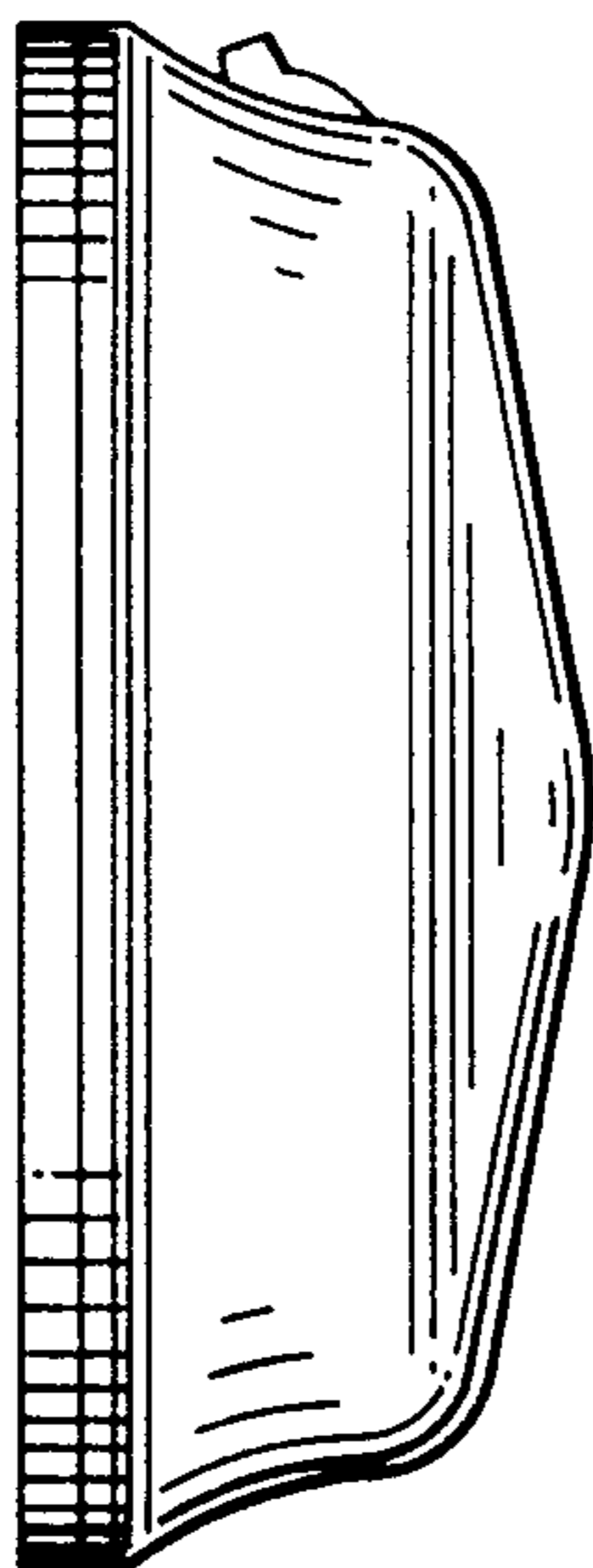

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an illuminated mirror showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being the mirror image thereof.



