[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a simulative toy vehicle, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a simulative toy vehicle showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being substantially a mirror image; and, FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.

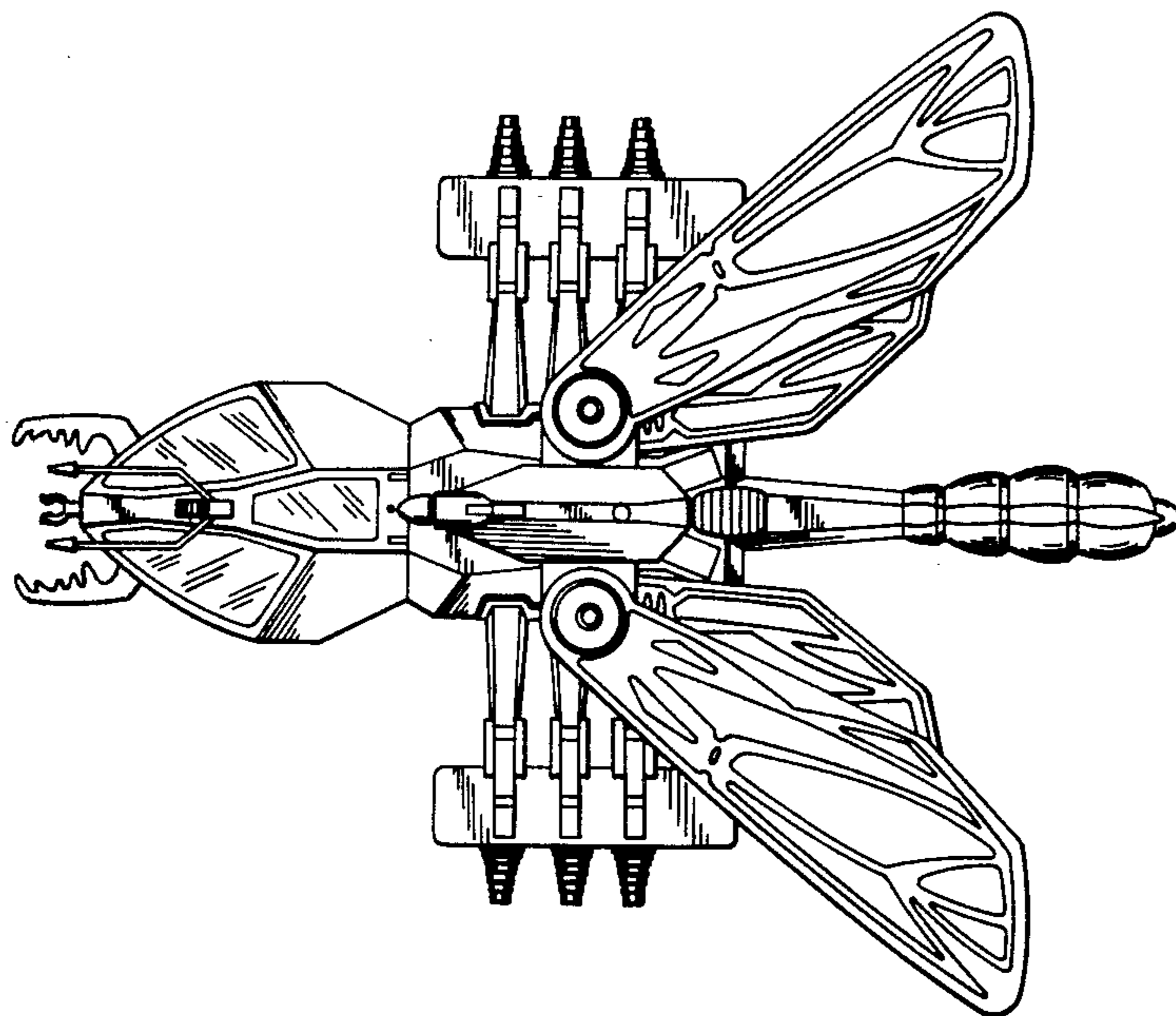

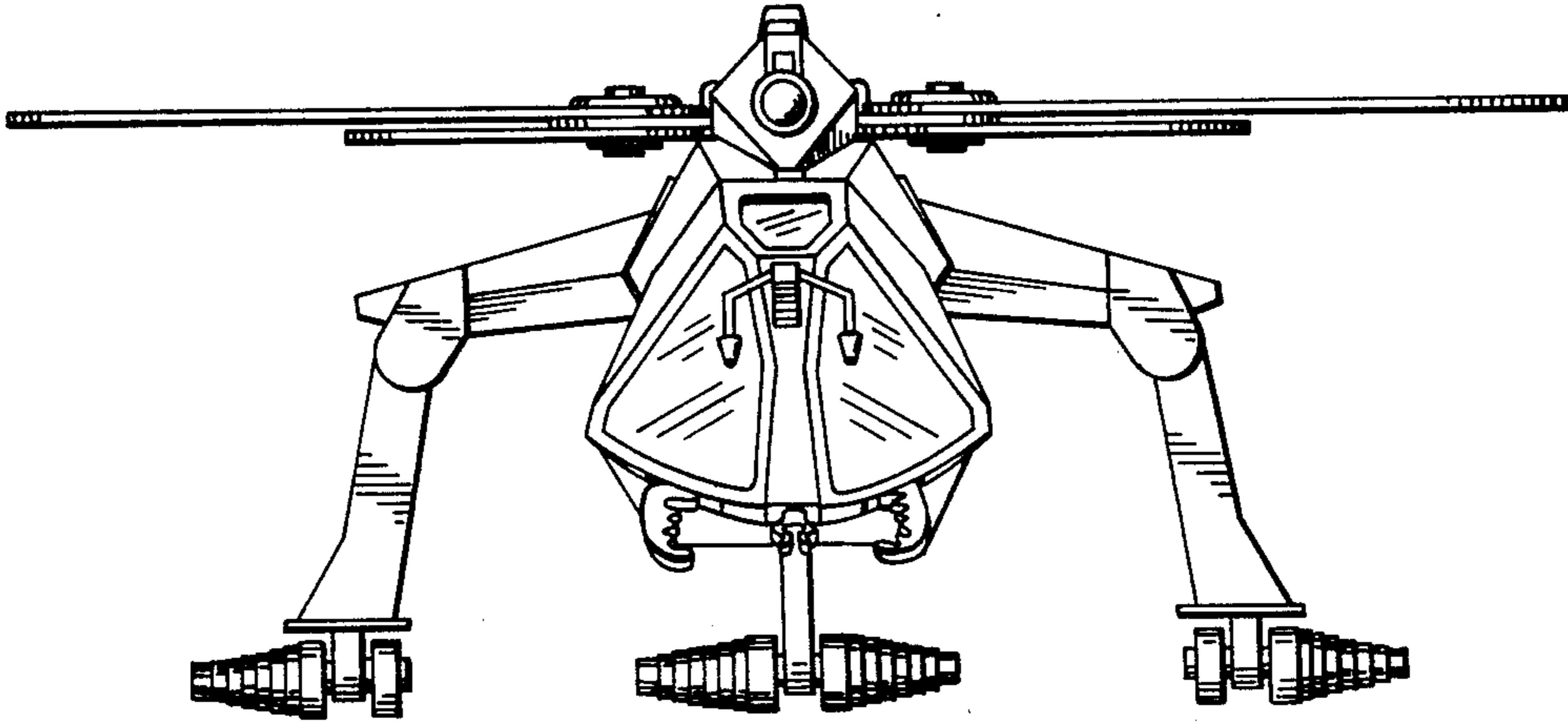

