[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a work-task simulator cabinet, substantially as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a work-task simulator cabinet showing our new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front perspective view thereof in fully open condition;  
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of FIG. 1;  
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of FIG. 2;  
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof; the side opposite being substantially similar thereto;  
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof; and  
FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof.

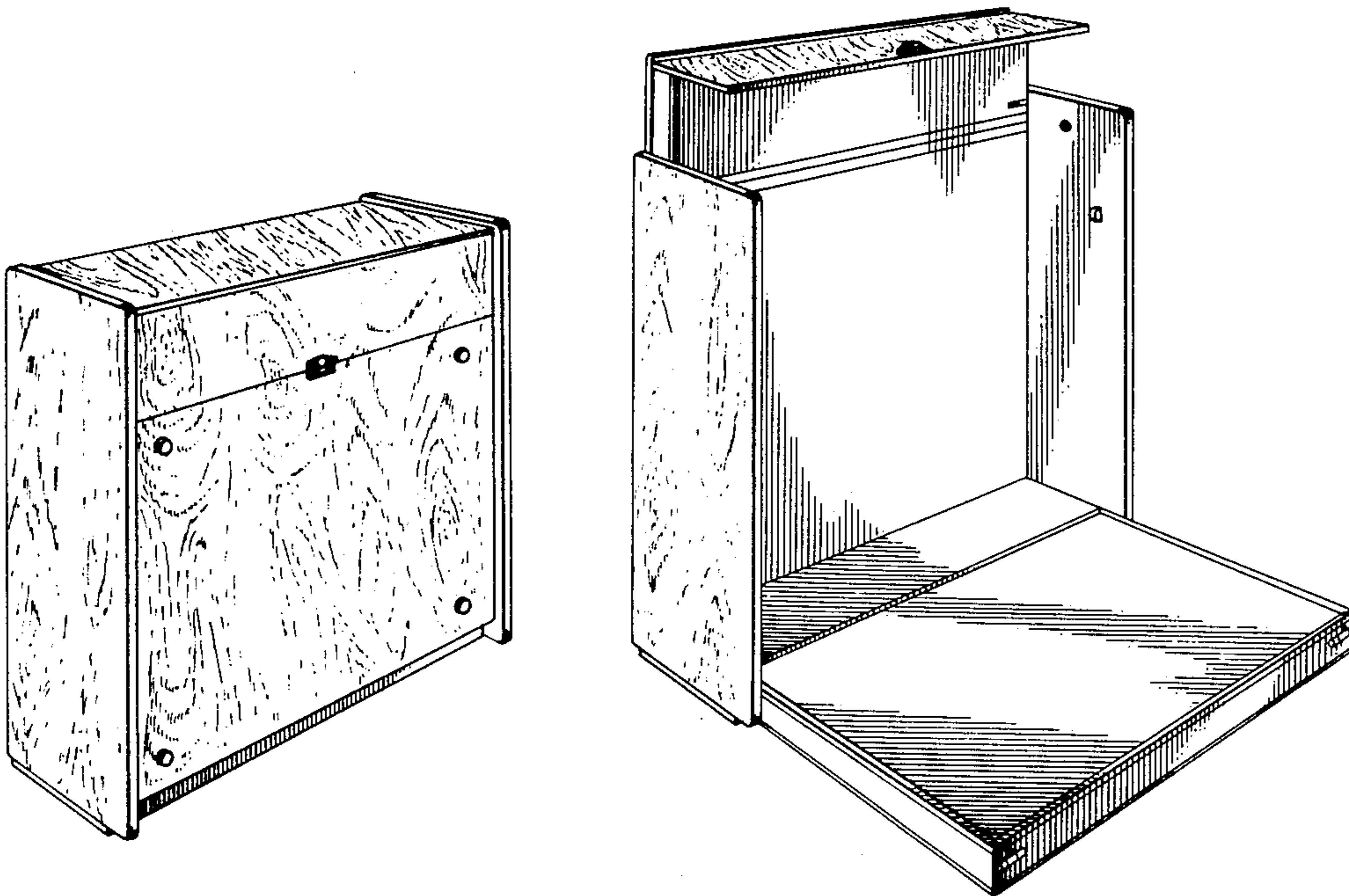

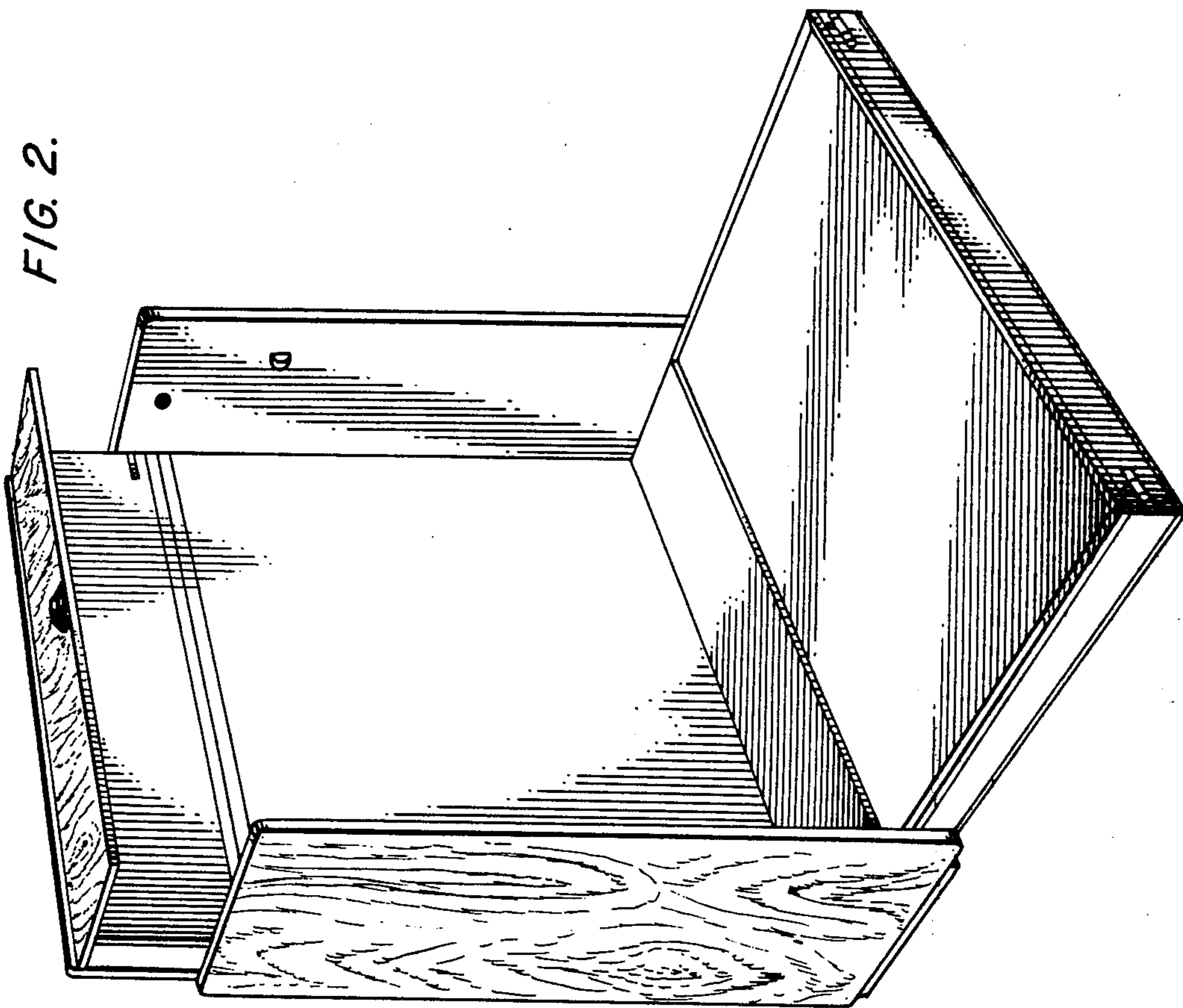

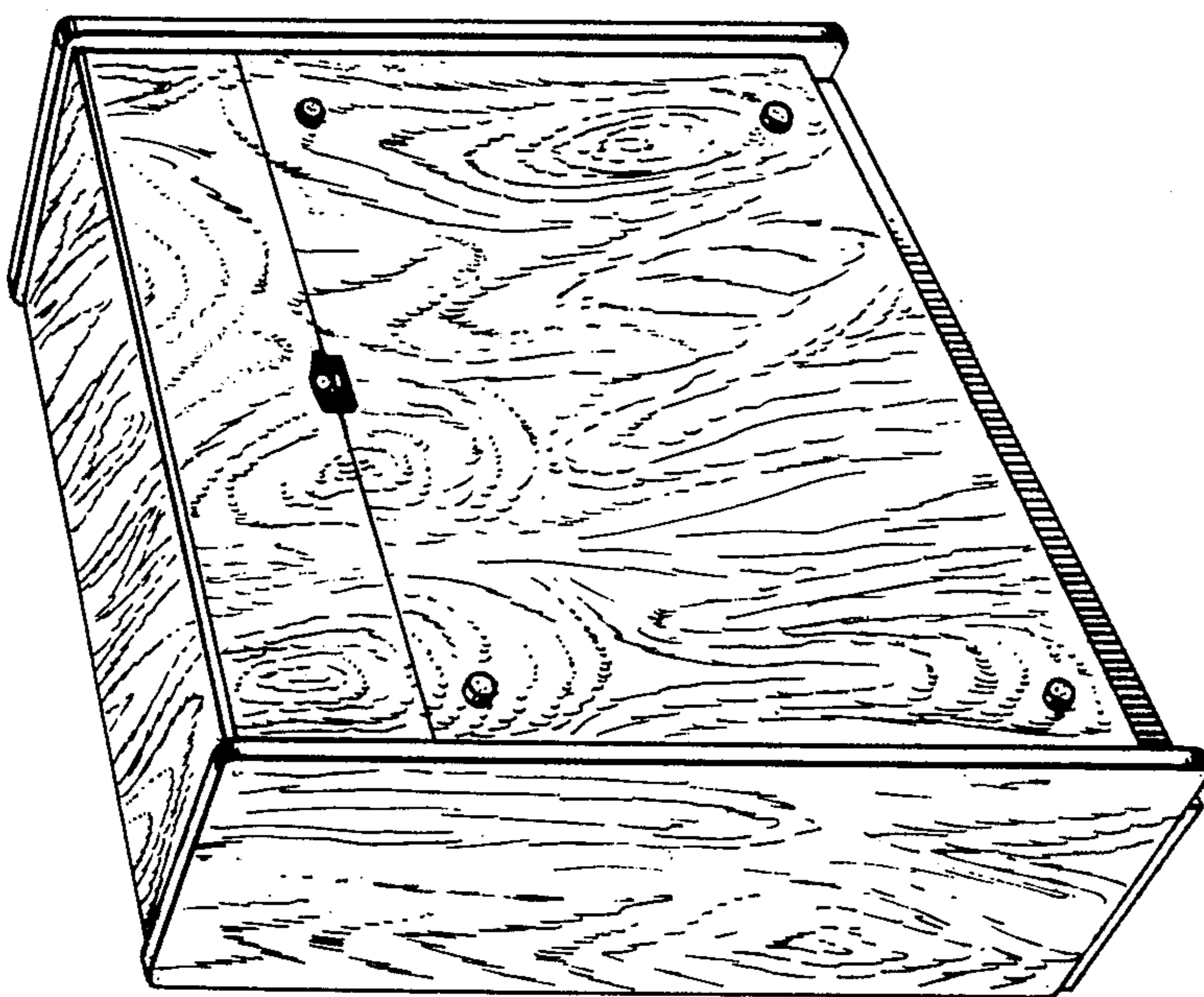

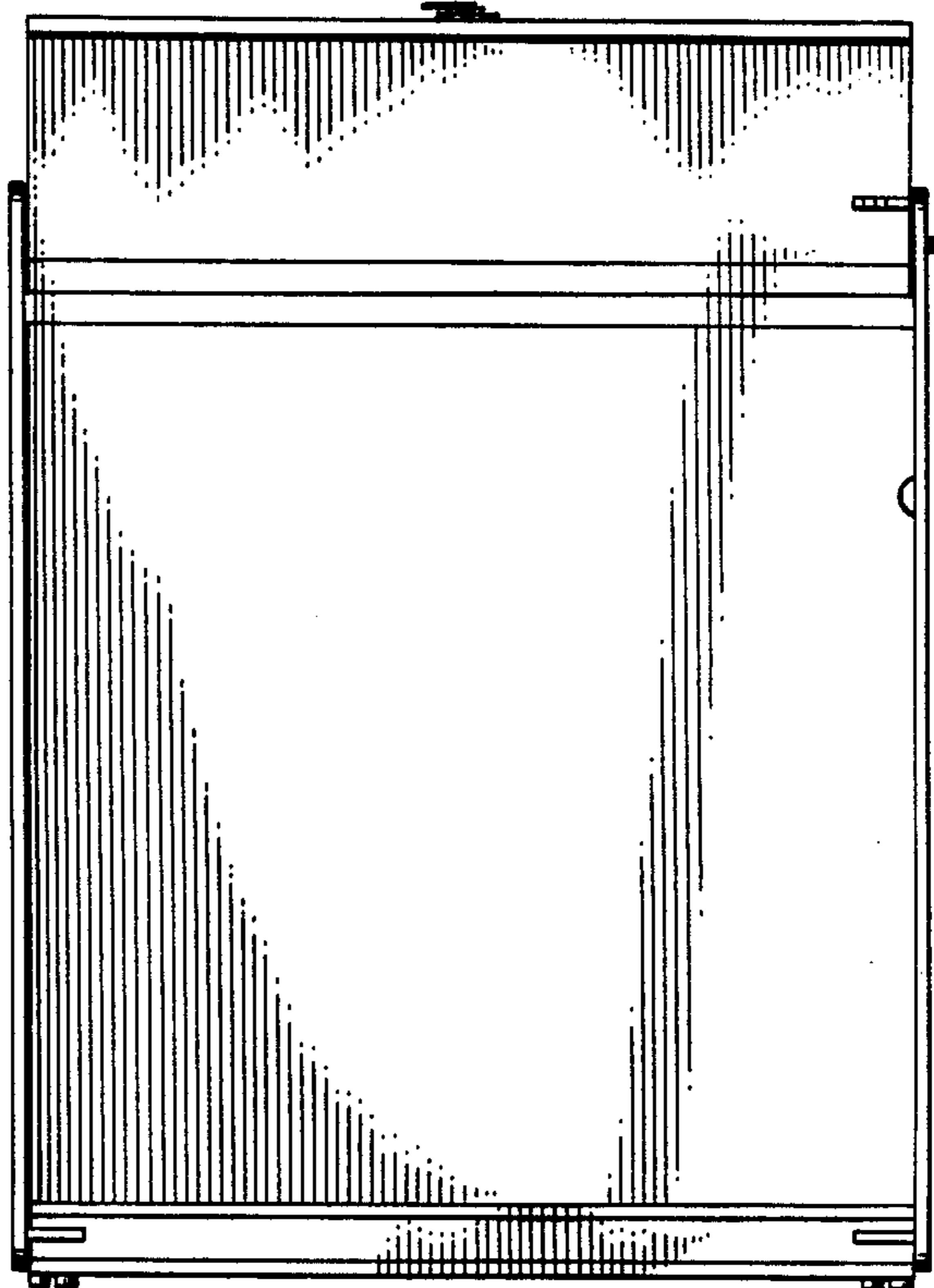
