[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a luggage case, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a luggage case showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a right end elevational view thereof.
The characteristic feature of the design resides in the strips of material extending along the top and bottom corners of the body adjacent the outer welting strips.

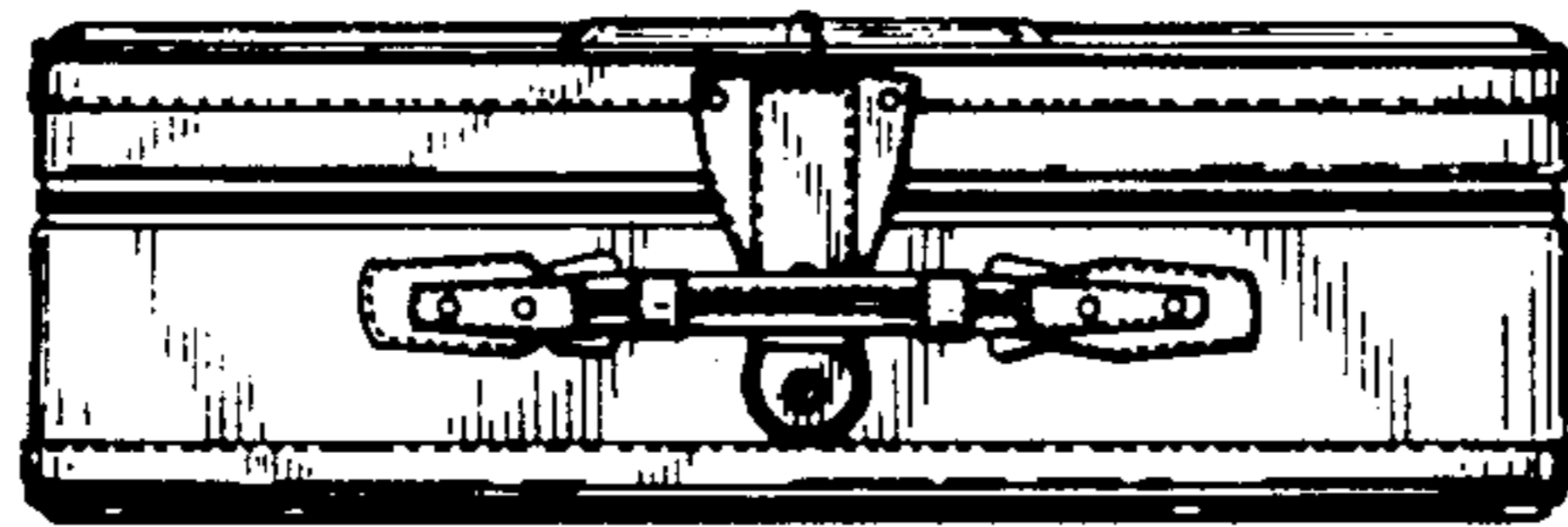
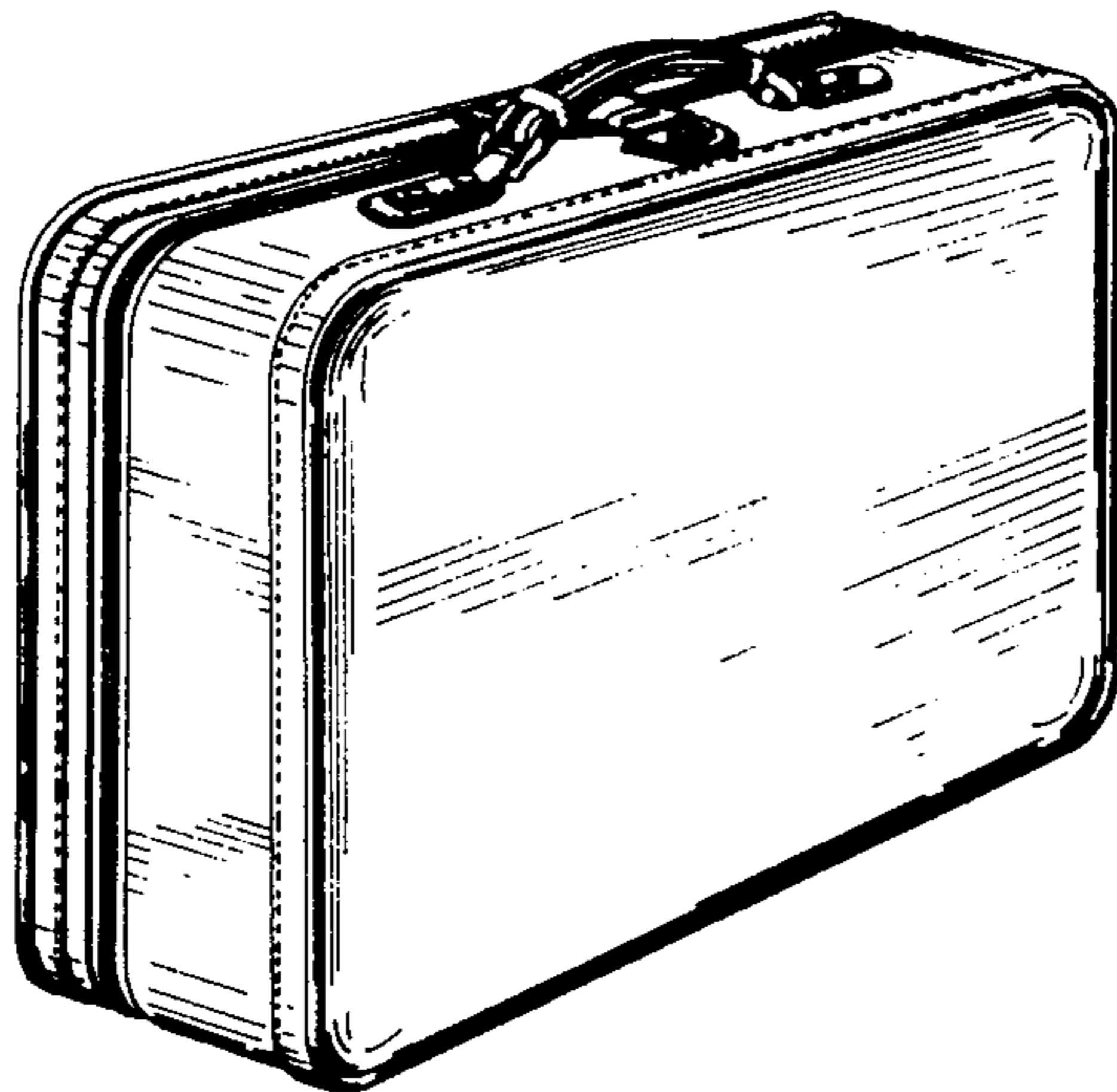

