The ornamental design for a dresser, as shown and described.

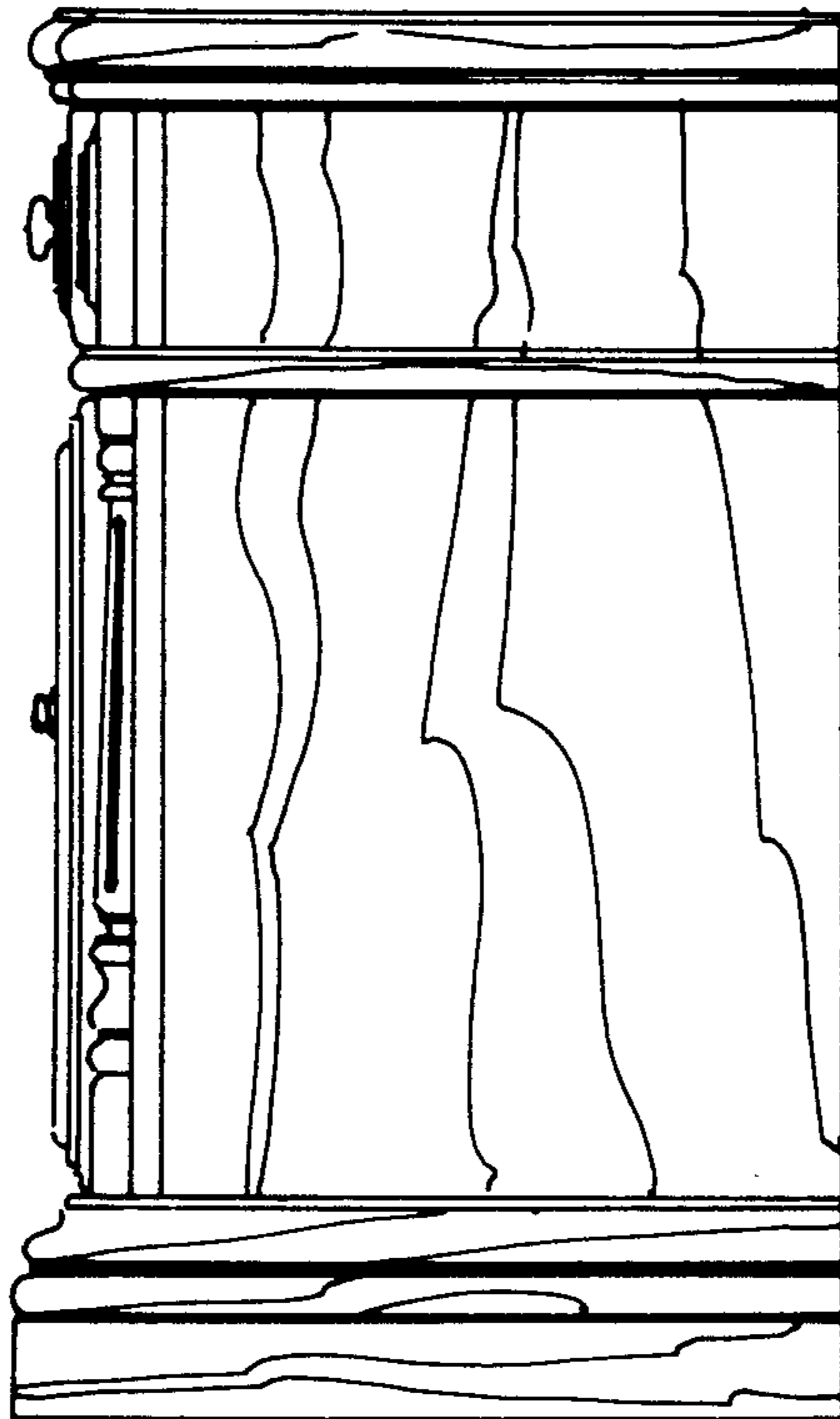
