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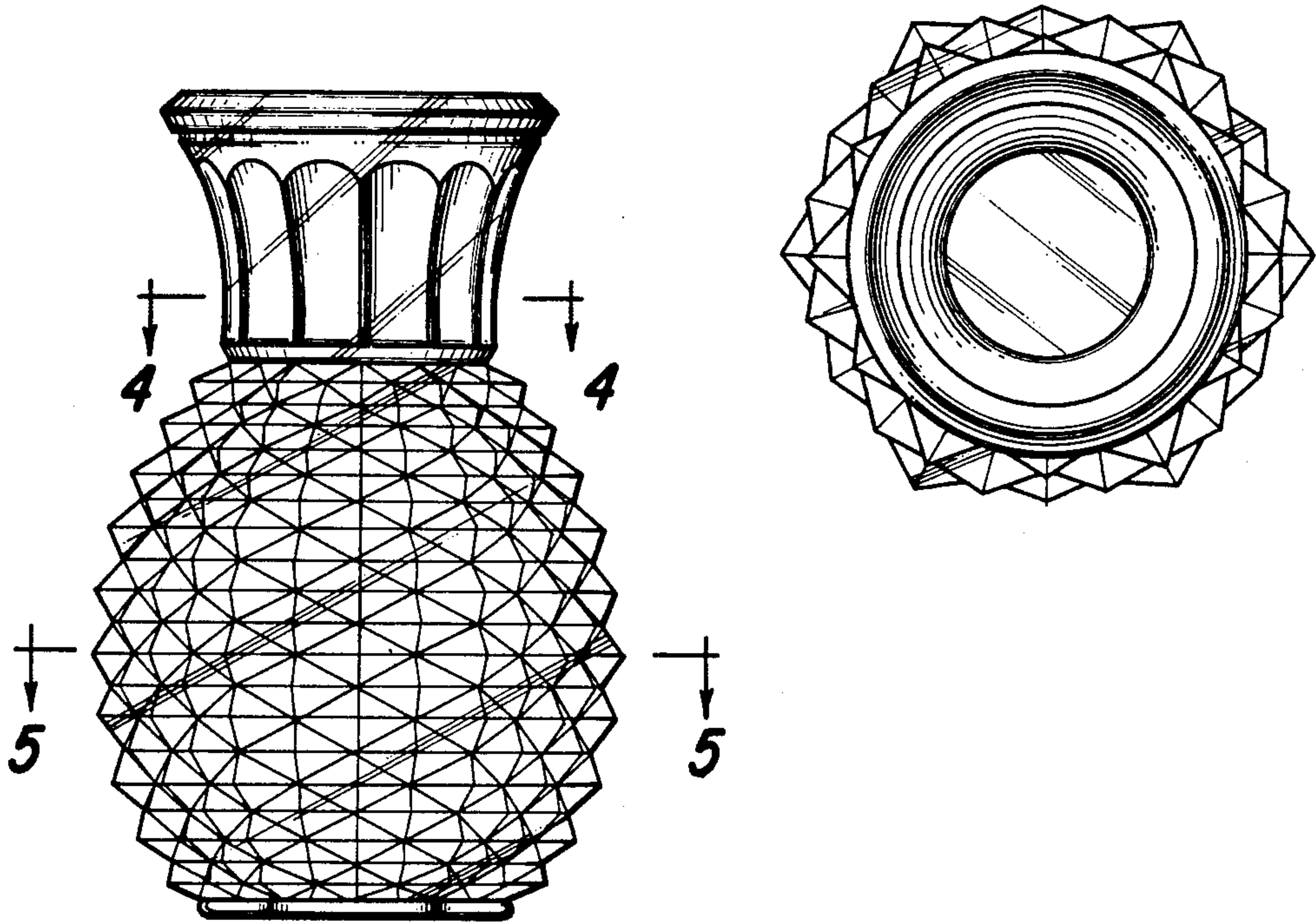

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a vase embodying our new
design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view; all sides being substan-
tially identical;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken in the direction of the
arrows on line 4-4 of FIG. 2; and
FIG. 5 is a sectional view taken in the direction of the
arrows on line 5-5 of FIG. 2.



