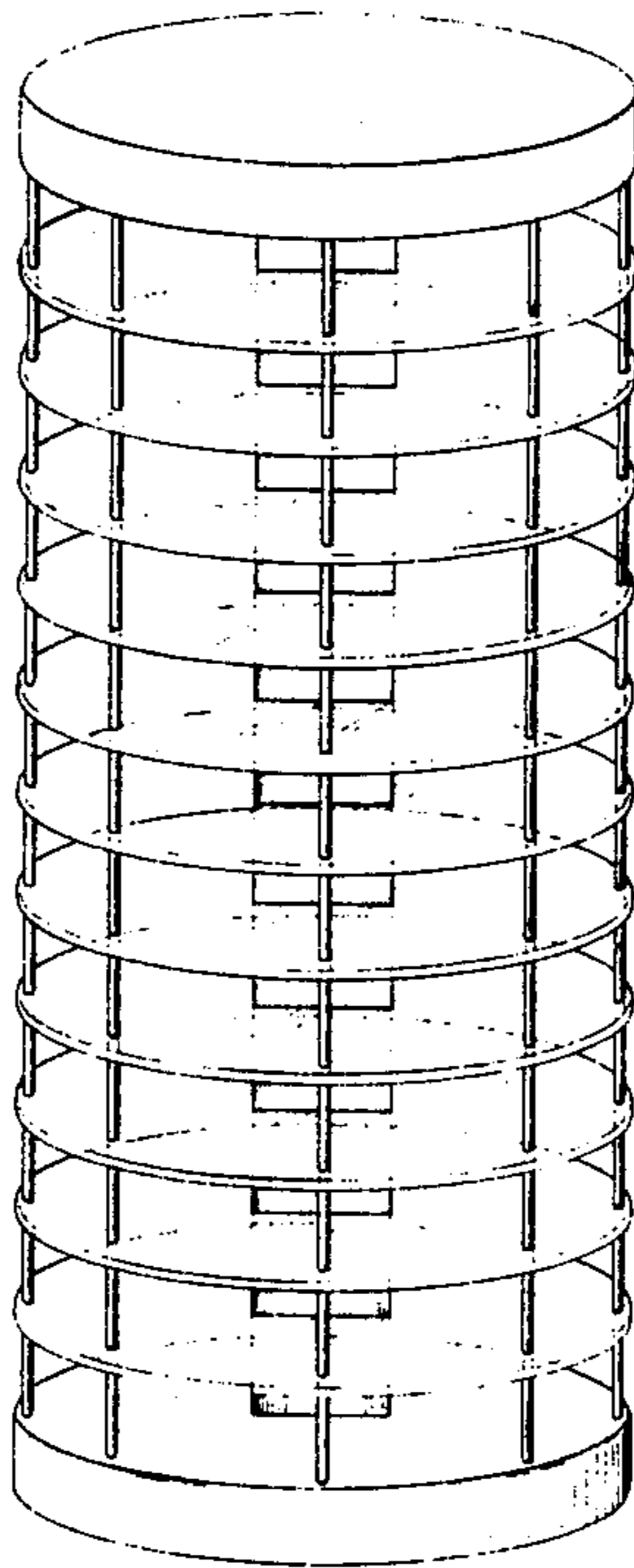

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a rotatable merchandise display stand, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a rotatable merchandise display stand showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a top plan view of FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken in the direction of the arrows on line 4-4 of FIG. 2; and FIG. 5 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the design of FIG. 1, the only difference being the use of wood.



