DESCRIPTION

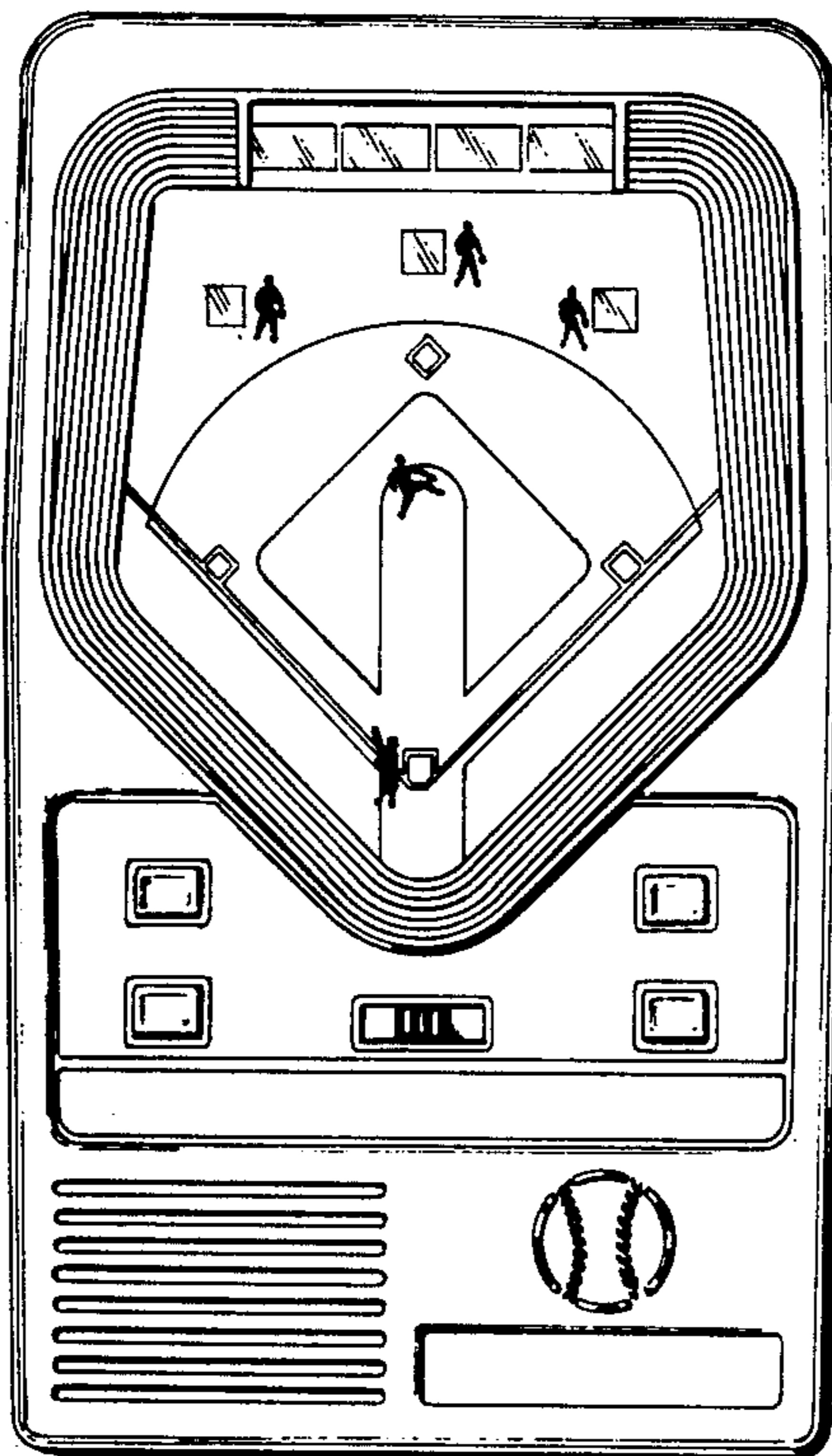
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an electronic baseball game casing or similar article, showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a rear view.