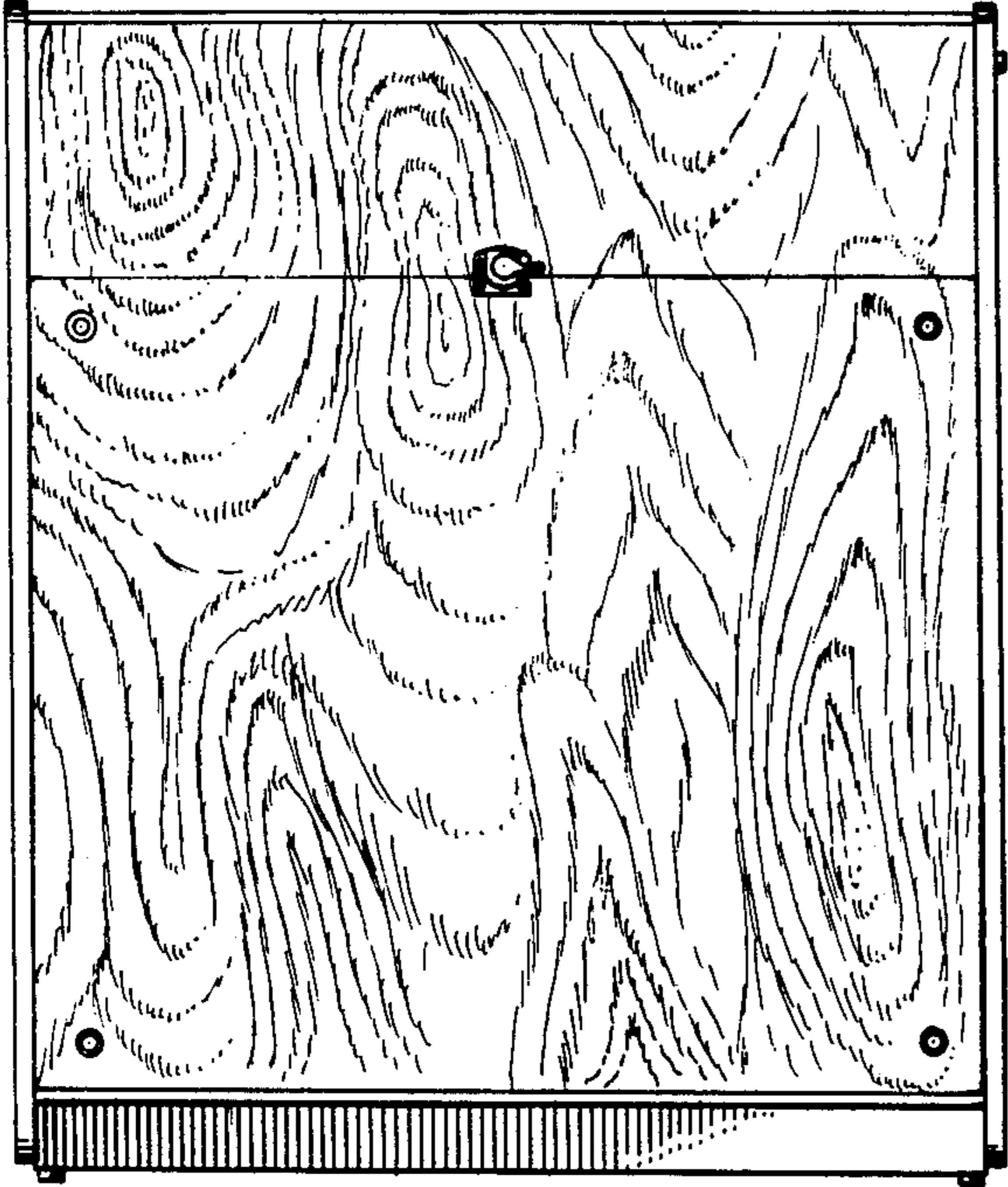

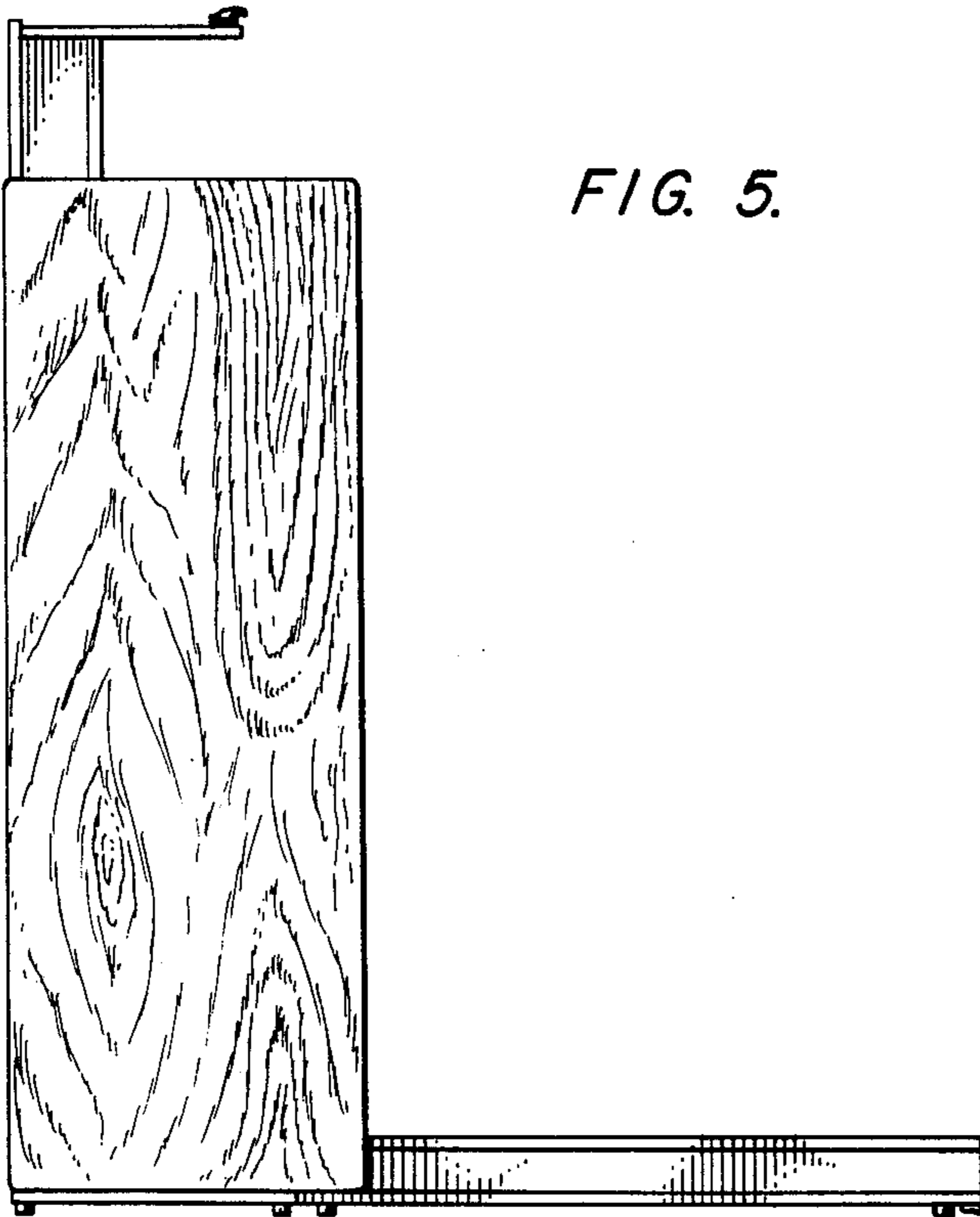

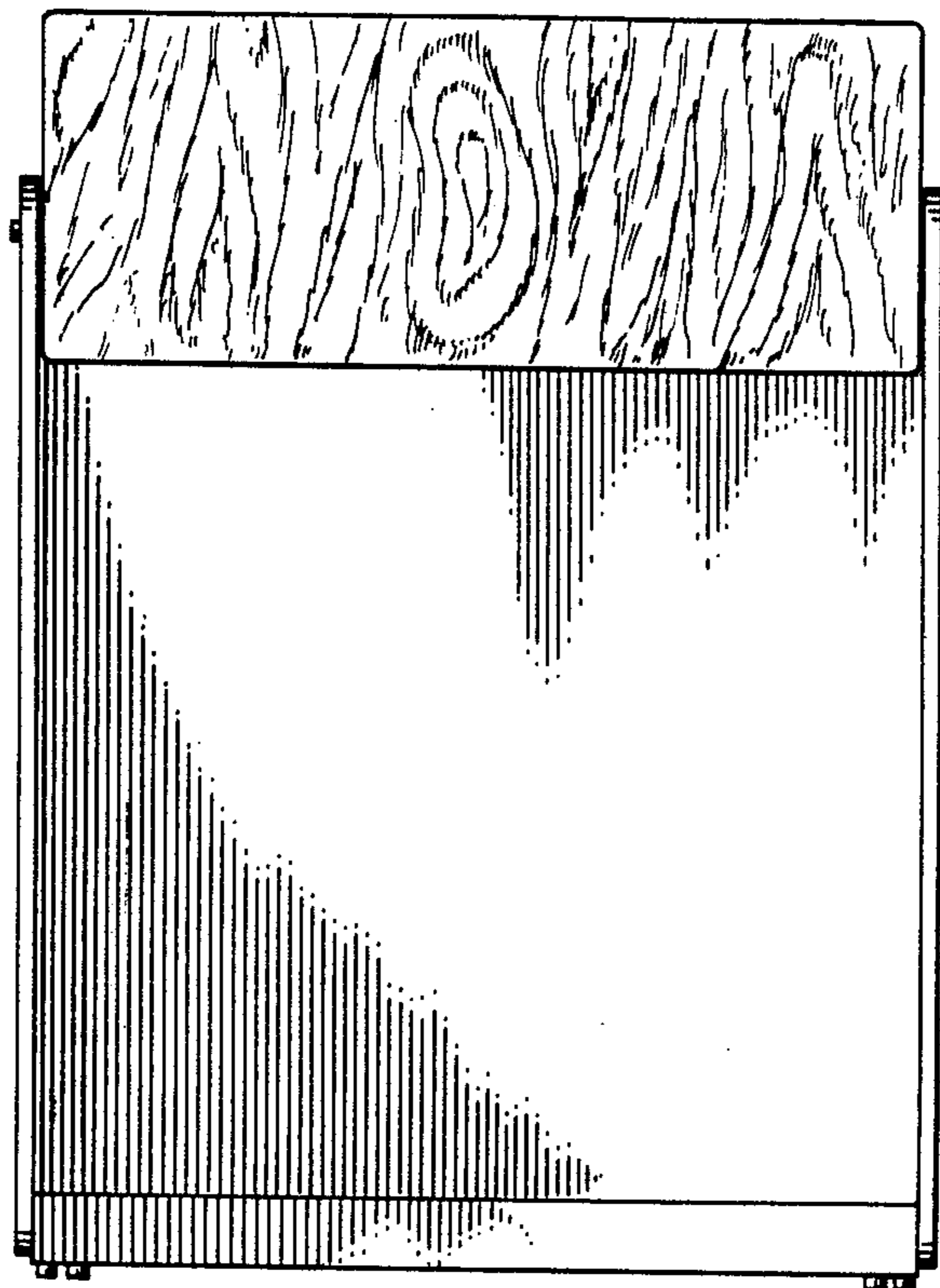
