The bottom, not shown, is flat, plain and unornamental.

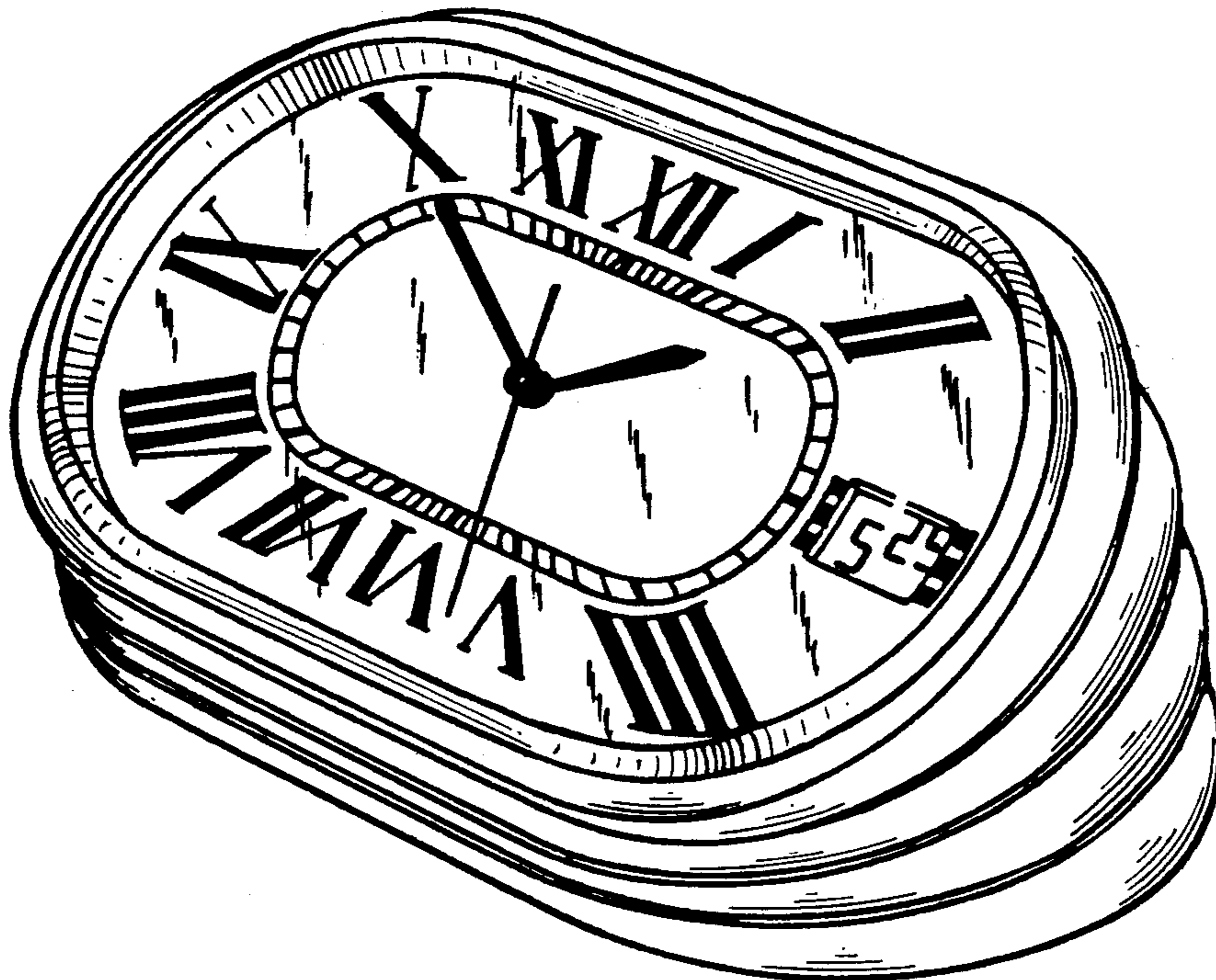

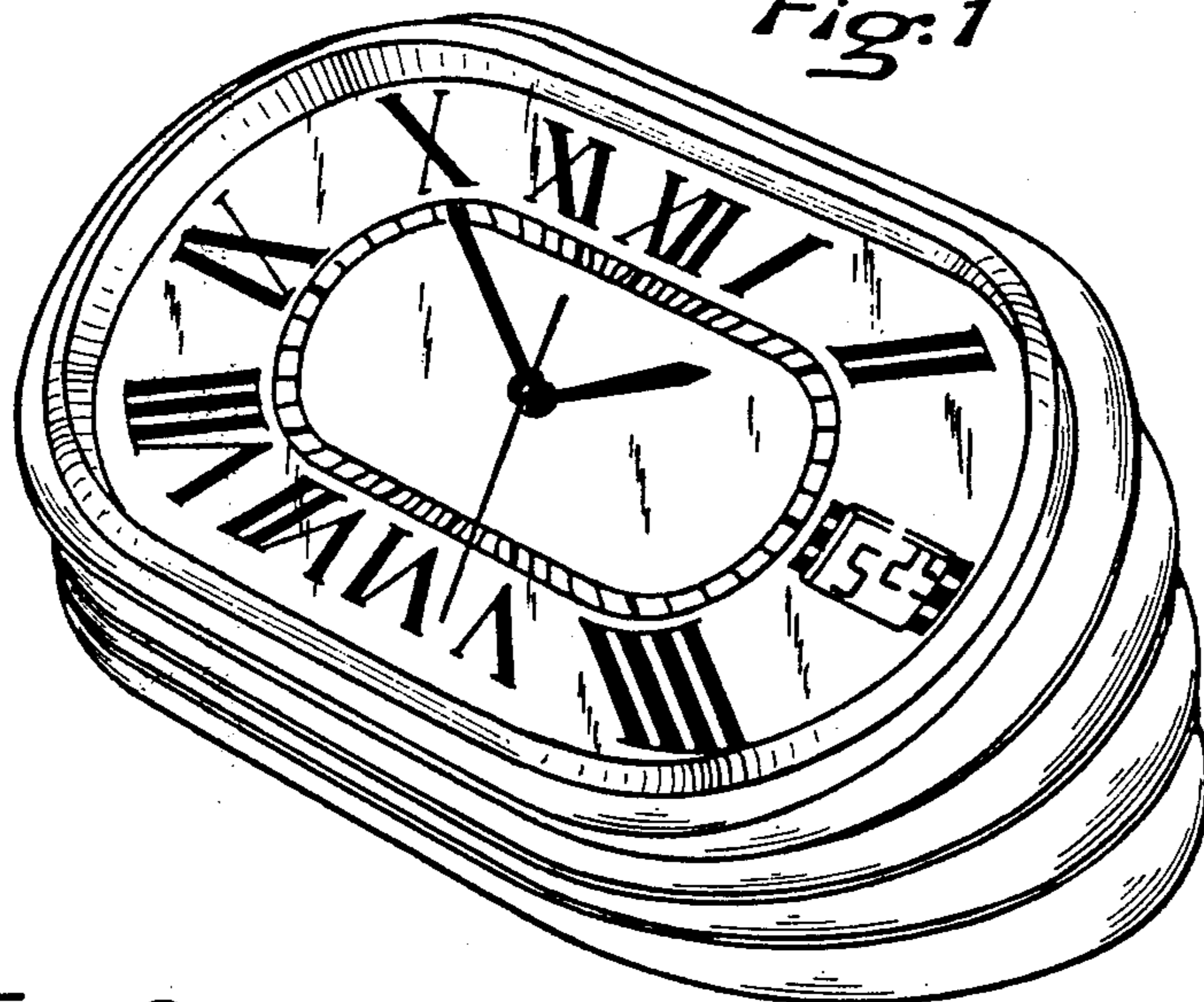