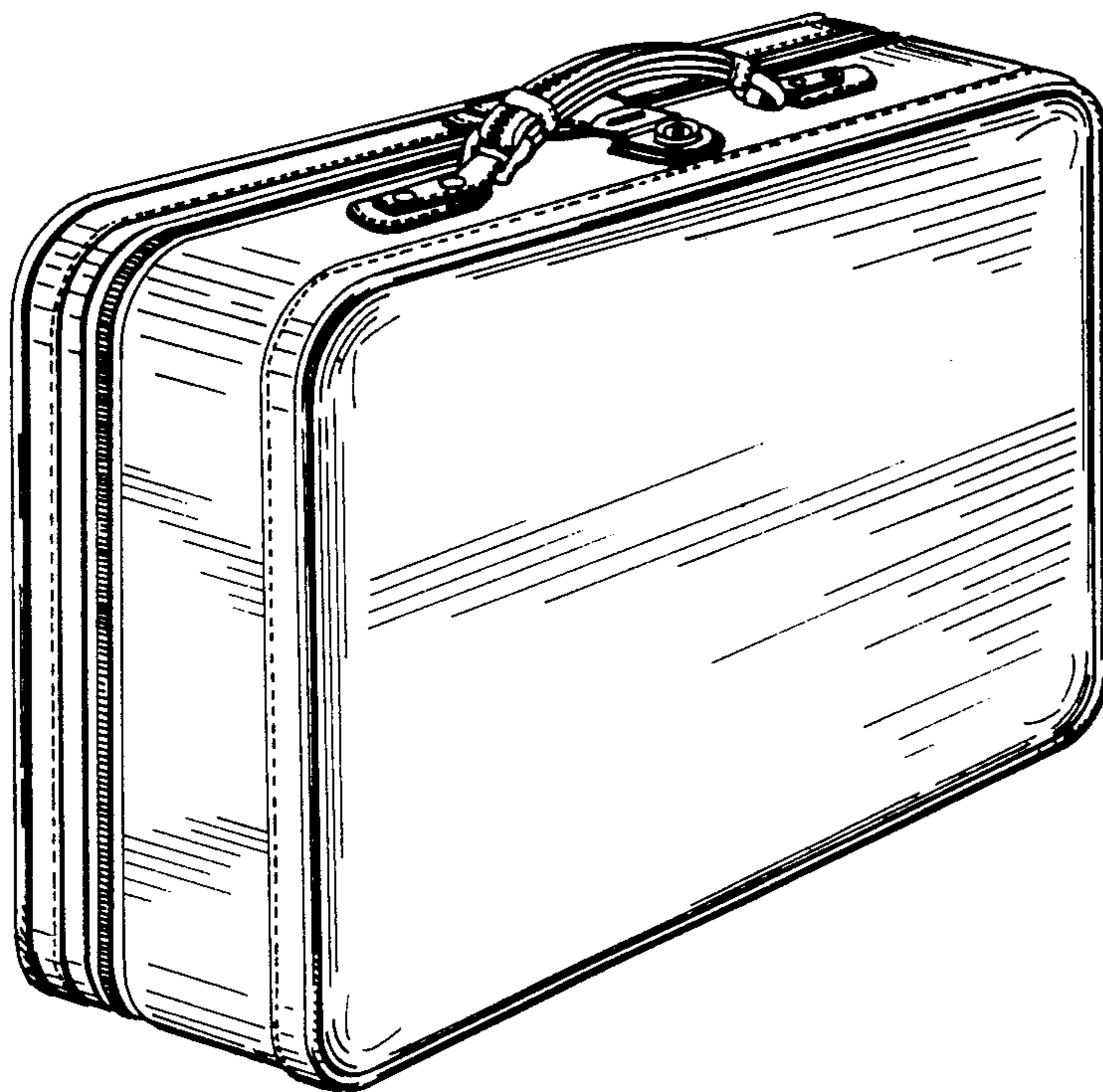

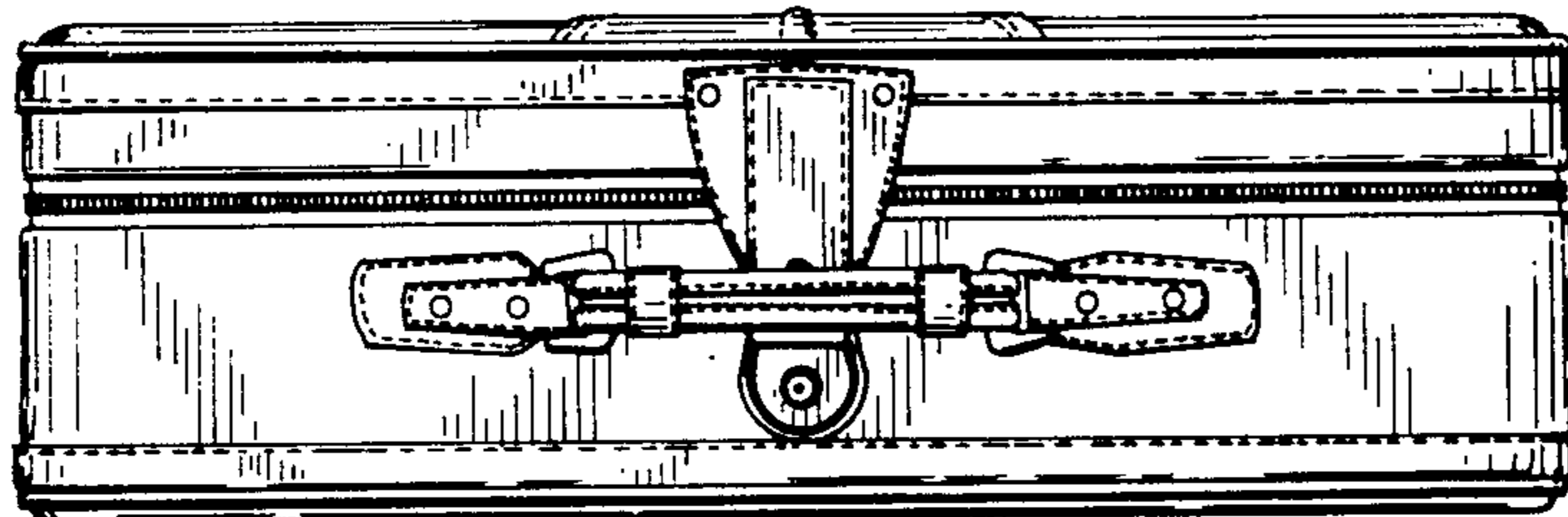

