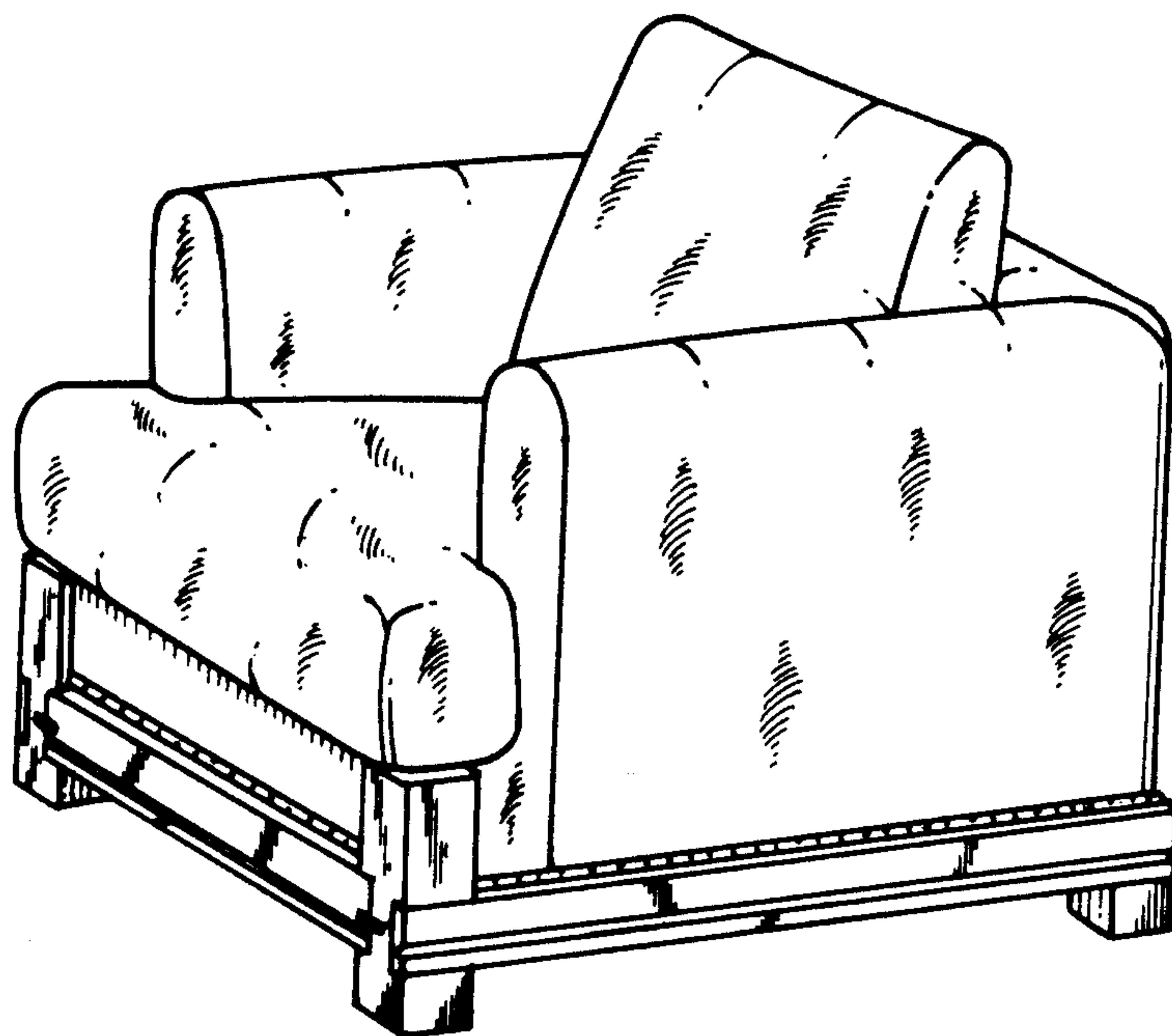

FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view of the seat shown in the form of a loveseat.



