The ornamental design for a cash cartridge for an automated banking machine, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view showing the front, top, and right side of our new design of a cash cartridge for an automated banking machine.

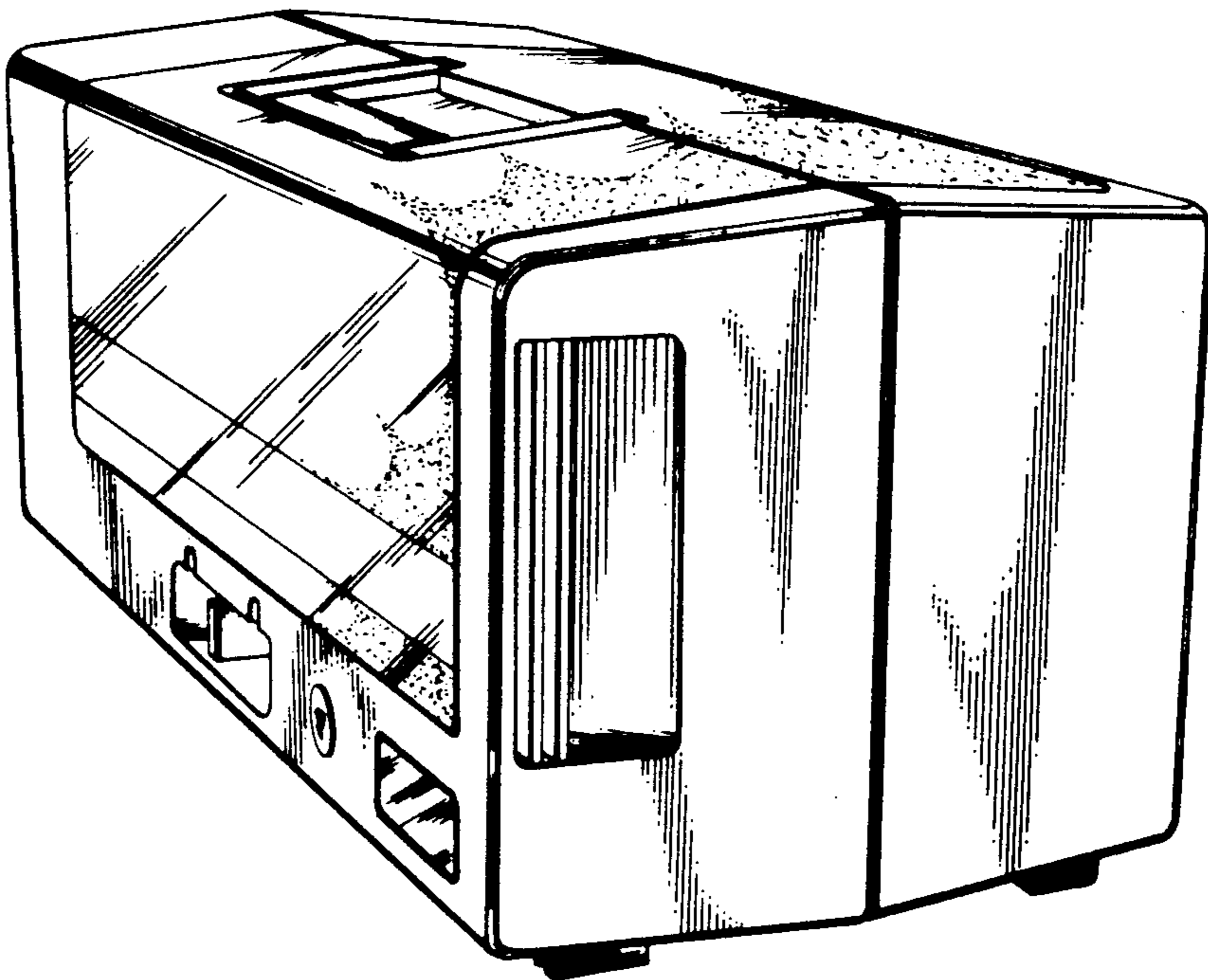
FIG. 2 is a perspective view showing the back and bottom thereof.