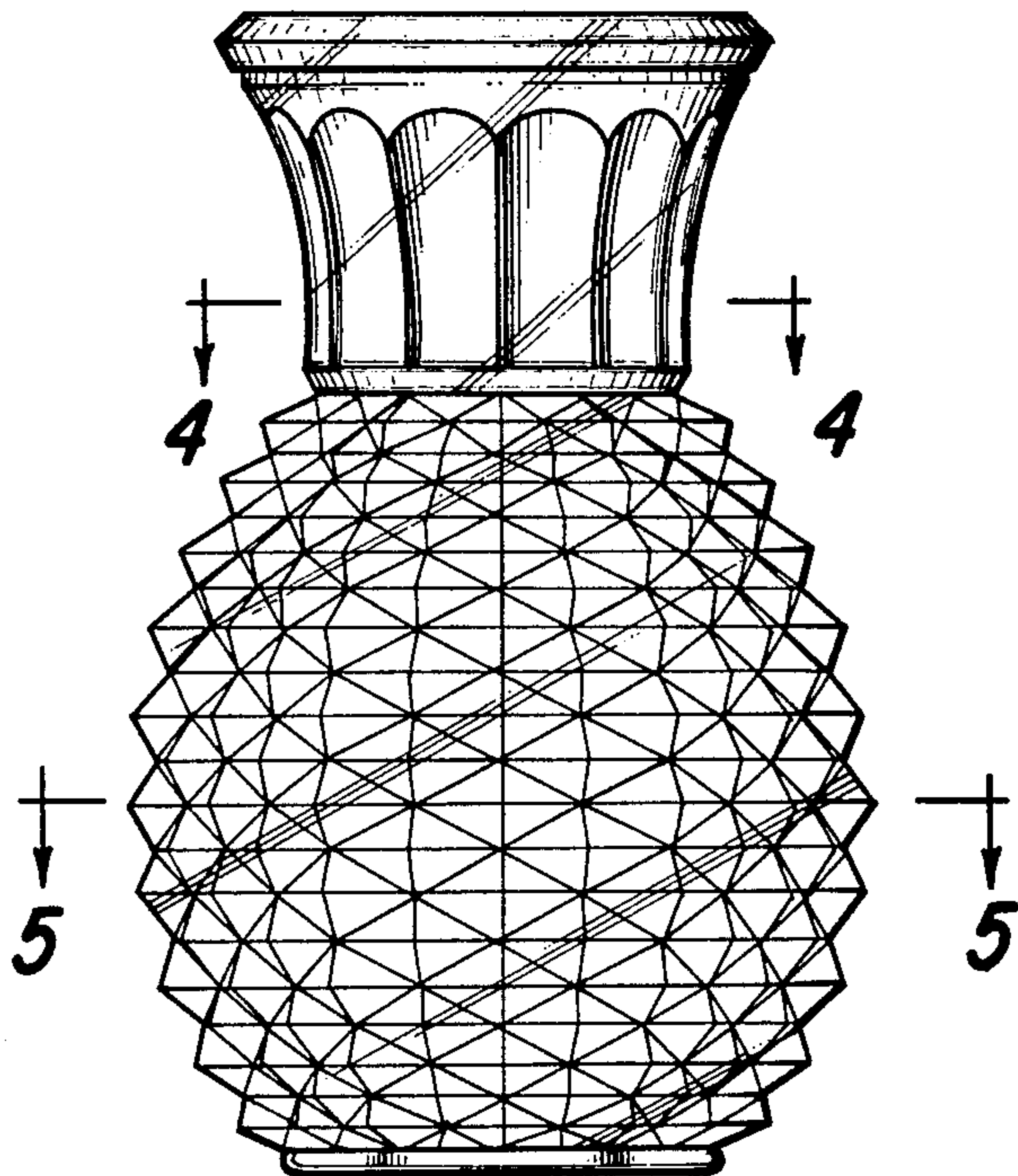

