FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a record player showing my new design;

FIG. 4, is a top plan view of the record player with the cover detached.

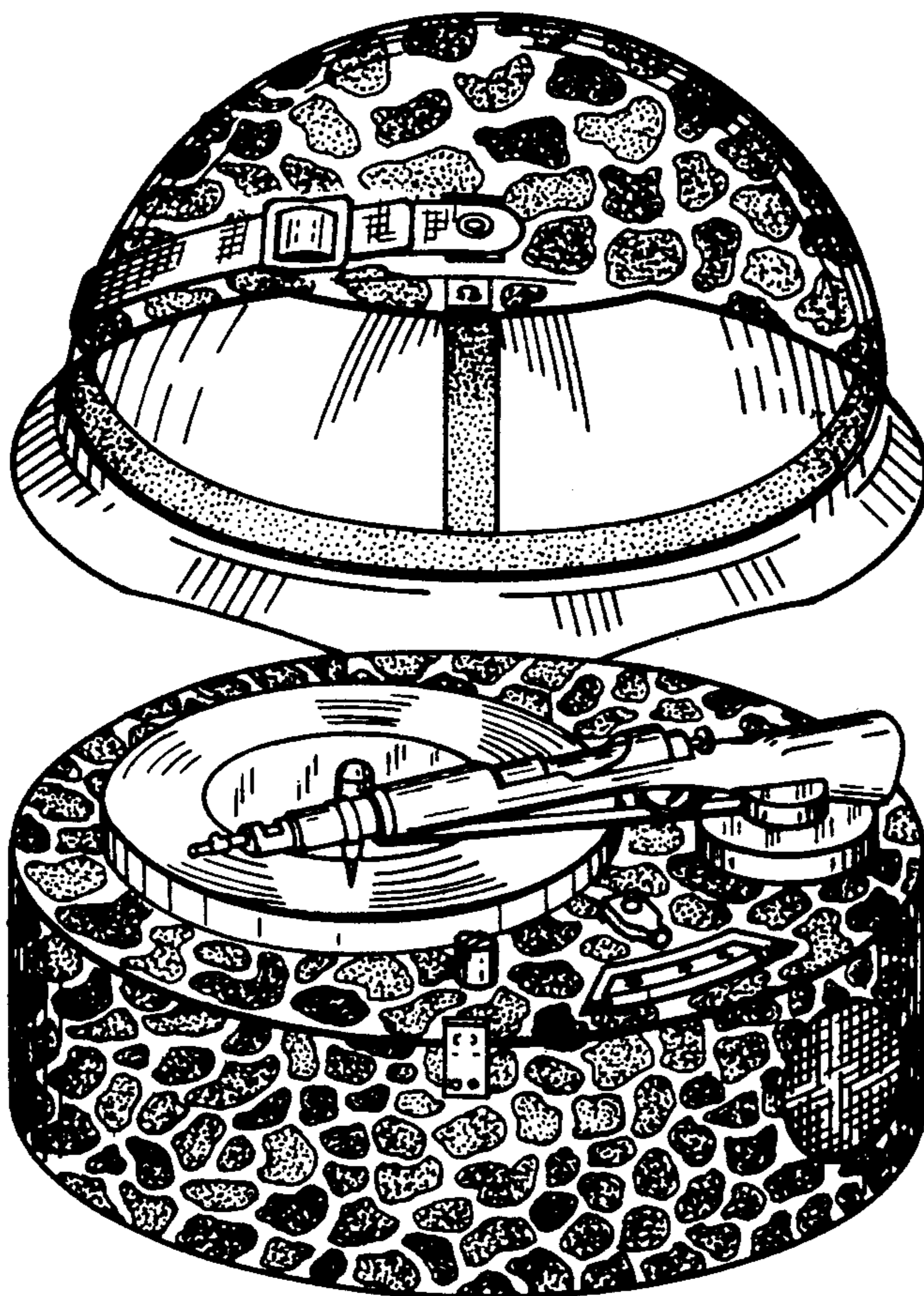

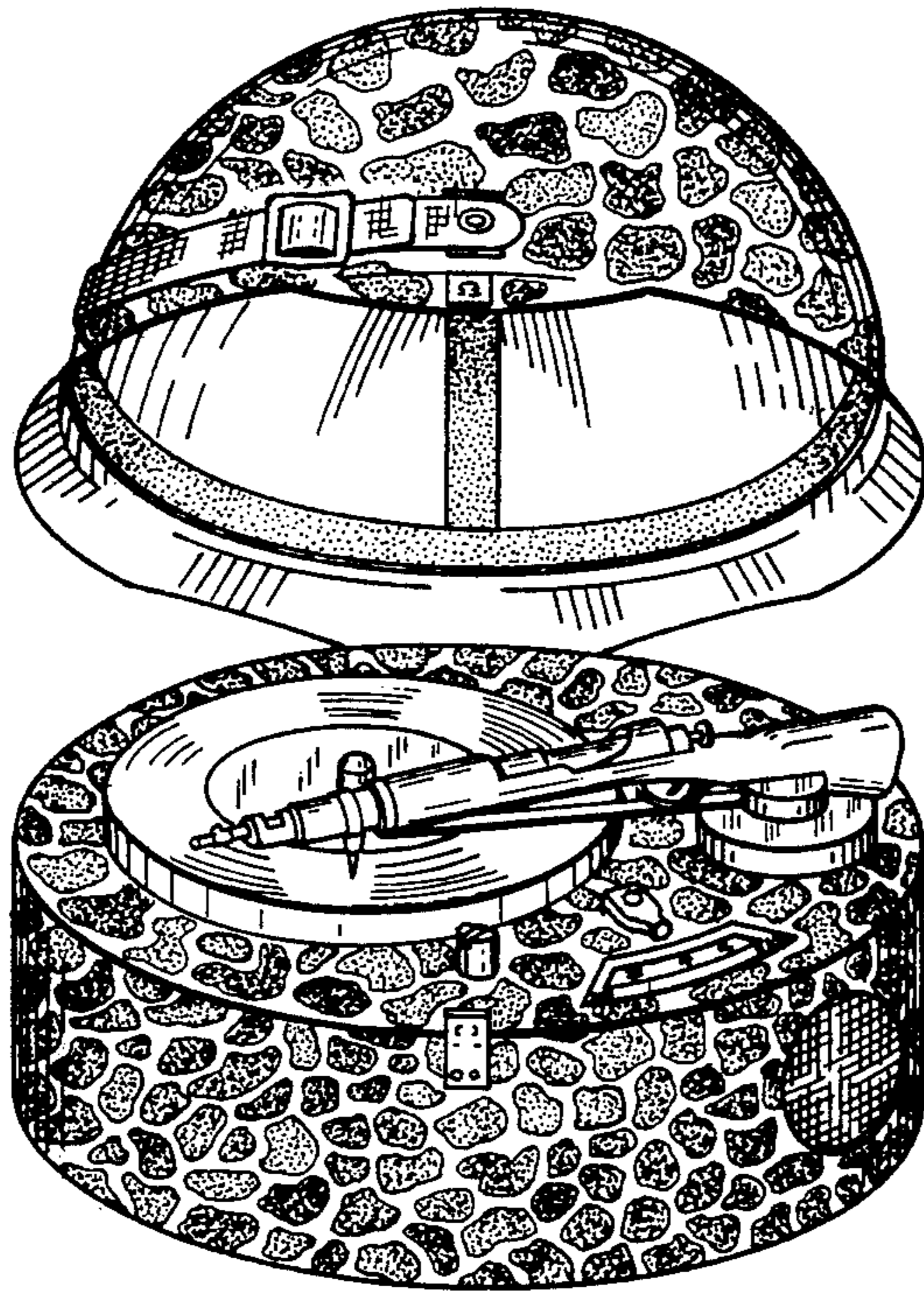
