[57] The ornamental design for a dresser, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a dresser showing my new design;

The rear and bottom of the dresser are substantially plain and unornamented.

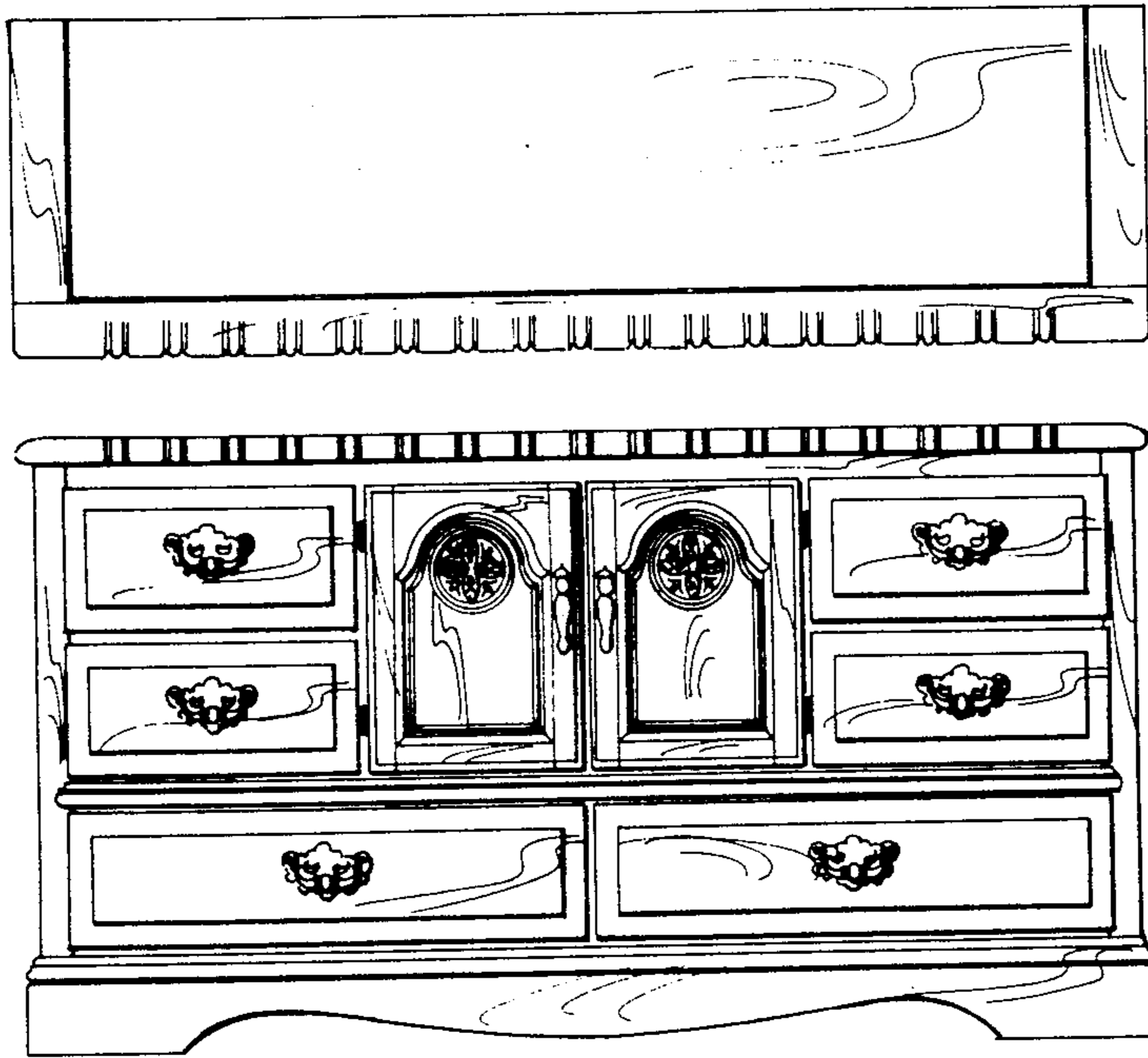

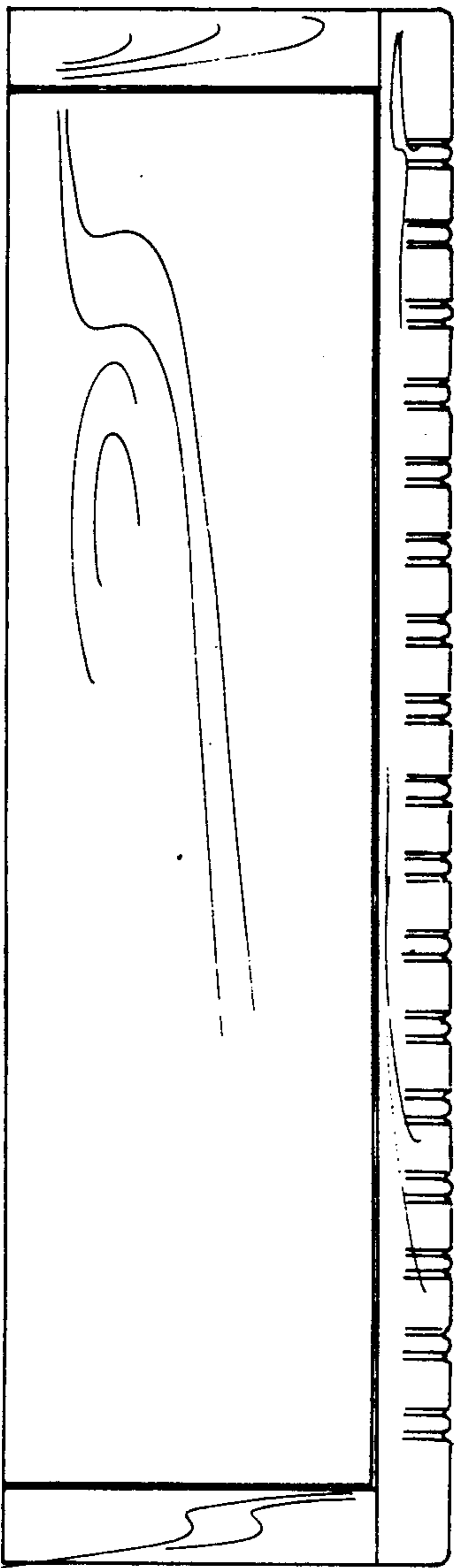

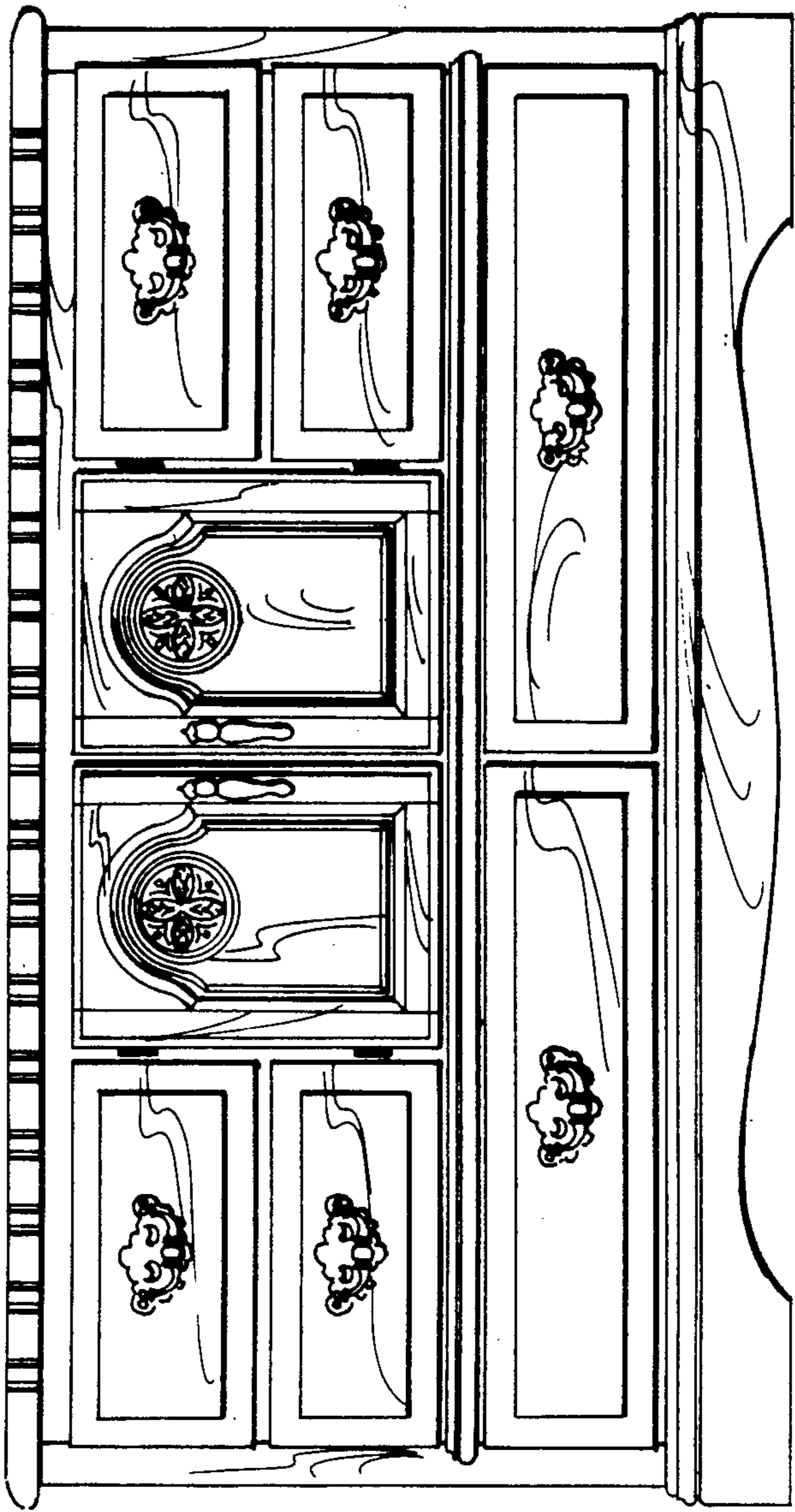