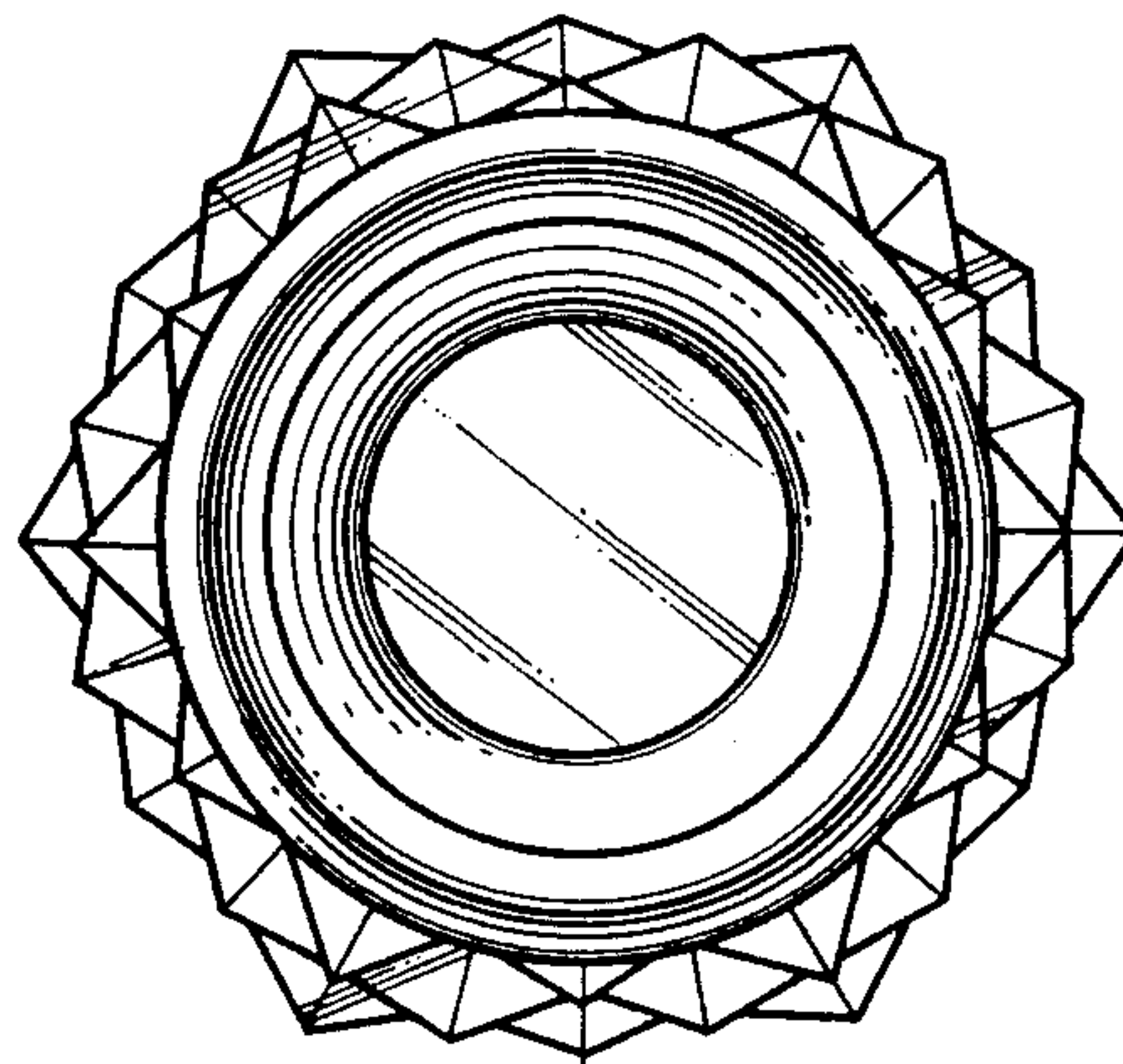