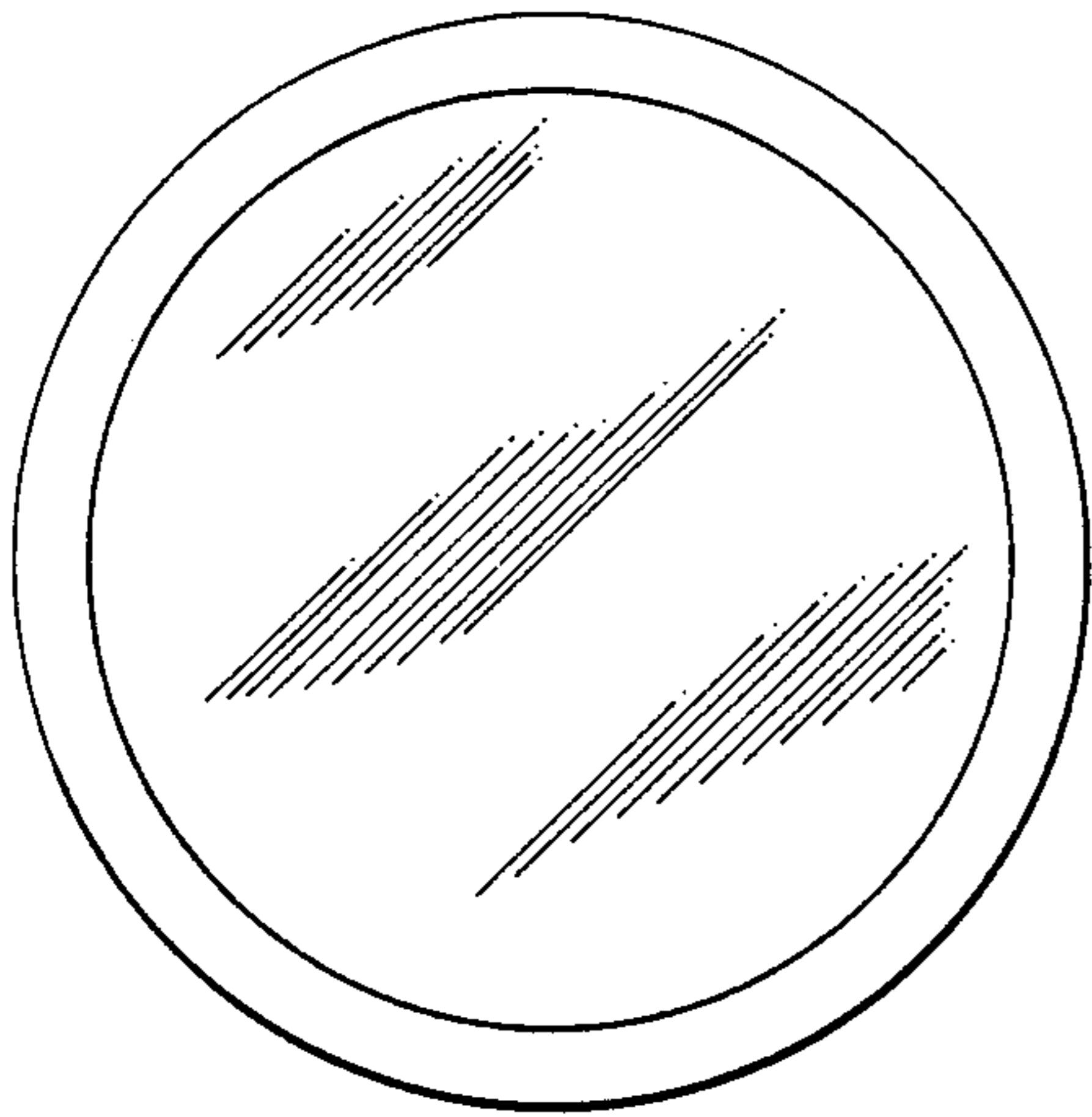

