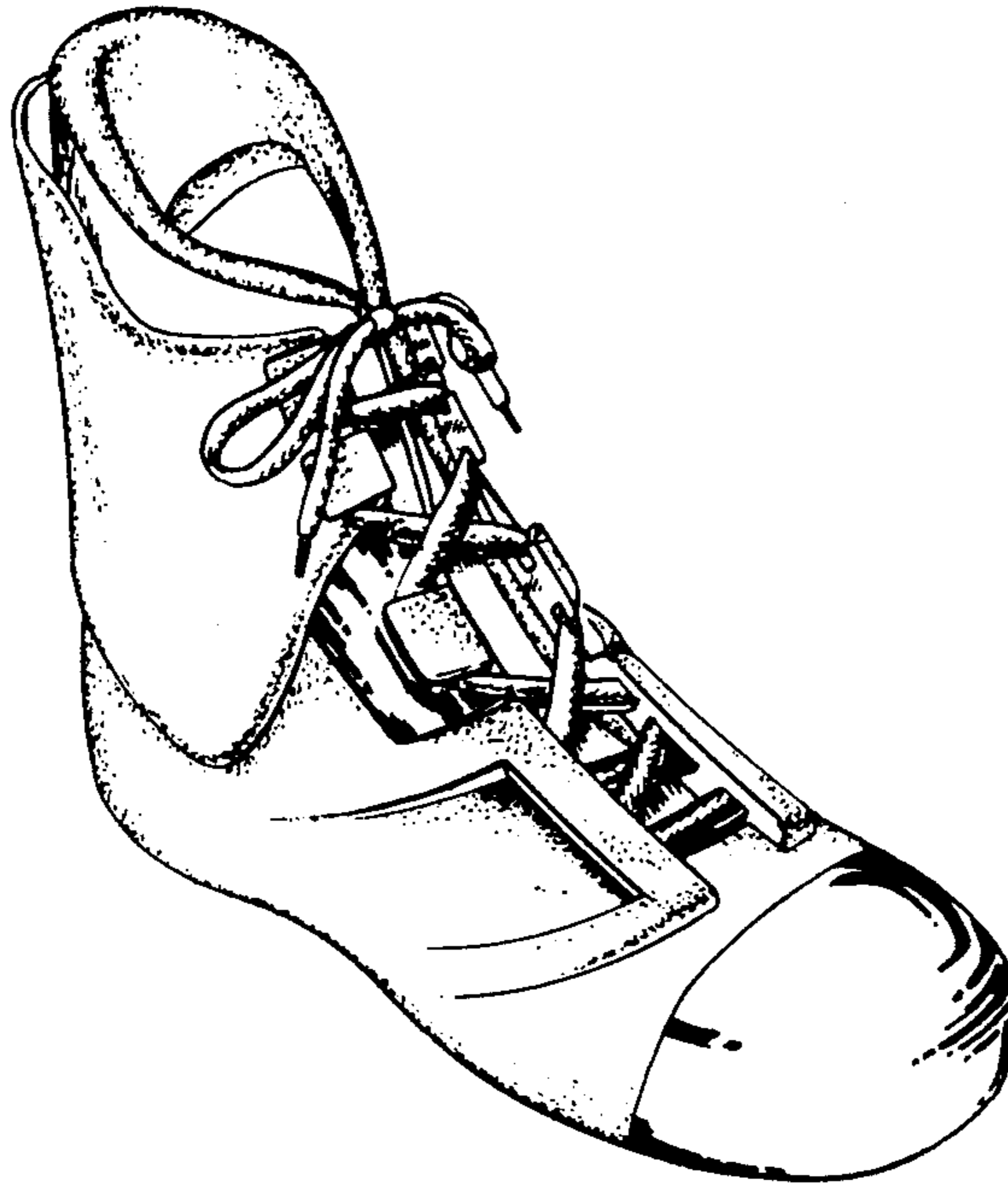

The ornamental design for a skate boot or the like, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left front perspective view of a skate boot or the like, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a right front perspective view thereof; and FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof. The bottom, now shown, is substantially plain and unornamented.