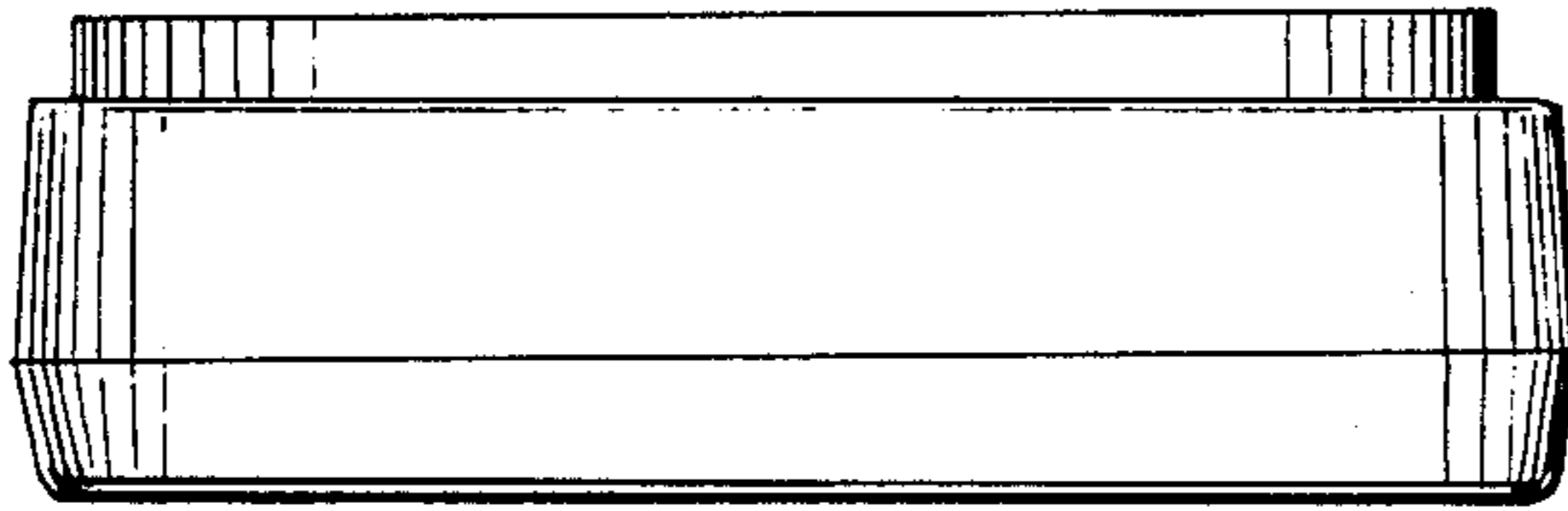

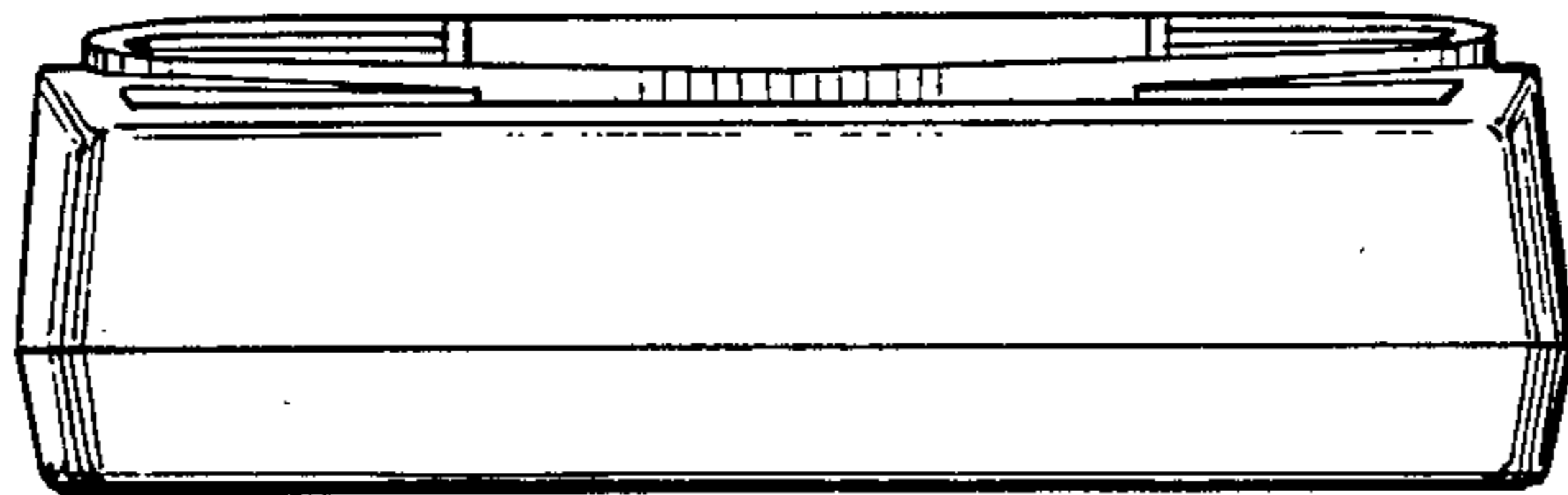
