[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a luggage case, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a luggage case showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
 FIG. 5 is a left end elevational view, the opposite end view being a mirror image thereof. The partial showing of surface shading indicating a fabric texture is understood to be continuous throughout on those surfaces where shown.

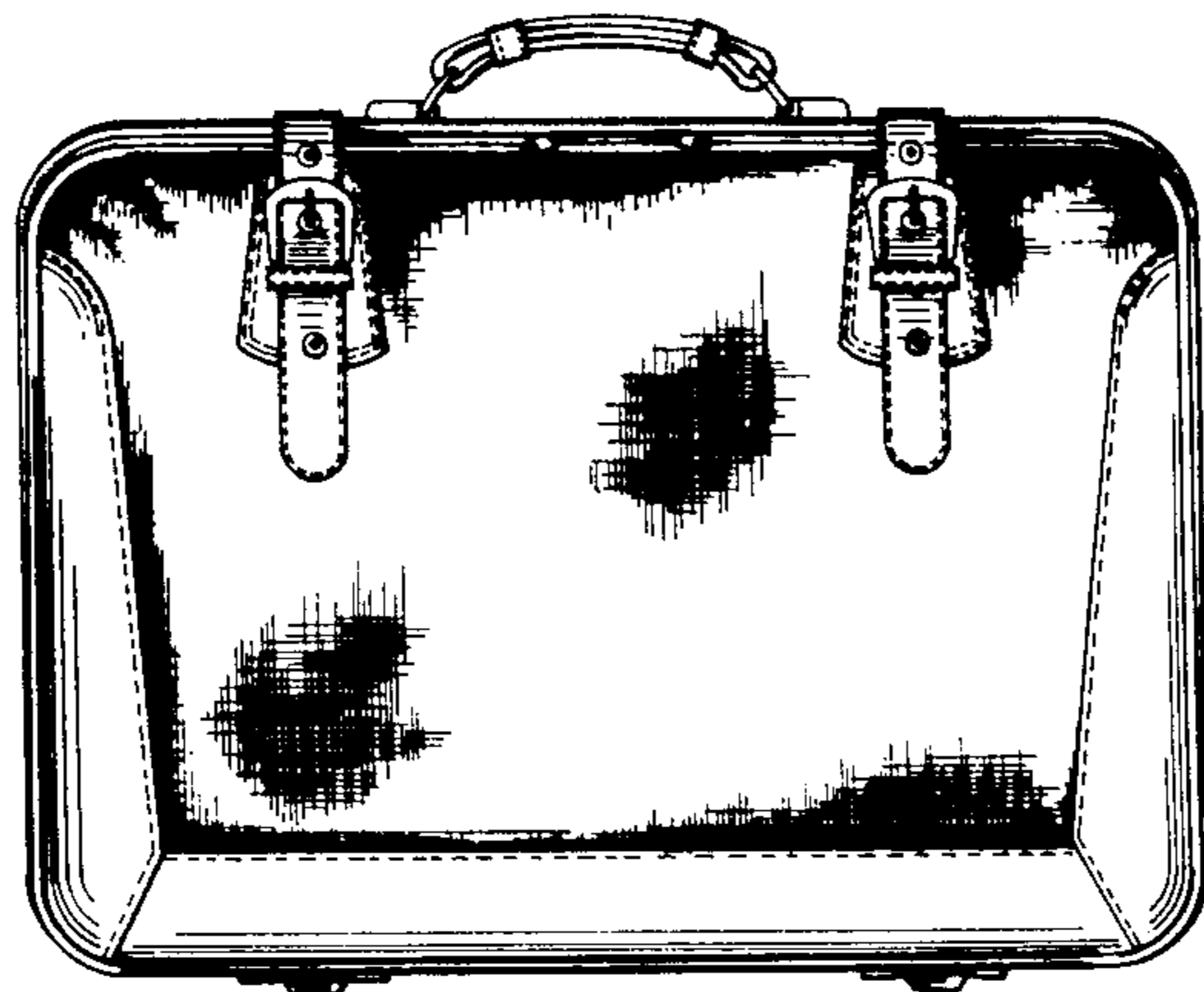
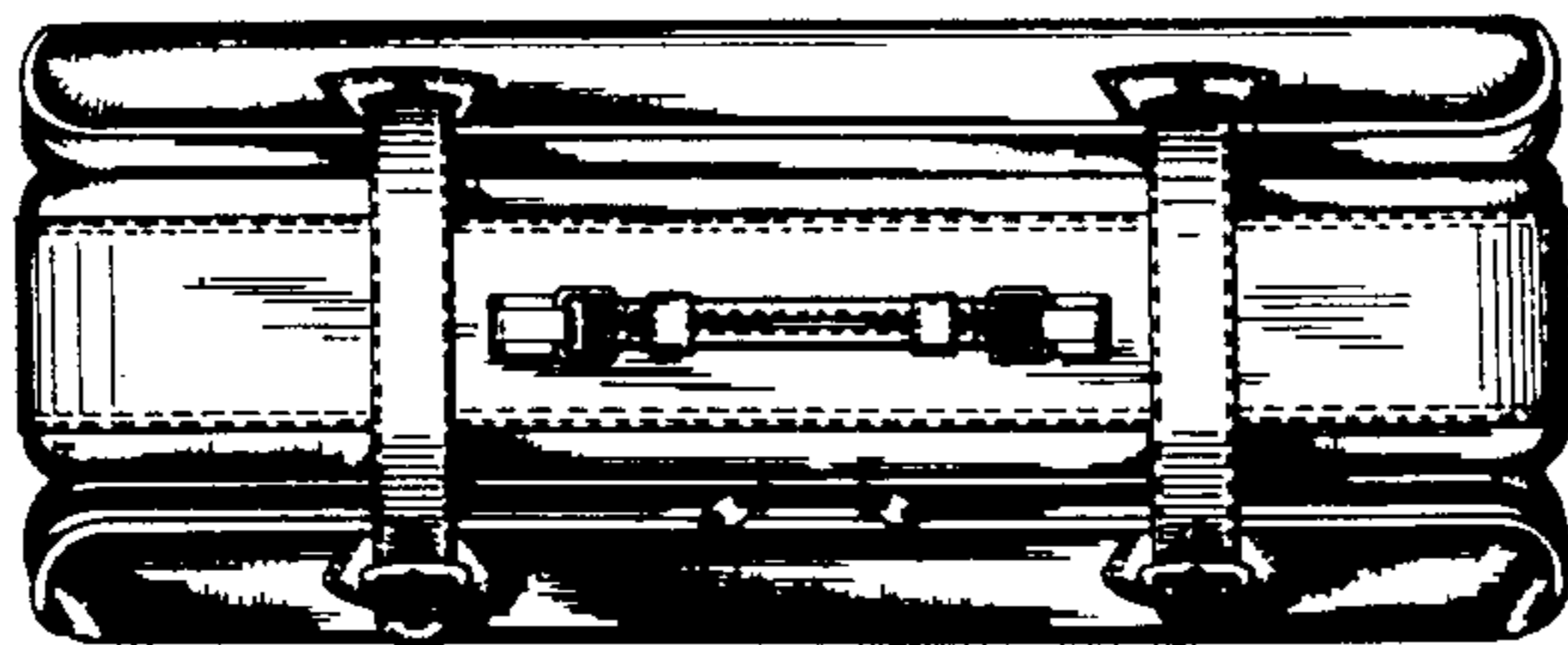

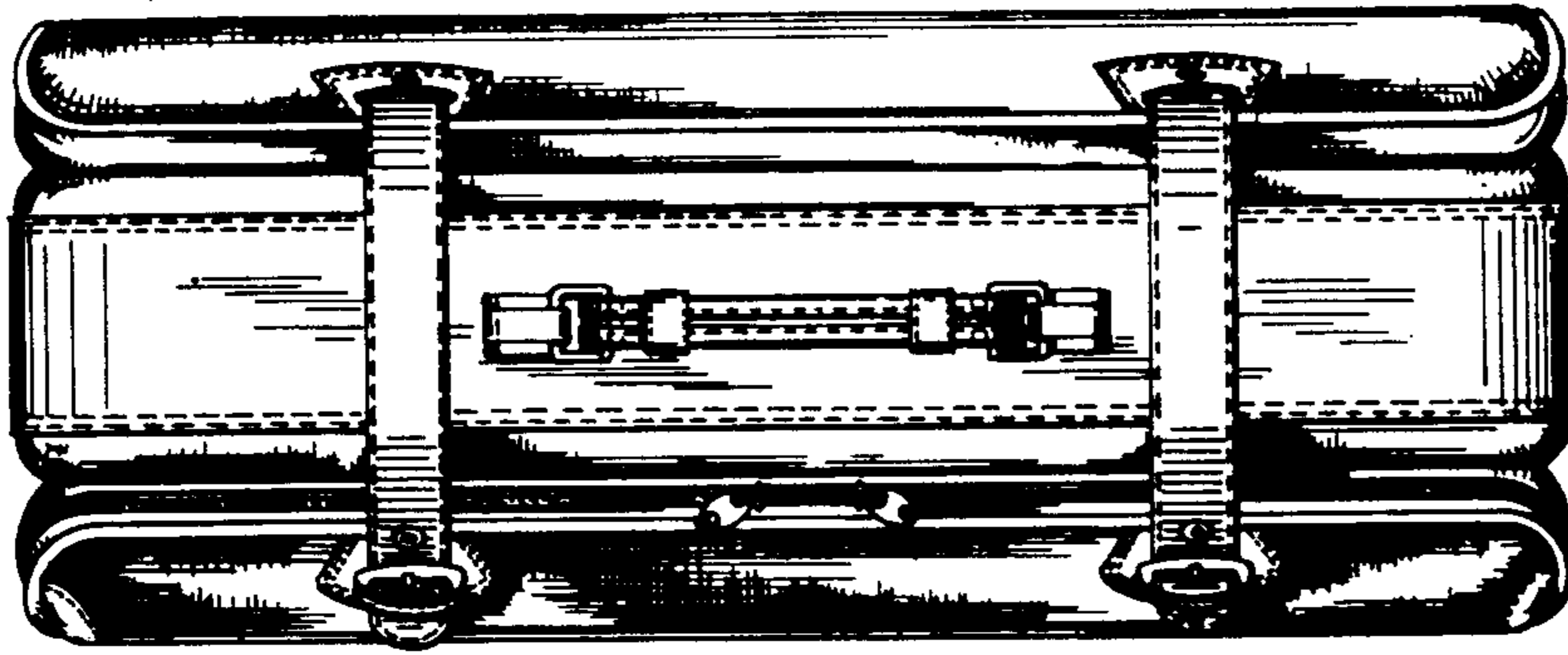

