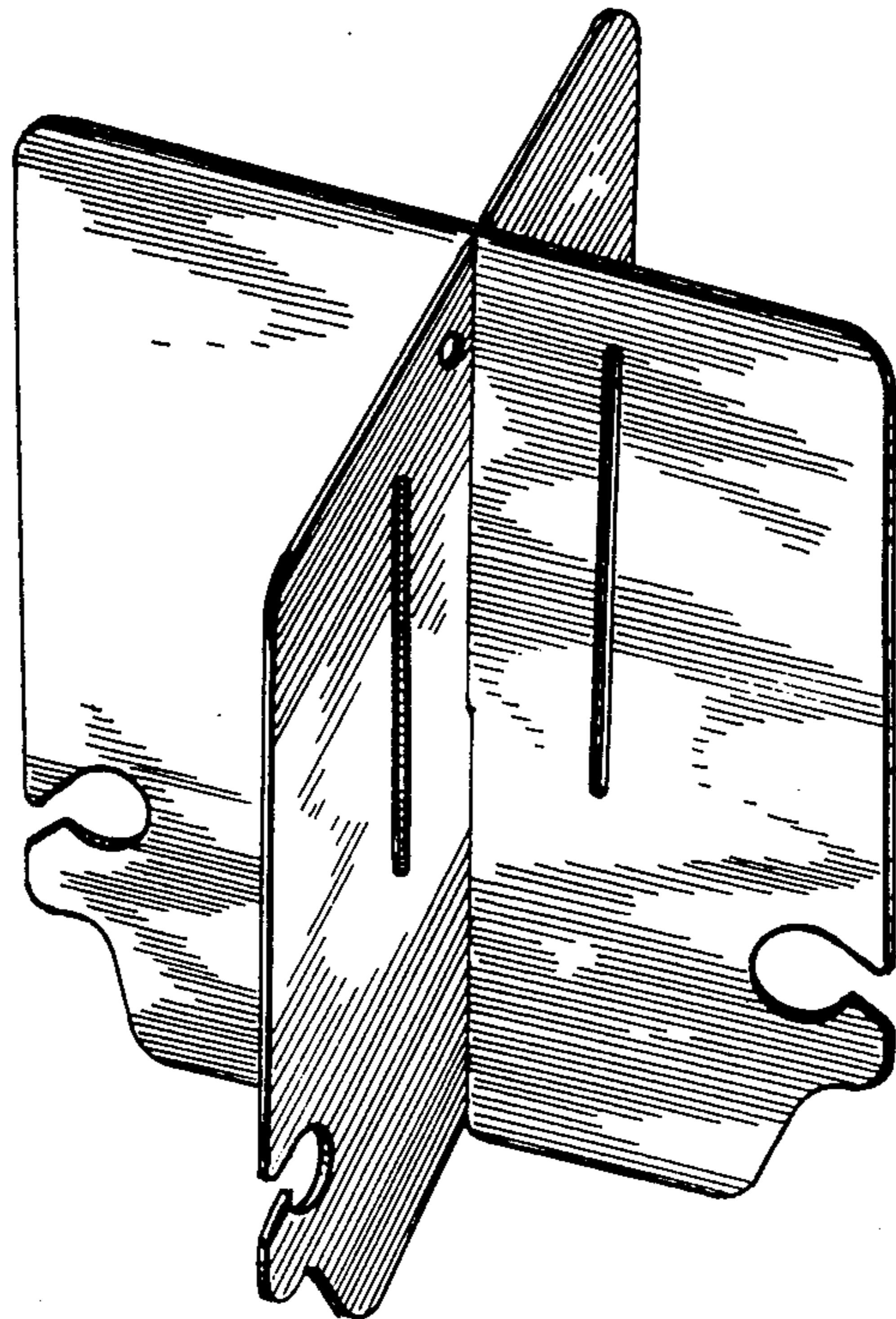

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the other mating support member.