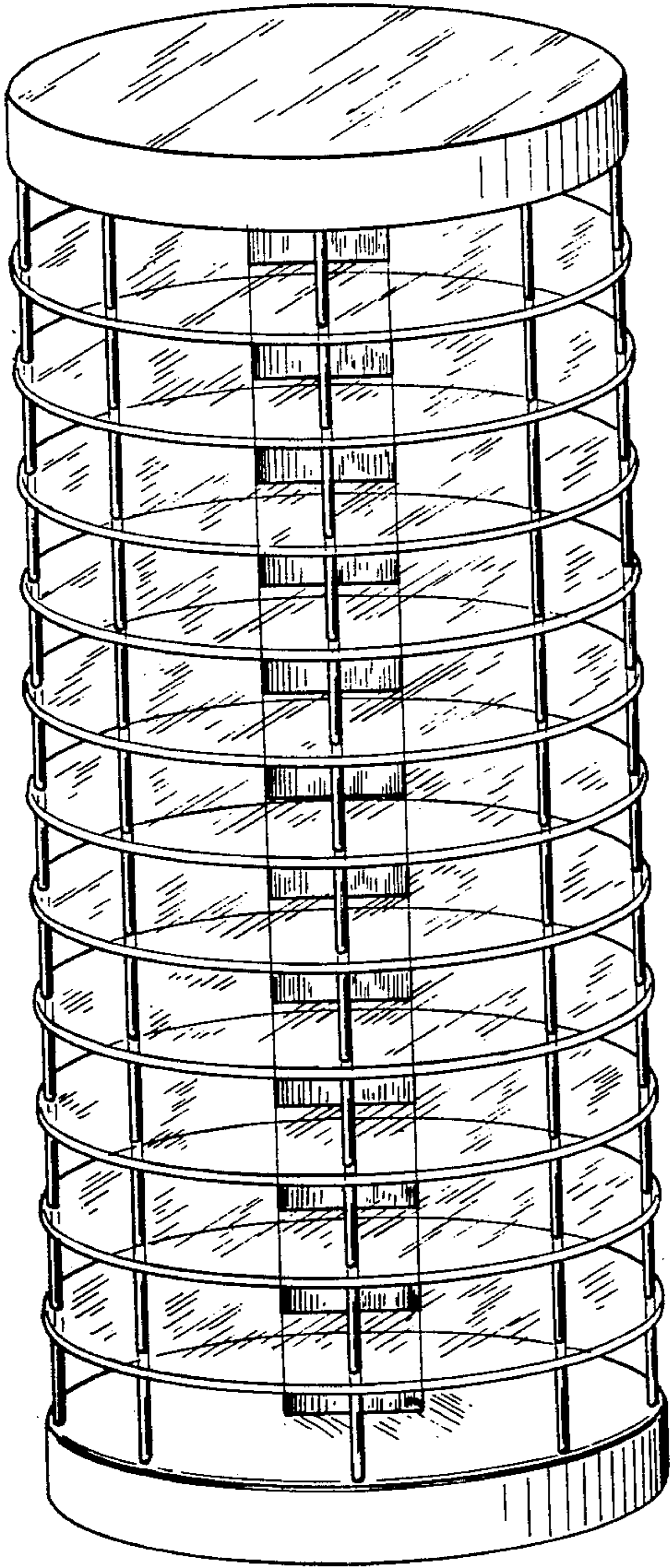