The stippling is partially shown on the translucent cover for convenience of the illustration, it being understood that the stippling is continuous over the areas indicated.



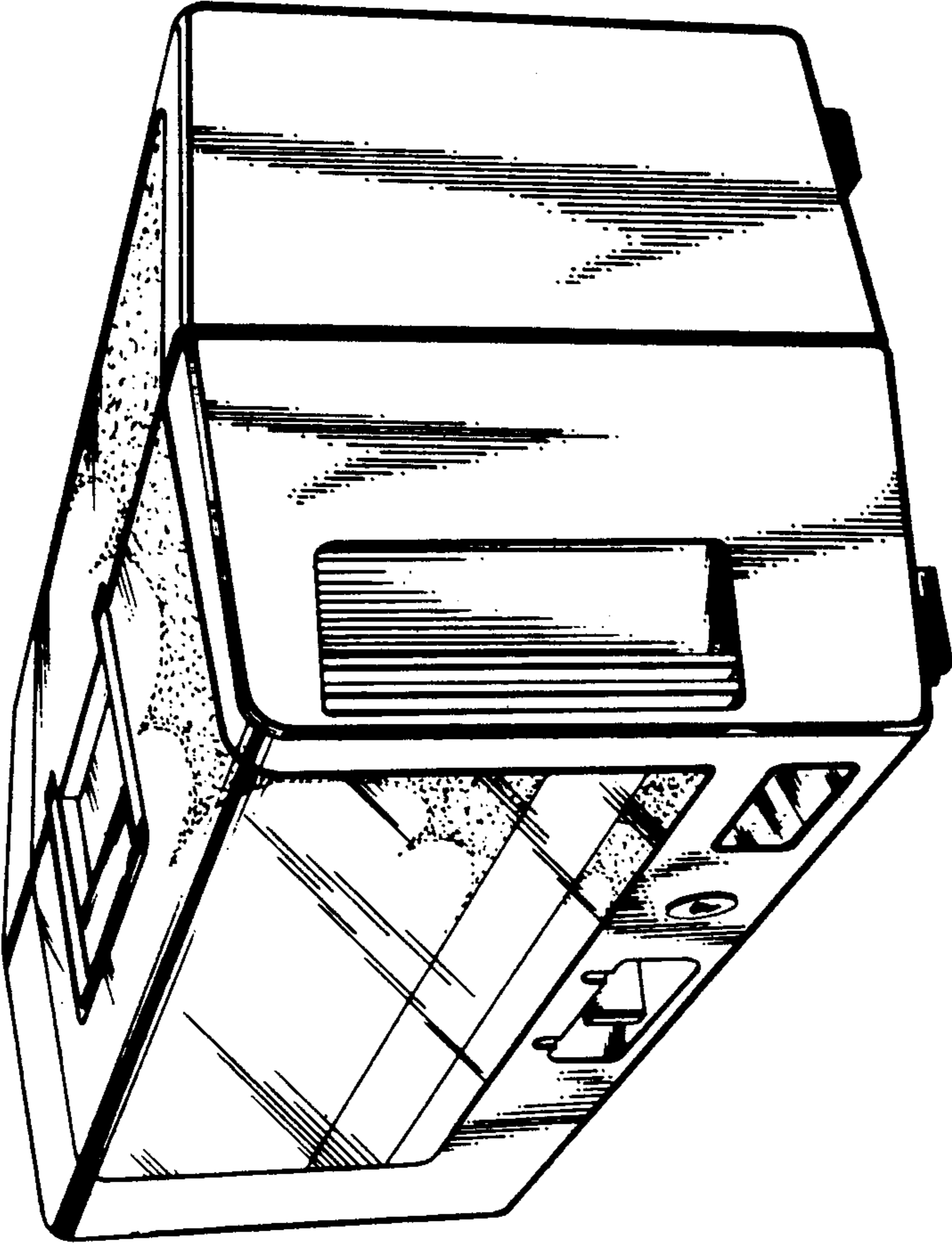