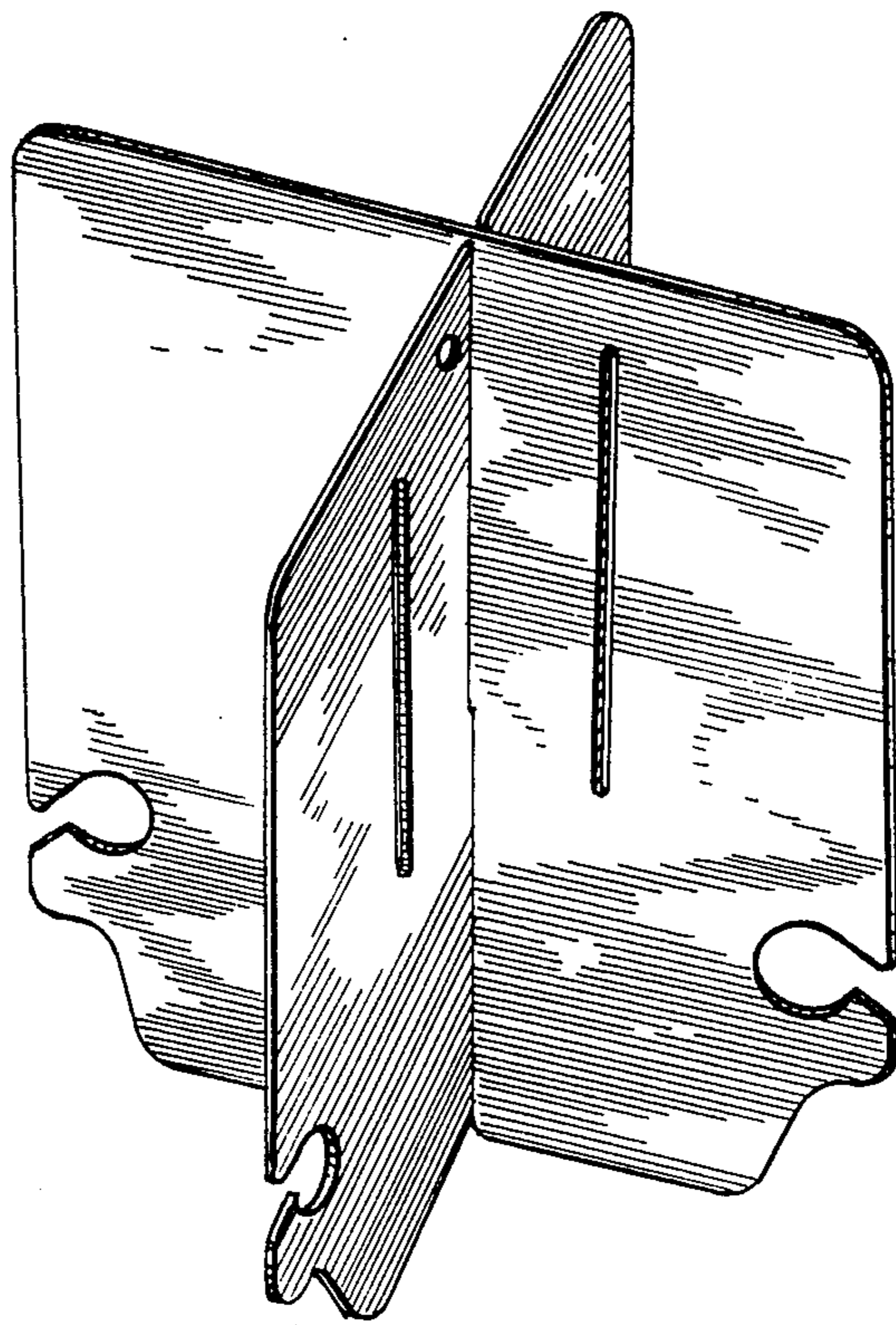