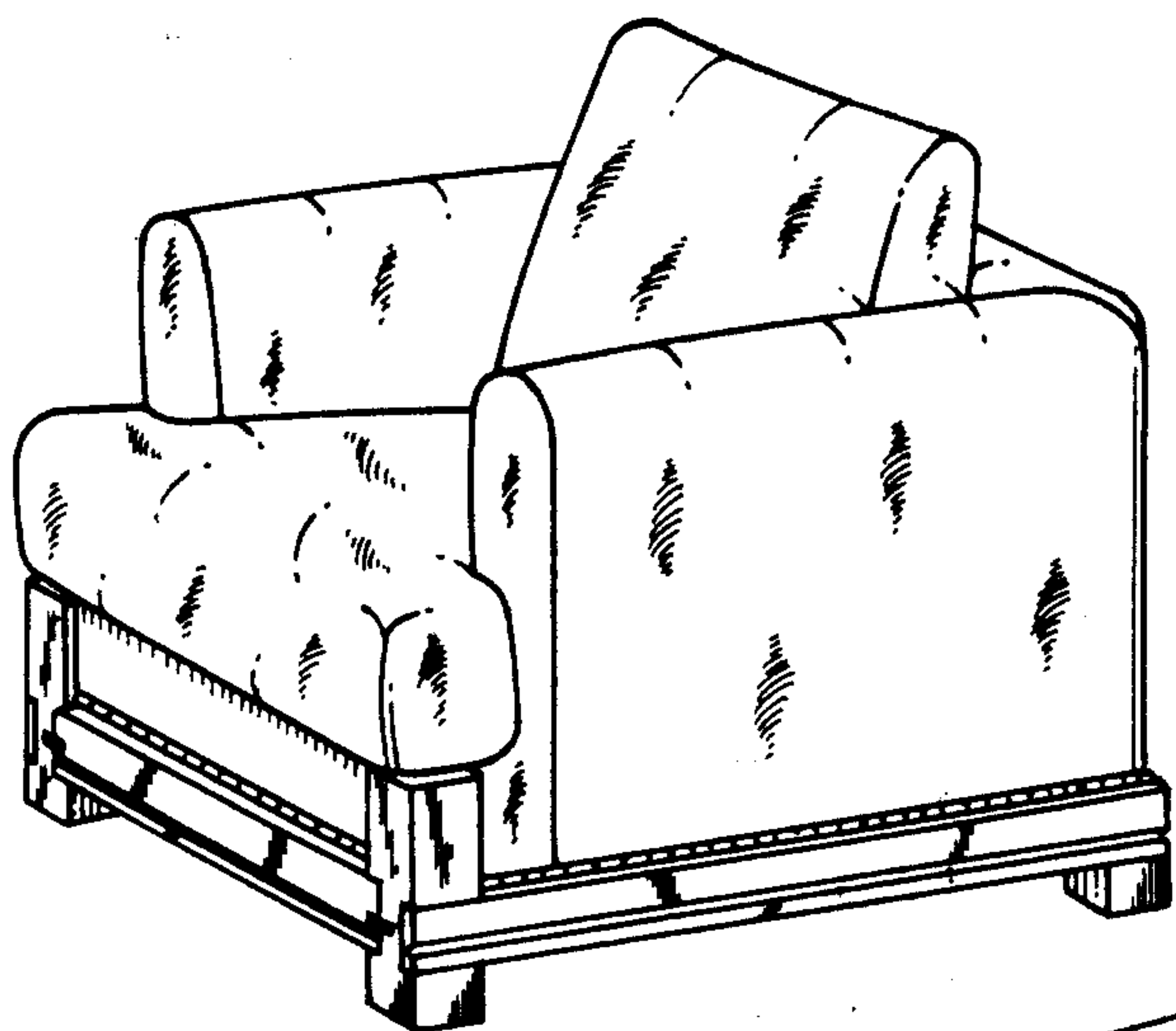