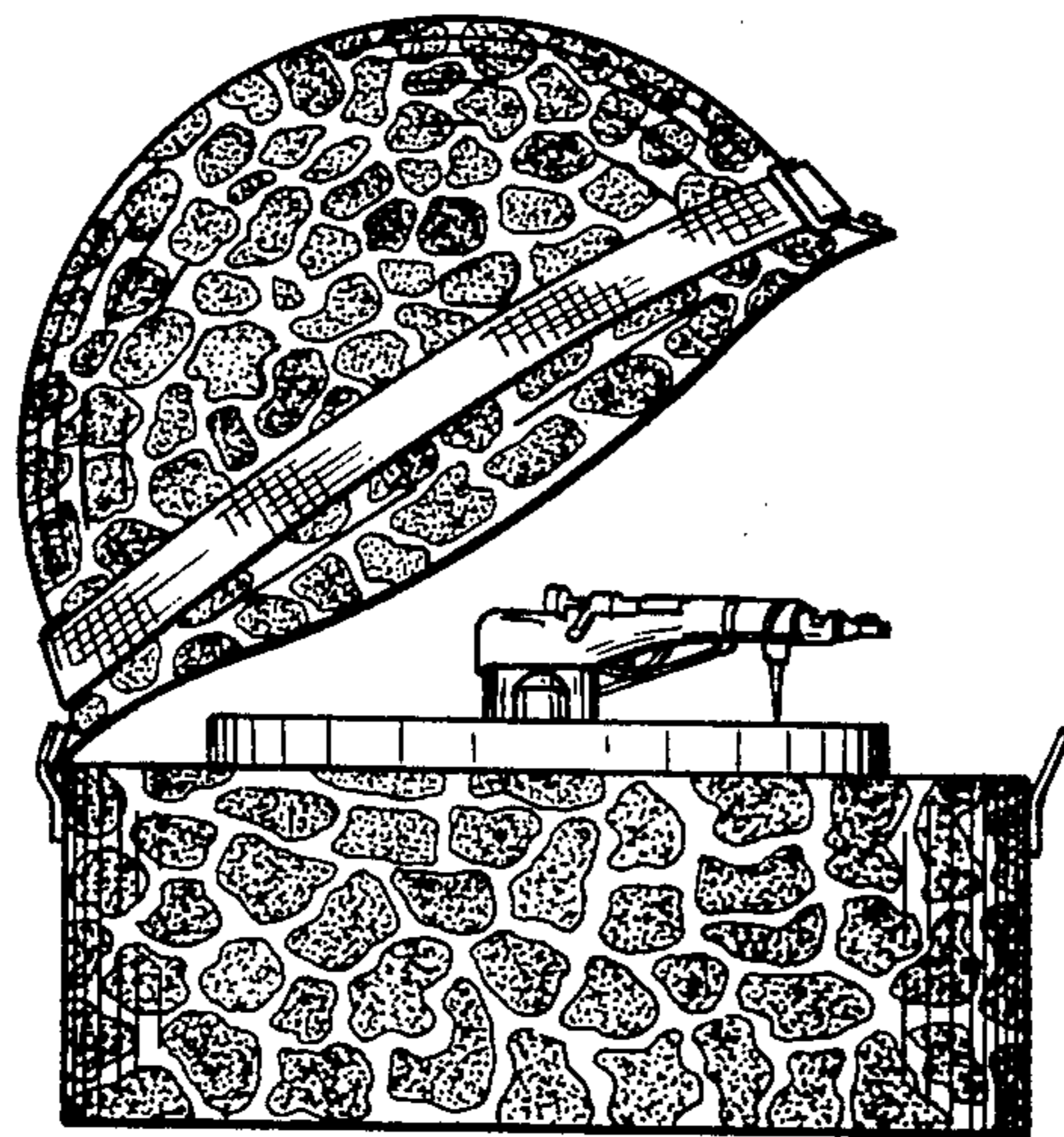

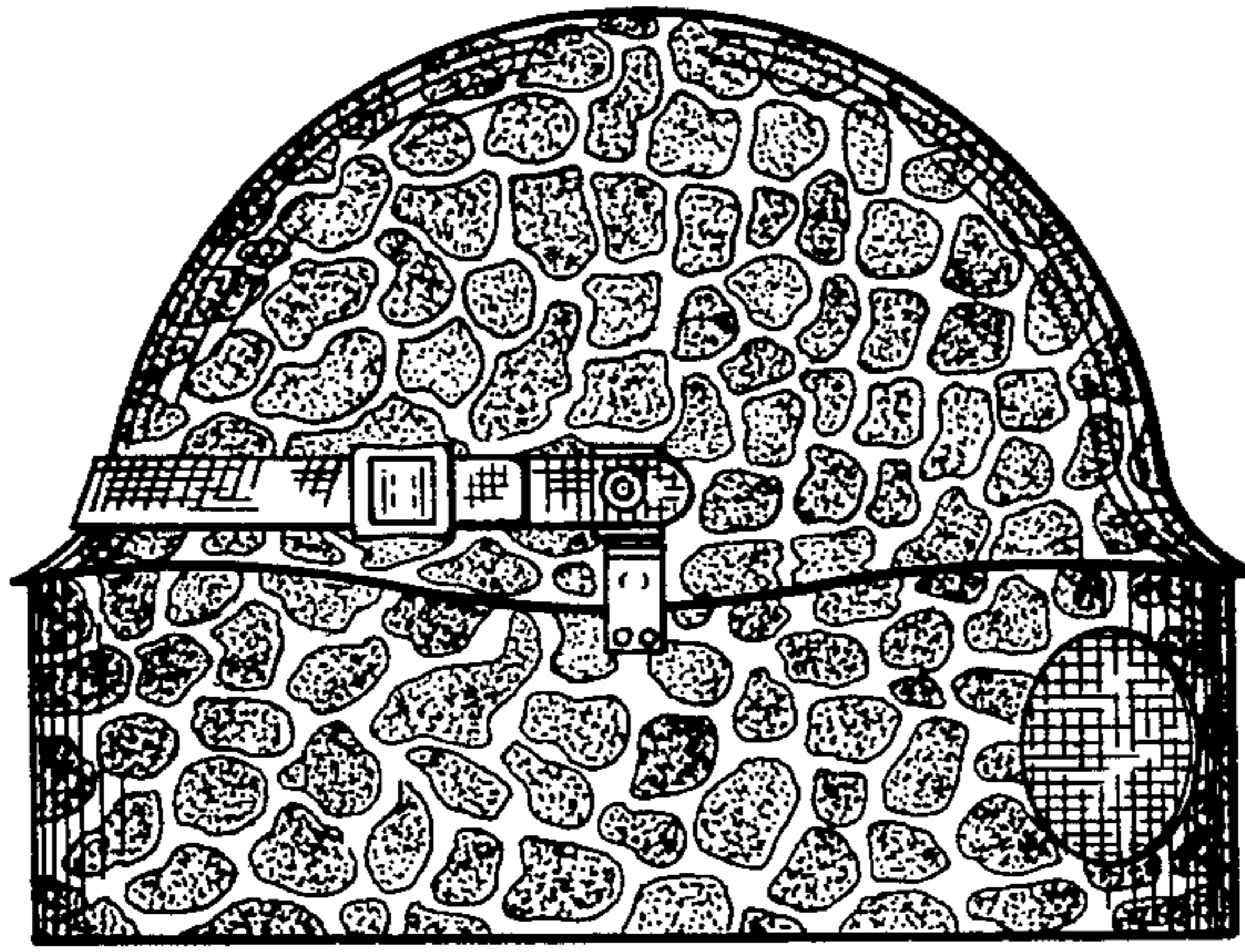
