The rear and bottom of the dresser are substantially plain and unornamented.

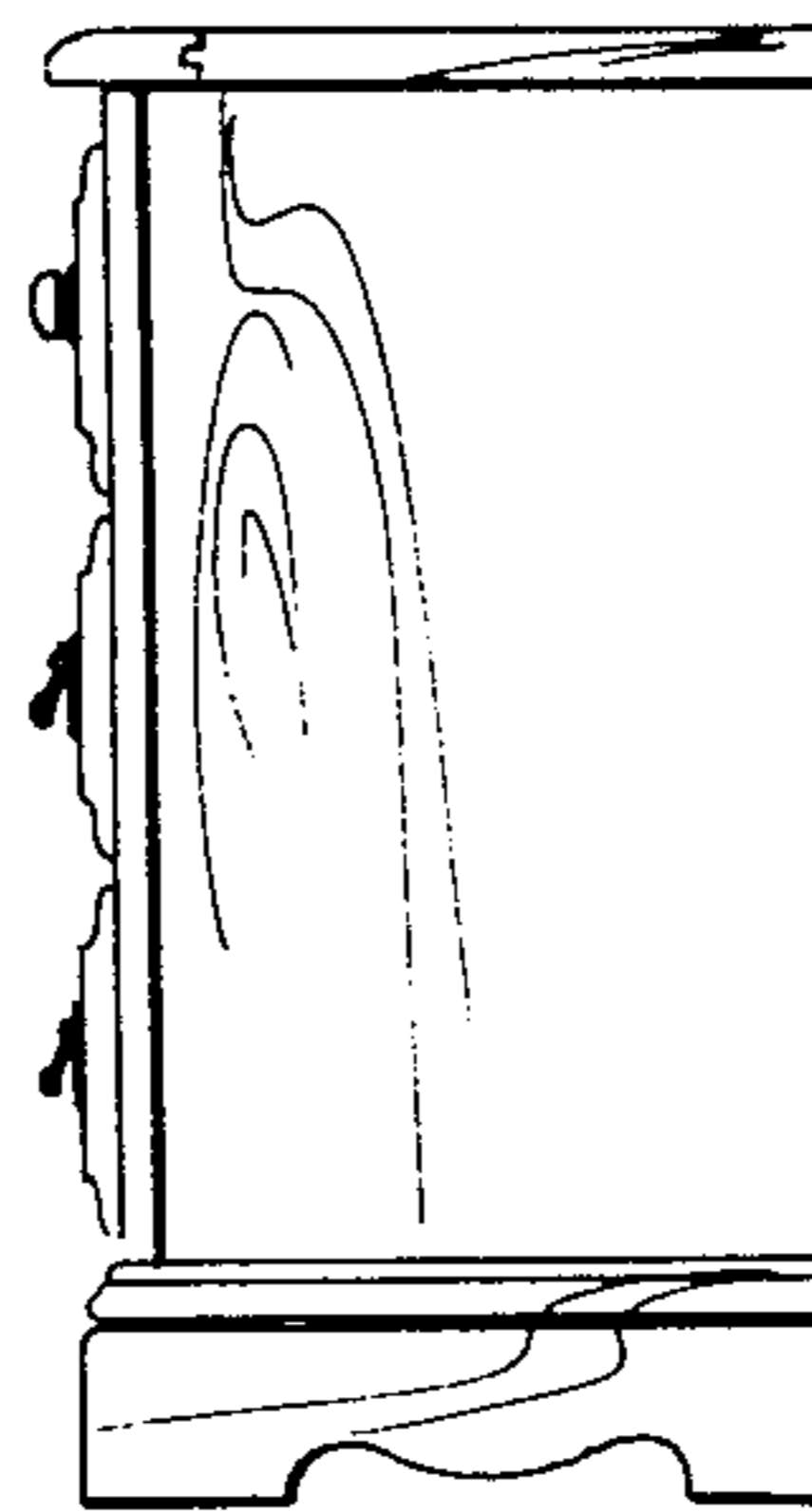
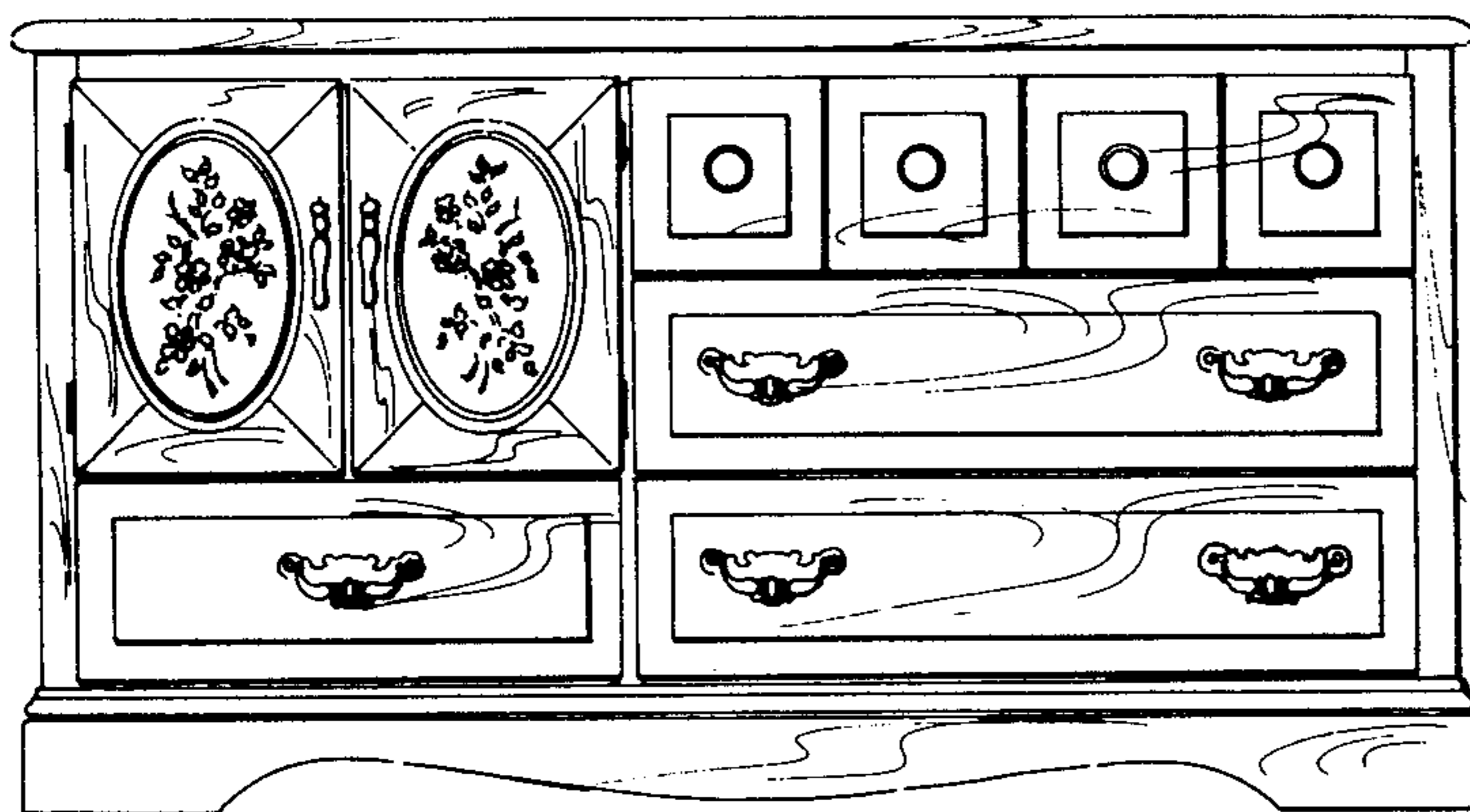

