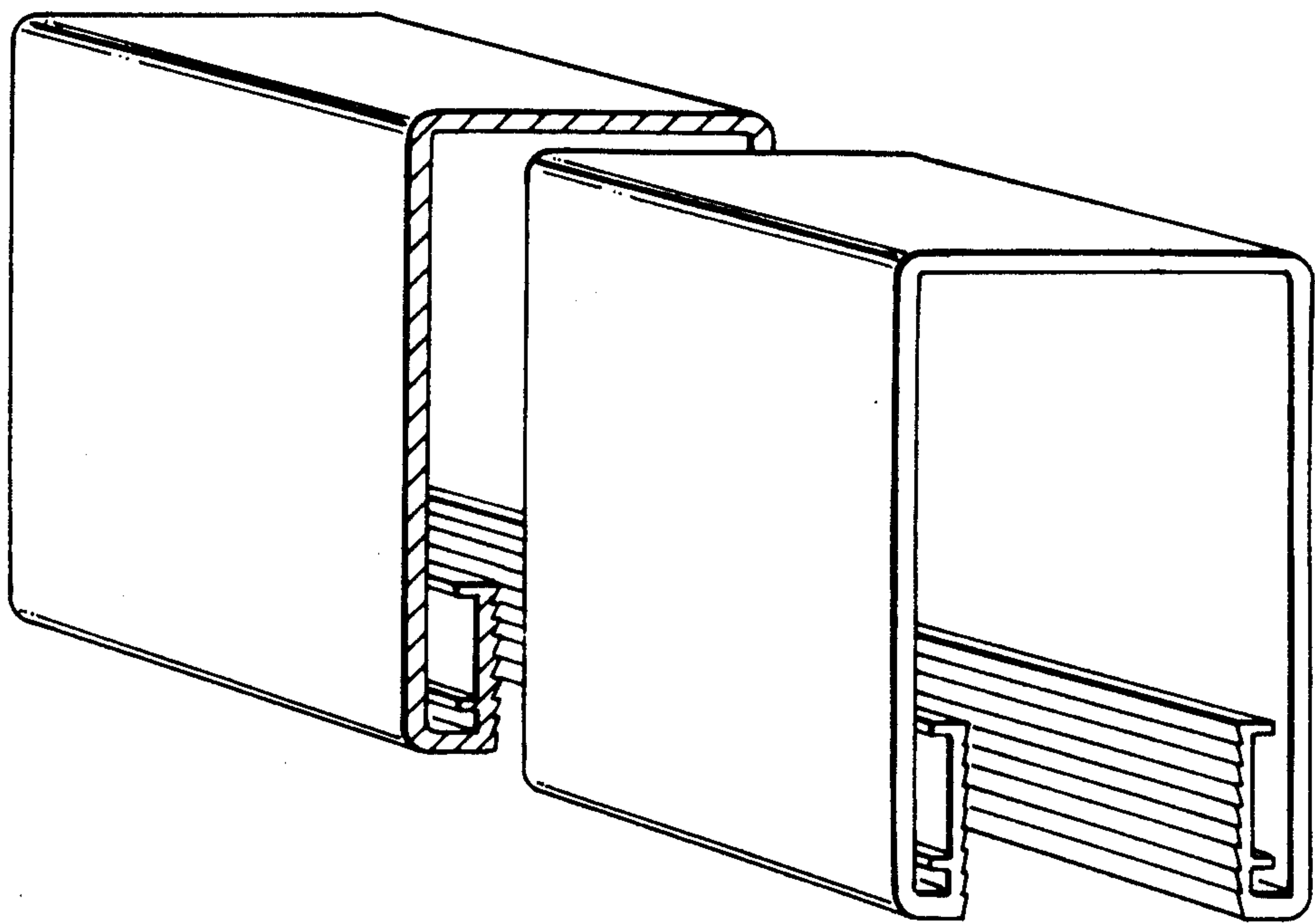

opposite side of the extrusion compared to FIG. 1.



