tially planar and unornamented.

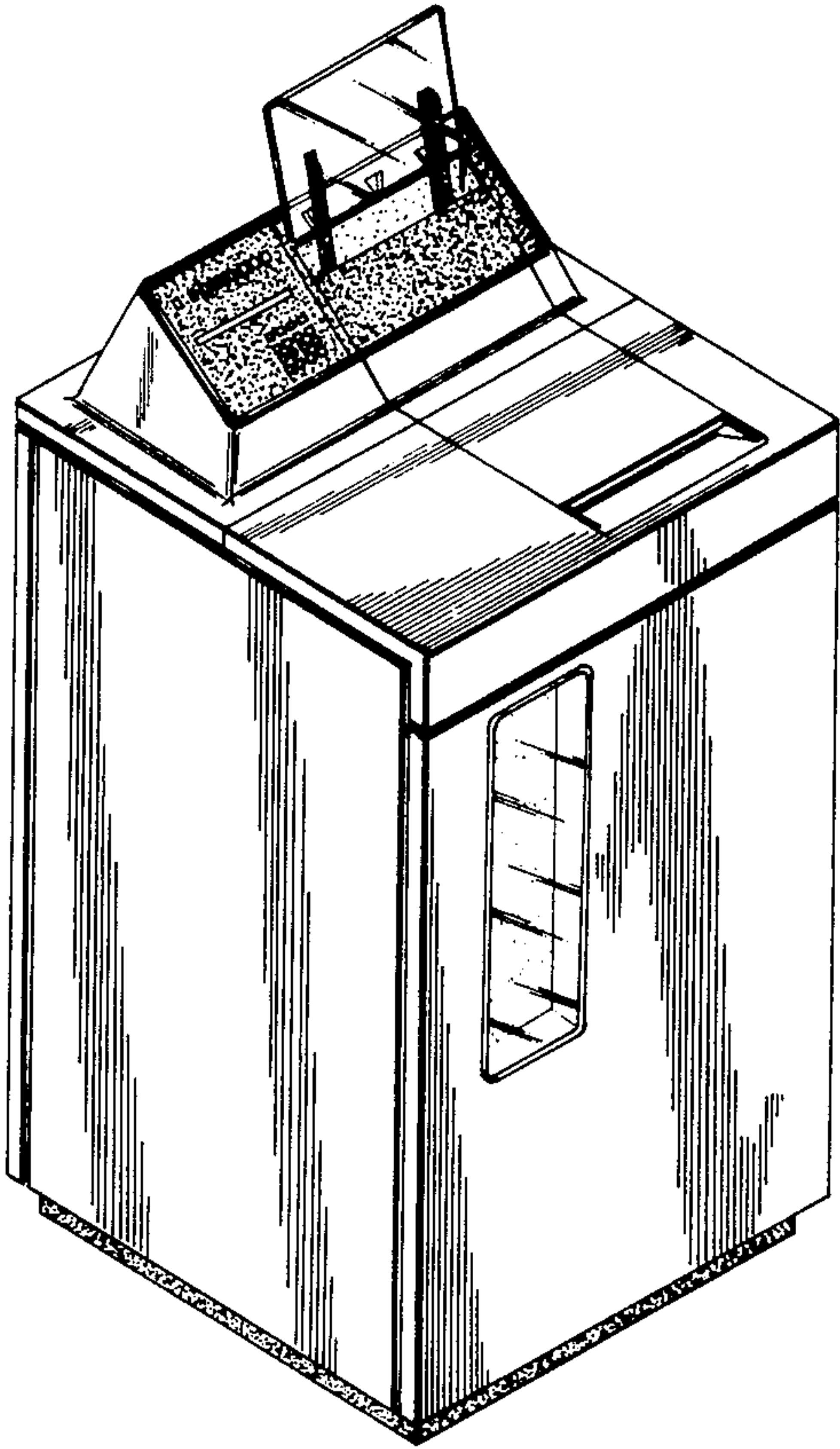