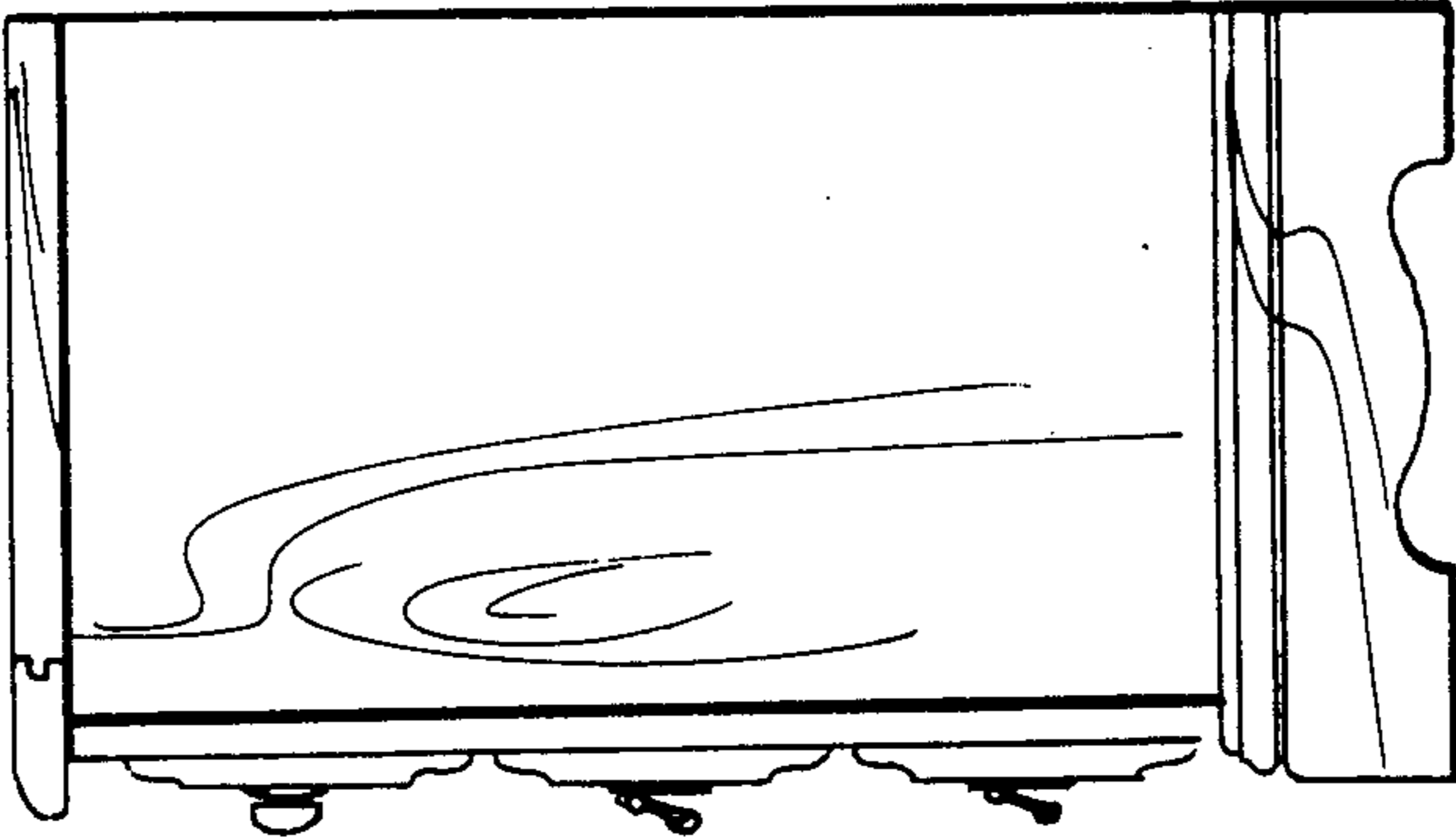