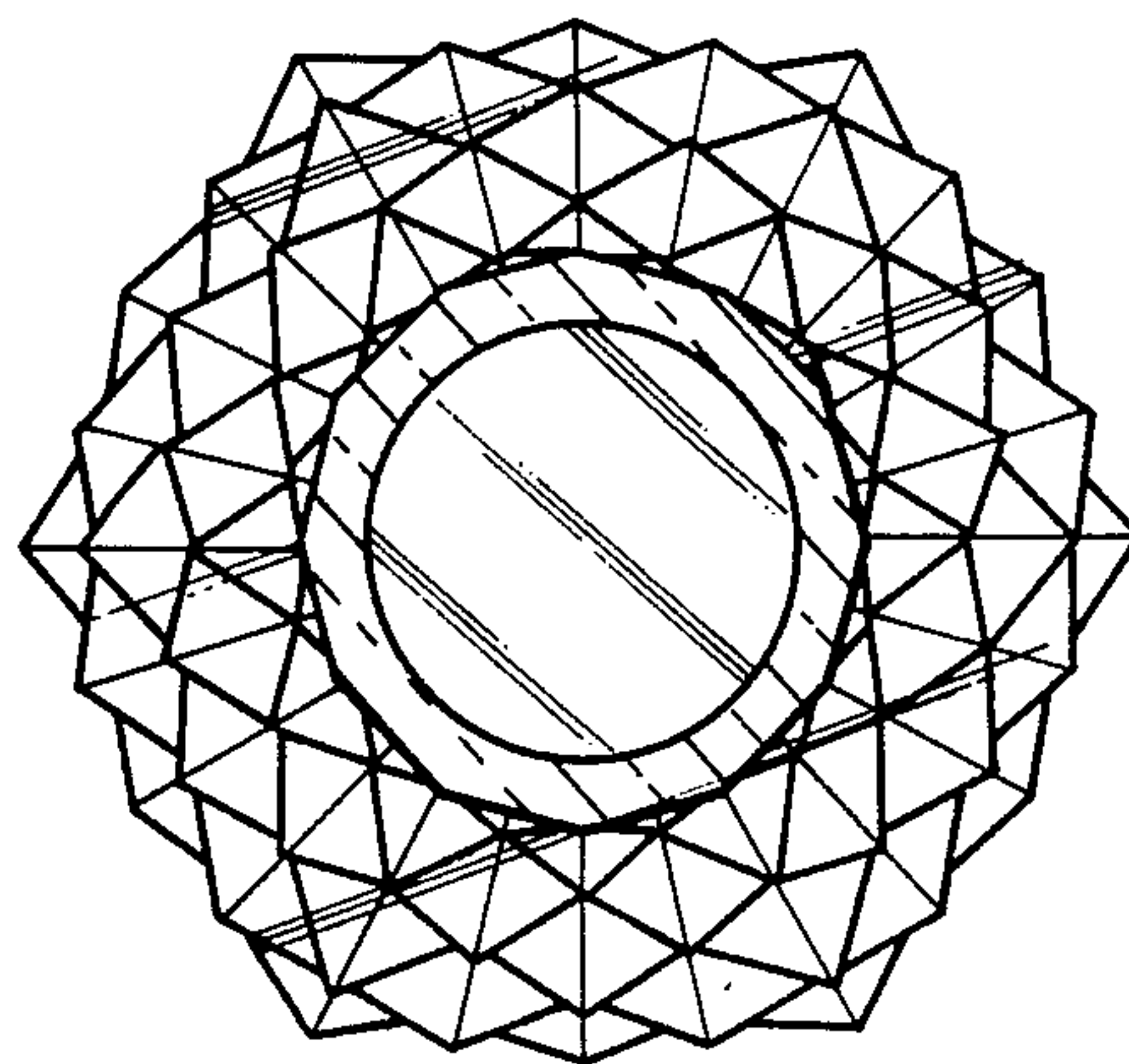

