FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

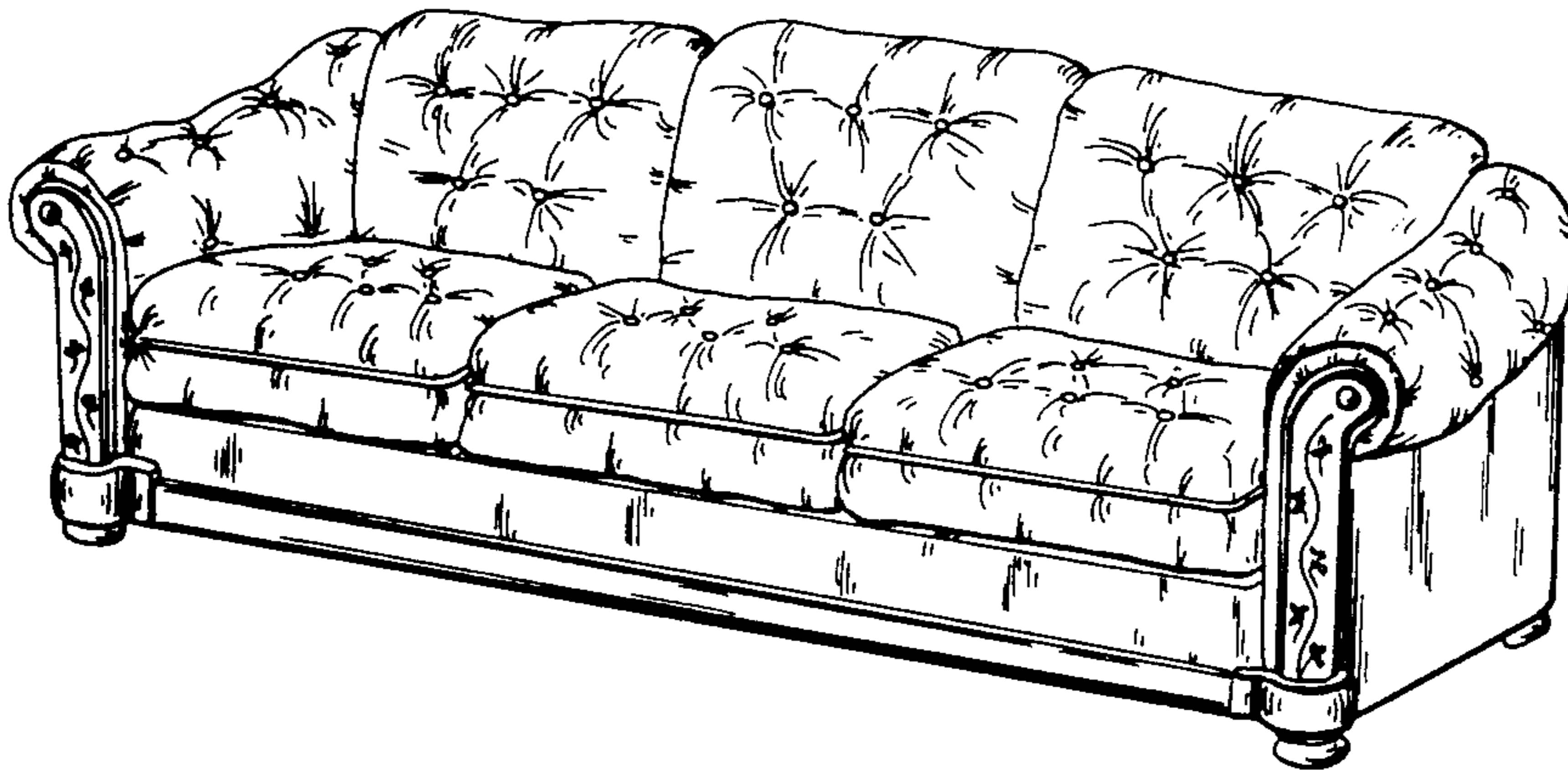