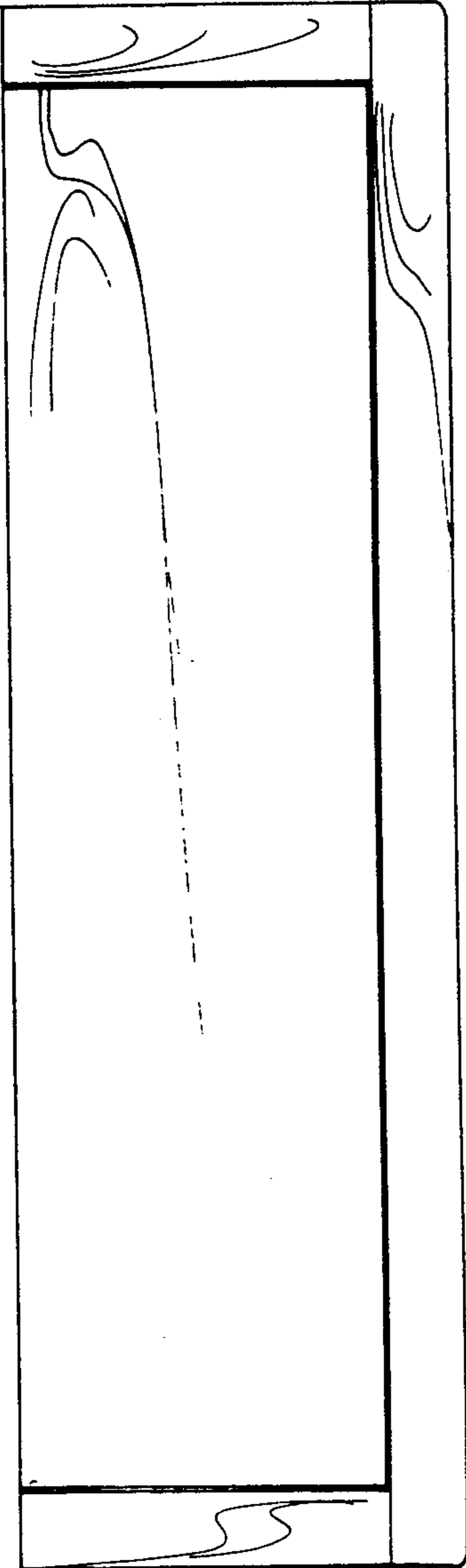

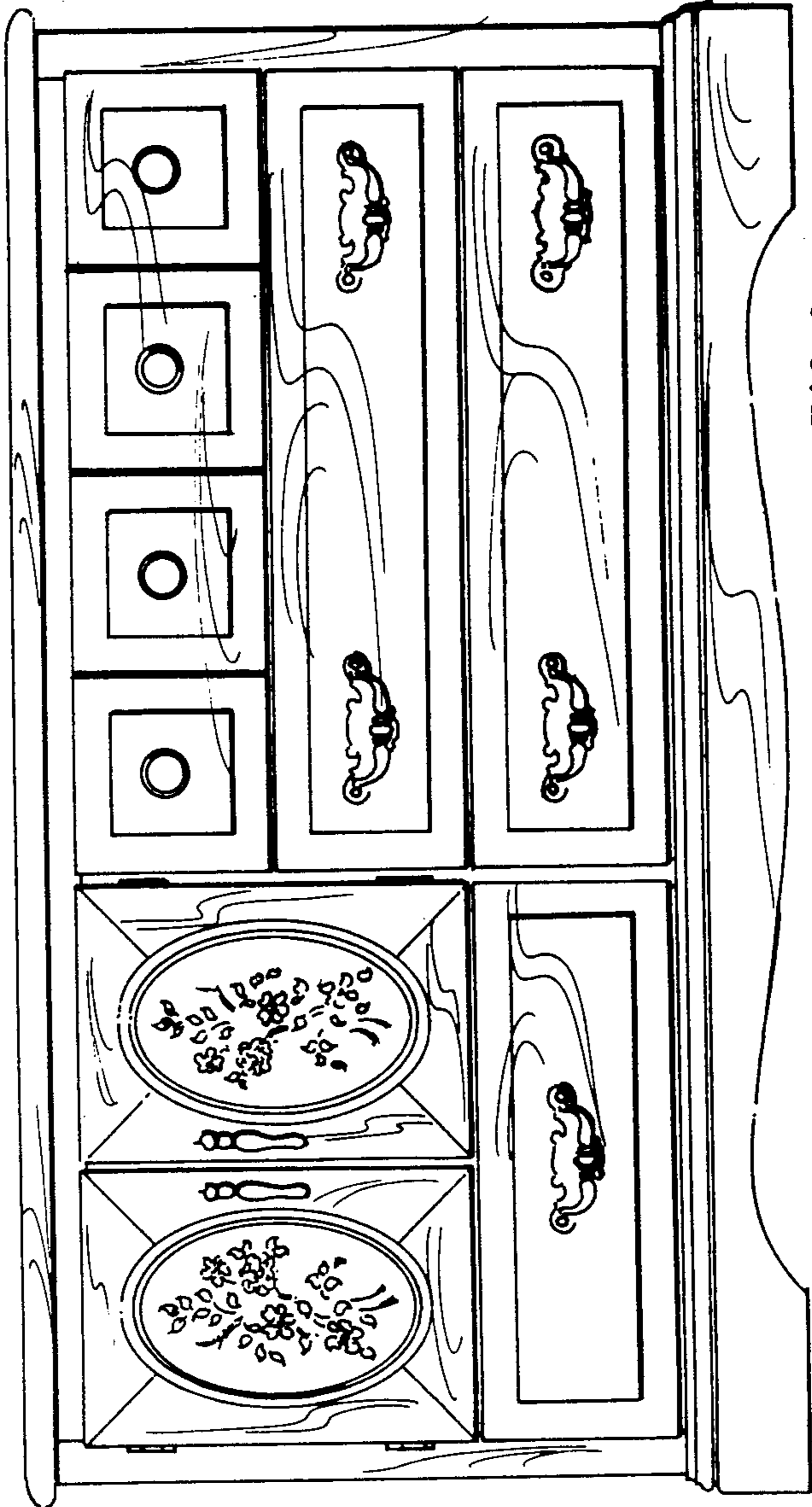
