[57] CLAIM

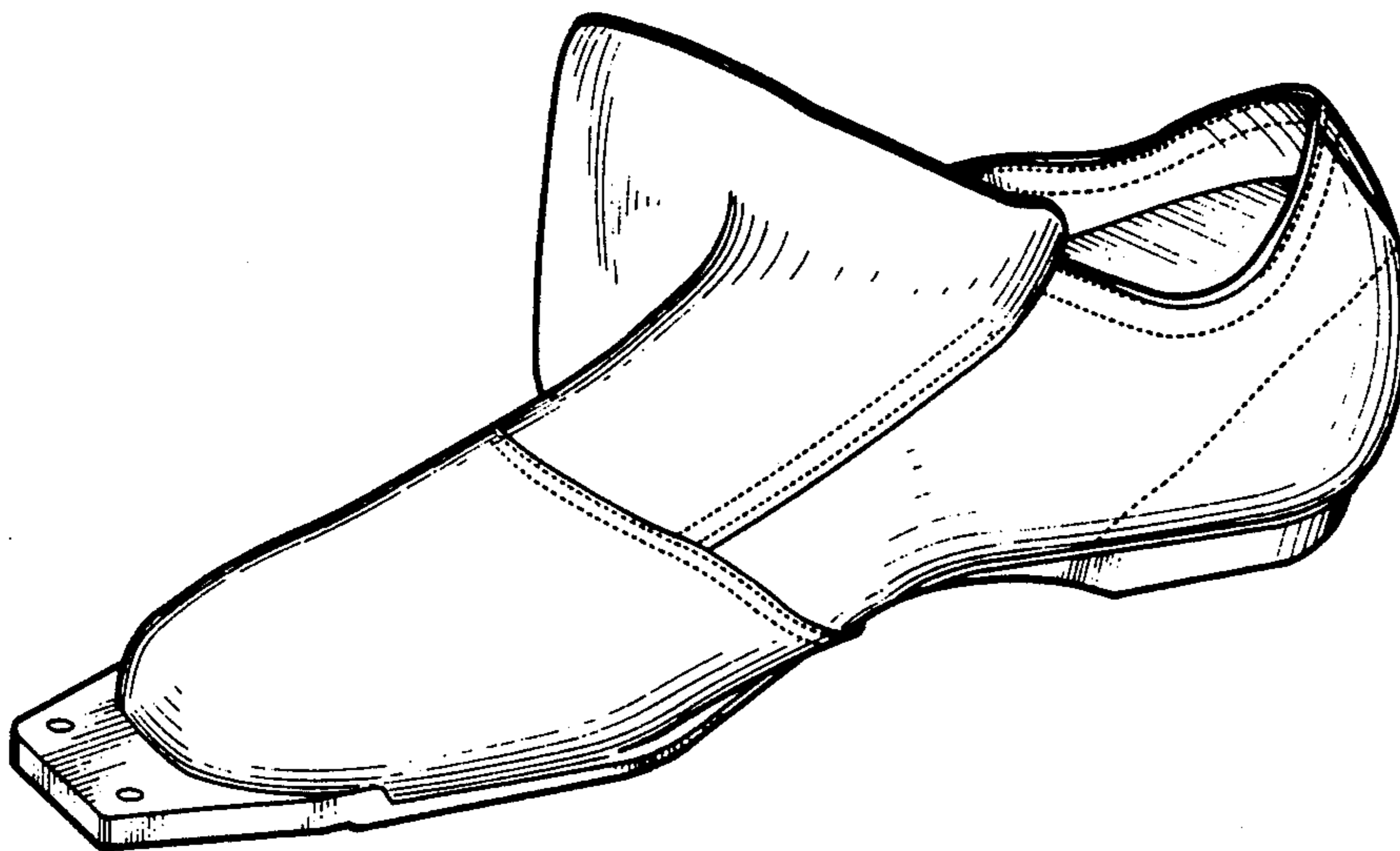
The ornamental design for cross country ski boot, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right front perspective view of a cross country ski boot showing my new design with the external tongue partially opened;

FIG. 2 is a left rear perspective view thereof;

The bottom, not shown, is substantially plain and unornamented.