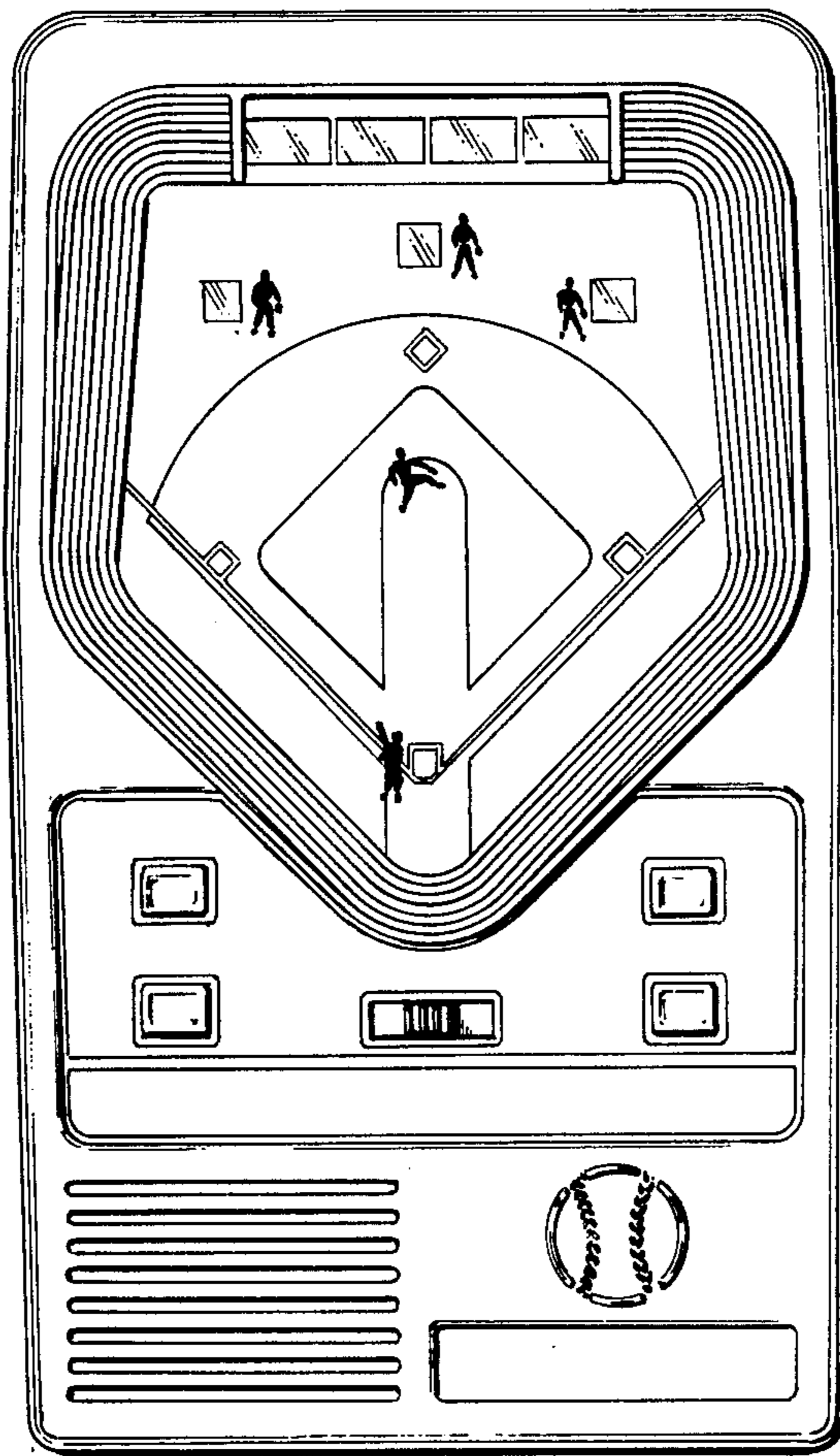