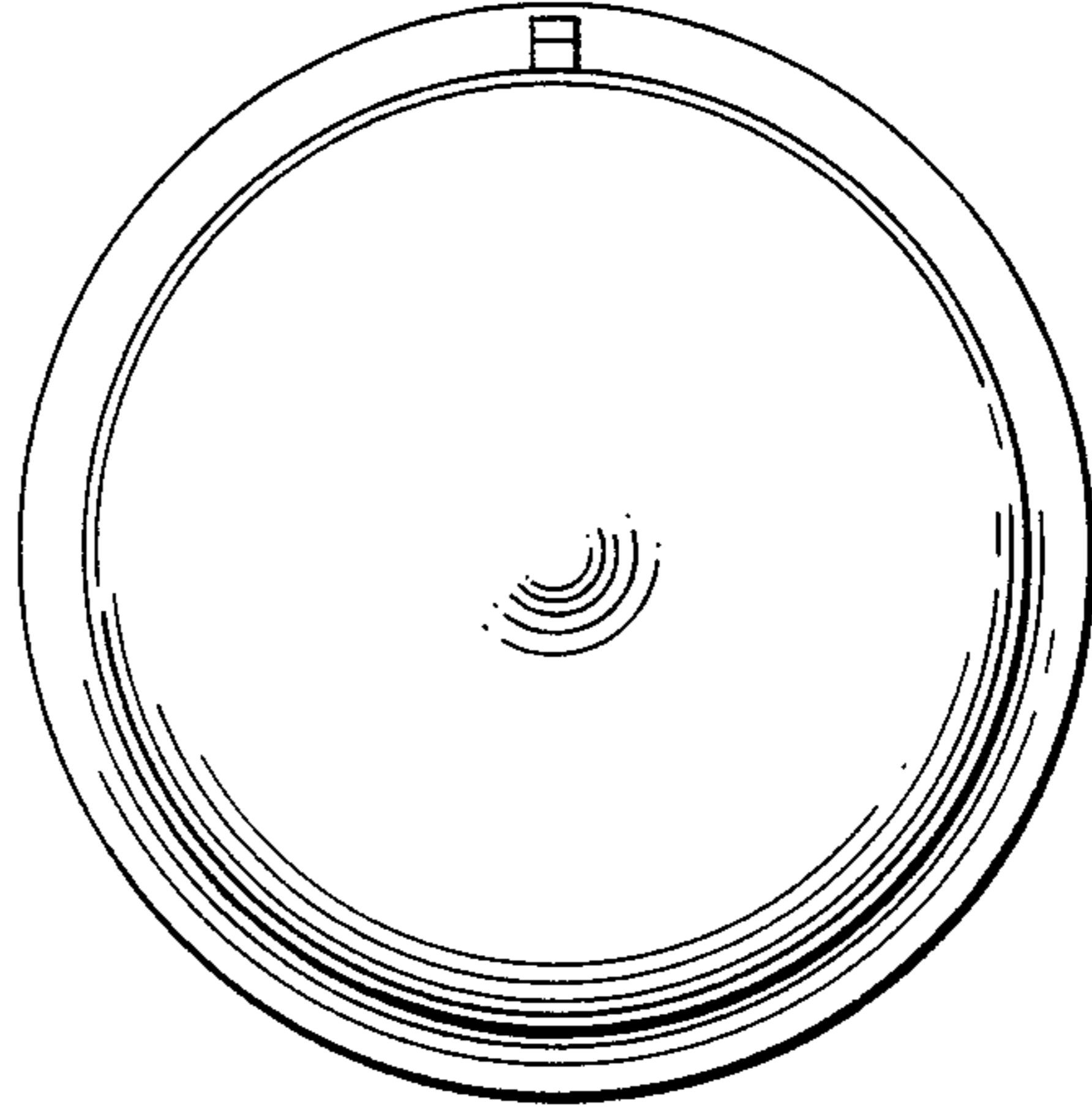

