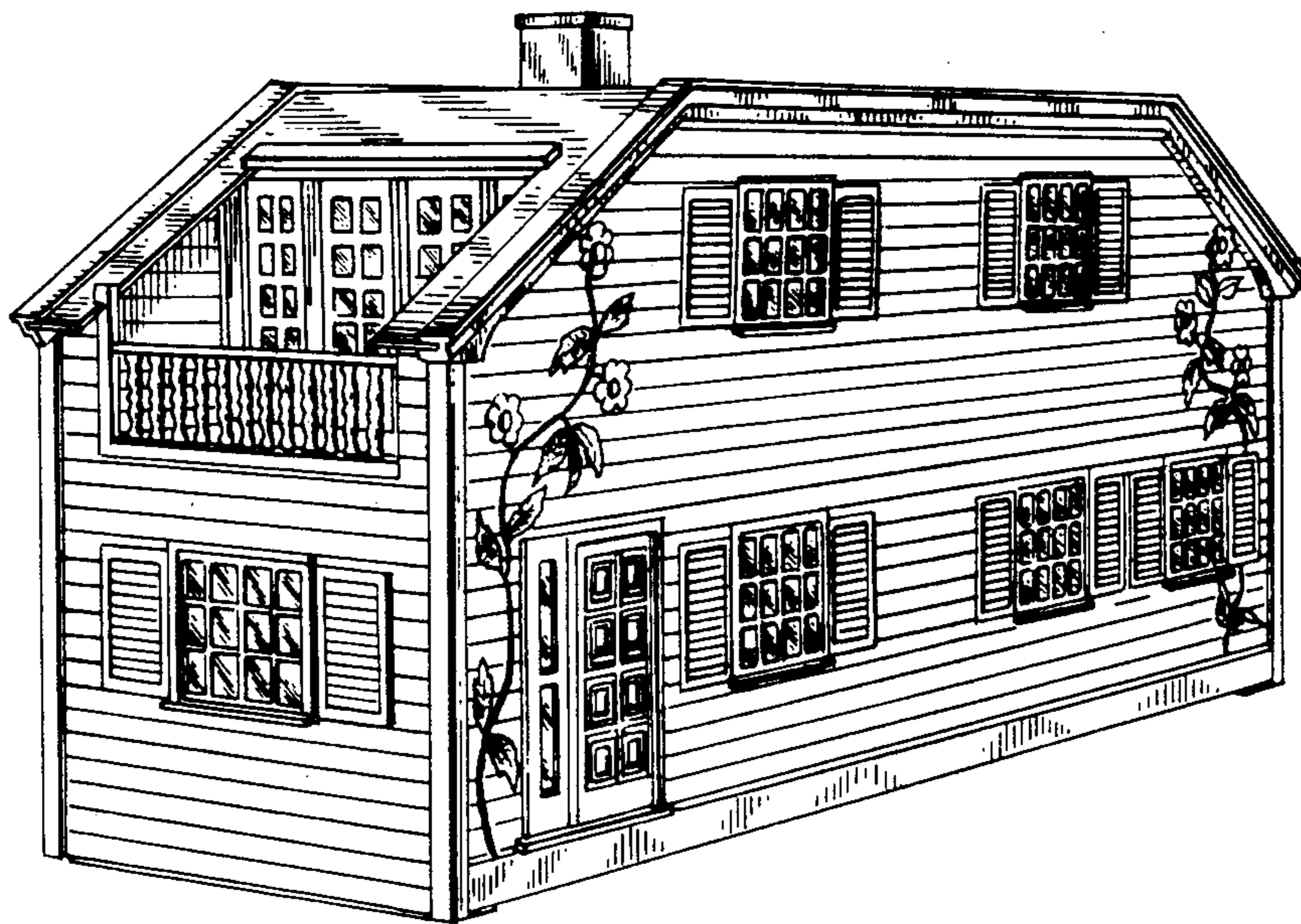

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