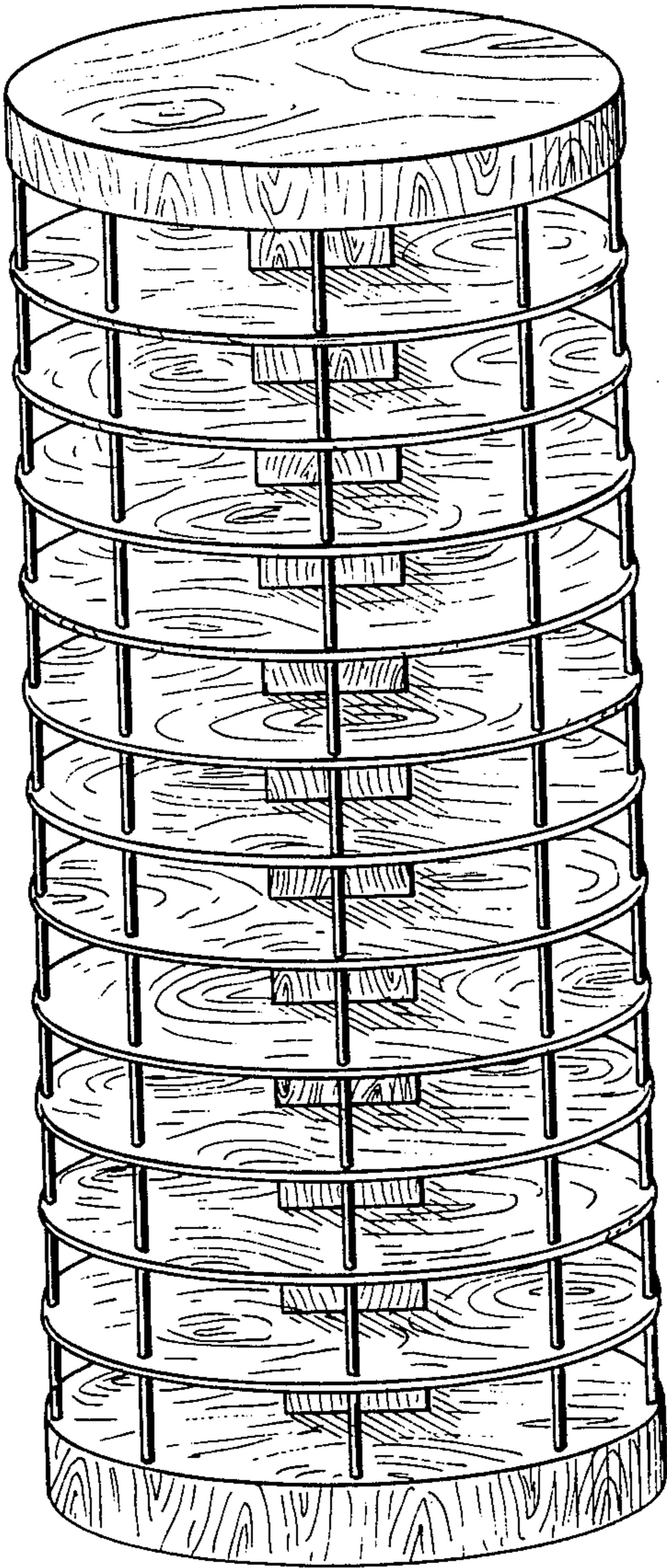