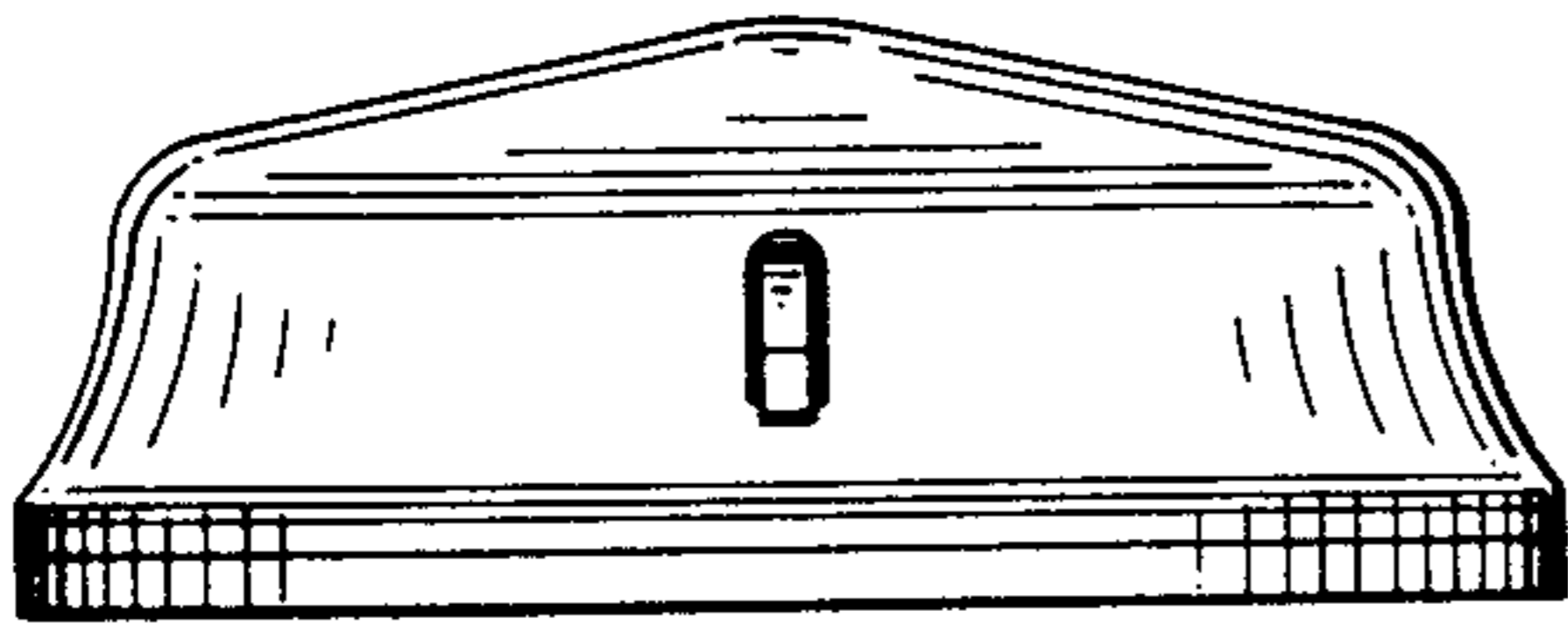

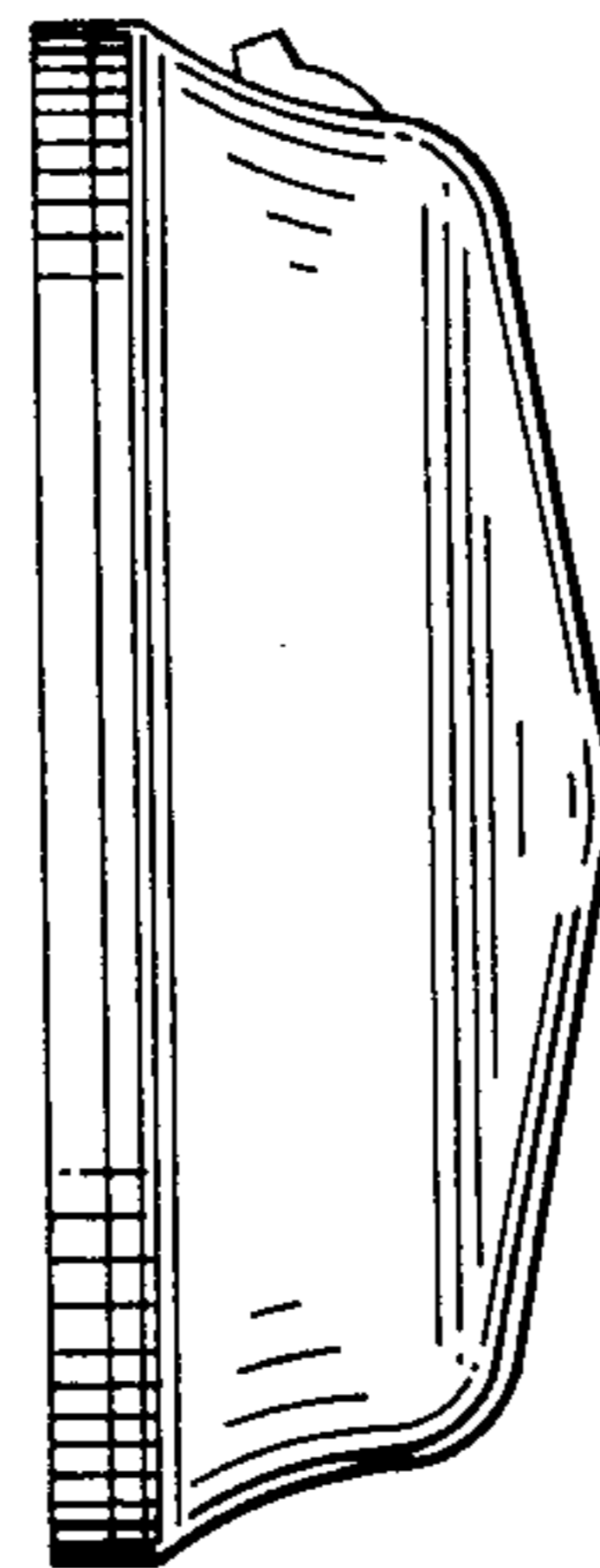