a toy house showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



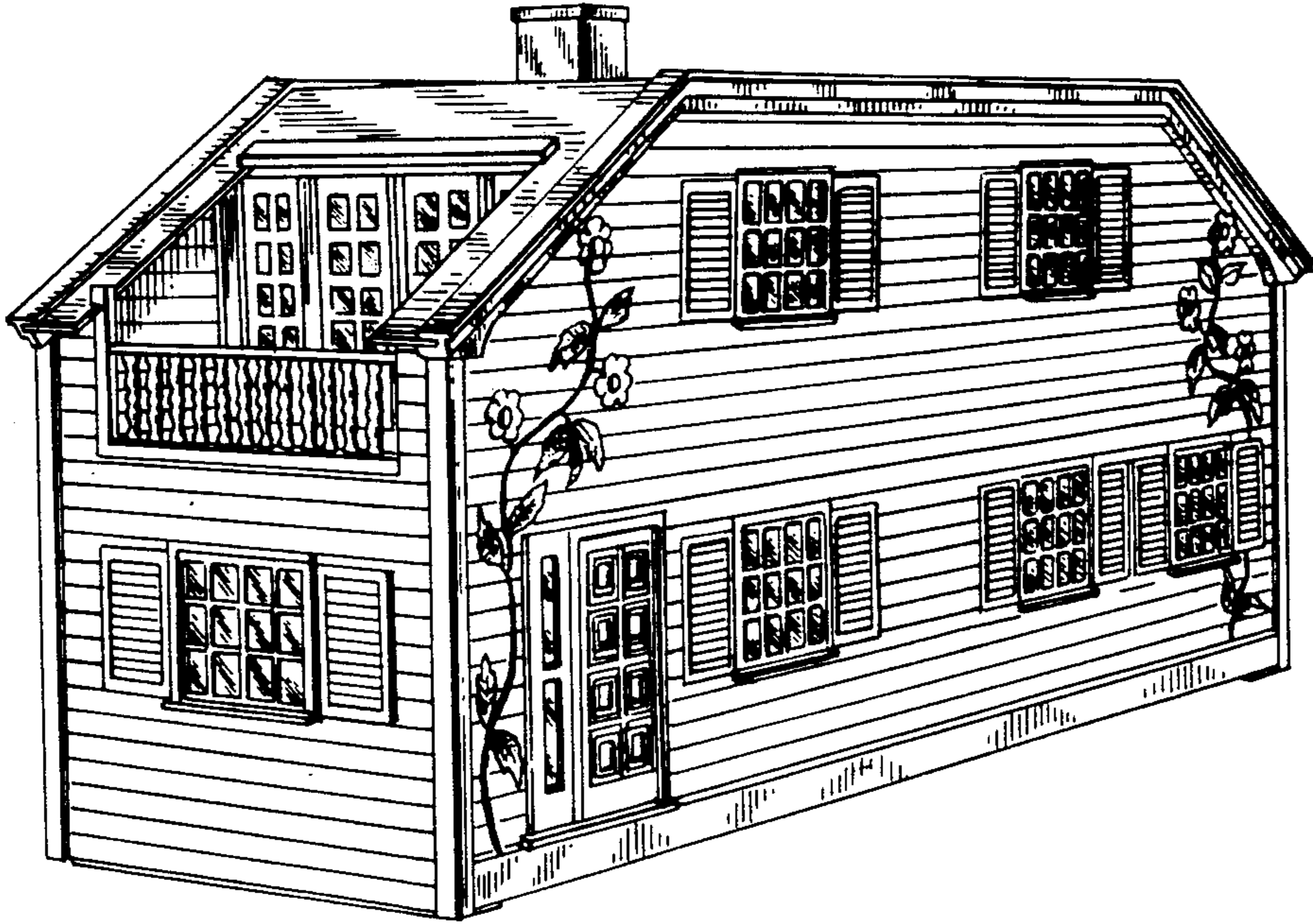

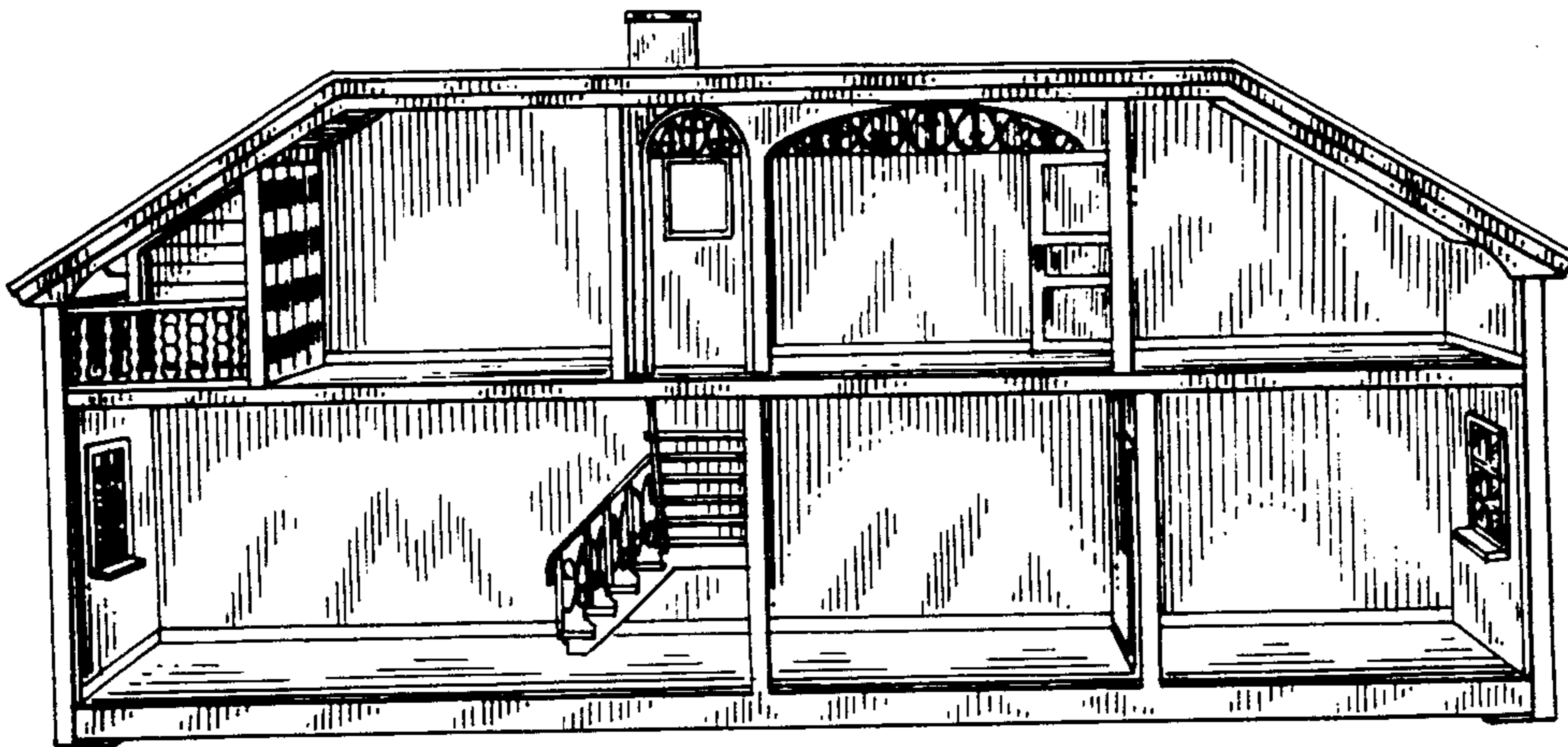