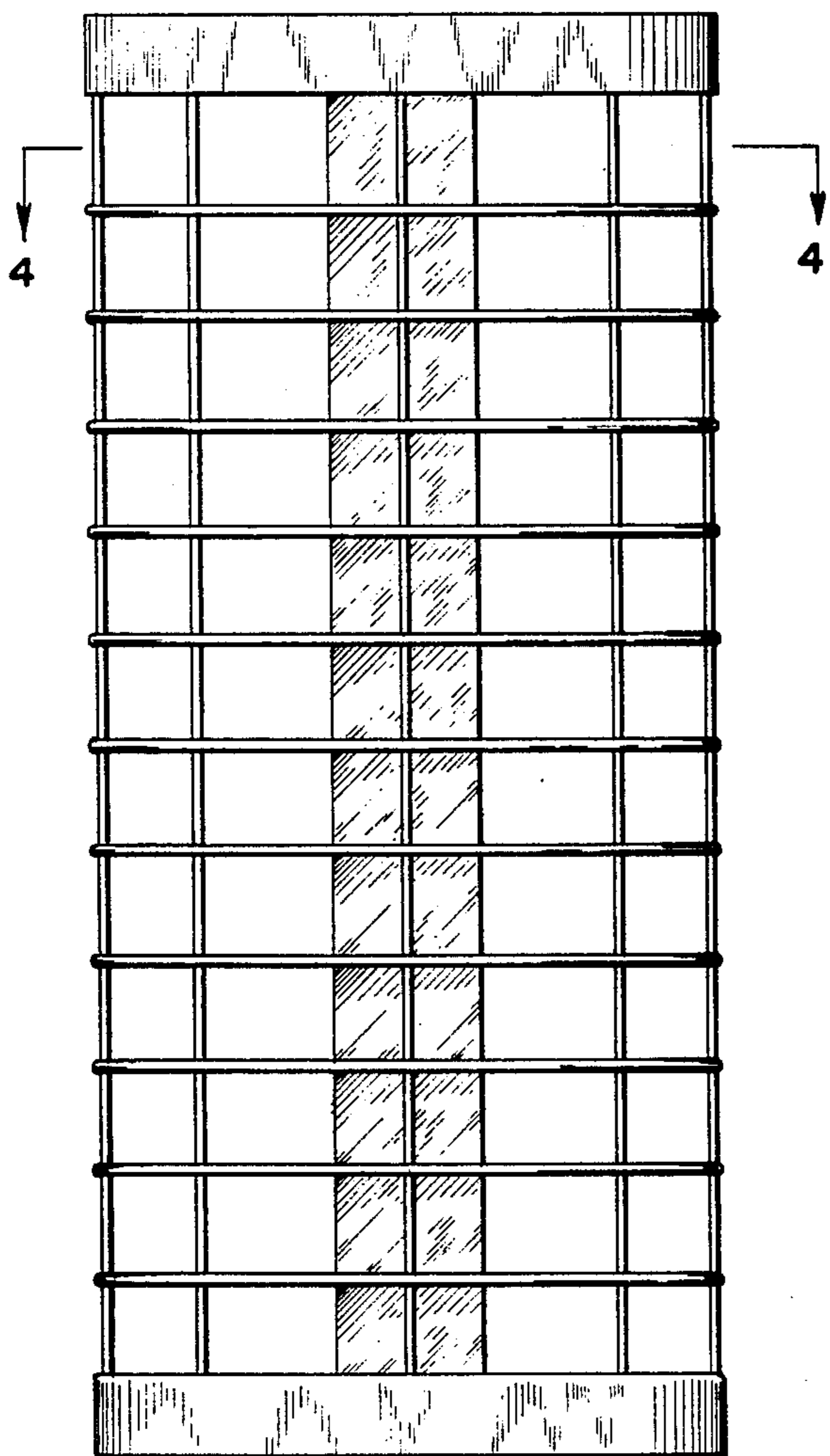

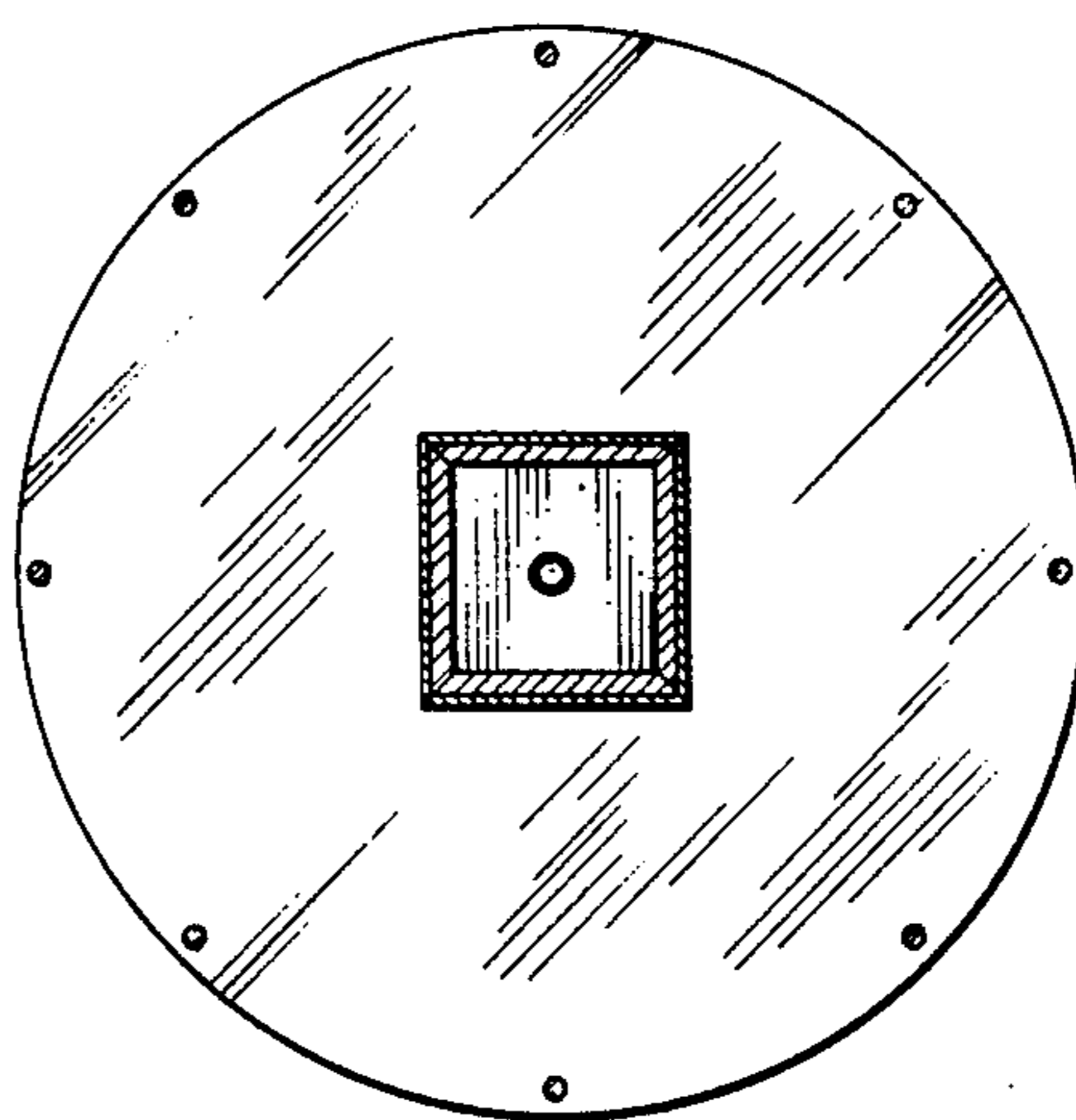

