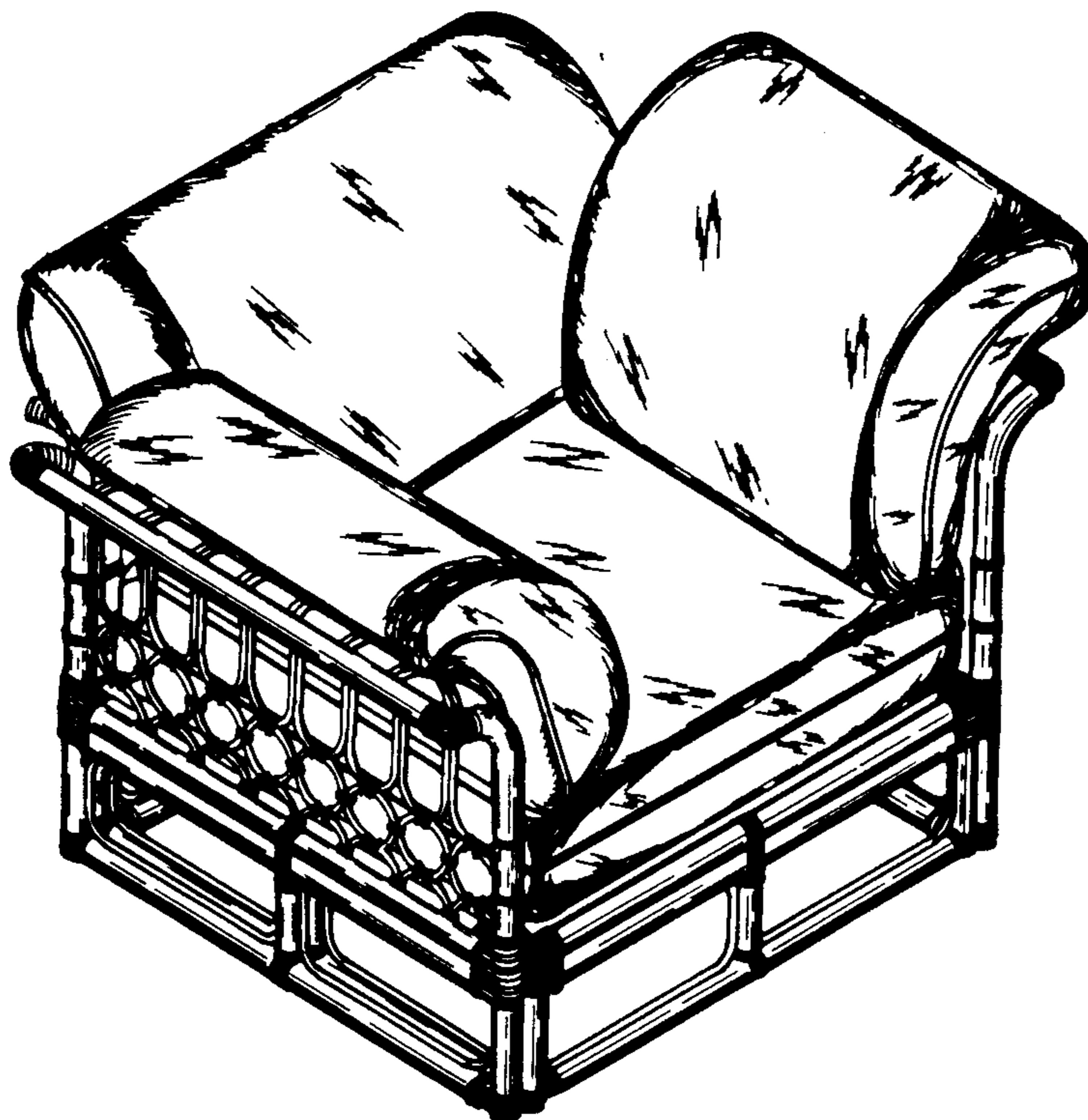

The side of the chair not shown is a mirror image of the side shown.