FIG. 3 is a front perspective view of the design shown in the form of a loveseat; and

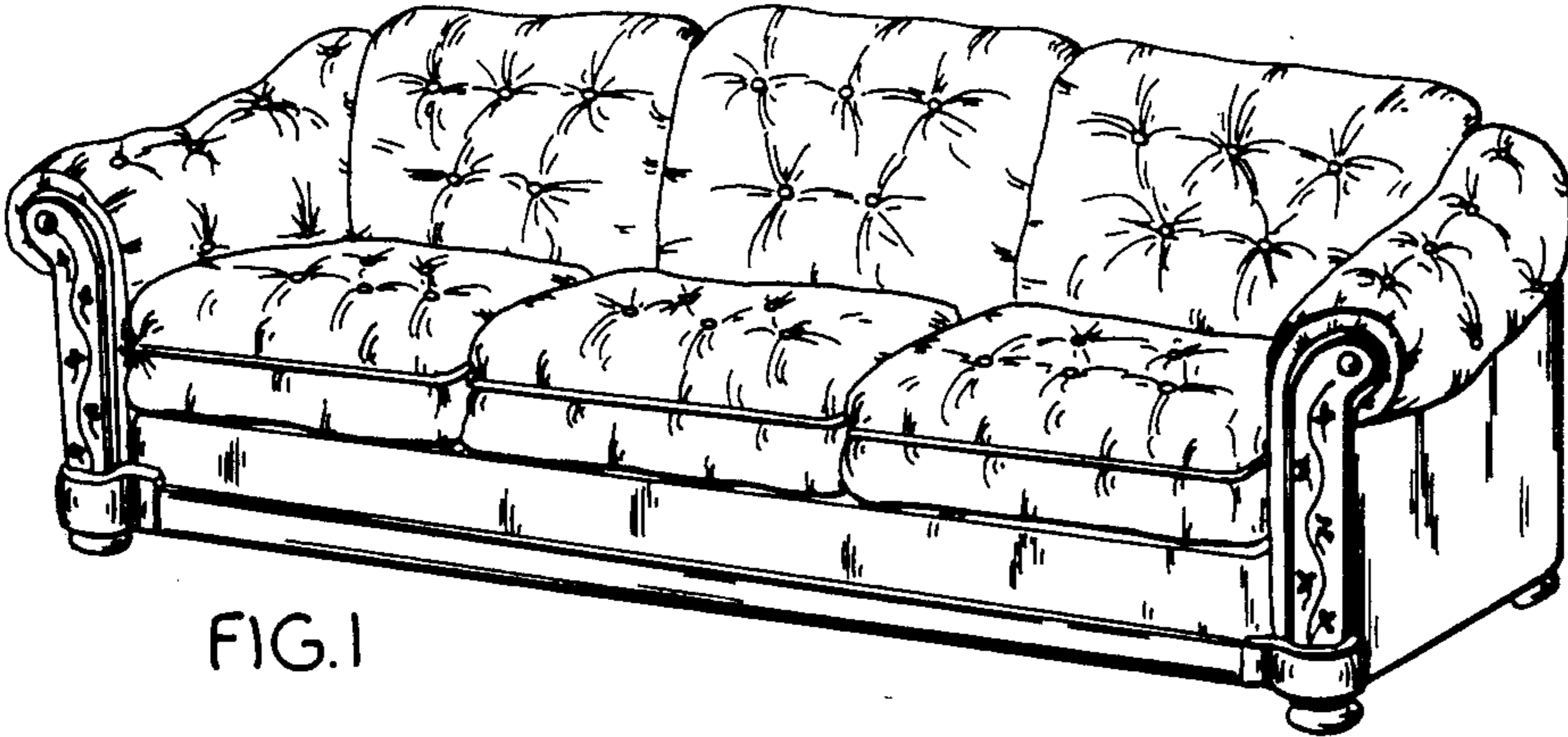

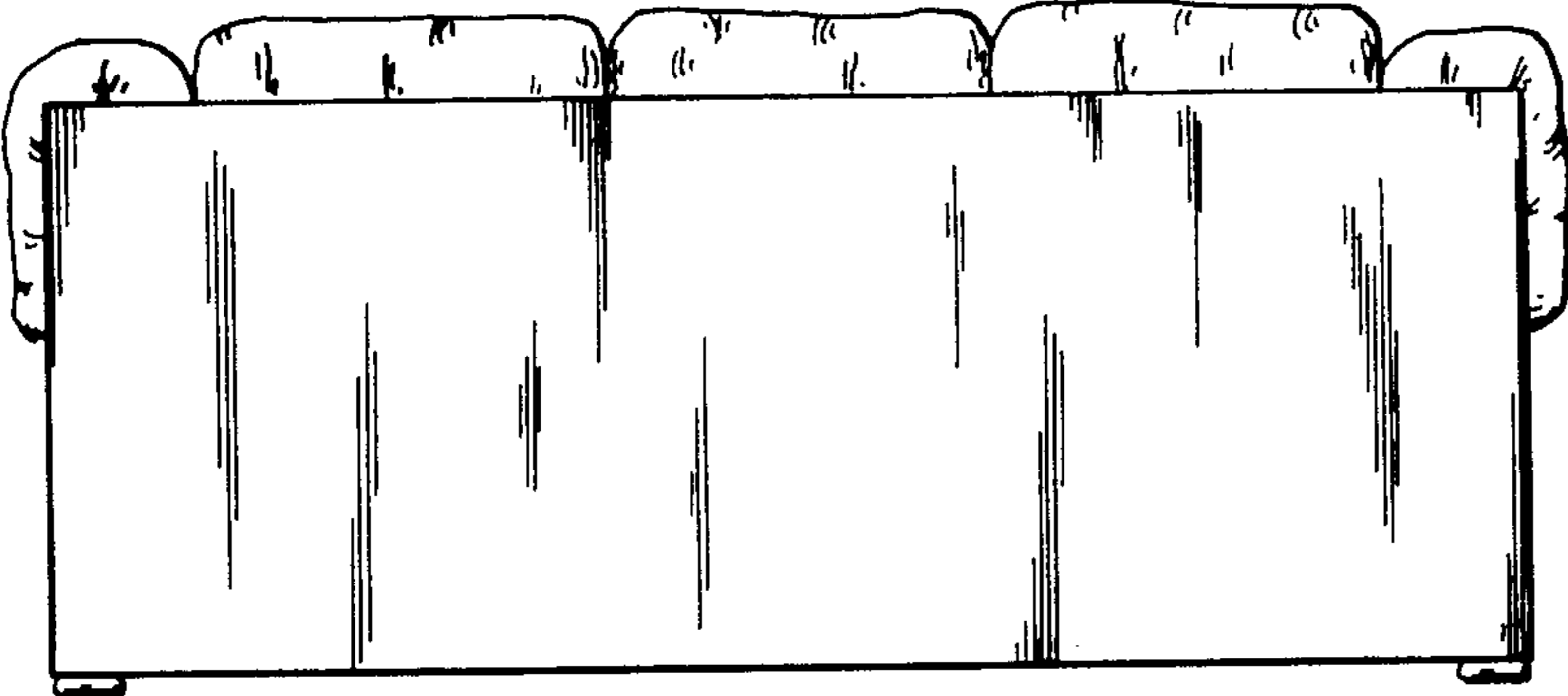