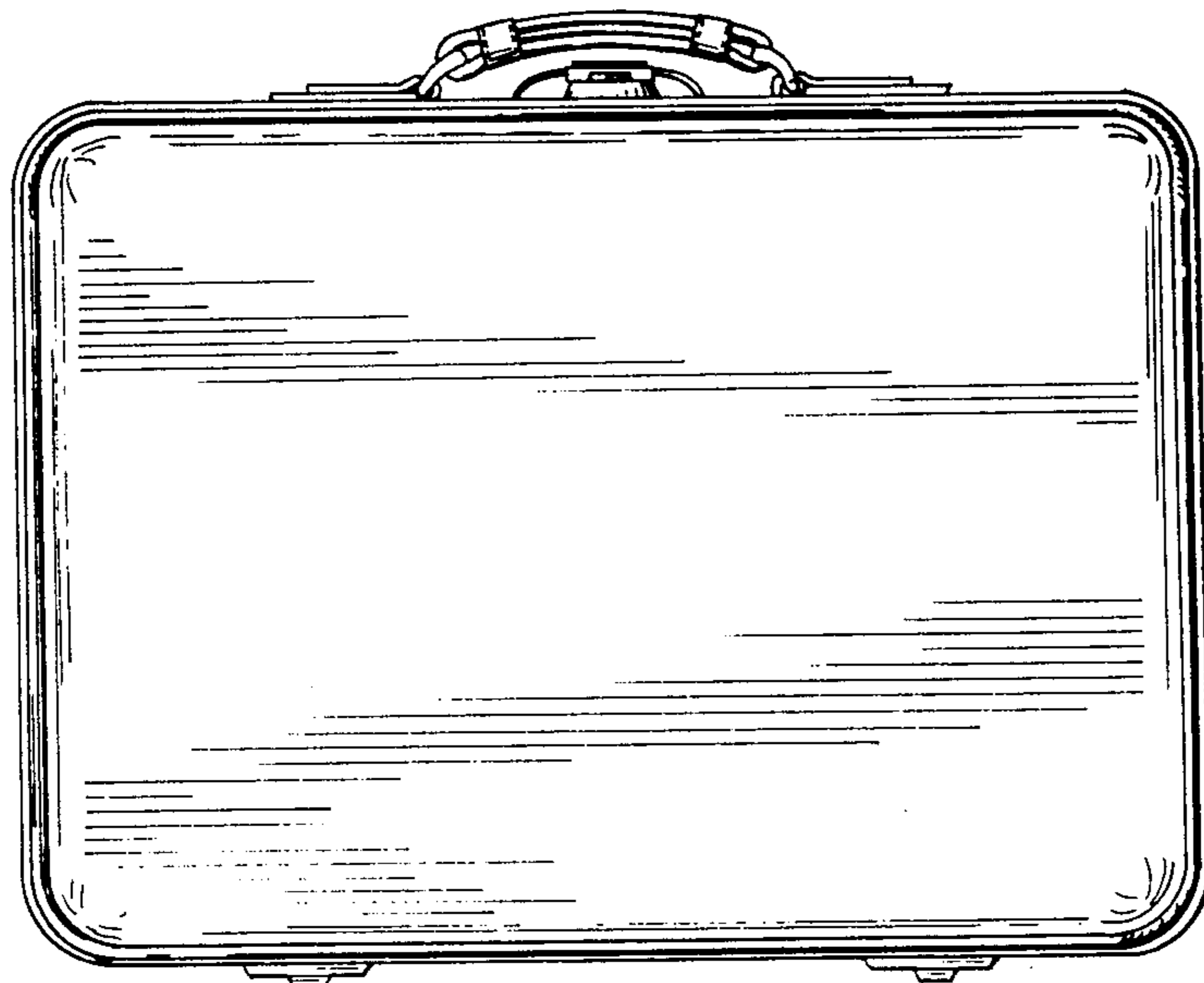

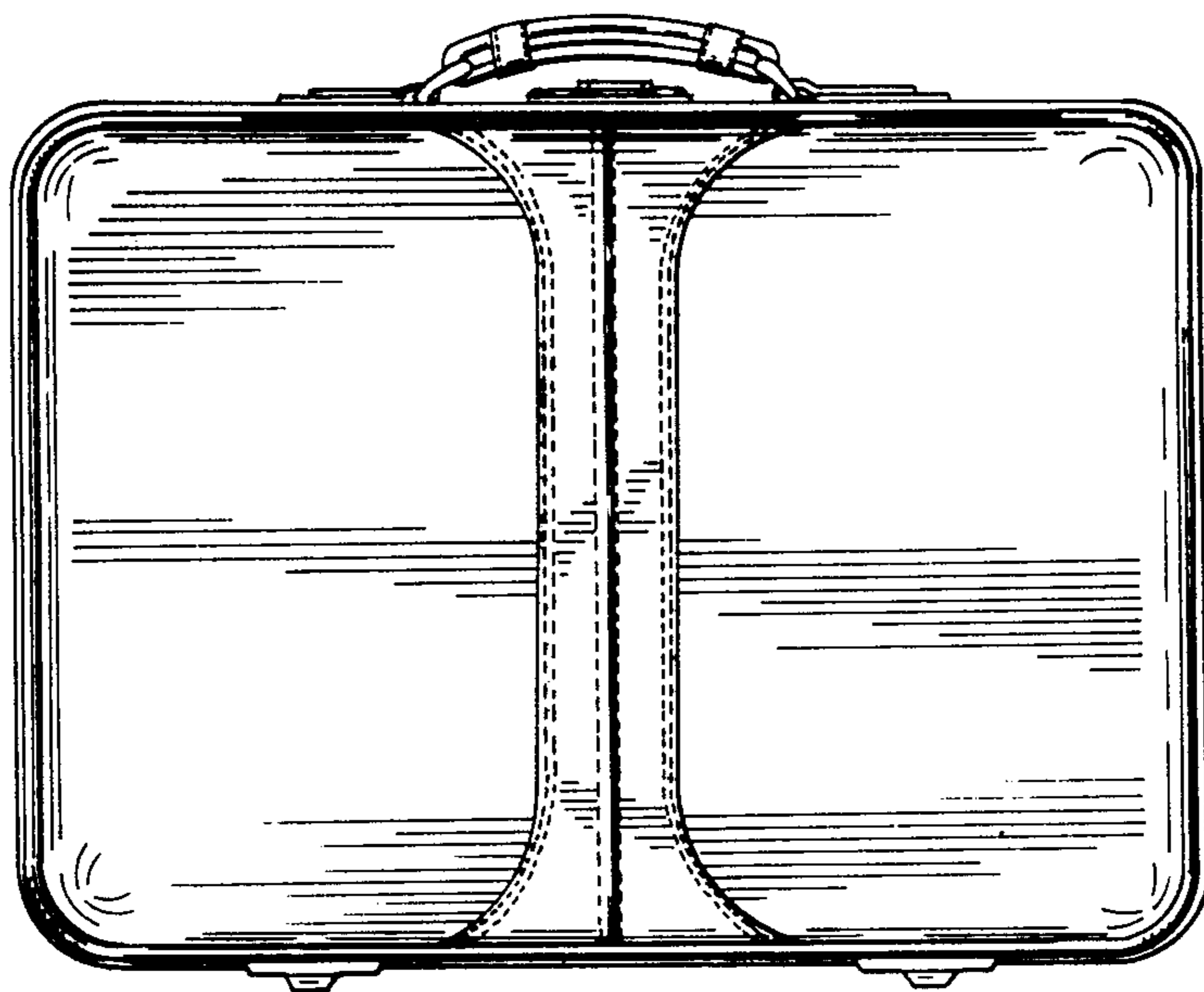

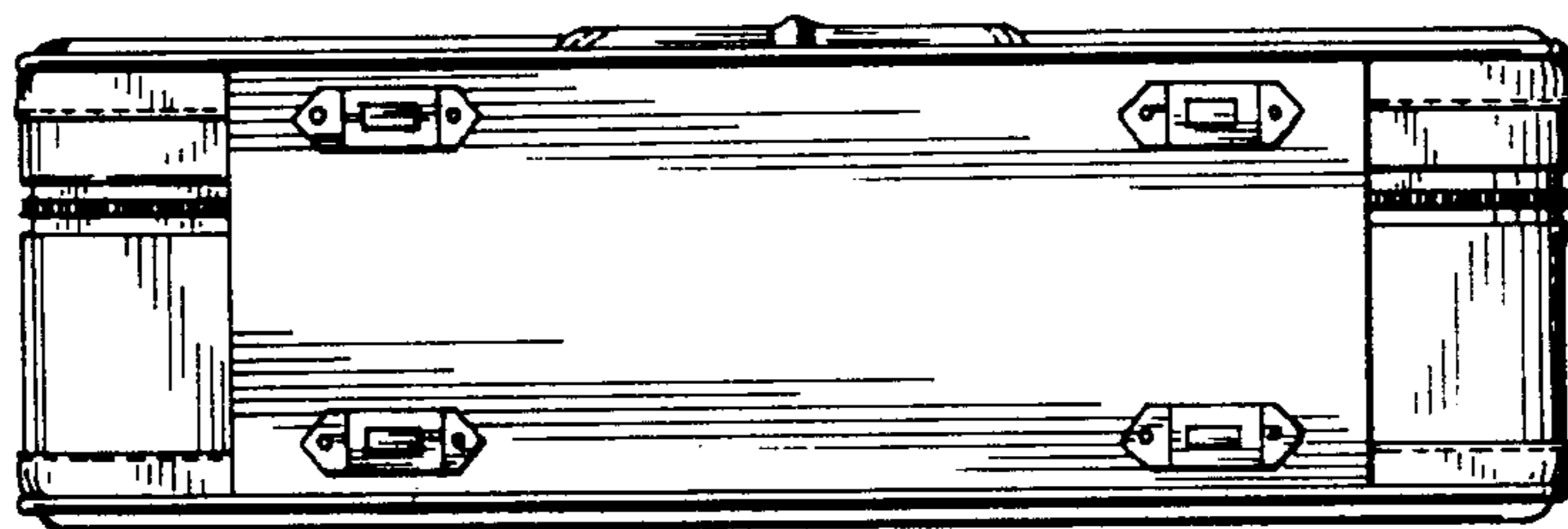