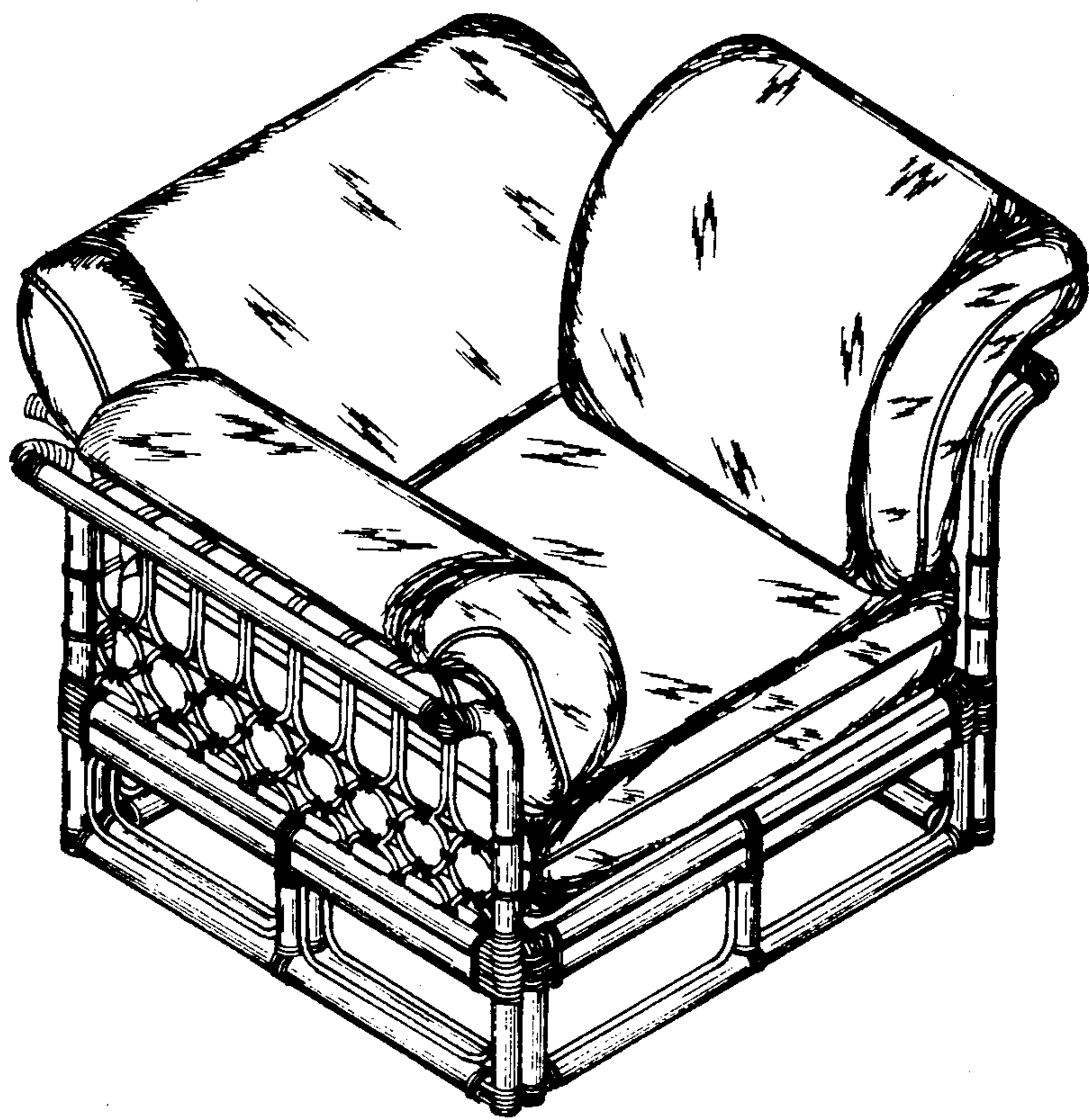