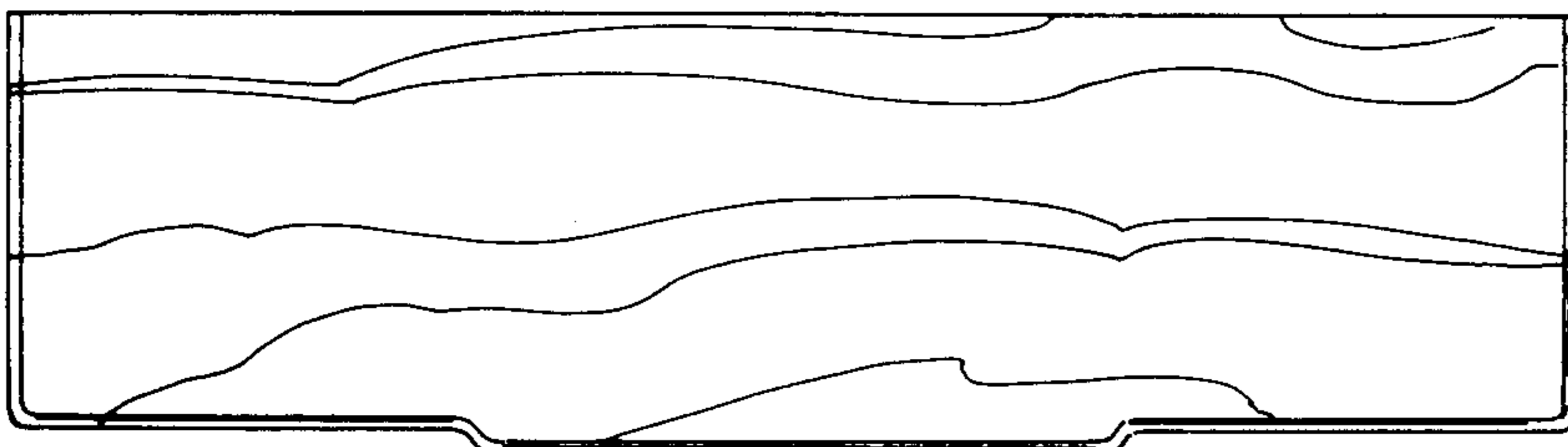
DESCRIPTION

The rear and bottom of