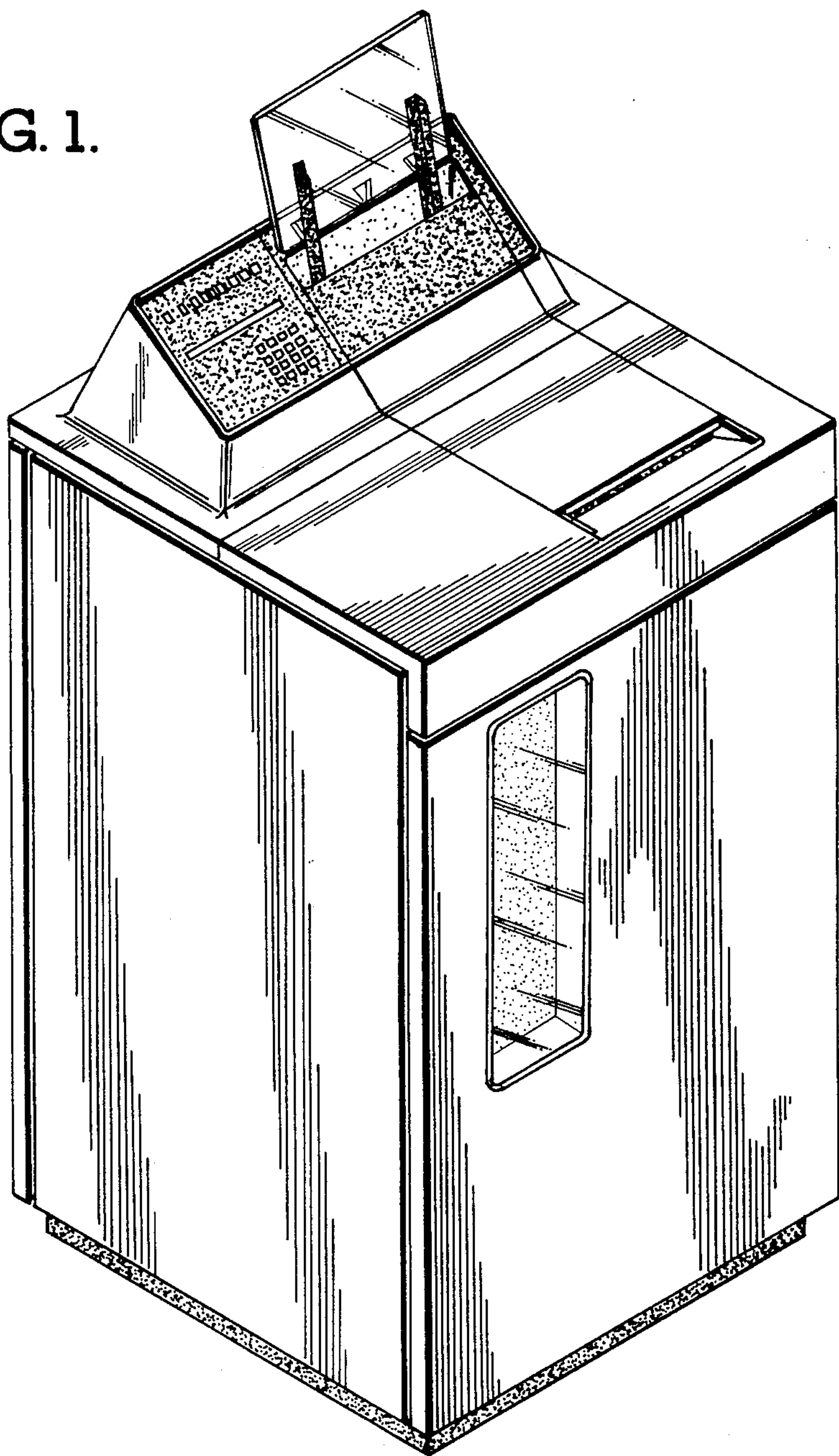