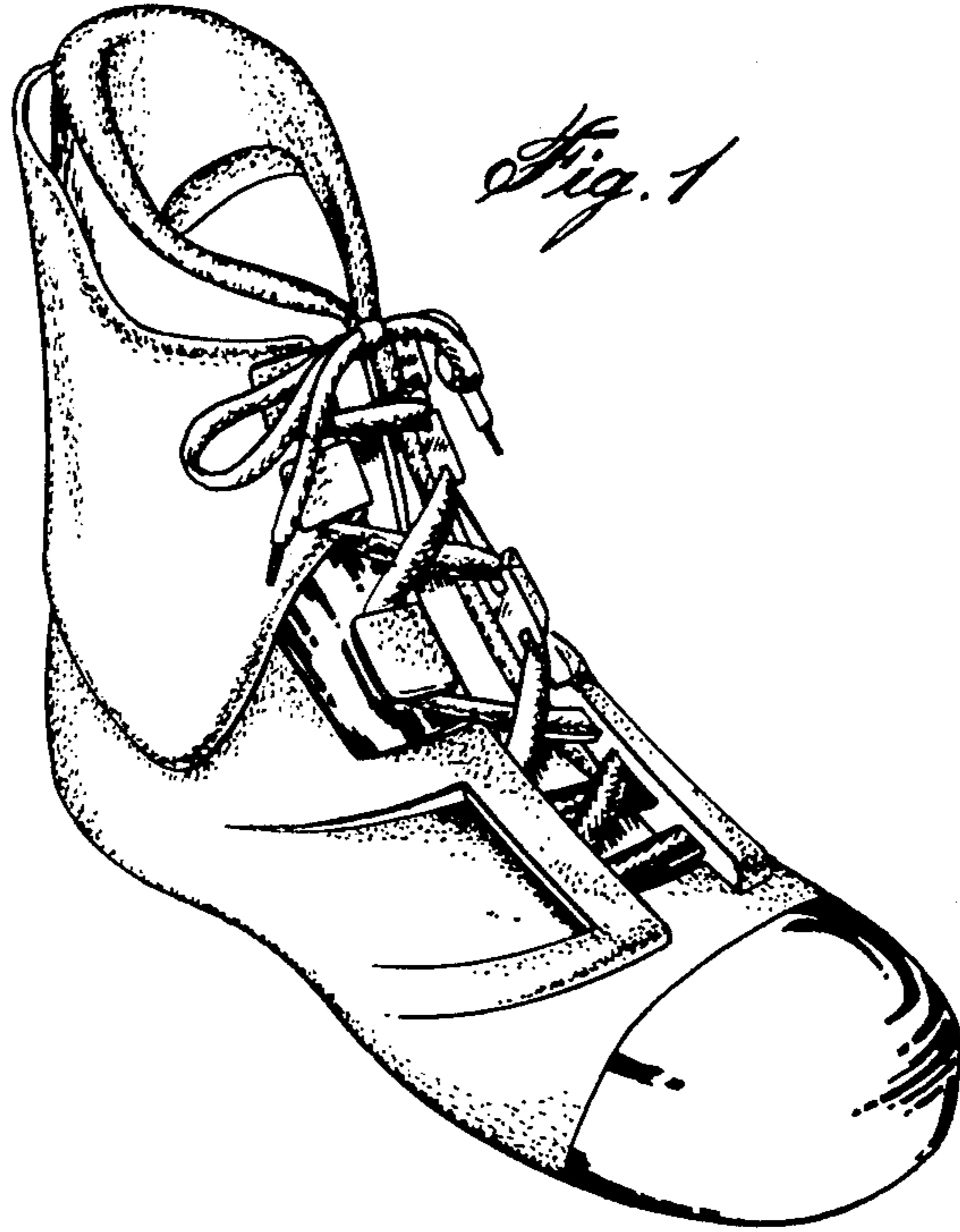