the dresser are substantially plain and unornamented.



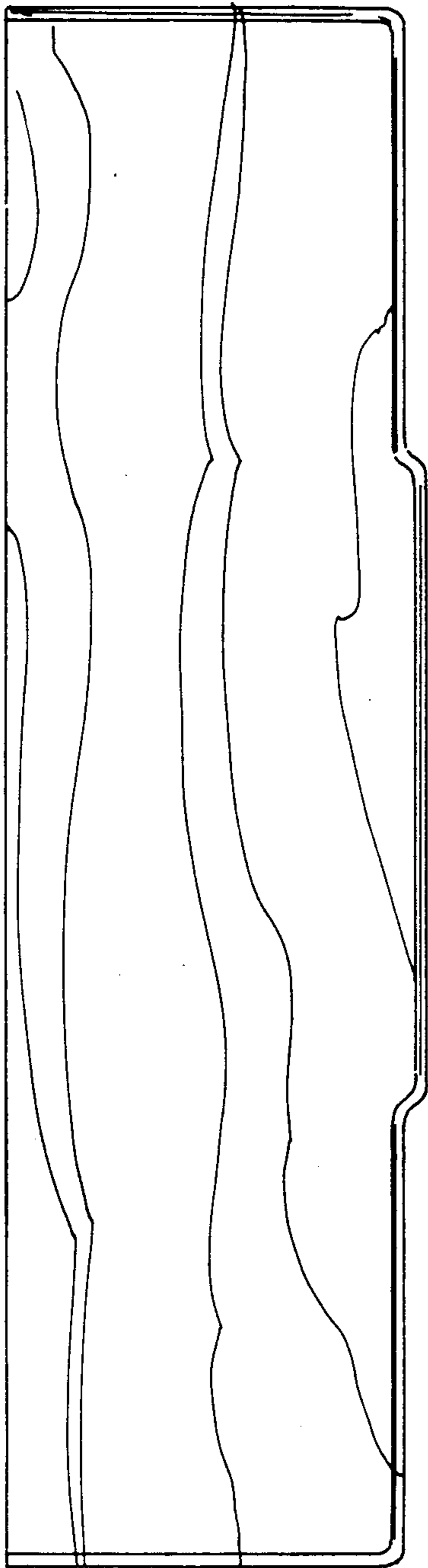