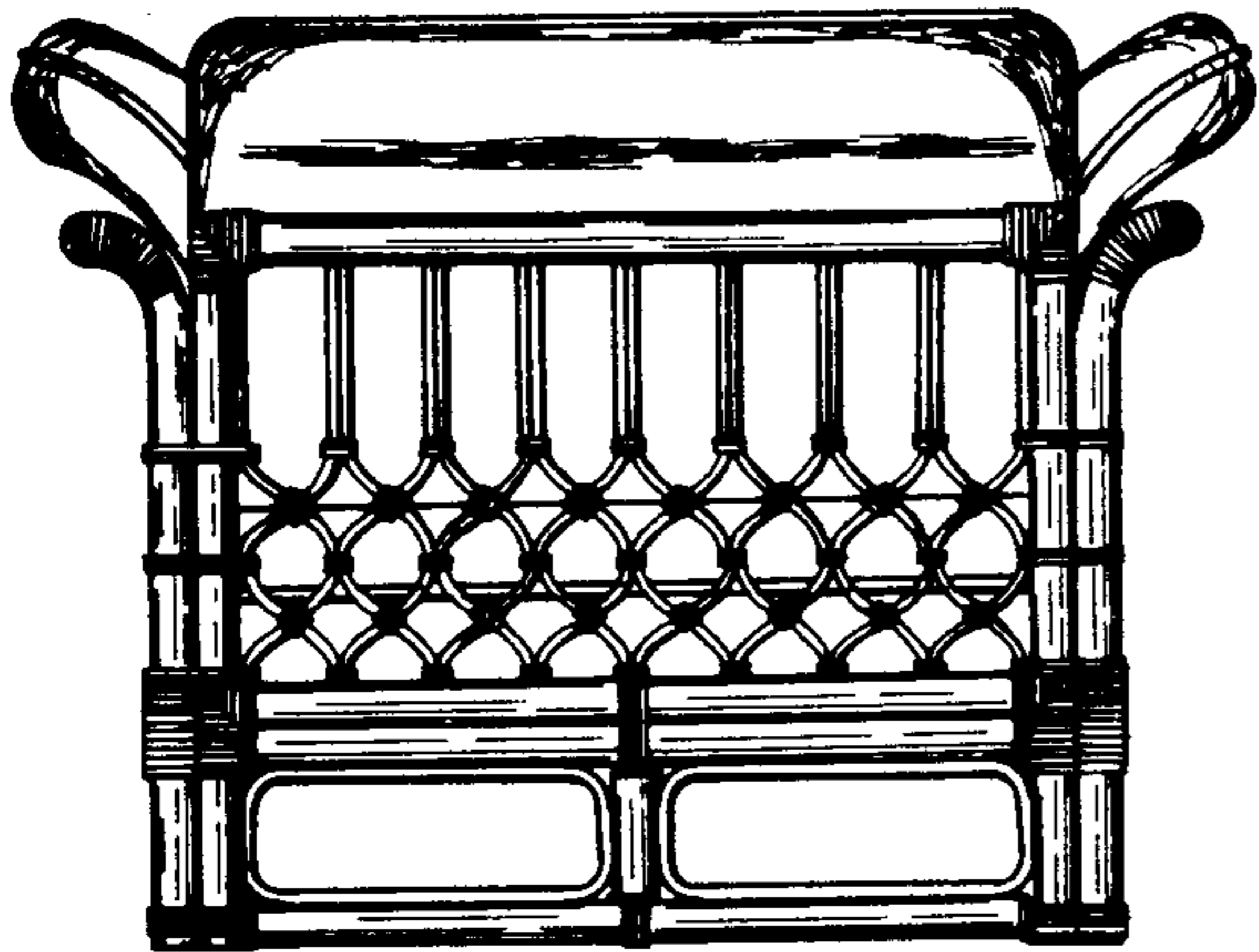