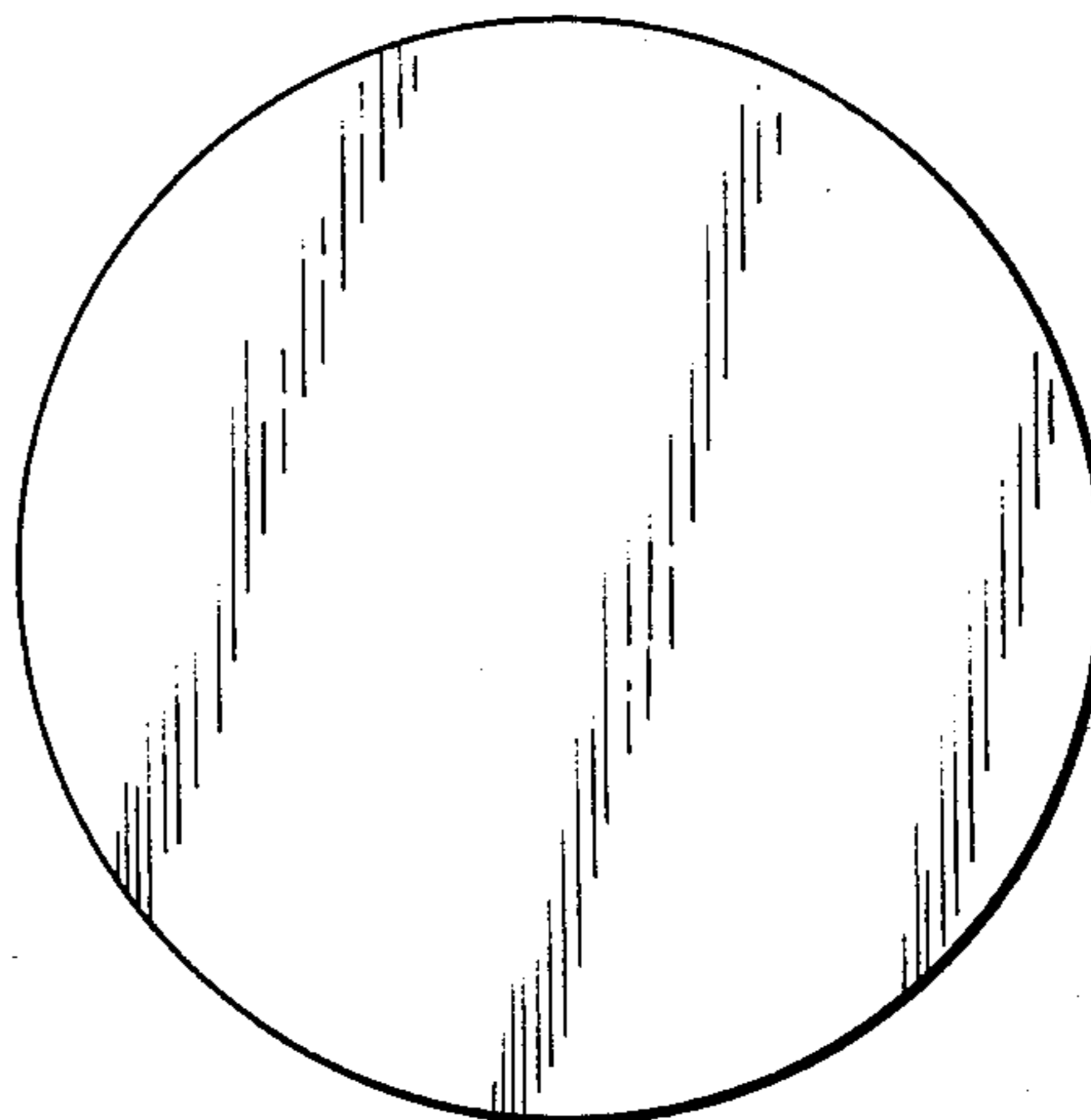