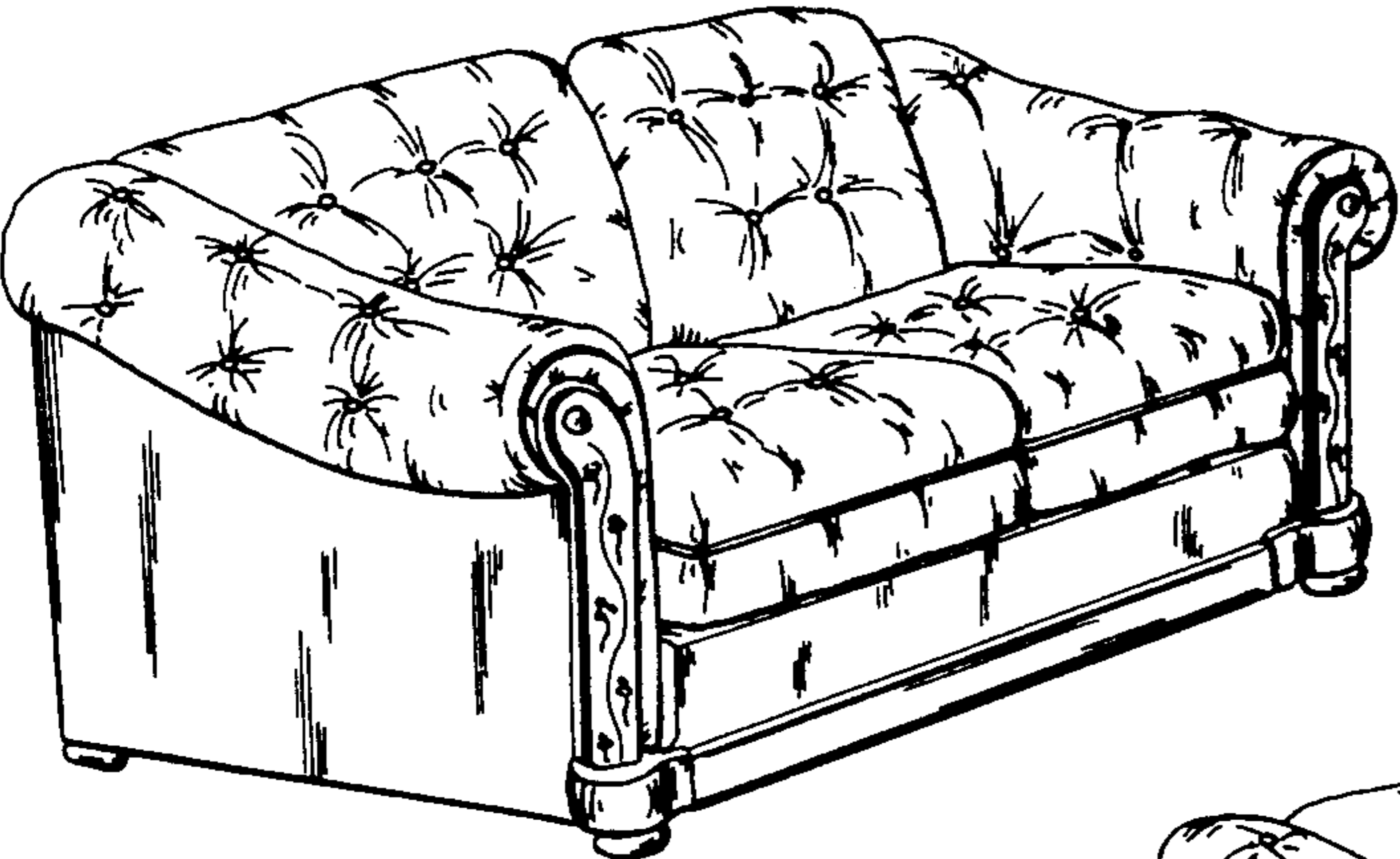

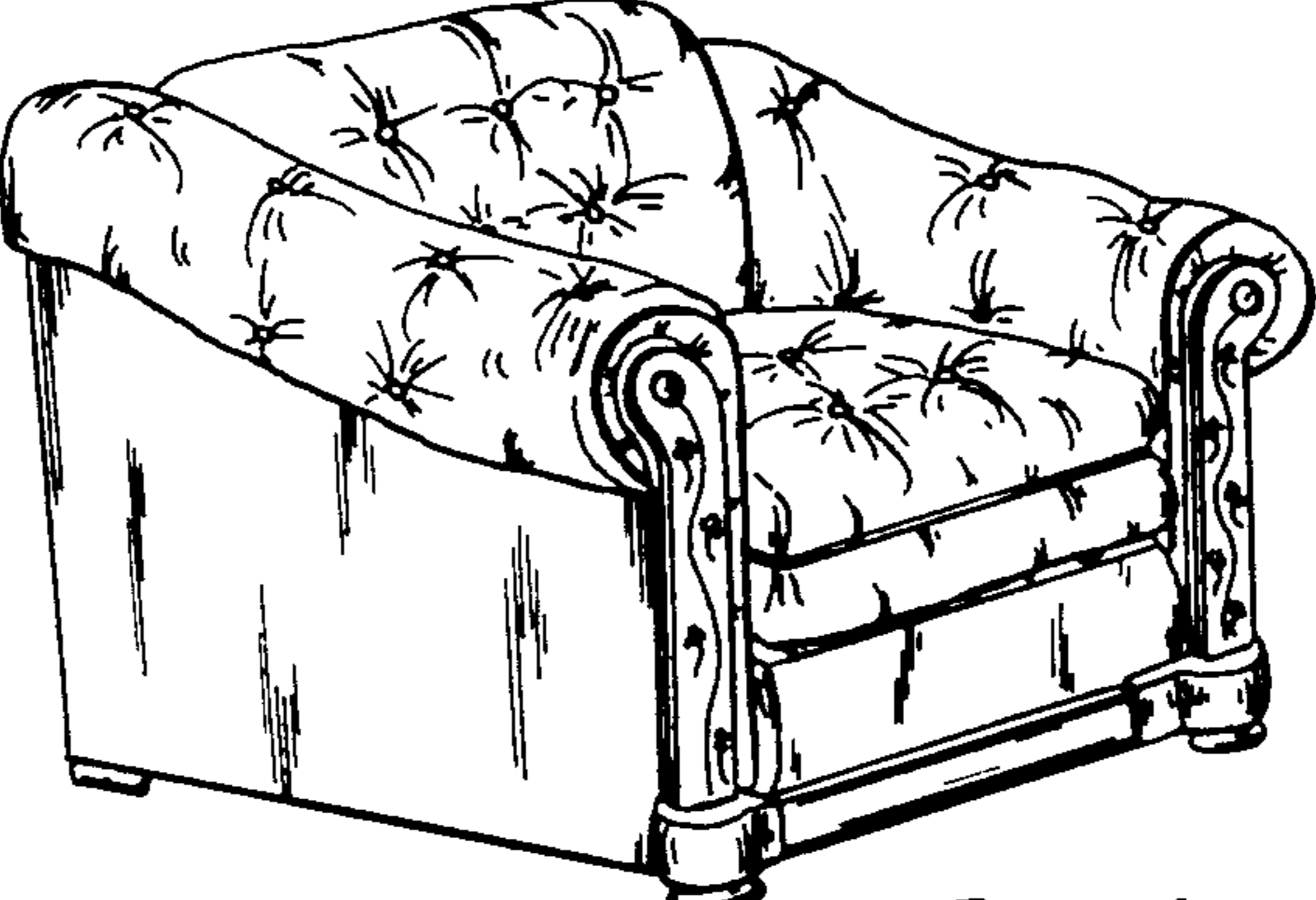