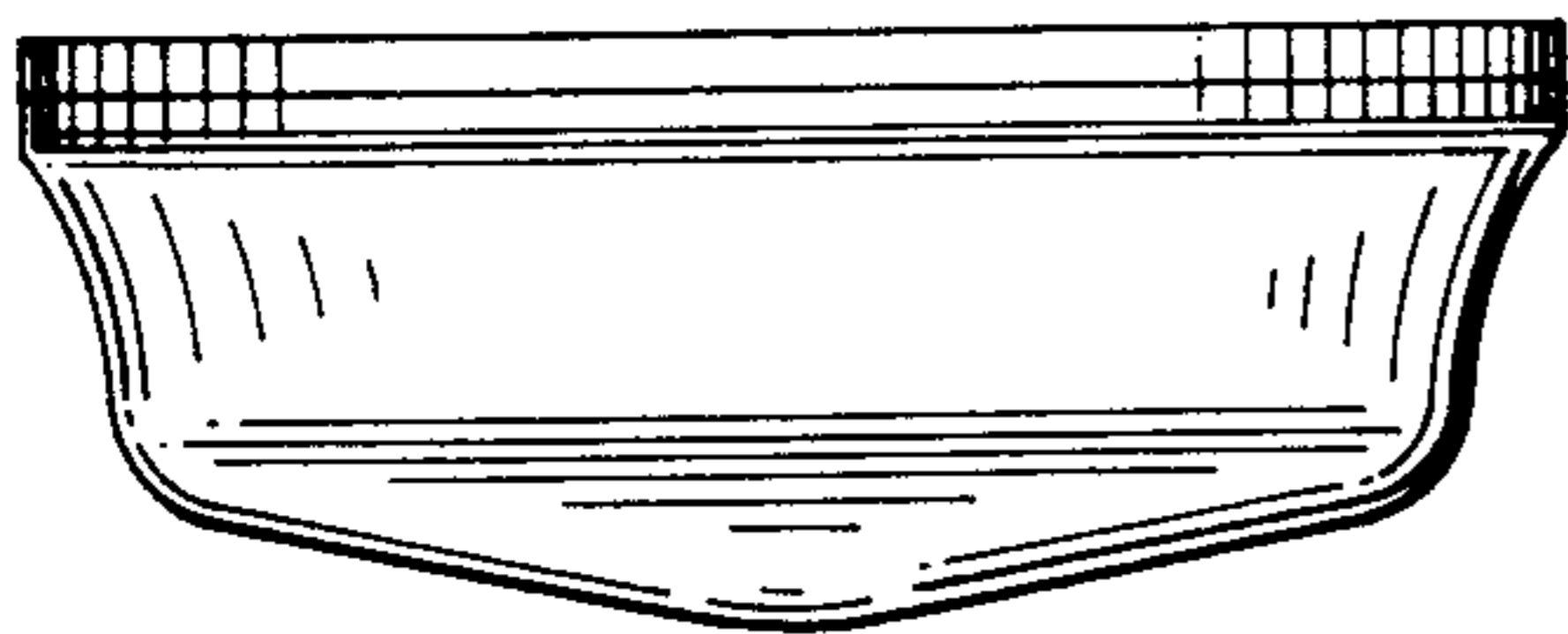