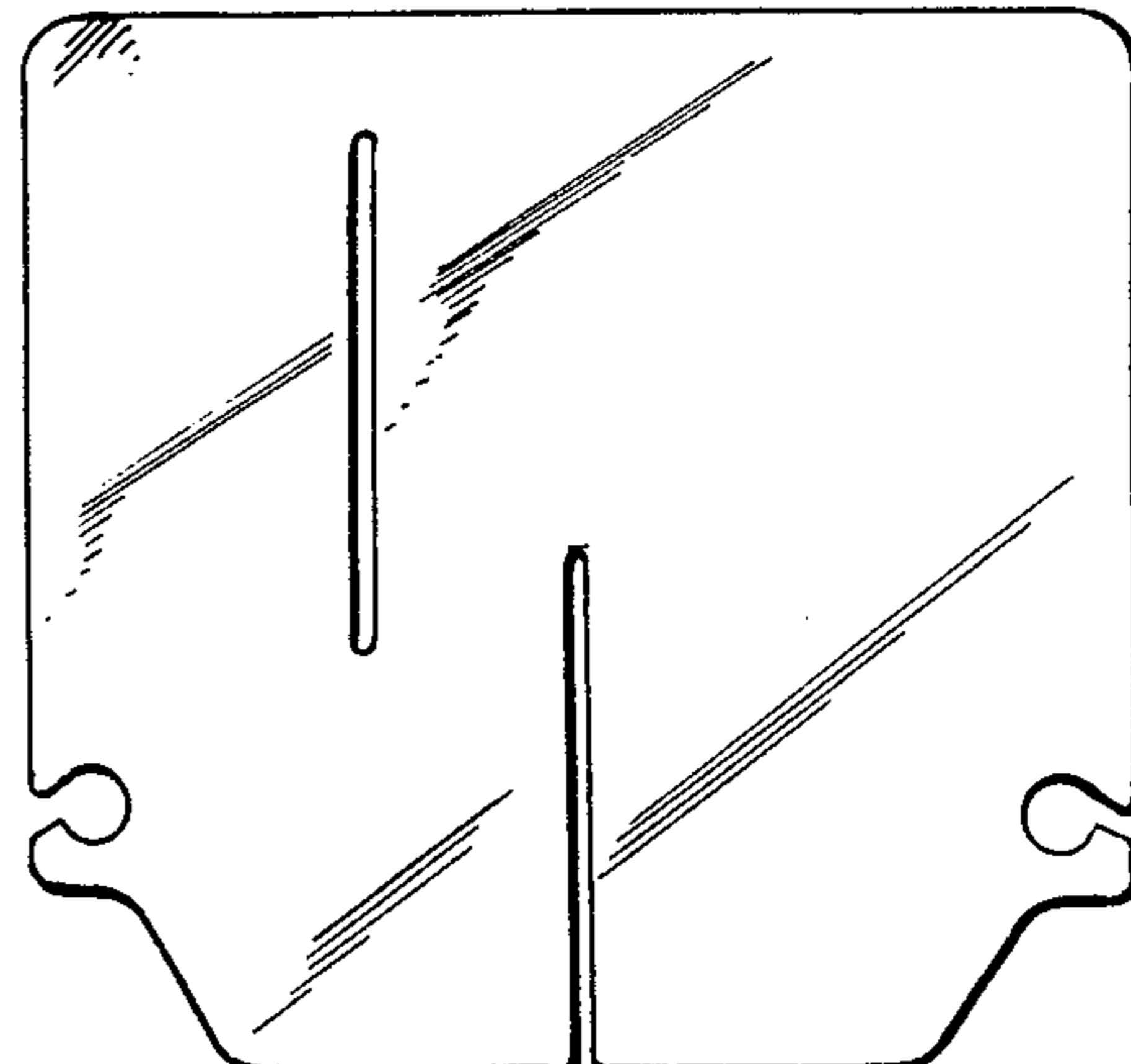