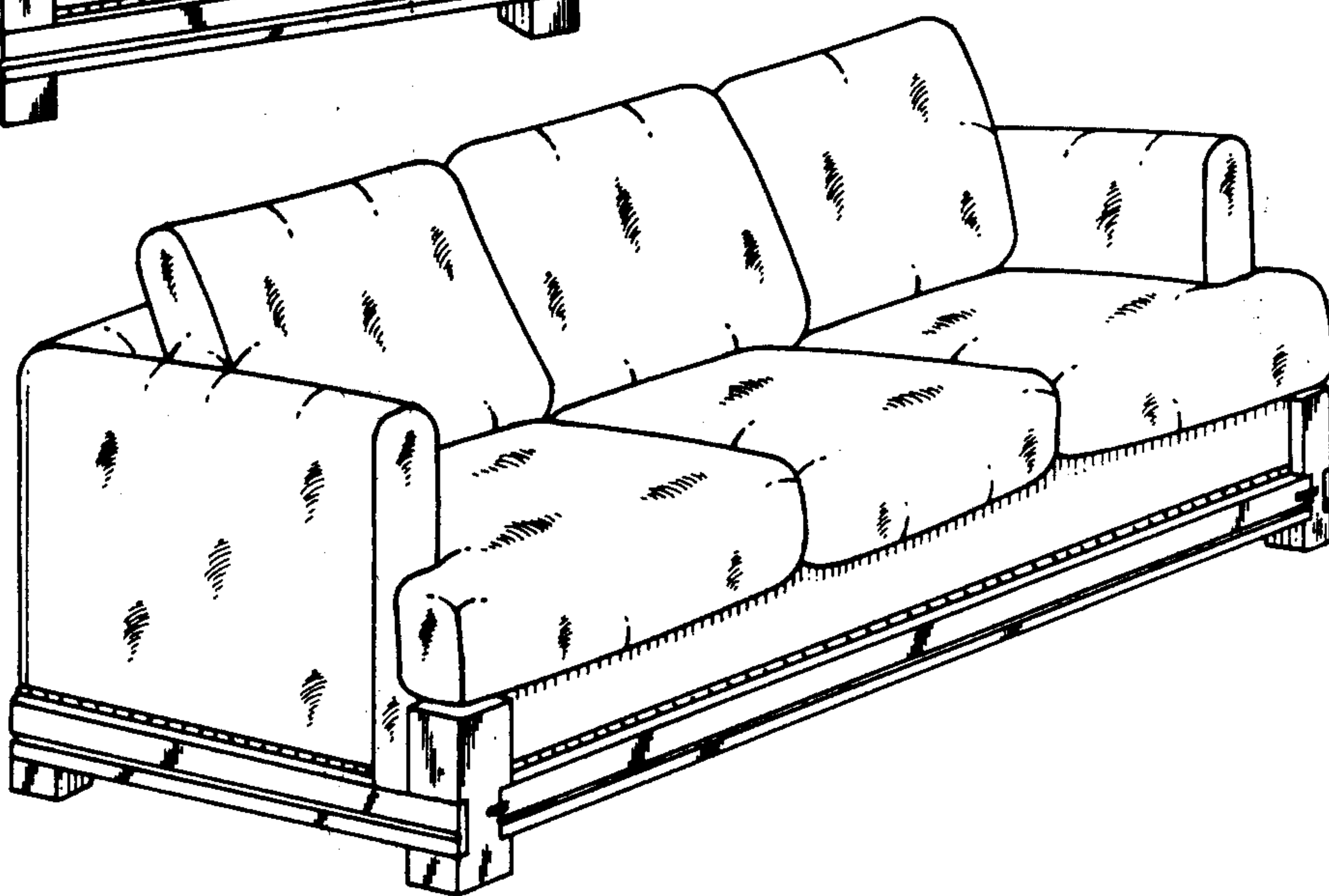