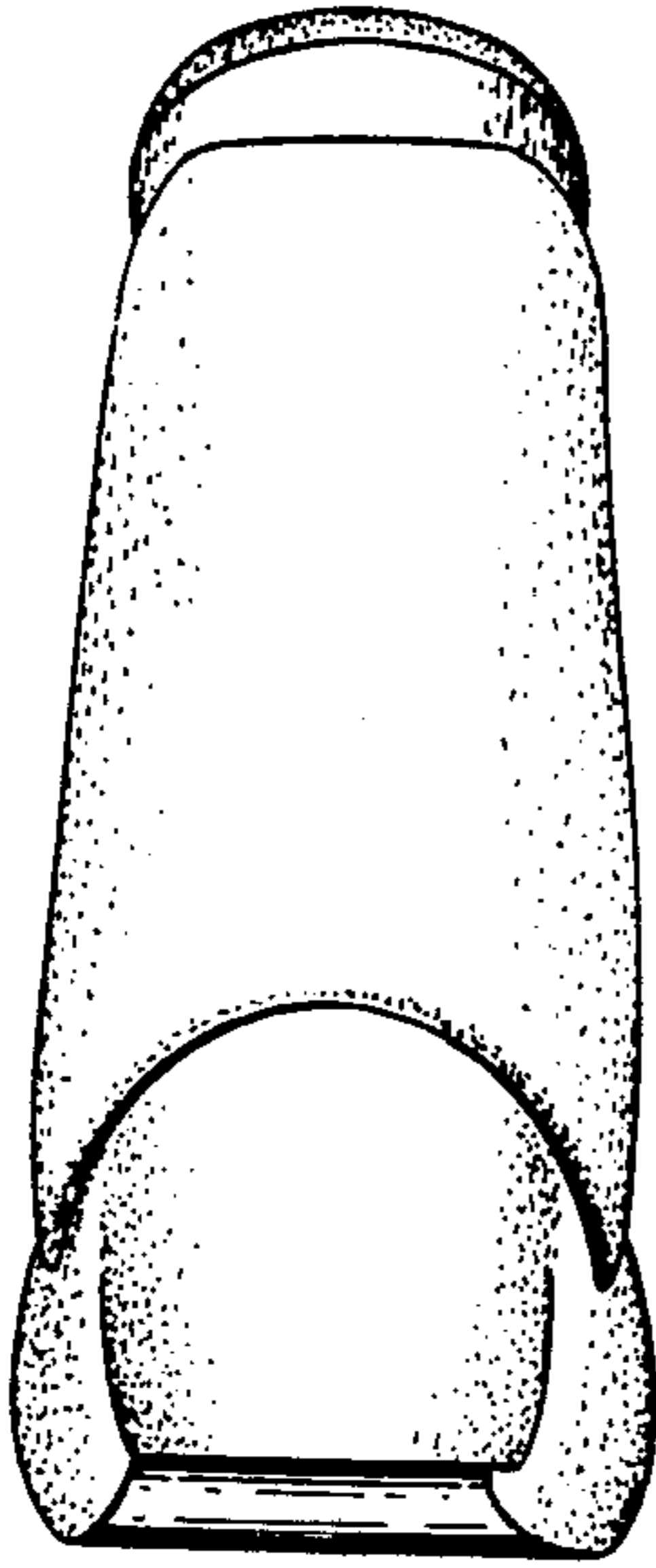

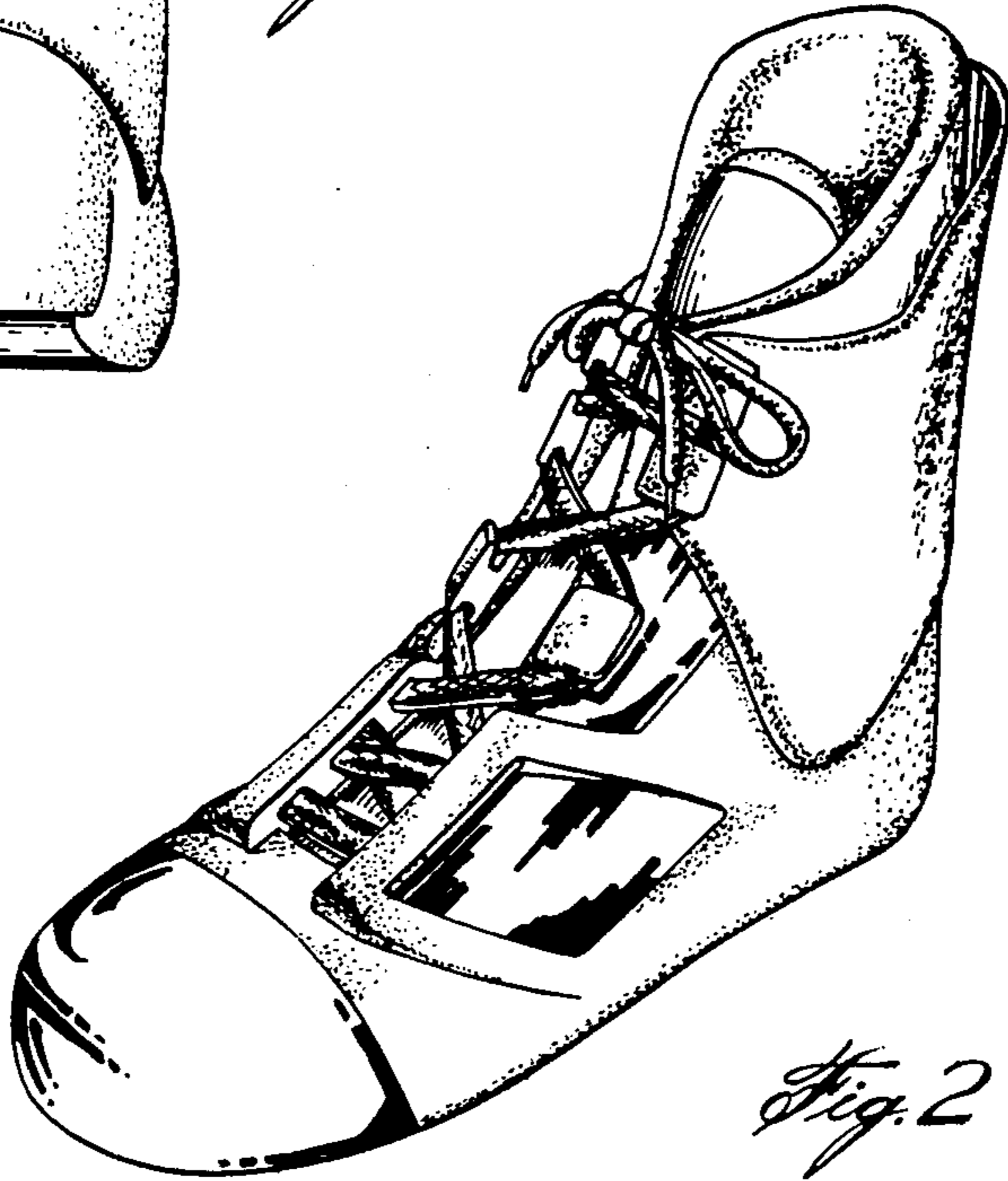