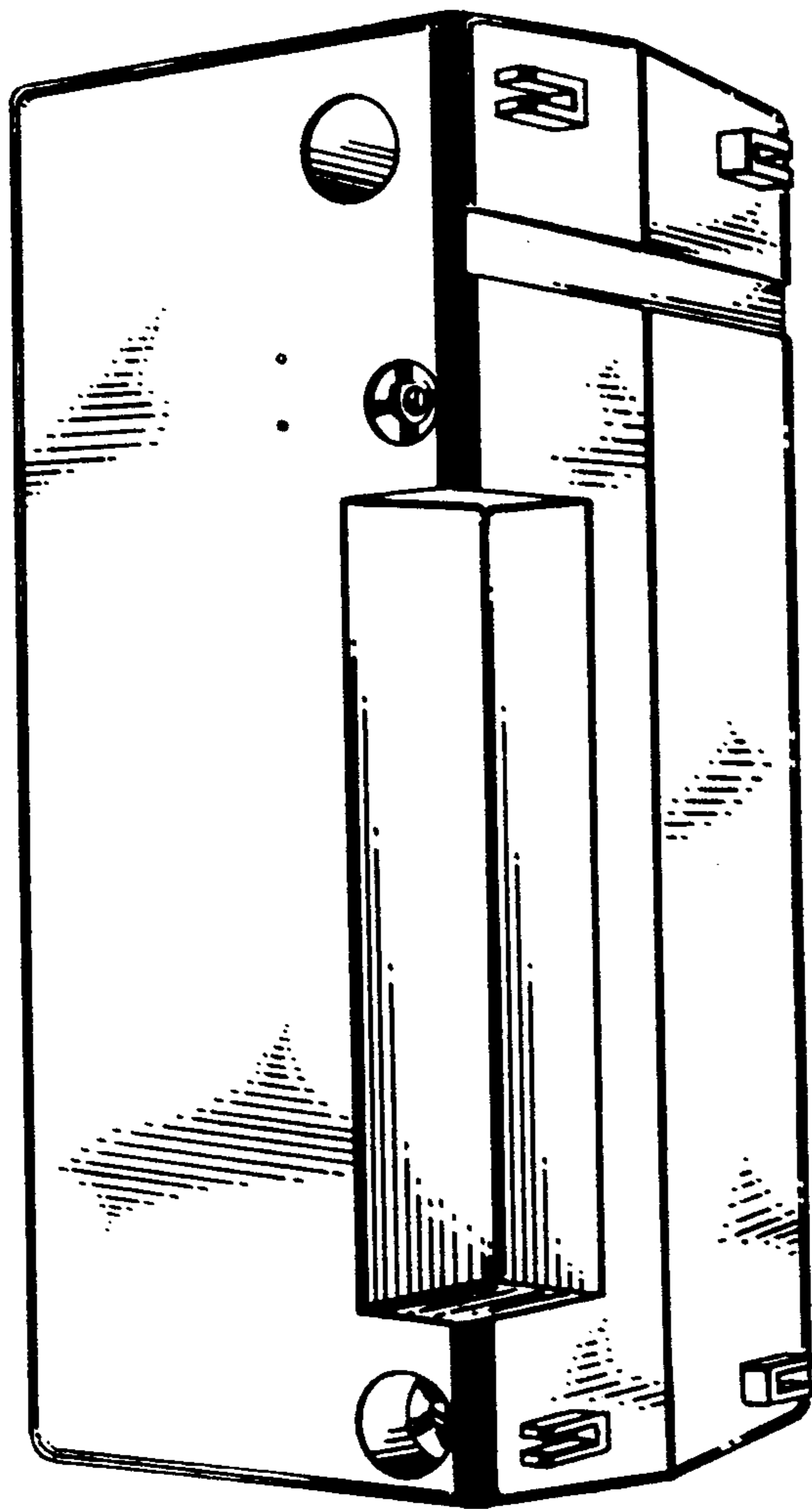

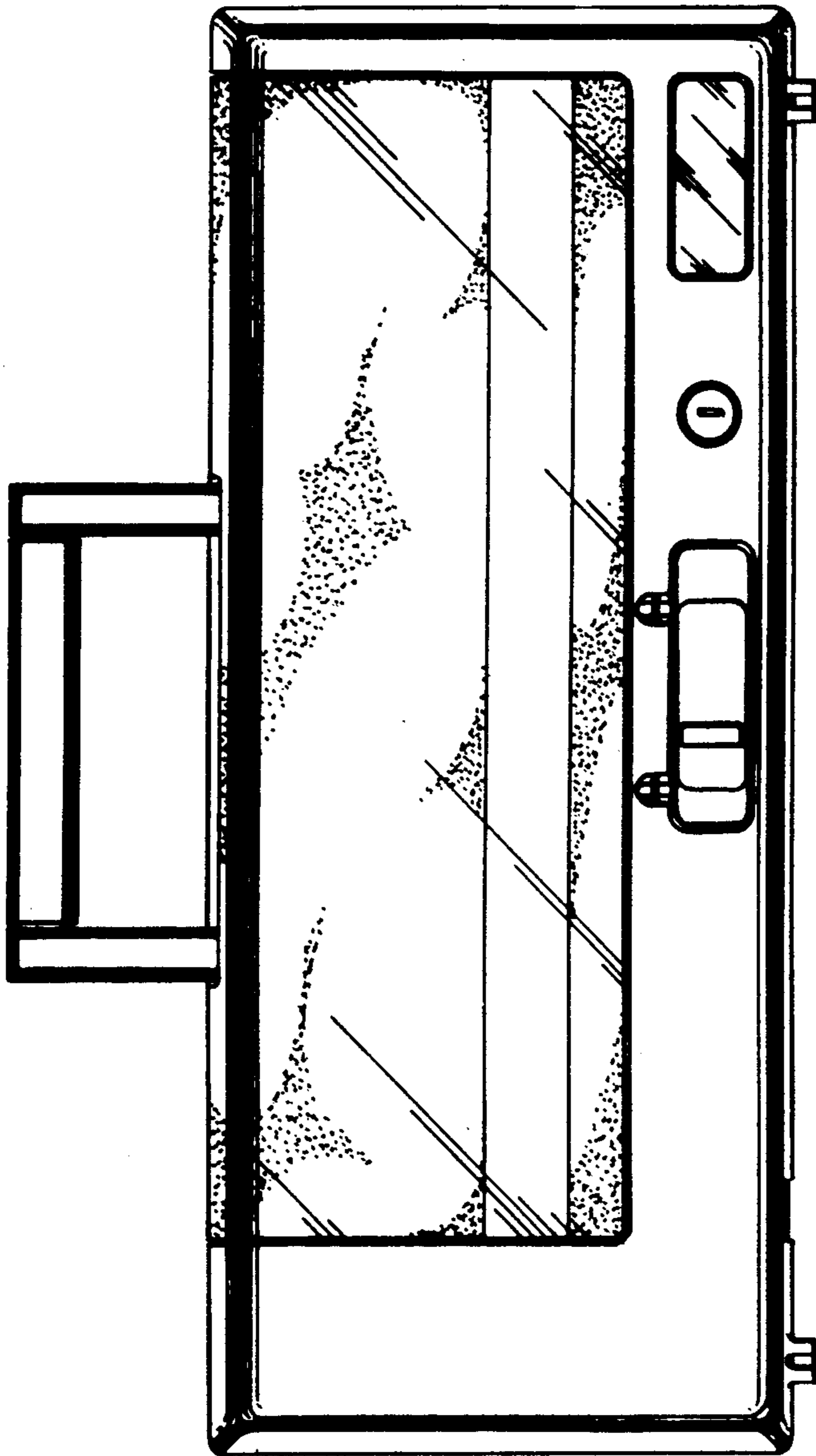