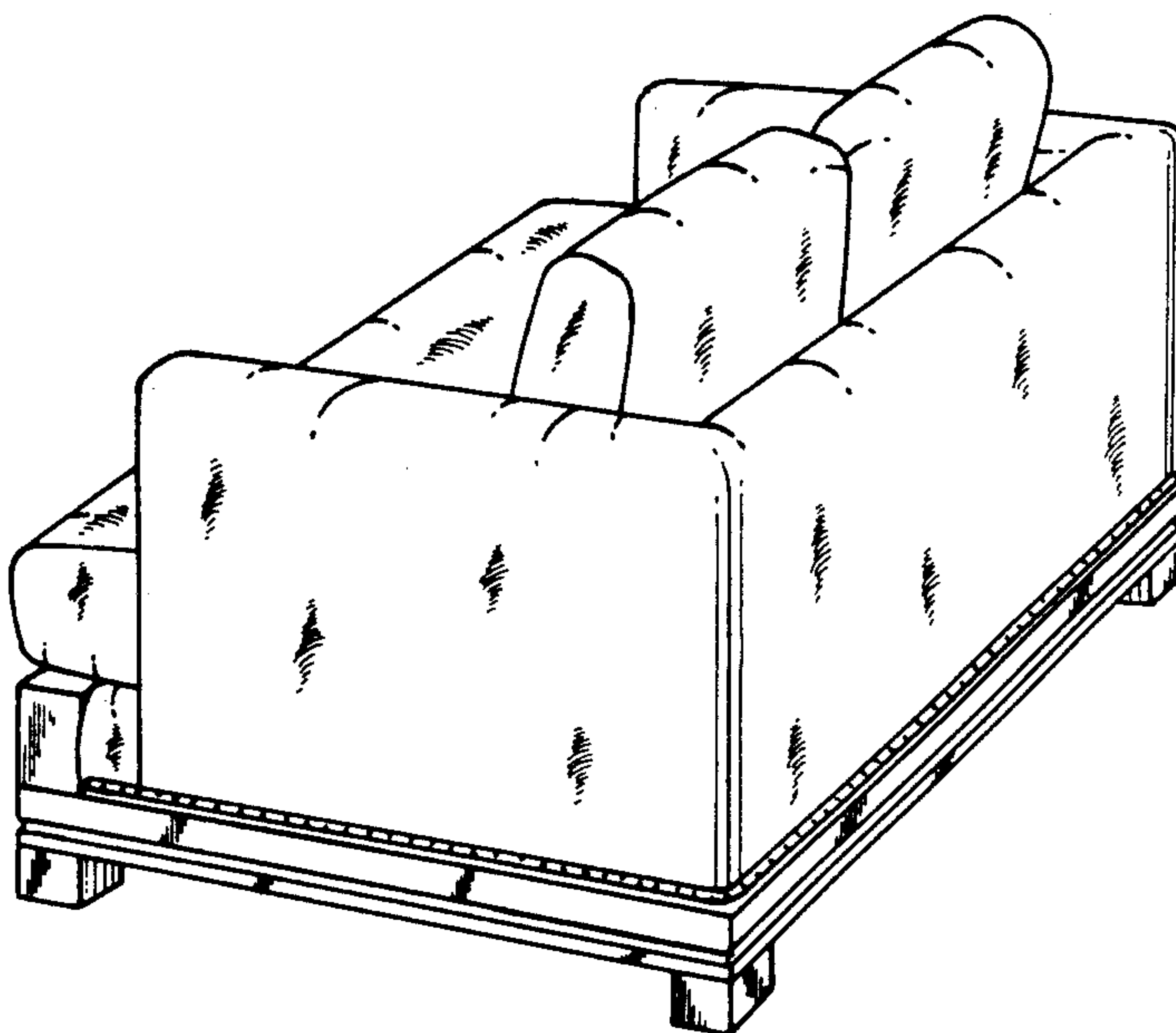