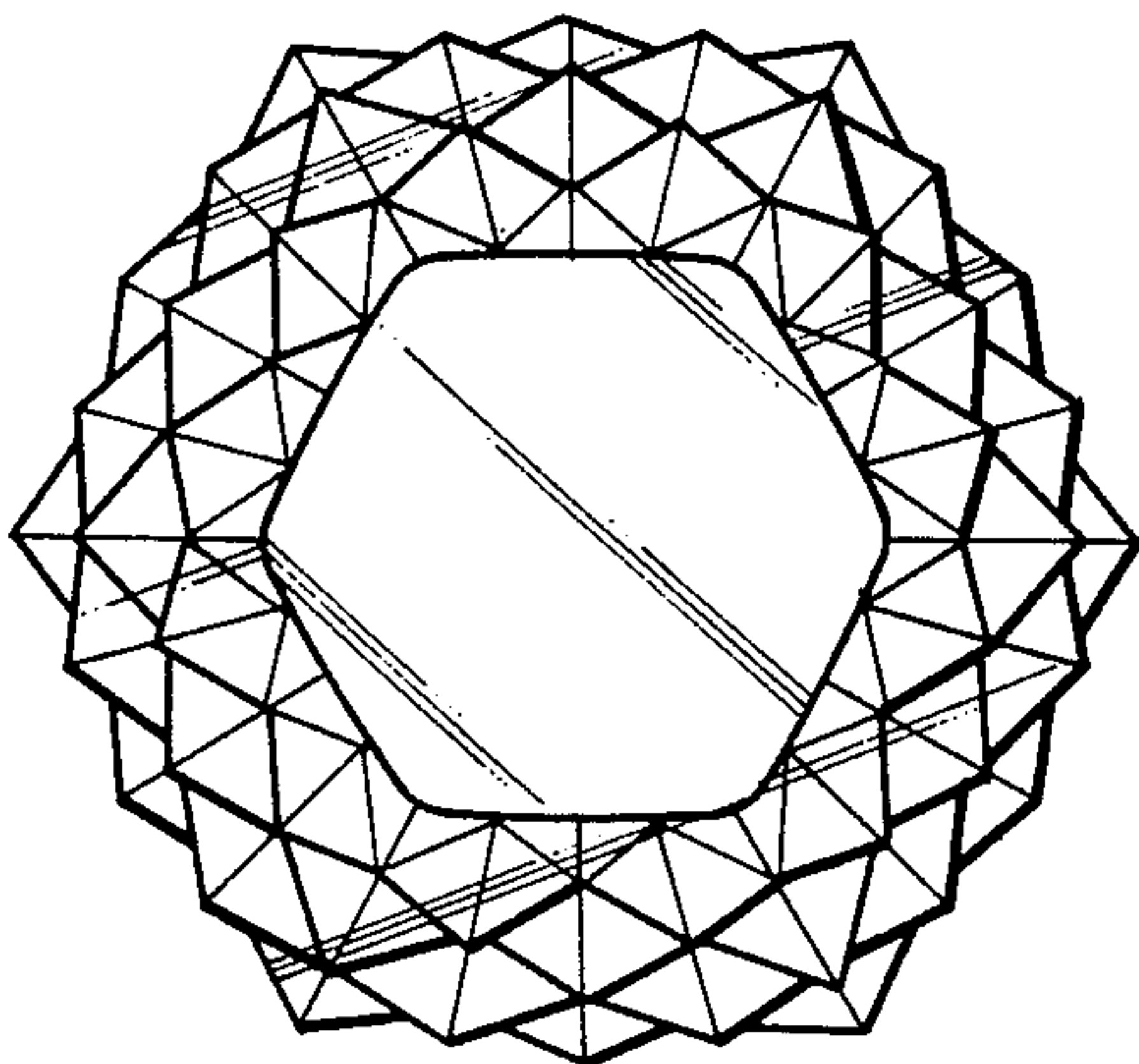