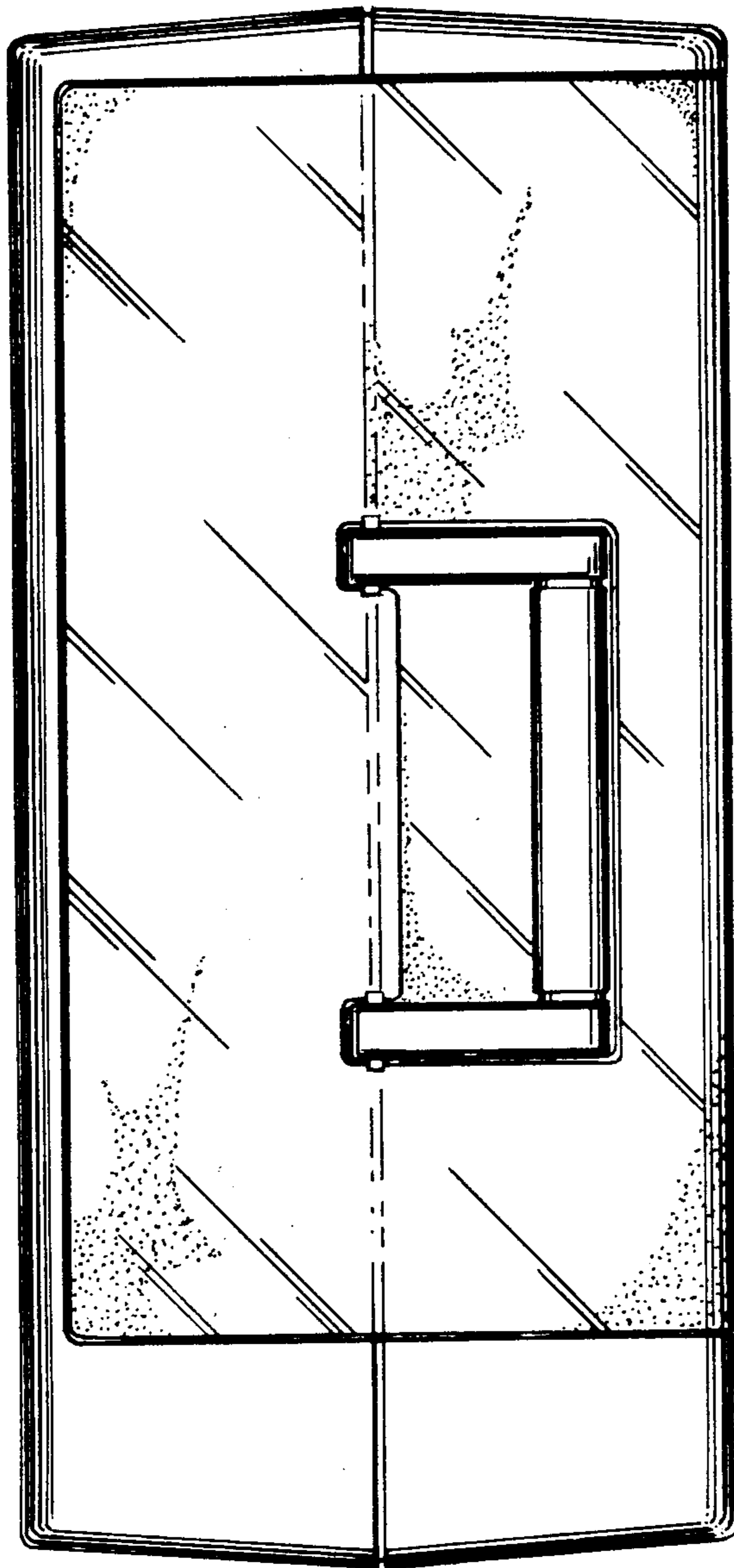

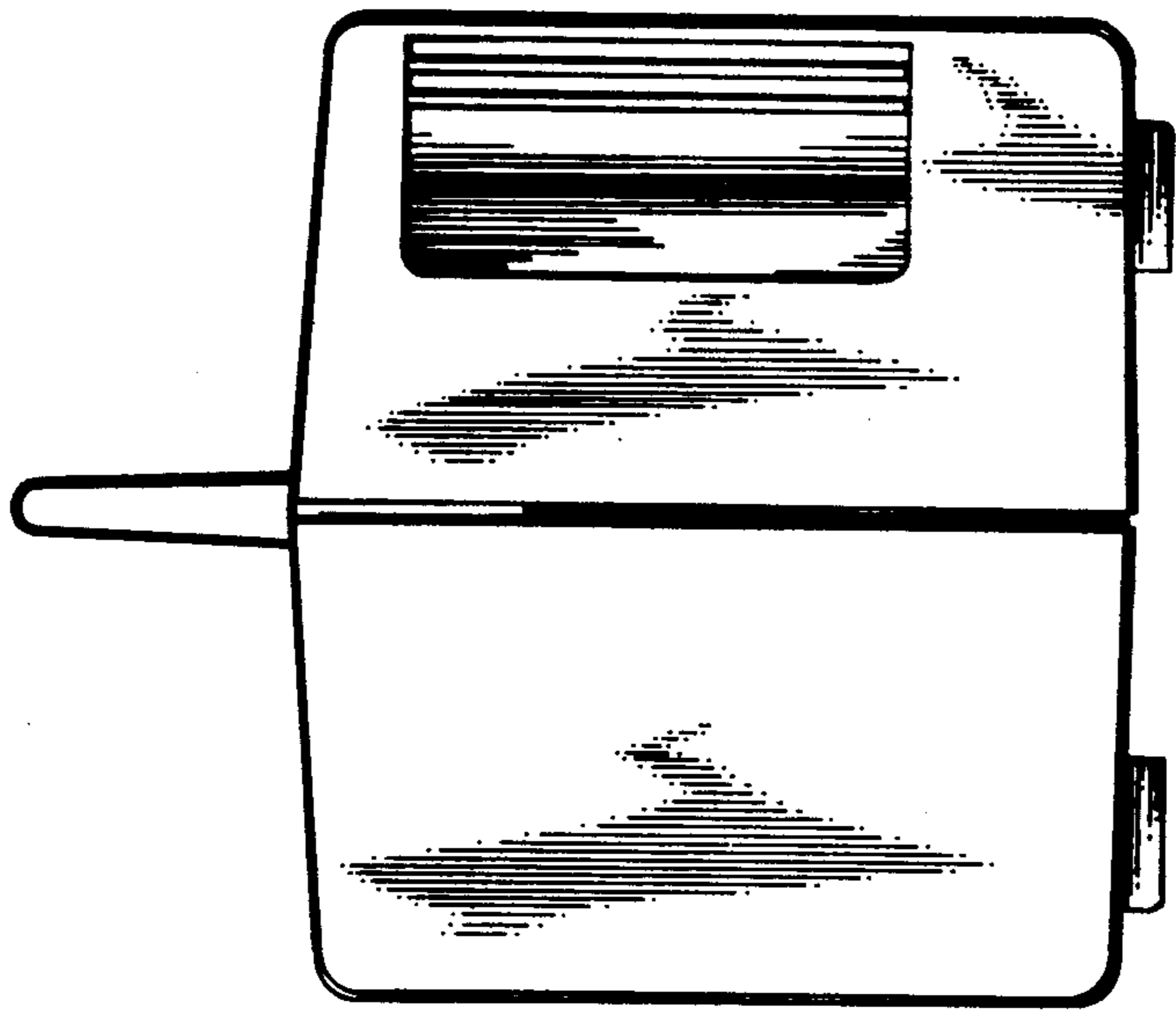