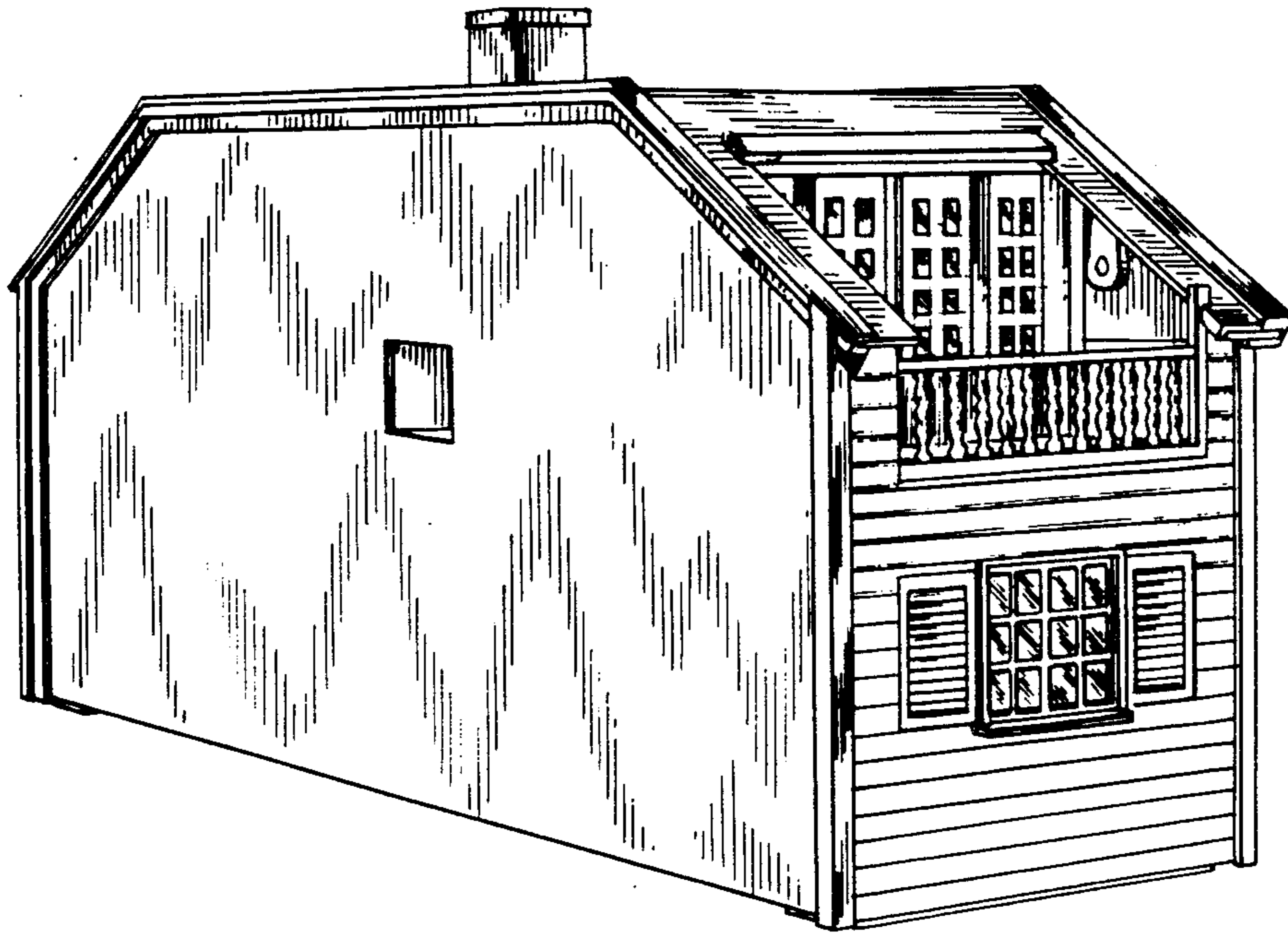

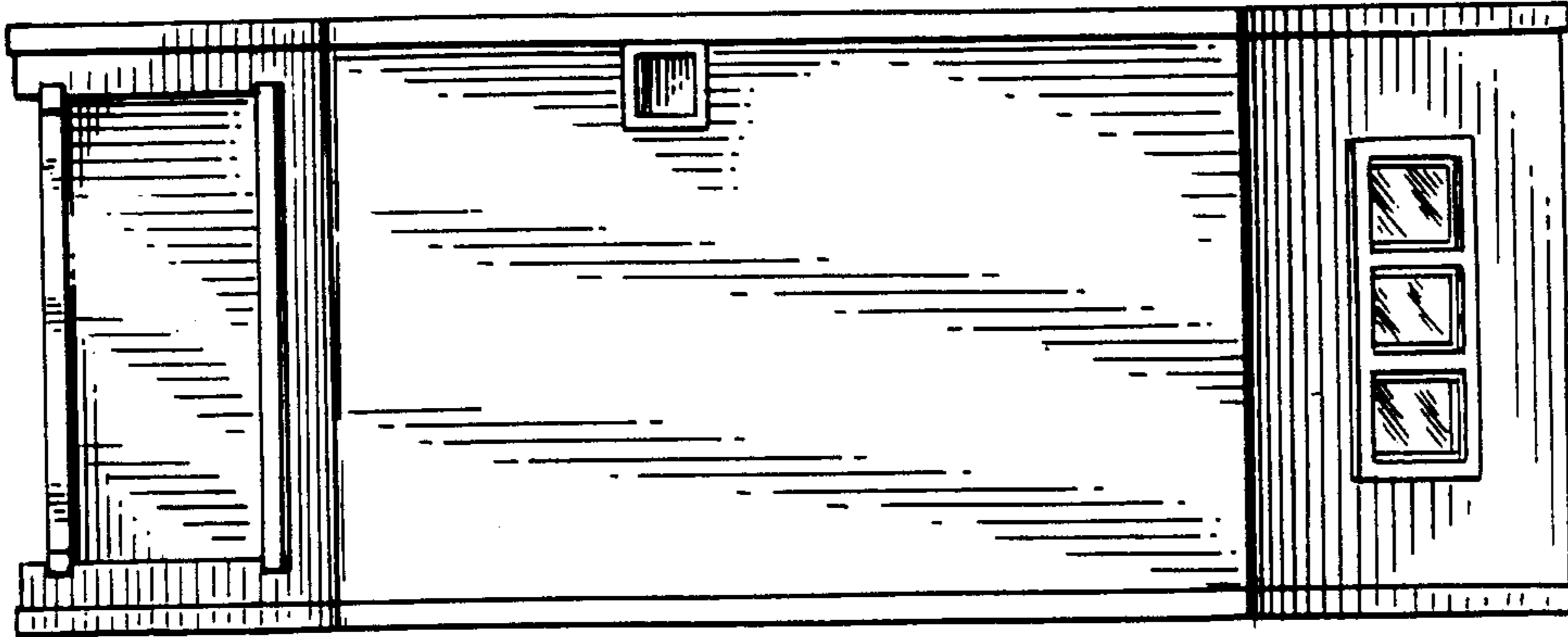