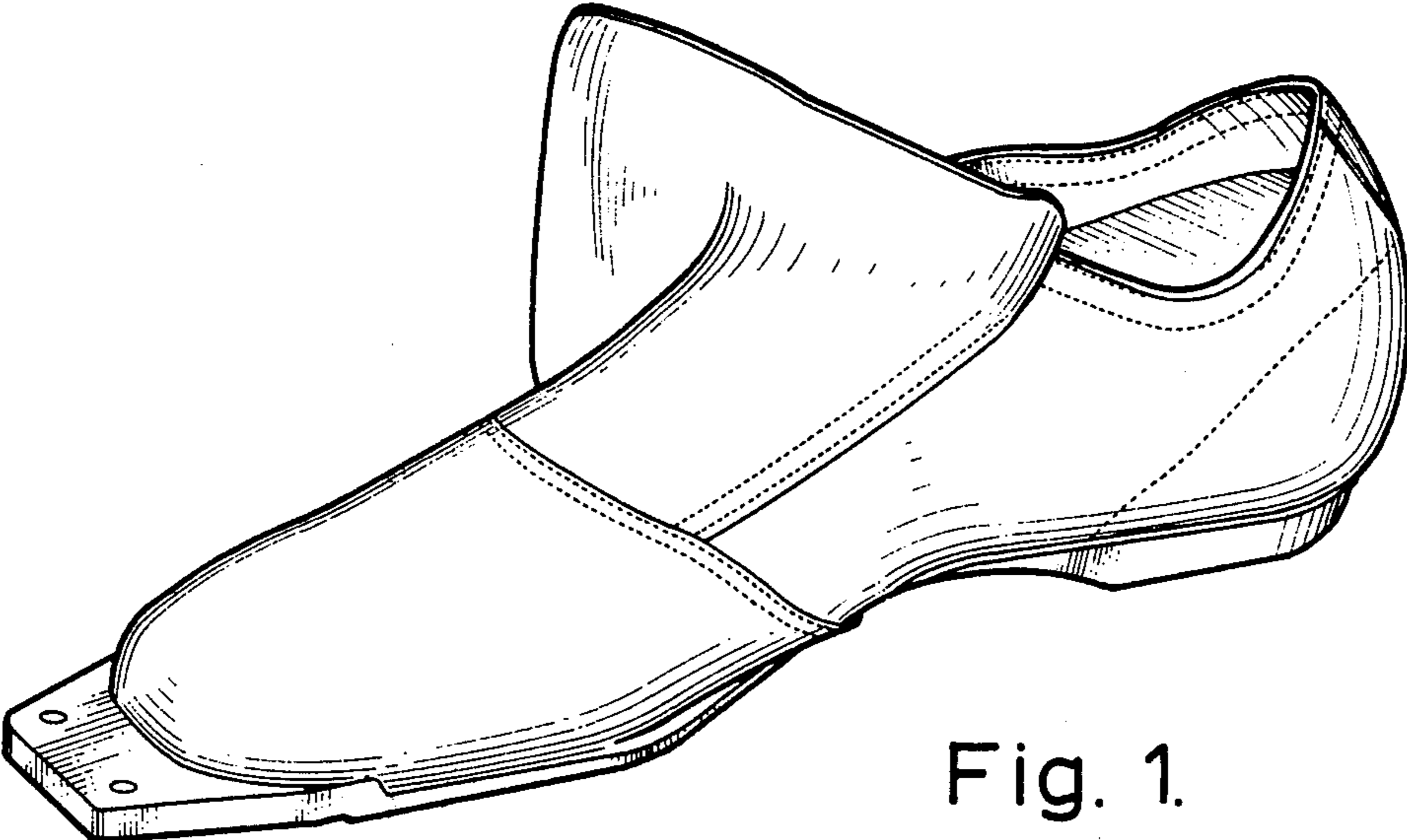