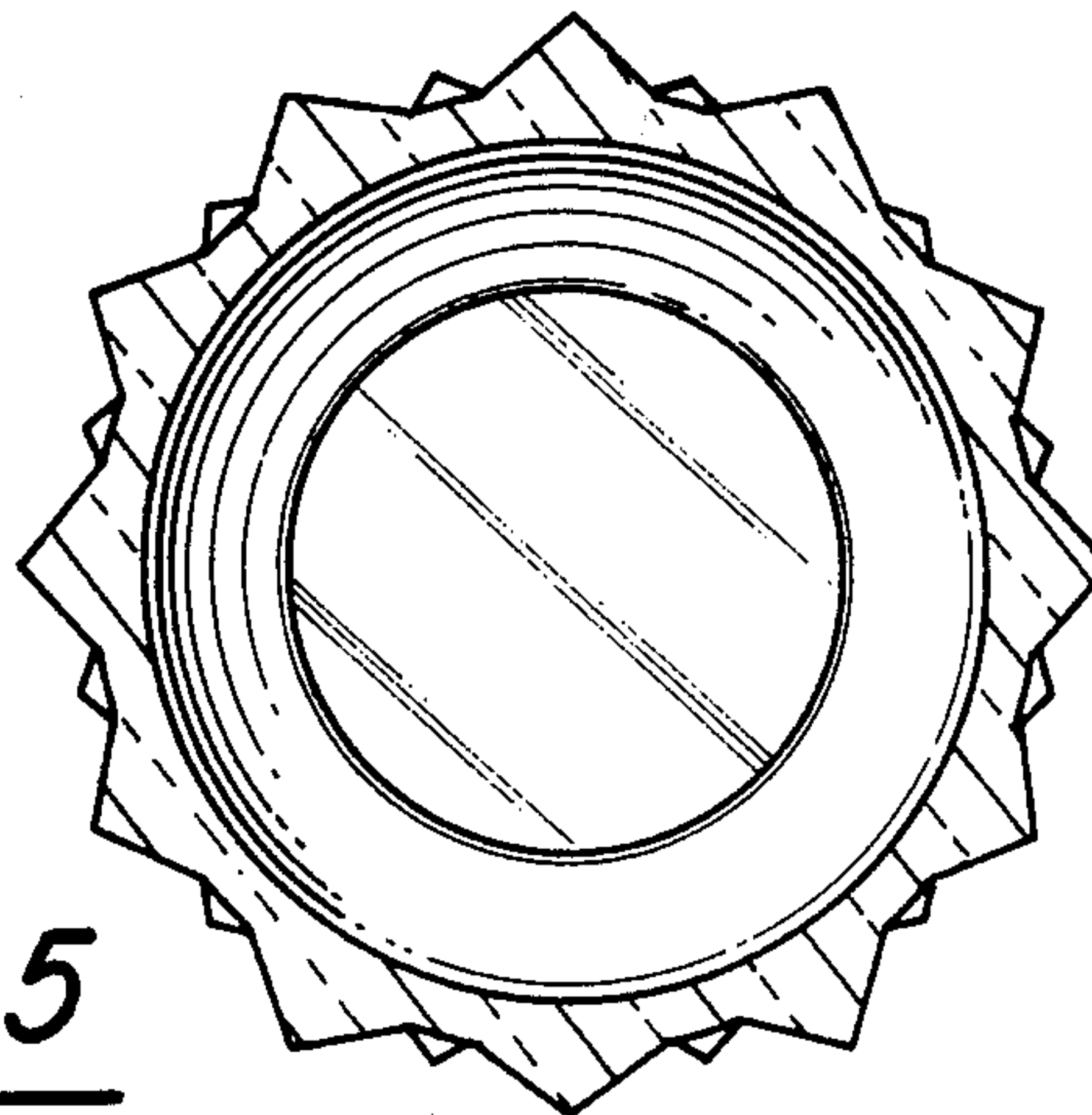