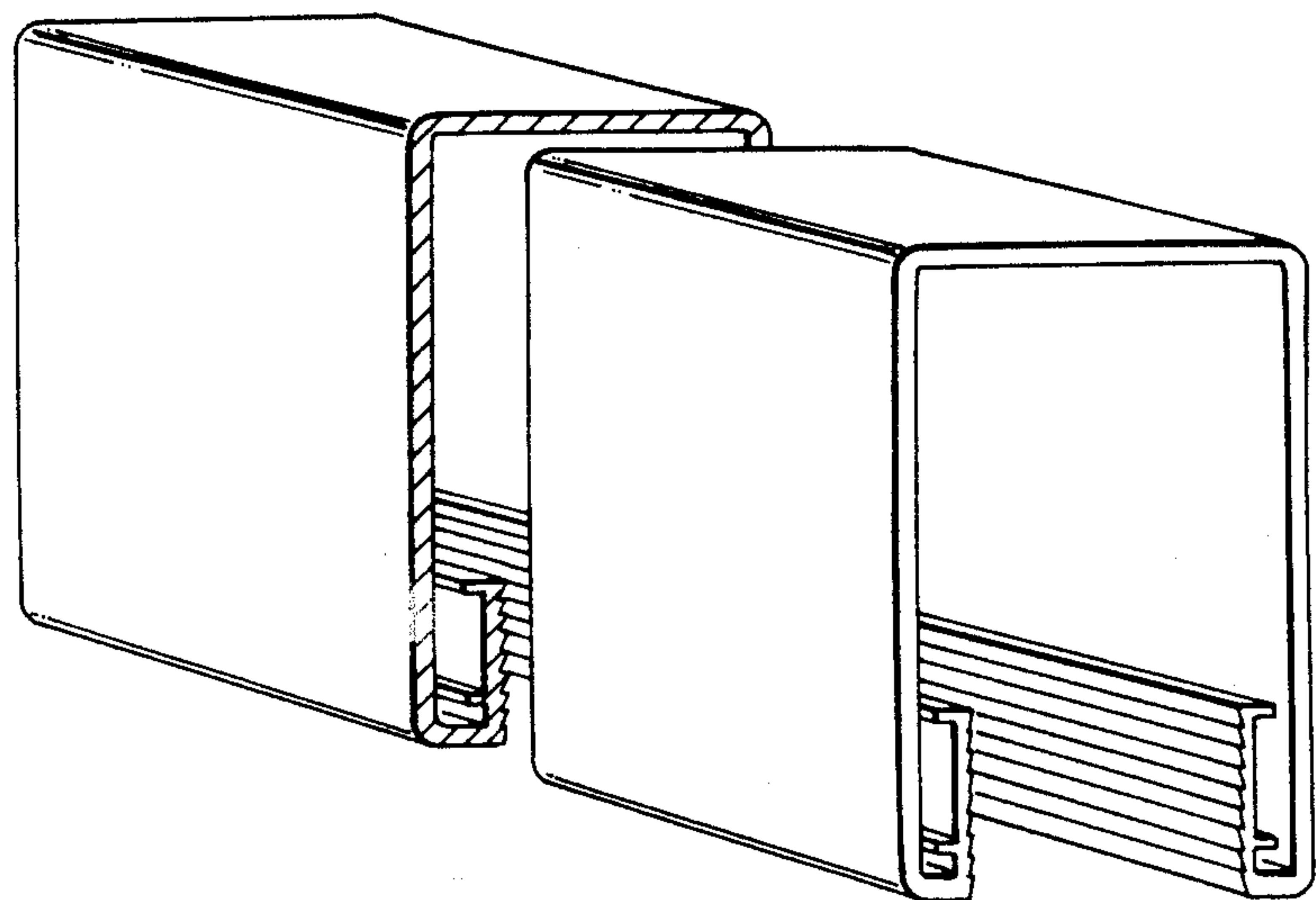