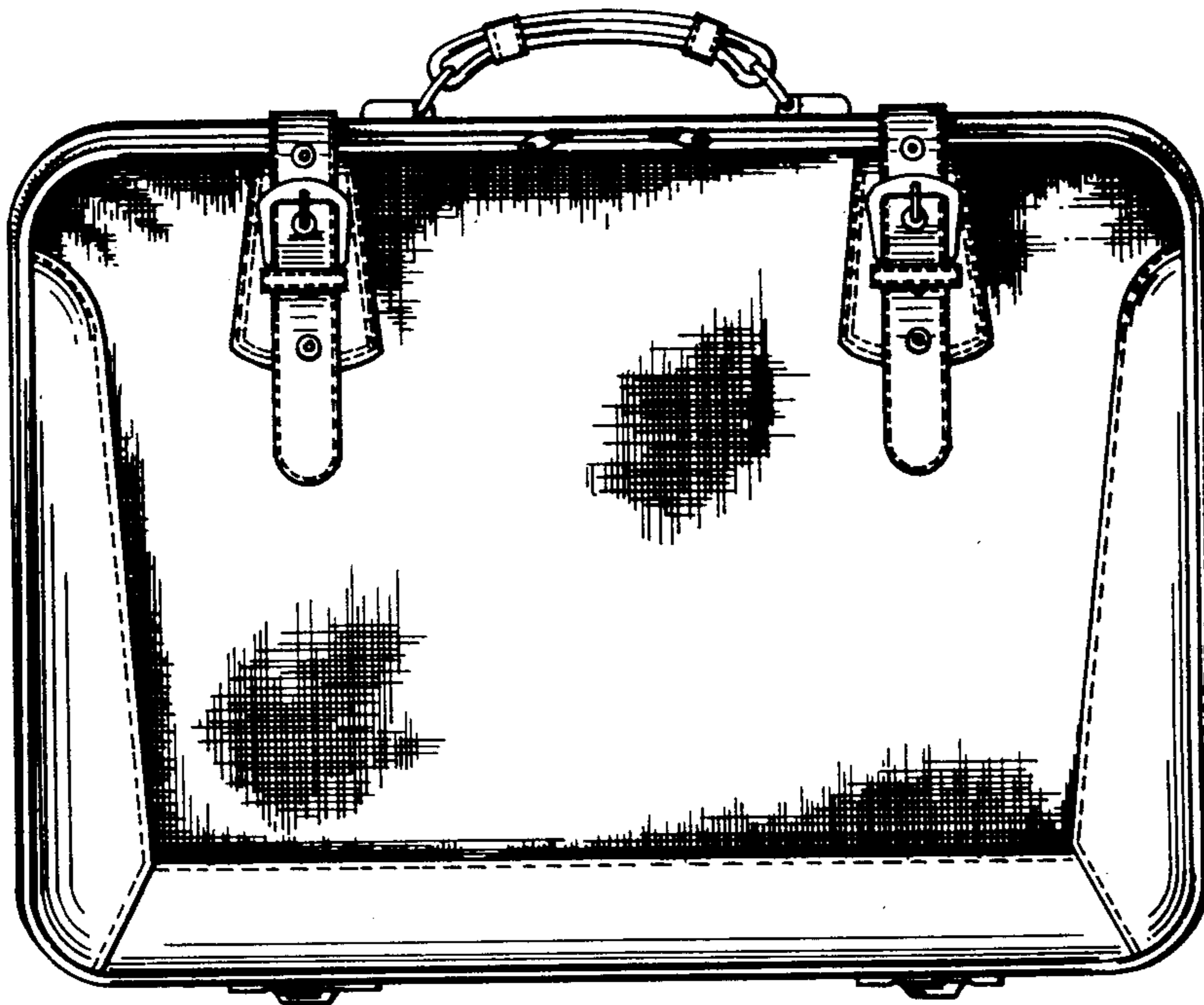

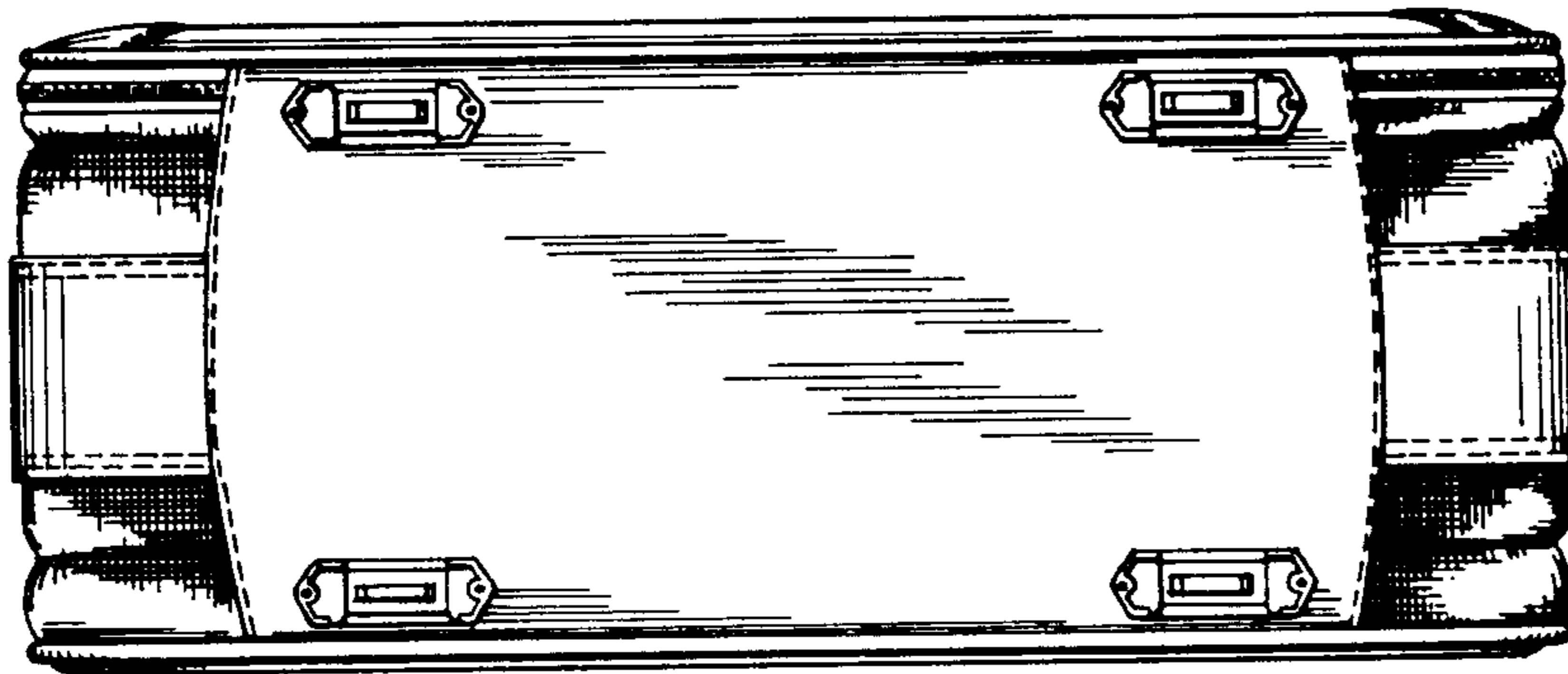

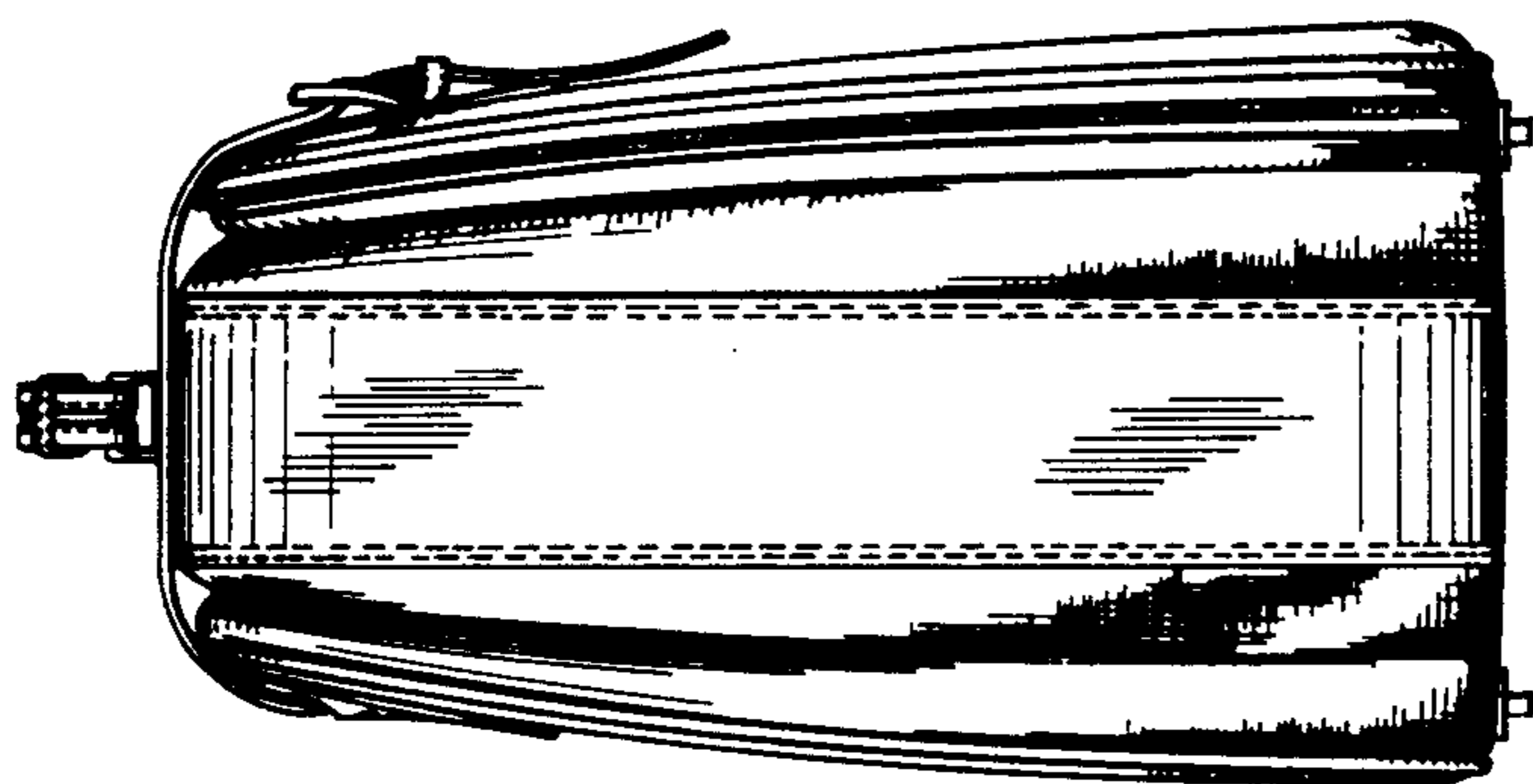
