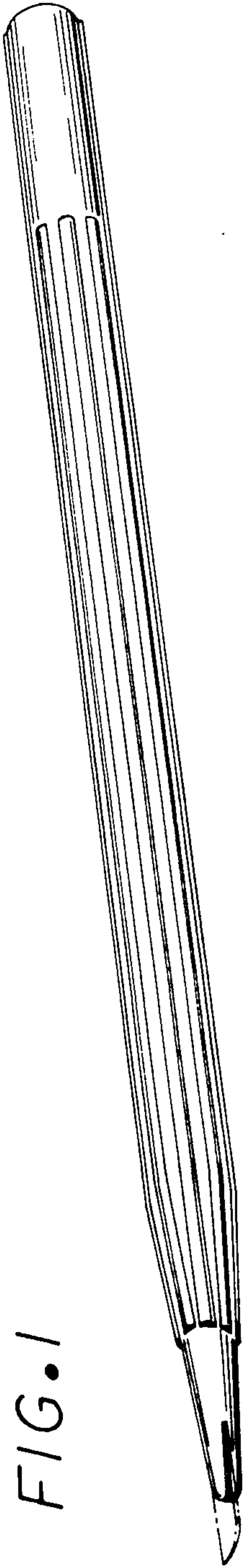

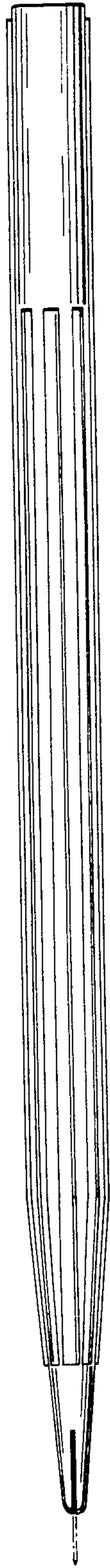

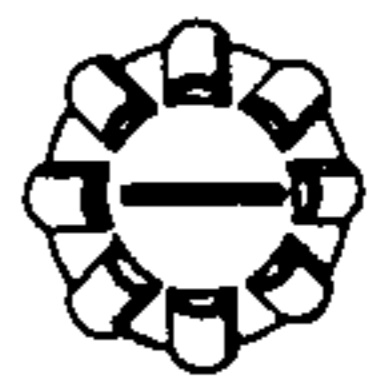