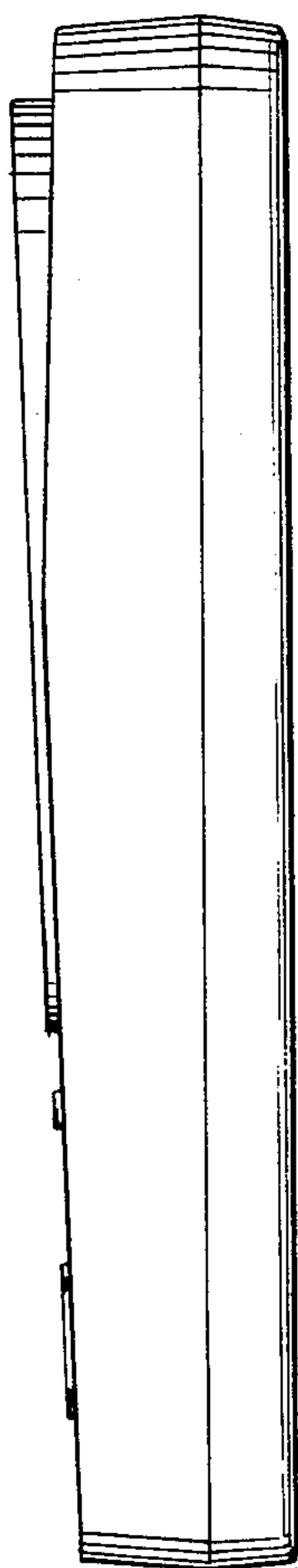

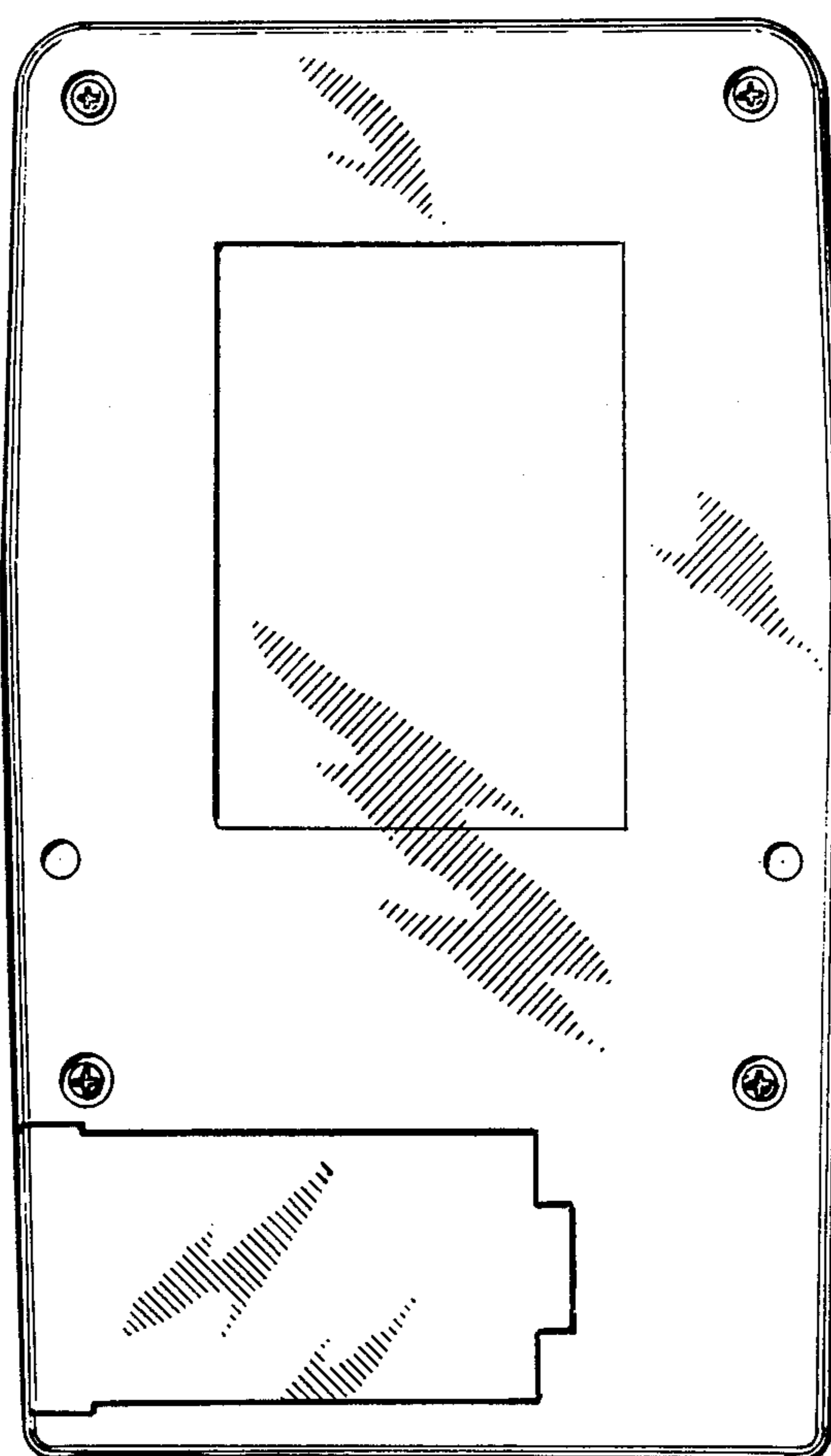