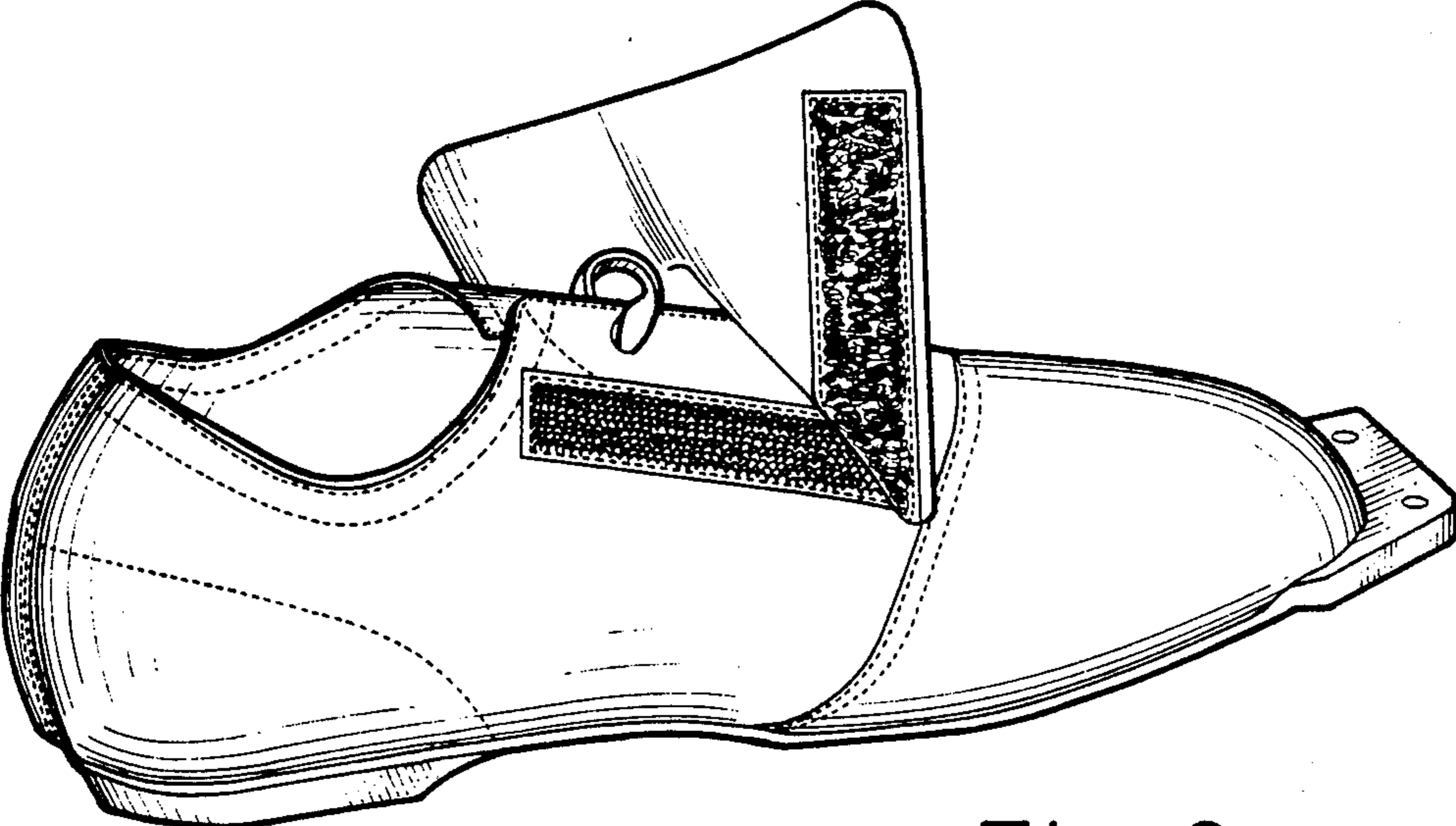