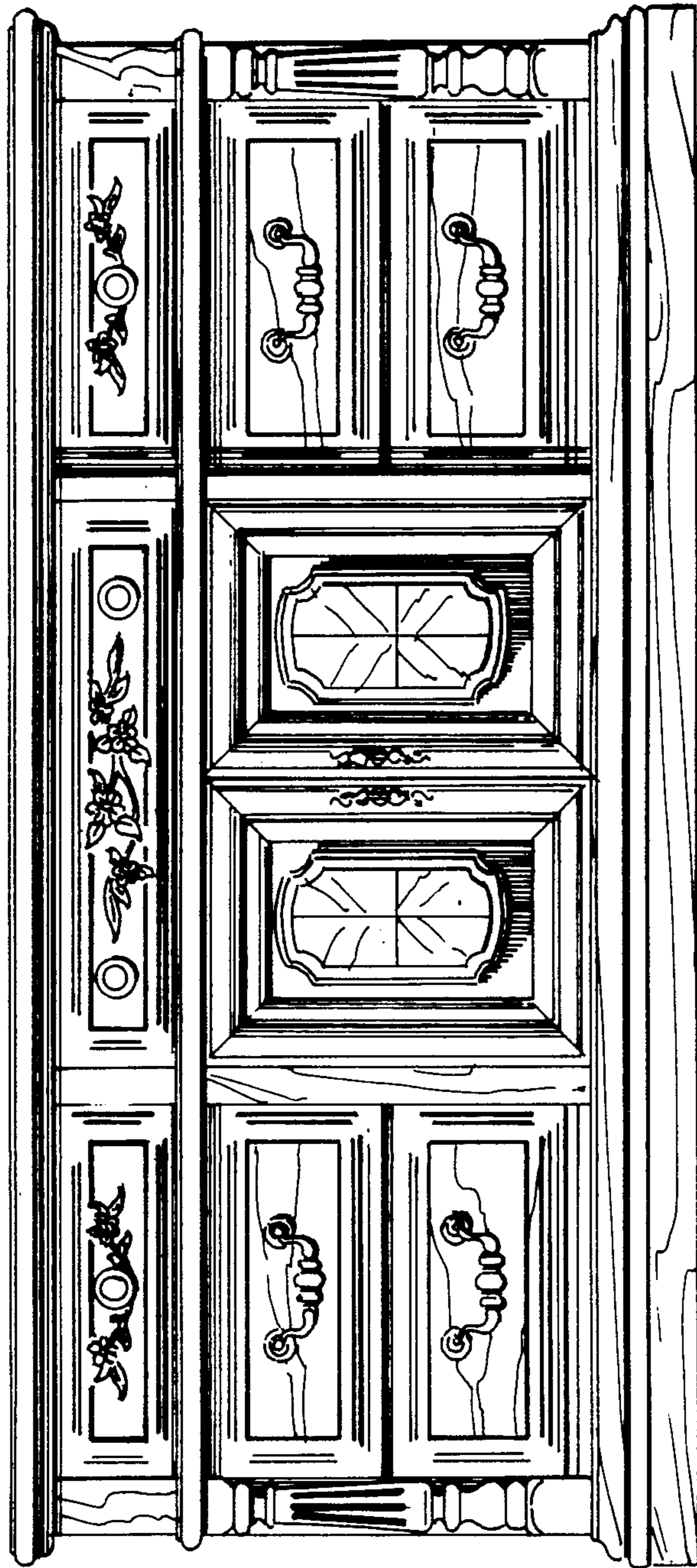

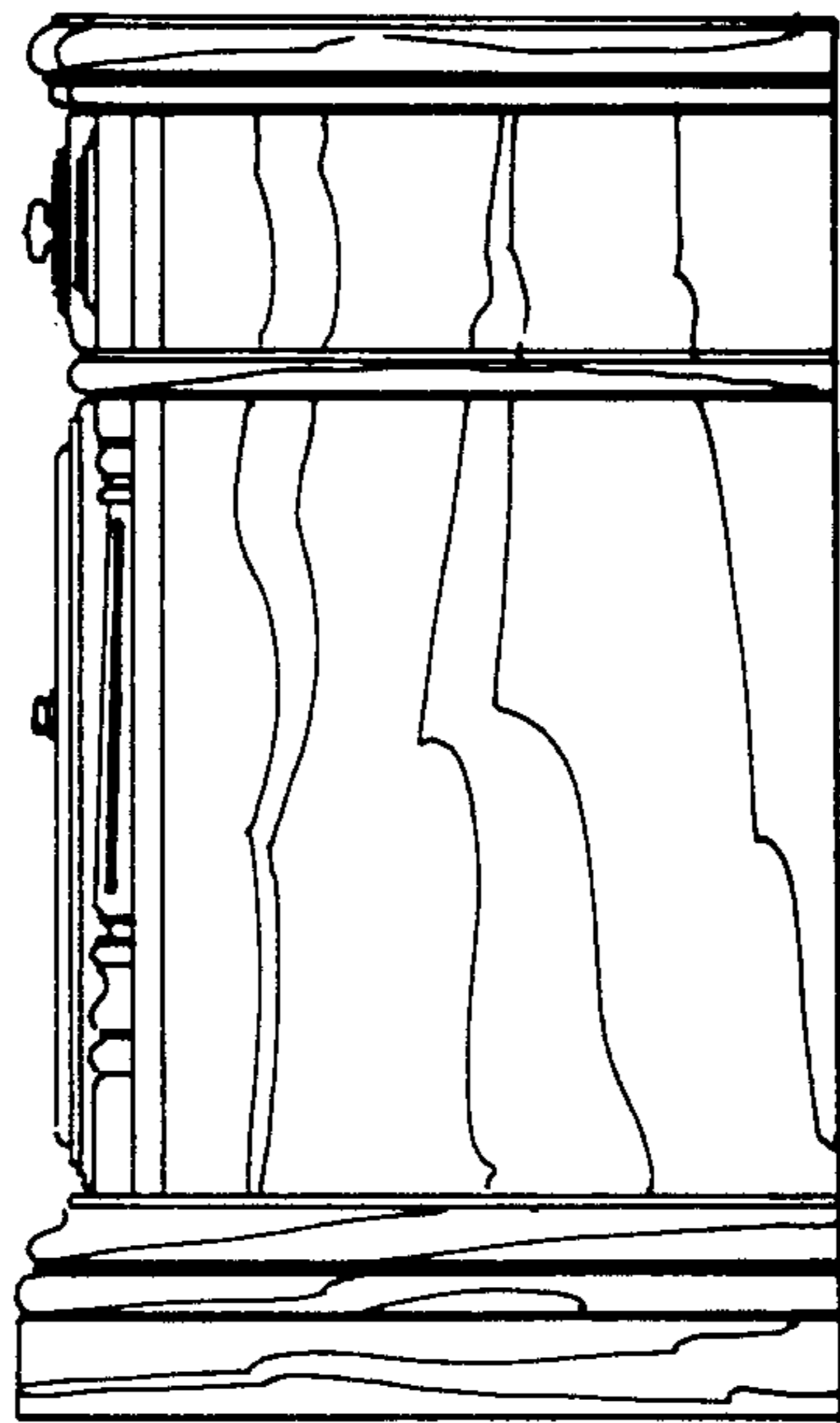