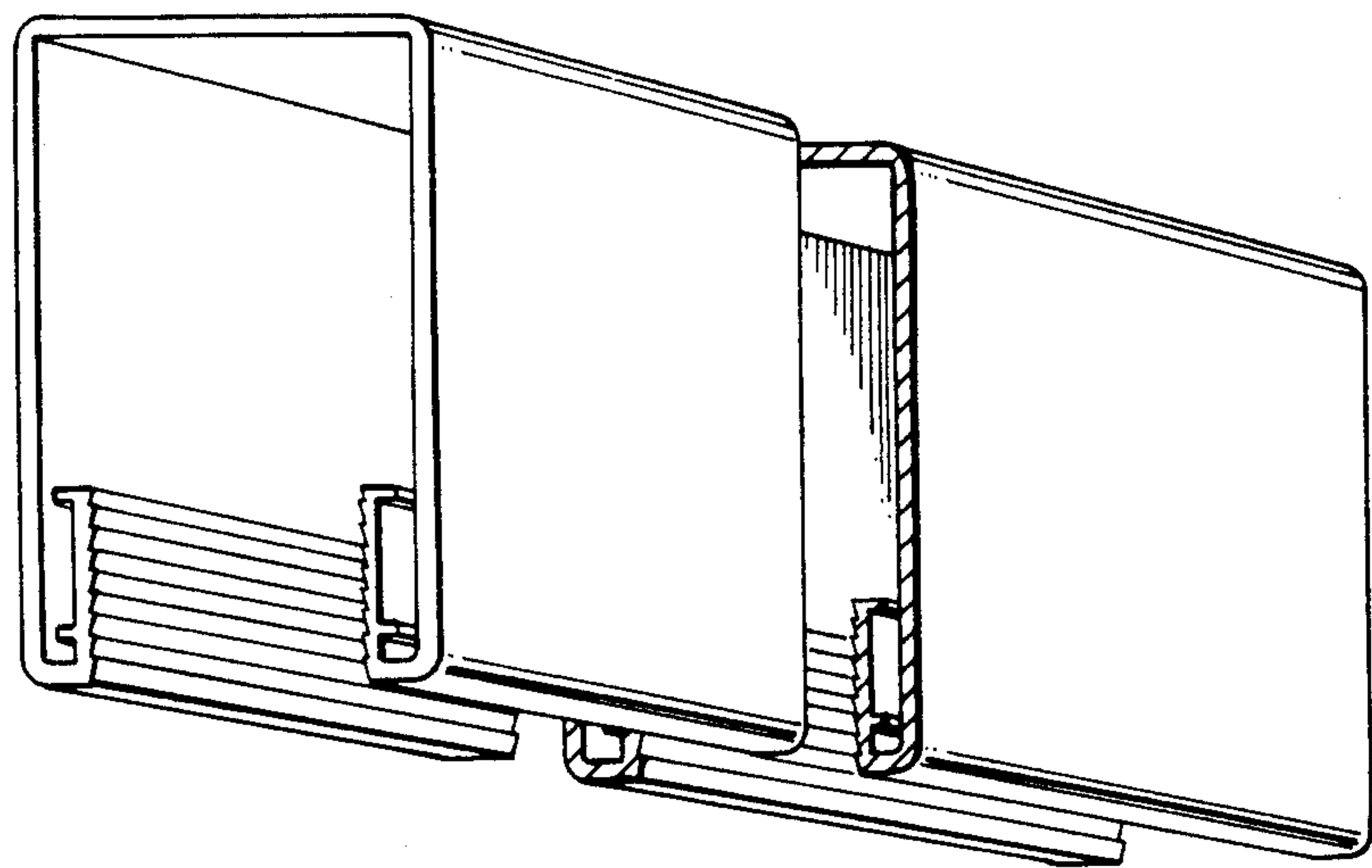
