The ornamental design for a portable infant bed, as shown and described.


DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view showing the invention prior to final folding and fastening of the side laces.


FIG. 2 is a bottom view showing the invention prior to final folding and fastening of the side laces.

FIG. 3 is a top view showing the invention after final folding and fastening of the side laces.


FIG. 4 is a side view showing the invention after final folding and fastening of the side laces and with the decorative top ruffles raised to expose the position and method of fastening of the side laces.