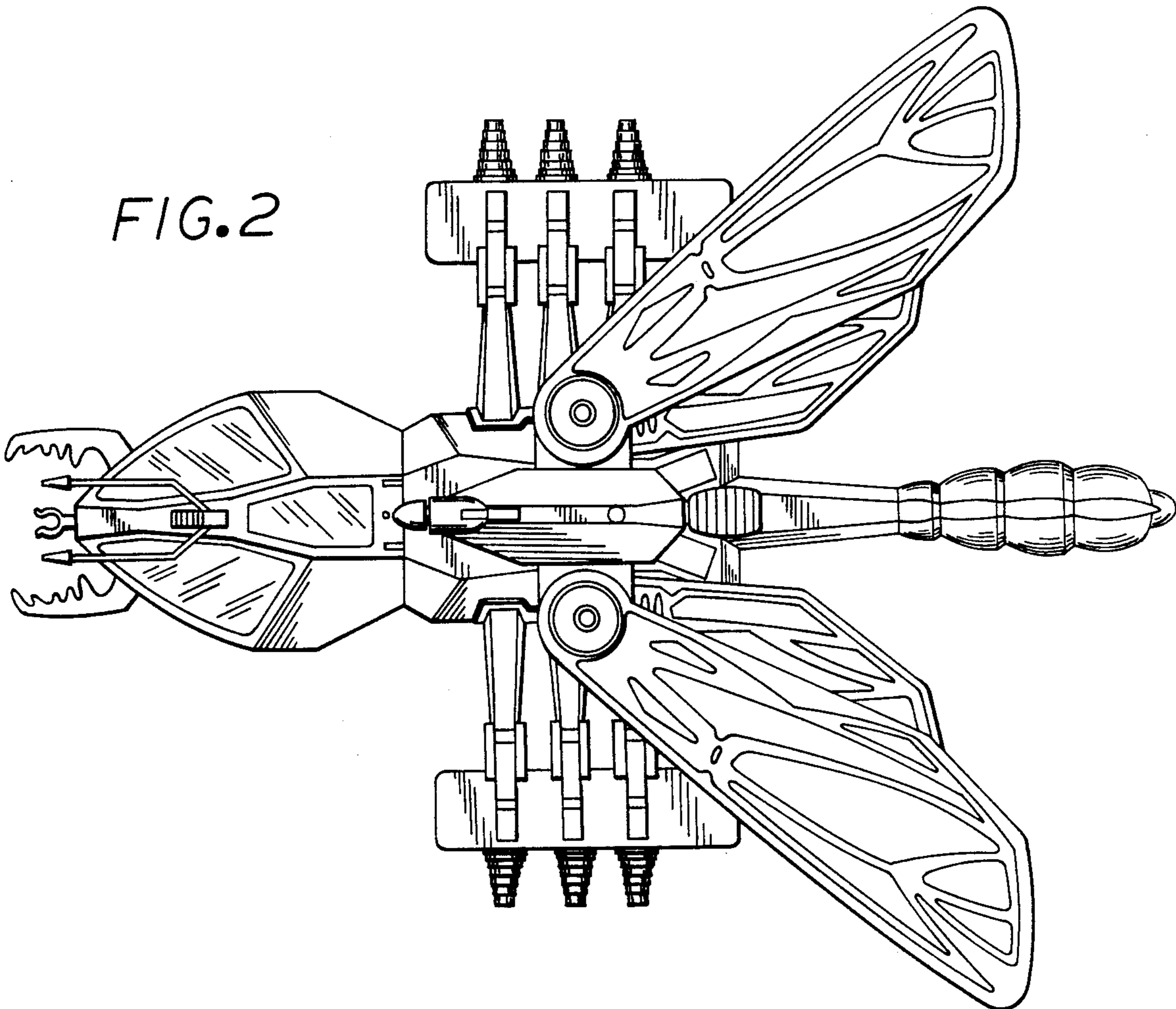

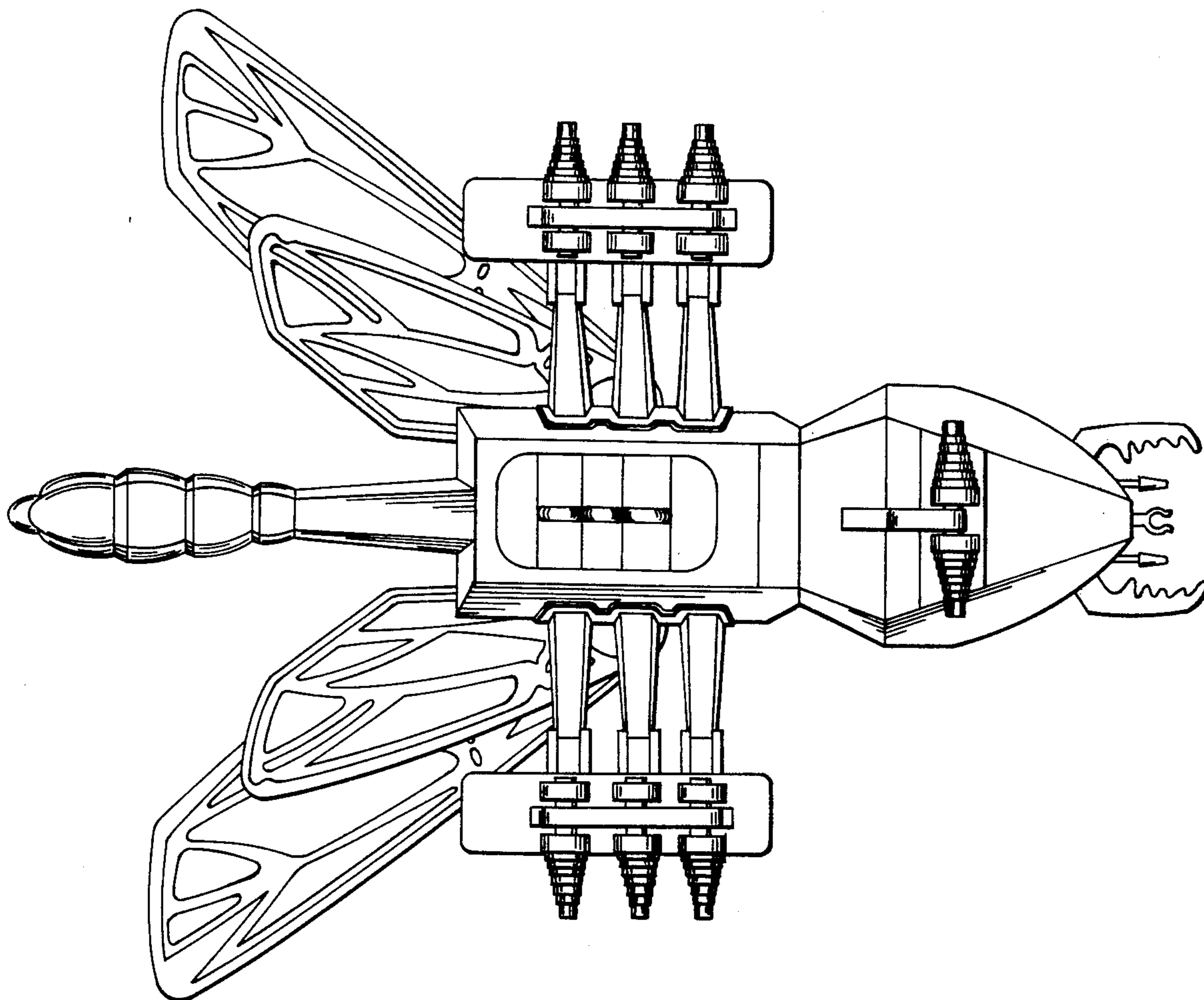

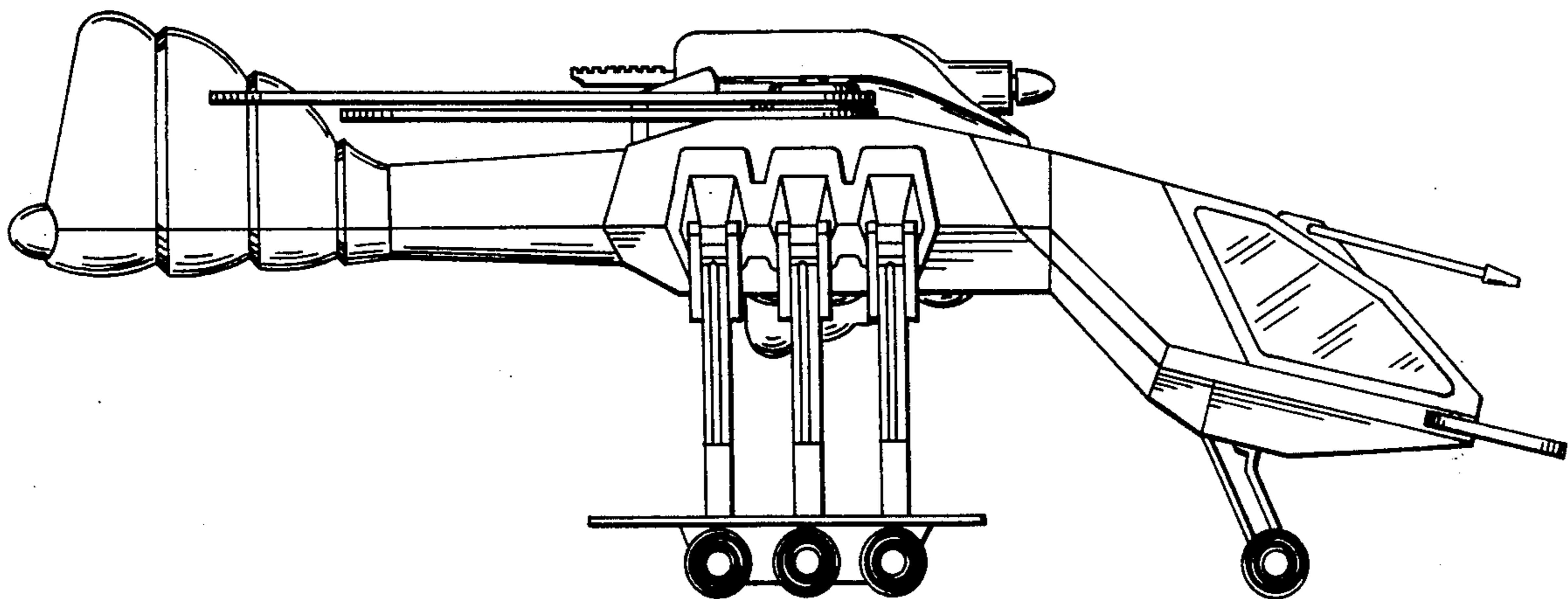