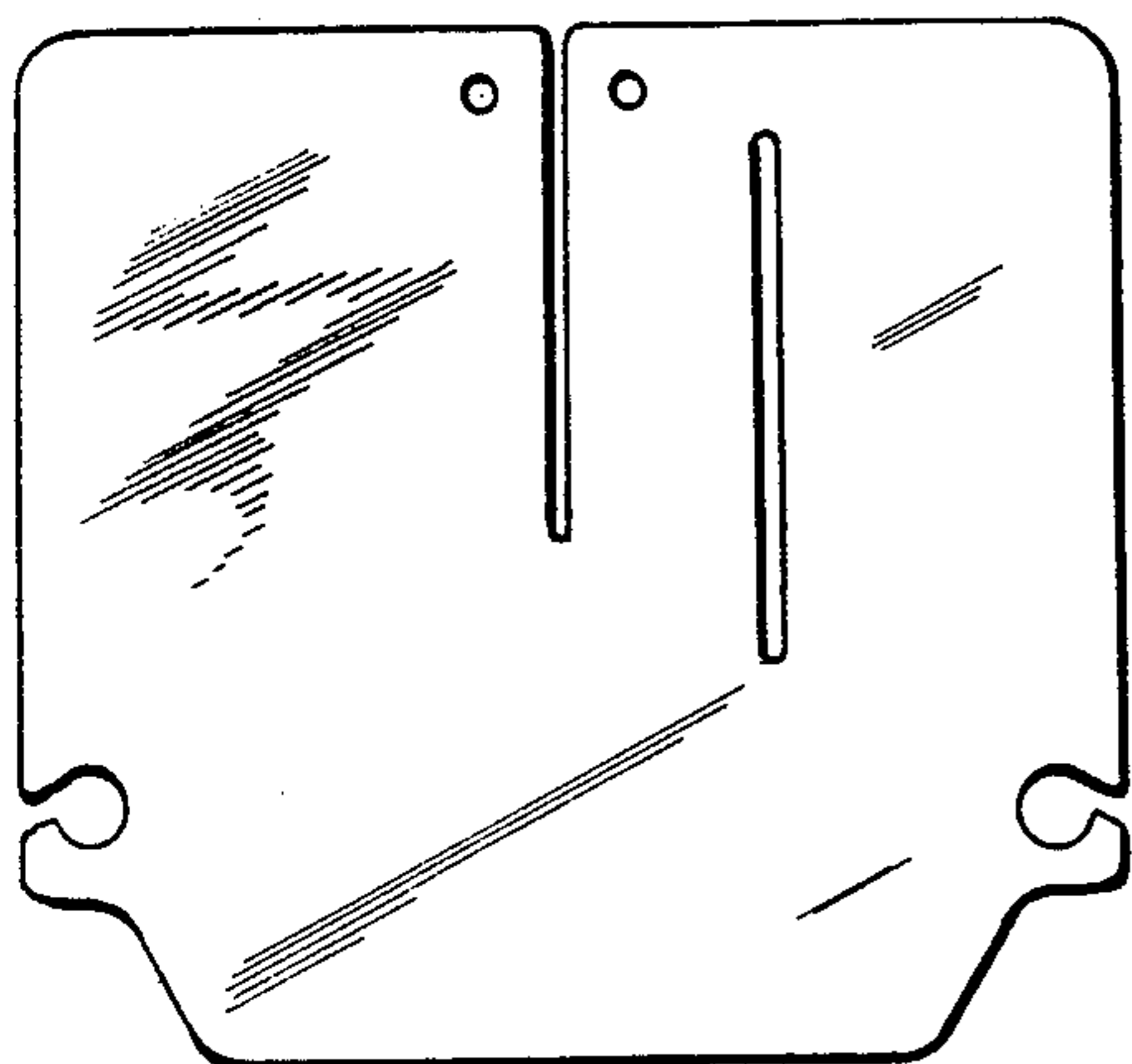
